SPIKEPHIL was loose on the lead in the beginning, set an even pace while having company on the outside at the half, battled on the rail around the last turn keeping a head in front of a pesky outside foe with a quarter mile from home, edged away in the two path in upper stretch, had company on both sides bearing down on him at the furlong marker but stubbornly dug in between rivals finding more in deep stretch to hold on bravely in a three way photo for the win. BRIGHT ANGEL (IRE) had a good spot tucked in on the fence, shifted out at the quarter pole off the contesting duo up front, loomed in the four path at the head of the lane, determinedly fought on outside of two others to the wire but was denied the win in a blanket finish for the top spot. ACCELERANDO travelled in midfield between foes in the three path on the initial turn, remained under a snug hold with runners on either side making little change along the backside, was checked just starting to make a run when the inside rival shifted out at the quarter marker, regained momentum inside horses just off the fence coming on the furlong pole and almost got there at the finish line in a tight picture for the top three placings. ENCORE MO was unhurried, trailing on the first turn, shared the rear outside a runner down the back straightaway, was scrubbed on for more making little headway around the last bend but did pick up a couple of tired rivals in the stretch running to settle for a minor role in the end. MAC GOWAN broke out on the start, recovered to track the pacesetter on the outside around the first of two turns, took closer order hounding the inside frontrunner down the backstretch, duelled outside on the final bend at the quarter pole, shifted to the three path at the top of the lane but weakened between horses in the final furlong. CASTLE HARBOUR travelled four wide around runners in midfield early on, remained outside foes three deep still in the middle of the pack down the backside, was under a busy ride trying to keep up to others while three wide around the far turn, moved to the five-path turning for home but had little to offer down the lane. ZIP TO ZAP was bumped by the inside rival at the break, stalked near the rear on the inside in the beginning, co-trailed with an outside foe along the back straight, could not

get into gear taking the short way around the final bend coming under a ride and could not factor in the stretch drive on the fence.

CLOSING APPEAL broke in a bit but gathered well moving forward in behind the leaders to track, bided time late on the turn, had room inside at the top of the stretch, was put to urging nearing the furlong marker making a bid up the rail and taking over, drew clear and held under vigorous hand urging late. HOPE SHE FIRES was away well between runners at the fore early, continued to stalk or press from outside just off the leader, was carried five wide into upper stretch by that rival, fought on to defeat that one for the place. CALL ME MISSLUCKY was lightly brushed at the start but still soon went to the lead, set the tempo inside shadowed by a foe, drifted out a few paths leaving the turn, was no match for the winner and outfinished for second. DANISH COOKIE settled outside off the pace, shifted in a bit racing in behind the leaders into the turn three to four deep, came into upper stretch five wide then altered in once in upper stretch, ran on inside but needed more. YA NO took back and shifted in moving forward inside in an early advance, was ridden along past the three-eighths to keep up, moved out at the five-sixteenths swinging ten wide into upper stretch, was not a threat. THE SCARLET TIARA was away well and among the early leaders, continued to chase from outside going four wide on the turn and under a ride by the five-sixteenths, floated six wide into upper stretch and weakened. FLIGHTMARE broke a half-step slowly, raced well back outside early, shifted in on the turn, failed to menace. HOW NOON IS NOW broke awkwardly bumping a rival lightly in the process, brought up the rear inside, angled five wide at the top of the stretch, was not a factor.

AUSSIE HYPER tracked the pacesetter on the outside, edged up by the half, moved in to battle outside bobbing heads for the lead with the inside frontrunner throughout the final bend, shifted to the three path between foes finally wearing down the early leader inside by the sixteenth pole and cleared off late to win going away at the finish line. PRINCESSONAMMISSION had good inside position drafting the pacesetter for the first part of the two turn race, sat all alone watching the engaged duo with a half mile still to run, shifted out being coaxed for more at the quarter pole to be four wide in the mix at the head of the lane outside of rivals, plugged away throughout the stretch and finished up solidly in the late going but was non-threatening second best at the wire. ECLIPTICAL LADYBUG assumed command from the outside setting a soft pace, remained up top by a narrow margin while pressed outside down the backstretch at the half, battled head-to-head midway through the final turn inside, determinedly continued to fight it out between foes with a furlong to go but faded in the late going to hold for the show award. SERENADING AMAYA trailed the field on the first turn, lagged behind seeming to be uninterested along the backside, could see the field but was starting to come up to runners at the quarter pole, lengthened stride just off the fence turning for home, shifted out at the four path with a furlong to go and found its best stride late, closing in to be a fringe player at the end. POWAQA broke a step slow on the start, stalked close to the back end inside of horses in the early going, started to uncork a rally under a busy ride at the quarter pole, moved in hugging the rail in upper stretch in with a chance for a piece of the prize early in the stretch running but flattened out inside of rivals by the sixteenth pole. RELOAD EH travelled three wide settling near the rear outside of foes in the first of two turns, galloped along having only one runner beaten along the backside, made little impression around the second bend and emptied out in the five path by the top of the stretch.

