HALCON NEGRO was allowed to find his stride well behind the pack out of trouble down the backside, continued to see the field on the turn, began to warm up to the task shifting out by the quarter pole, swung out widest gathering more speed having clear run in the seven-path turning for home and was in full flight powering past with authority by the sixteenth pole to win going away easily when crossing the finish line. CARRICK ON STAGE had the fence rating kindly sitting in the middle of the pack, waited for cue to move having the rail in the second flight inside another around the oval, scraped paint to be in the hunt turning for home, lacked running room stuck behind the tiring frontrunner at the furlong pole, finally had a clear lane bursting through inside by the sixteenth pole coming with solid late kick but was no match for the winner who was opening up in full stride by then. SILENT KNIGHT broke out on the start, settled in midfield outside another along the back straight, sat poised watching the engaged duo while still outside a runner throughout the turn, moved in splitting horses three wide in the mix at the top of the stretch and finished up mildly to be a clear third at the wire. FIRSTGENERAL NIKAO was forced out by the troubled runner when entering the back straight, recovered to press the issue along the backside on the outside, chased the pacesetter throughout the turn, shifted to the six path between foes in upper stretch and ran on evenly to settle on the fringes in the end. CROSBY was brushed by the inside foe on the break, then had to be checked avoiding the bearing out horse early on down the backside, recouped to have the lead by the nine sixteenths pole, maintained a slim advantage taking the short way around the turn, had the two-path getting weary clinging onto the front end at the furlong pole but had little left to give in deep stretch and tired in the final sixteenth of a mile. IDEALSANDDREAMS was under a hustling ride leaving the gate, bore out badly when entering the backstretch despite the riders best efforts at the eleven sixteenths pole, was on the outer fence attempting to be pulled up by the half, was corralled by the outrider around the turn and walked off. STEWARDS INQUIRY REGARDING #2 IDEALSANDDREAMS DOWN THE BACKSTRETCH RESULTED IN NO CHANGE

NIKITA'S GEM tracked the pace inside, patiently waited on the far turn before moving out three wide coming past the quarter pole, struck a narrow lead in upper stretch, edged away under steady handling. READY TO BATTLE pressed the pacesetter from outside, took a brief and narrow lead at the quarter pole, was overtaken by the winner in upper stretch, proved no match but was second best. ENGLISH JUBILEE settled mid-pack inside, saved ground both turns, angled four to five wide at the top of the stretch, ran on from between runners late and held show honors. STARSHIP SERENITY settled at the back inside a rival but off the fence, waited inside and behind runners at the five-sixteenths then moved out a path or two, was guided six wide in mid-stretch, kicked on mildly outside. PEACE POSEY was urged forward from the start four then three wide stalking up the backstretch, dropped back and shifted in past the five-sixteenths, came out a bit in upper stretch, ran on but needed more. ANITA MARGARITA set a pressured pace inside, gave way. DREAMS

AND SCHEMES settled outside at the rear, was ridden along at the five-sixteenths, swung eight wide into upper stretch, was lightly bumped in mid-stretch. BELLA CLASSICA was urged forward at the start, settled outside mid-division stalking three to four wide, was ridden past the seven-sixteenths, moved out in upper stretch bumping a rival in the process. LEZIATE was taken hold early heading to the first turn, chased from between runners, dropped back and faded.

CONN SMYTHE (GB) was tucked in on the rail watching the lead trio, settled into a good rhythm galloping along in the second flight inside down the back straight, waited to move on the far turn liking what he saw tracking the contesting trio, moved outside at the quarter pole unleashing a rally, pounced four wide in upper stretch and went by at the sixteenth pole to edge clear for the late charging win when crossing the finish line. SHAMATEUR had the lead setting a moderate pace into the headwind early on, narrowly maintained the advantage quickening the wind aided tempo along the backside, was collared by a couple of outside rivals at the quarter pole, fought on valiantly inside of runners to the wire but was just second best behind the winner who had an ideal set up throughout the race. GRANDE SOIREE was in the fray up front between horses in the beginning, was reined back sitting outside the eventual winner while watching the lead pair down the backstretch, moved into contention three wide at the five sixteenths pole, loomed in the four path turning for home, drifting inwards driving up top coming to the eighth pole, did not switch leads through the lane and faded in the last sixteenth lasting for the show money. THREE SONNY SIDEUP prompted the pace going three wide around the first of two turns, took even closer order flanking the frontrunner outside down the backstretch, dueled between horses on the second bend at the quarter pole, had to be checked losing his path three wide between foes at the top of the lane losing all momentum but did show some resolve to come back on trying to get the show award in deep stretch. ARMINO tossed its head on the start, trailing in the early stages, remained at the rear down the backside, could not make any impact on the final bend, moved out three wide for the drive to the finish line and managed to pass a weary rival on the inside in upper stretch. AMAZIN QUEEN had a stalking trip ahead of only the poor starter, made