PHILLIP MY WINE broke in slightly brushing the inside rival on the start, recovered to press the pace three wide under the wire for the first time, was wisely gathered back moving closer to the fence off the contesting front pair heading into the first bend, tracked the pacesetter who was setting a brisk tempo down the backstretch, began to reel in the leader at the three eighths pole, edged up through the turn measuring the frontrunner, pounced three wide in upper stretch bracing for the battle down the lane, duelled outside holding his ground with the leader fighting gamely to the wire and found more late to inch away in the last few jumps for the win. NORTH YORK set a pressured pace inside, dueled under increased pressure through the far turn, edged away by mid-stretch, held. ELISSA'S MACHO was bumped fairly hard at the start but recovered well to stalked from between runners in the second flight, was ridden along past the five-sixteenths, came out five wide turning for home, gained steadily in the lane but was not enough. CHOCOLATECROISSANT (IRE) hopped at the start, settled off the pace inside saving ground, came out in upper stretch, split foes past the furlong marker, was even late. RED GUITAR broke awkwardly and bumped a rival, settled at the back off the inside, moved up between foes at the half, was asked at the quarter emerging from between rivals and shifting seven wide into upper stretch, ran on steadily outside to improve position. SHE REIGNS was caught outside three to four wide, raced a bit keenly in the early going pulling against restraint, came into upper stretch six wide, ran on evenly. HEART TAP tracked inside the second flight, was one-paced and made no bid. LET'S GO SOUPER pressed the eventual winner from outside, was on even terms up the backstretch, dueled on the far turn, faltered in the stretch. BERMUDA BREW was outside off the pace four to five wide, shifted in at the top of the stretch, failed to menace.

SAUCY NAME was roused from the onset with intent getting the early lead, maintained a narrow advantage on the rail midway around the bend, relinquished the front end briefly inside of two rivals at the quarter pole, regained control edging away under a well rationed ride in upper stretch and pulled

away for the win in the final sixteenth of a mile. SOBIECH prompted the pace on the rail to begin, was throttled down on the fence just behind the leader now watching the lead threesome fight it out at the three eighths marker, kept pace with the leaders taking the short way around the bend, moved to the rail in the final furlong unable to threaten winner late but did show grit inside to dig in capturing the secondary award in photo. GIZMO'S B F F tracked the engaged duo while outside foes down the back straight, advanced on the outside at the seven sixteenths pole to be part of the lead trio while widest in the three path around the turn fighting for the top spot, briefly had a head in front with a quarter mile to run, shifted to the five path still in the hunt in upper stretch, drifted out in the final furlong and lost the battle for the place share in deep stretch. NAUGHTY DESTINY had good early position watching the lead pair initially, moved in together with the outside rival at the half, vied between horses arguing on the front end around the turn angled in the four path between runners in the thick of it all straightening out for the drive but stalled at the eighth pole just lasting in a tight finish for the minors at the wire. HOLIDAY ROSE had a stalking role near the rear, began to pick up the bit on the fence by midturn, angled out four wide at the quarter pole, shifted back inside to the two path in mid-stretch and had good late energy finishing up well in the late going. LADY MOONSHINE was part of the back threesome having the inside on the fence down the backside, saved ground but was making little progression through the bend and while in the two path found its best stride late finishing with good intent in the final furlong. WILDFIRE travelled in mid-pack between horses, settled on the outside of another in range of the lead trio tracking in the second flight around the turn, offered a mild rally at the quarter marker to be in with a chance six wide at the top of the stretch but flattened out not switching leads in the final furlong. SHAMRA tossed her head on the break, shared the rear going three deep along the backstretch, made little headway just off the fence in the turn running, shifted to the five path for the drive to the wire but could not get involved. ZIPFIRE broke inwards at the start, settled in midfield having rivals on either side along the back straight, crept closer travelling outside runners three wide around the oval making a brief rally in midturn but drifted out weakening widest in the seven path at the head of the lane and could no make his presence felt in the late going. NO VISOR stalked between horses at the back of the pack in the beginning, was asked for more offering no response when relegated to the rear at the five sixteenths pole, scraped paint turning for home had had little to show for in the stretch drive.