little impression down the backside and through the last turn and came up empty just off the fence in upper stretch. RIDERS CLAIM OF FOUL #3 THREE SONNY SETUP AGAINST #4 GRANDE SOIREE AS WELL AS A STEWARD'S INQUIRY IN UPPER STRETCH RESULTED IN #4 GRANDE SOIREE BE DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED FOURTH FOR INTERFERENCE

HAPPY QUAD was unhurried at the back end in the early stages, began to pick up the bit saving ground throughout the turn making a good rally at the quarter pole, skimmed the fence at the top of the stretch having a clear lane, shot through taking control by the furlong marker inside of runners and was kept to the task late holding comfortably for the win at the wire. FAIRWAY TO HEAVEN travelled on the fence sitting in mid-division along the backside, had a good spot on the rail waiting behind the embattled duo under a snug hold around the turn, opted to take to overland route shifting outwards off the front pair at the quarter marker, was stuck behind the tiring early leaders three wide in upper stretch with nowhere to go, finally shifted out getting clear run in the five path with a furlong to go, could not get to the winner late but made a good late charge getting the runners up share in a tight photo at the finish line. JMR SPEEDY ESCAPE was on the outside of two rivals going three deep in midfield down the backstretch, made a circling move rallying three wide in midturn, shifted to the four path fighting for the lead outside in upper stretch, chased the winner in vain in the final furlong and just got nabbed outside right on the line for the second-place share at the finish line. ABSOLUTE CHAIRMAN had the lead outside another initially, got to the rail up front by a narrow margin going into the turn, battled inside going head-to-head around the oval, was just holding on two wide in upper stretch with rivals bearing down on either side, yielded by the furlong pole but did show some grit to come back on in the final few jumps for a minor placing in the end. BENNYS JETS was hustled on the start forcing the issue on the inside at the start, was then reined back at the nine sixteenths pole letting the leader go on, came back to re-engage on the outside heading into the bend, dueled outside for the top spot around the turn, remained in the thick of it all in the three path between foes

turning for home but tired in the final furlong. TRINIDAD travelled in the middle of the pack with runners on either side at the half mile marker, was nudged for more on the fence at the three furlong marker offering little response, retreated between horses at the quarter pole to be at the rear straightening out for home and could only pass a weary outside rival in upper stretch. CRUCIAL TAUNT had a stalking role on the outside down the backstretch, made no headway going three wide around the oval, shifted out widest in the five path for the stretch drive but failed to menace in the late running.

DELTA FORCE moved forward three wide into the first turn, pressed the early pace then took the lead by the five-eighths and edged away dictating terms in the clear outside the half, was put to vigorous hand urging in upper stretch and held foes while kept to task. BIG SCREEN BOSS was sent clear and shifted in heading to the first turn setting the early tempo, was overtaken by the five-eighths and stalked the leader up the backstretch, switched outside that one, kept on in the lane between runners late for the place. NOT A CARE was bumped at the start, switched out off the inside settling at the rear, advanced four to five wide on the far turn, continued to gain late, was transported off the track via equine ambulance. GONE HUNTING bumped a rival at the start, had forward position heading to the first turn switching out off the inside but was in a bit tight early on that bend, settled just off the leading pair stalking outside,

ALLEY OOP JOHNNY broke in at the start, assumed command heading into the first turn, dictated an even pace up top along the backside, was nudged along holding onto the front end by a slim margin with an outside foe turning up the heat, shifted two wide still holding on in upper stretch and prevailed in the stretch duel, inching away for the wire-to-wire score in the final few jumps. SWAN LAKE was content to track the pacesetter outside in the beginning, took closer order to hound the leader outside down the backstretch, continued to determinedly battle outside going head-to-head around the final bend, shifted to the three path still fighting on outside down the entire stretch drive but could not get by the winner in the late going. GRAFFITI WRITER had a good trip nestled on the rail, rated kindly well in hand watching the twosome argue up top down the backside, took the short way around the last turn keeping pace while scrubbed on for more and finished up willingly but was a non-threatening third at the wire. GOOD SIN was pushed in and squeezed at the start, recovered to sit in midfield while going three wide outside of horses on the initial turn, travelled in the second flight outside another foe keeping a close eye on the engaged lead couple down the backside, came under a drive chasing the front duo but to no avail on the second turn and ran on mildly

down the lane to garner a minor placing in the end. DELIAN LEAGUE was pushed in on the break, shared the rear inside another early on, had the fence part of the rear threesome down the backside, angled out at the five sixteenths pole coming with a mild rally on the final turn but could not sustain the run in the stretch drive. SAILOR'S PASSION travelled three wide near the rear, was part of the back trio between rivals with a half mile remaining, had to be checked in tight with runners on each side leaving the five sixteenths pole losing all momentum and could not recover pose a threat in the drive to the finish line. PET SOUNDS was in tight on the break, co-trailed outside another around the first of two turns, settled at the back end three deep outside of horses at the half, could not improve around horses going three to five wide through the second turn and made no impact, having little to offer in the stretch run.

PAYNES SPIRIT was under a snug hold travelling well just outside off the pacemaker along the backside, edged up shadowing the frontrunner outside on the bend, loomed menacingly three wide between horses turning for home, battled relentlessly outside in the final furlong and grinded away on the leader in deep stretch to inch away for the win in the final few strides. PHILIP BANKS broke sharp getting the early advantage, controlled the pace moving comfortably up top by a narrow margin throughout the turn, was holding on just off the rail at the top of the lane, had the winner outside bearing down at the furlong pole, battled stubbornly inside in the final sixteenth of a mile but could hold on nearing the wire losing the nod at the finish line. SPEEDY BEAR drafted behind the frontrunner having the fence down the backstretch, settled smartly on the rail in the second flight watching the contesting pair around the oval, shifted to the two path for the drive, was no match for the lead twosome who had it to themselves in the final furlong but closed belatedly to win the show battle inside in deep stretch. NEXT PITCH settled in midfield going three deep outside of runners, moved to the lead duo going three wide outside of horses on the turn by the quarter pole, shifted to the four path in the thick of things straightening out for home but stalled with a sixteenth remaining settling for a minor placing in the end. DEWOLF travelled with runners on either side sitting in mid-pack, was roused for more between horses in midturn, offered little response unable to quicken with others by the quarter pole and finished up in the three path running one paced in the stretch drive. SUNDAY'S WELL was unhurried on the rail in the early going seeing the field, lagged well behind rivals in the running around the oval and could only manage to pass a weary straggler in deep stretch. SIGNATURE SIR hopped on the start, had a stalking role close to the back end down the backside, made little improvement around the bend and showed little, unable to offer any sort of offense in the stretch running.

EXUDE settled close to the back on the outside, ranged up, progressing between rivals at the half, rally sharply when called upon four wide at the five sixteenths pole outside foes, shifted to the six path full of run at the top of the stretch, drove by taking control by the furlong pole and was kept to the task late holding sway at the wire for the win. WELLER GREEN shared the rear inside another early on, stalked, ahead of only one runner with a half mile still to run, had a quick turn of foot when called upon at the quarter pole making a rally, was stuck behind a wall of runners going five wide at the top of the lane, had a clear run with a furlong to go and ran on smartly chasing the winner home to be second best at the finish line. DECADENT DANISH was under a tight hold in mid-division on the fence, started to come with a good run on the rail midway around the final turn, had to tap on the brakes on the fence when stuck behind the tiring early leader in upper stretch, shifted outside coming to the eighth pole, darted back inside on the rail with a sixteenth from home and got up late for the show money. BOWMAN'S RUN had a good spot on the fence watching the contesting trio for the first part of this route race, sat poised looking for a seam on the far turn behind the lead pair at the quarter pole, had a clear lane shifting to the four path turning for home, rallied at the eighth pole but was outkicked late losing a couple of positions nearing the wire and settled on the fringes in the end. RUNNER EYES was steadied sharply going under the wire for the very first time, recovered smartly to sit in midfield on the outside through the first bend, edged up some along the backside, tracked in the third tier with rivals on either side around the last turn, angled to the five path at the top of the stretch and showed good tenacity between horses fighting until the very end but was on the losing side of a three way photo for the show award. ITS IN THE CARDS co-trailed on the outside, advanced four deep outside of rivals down the back straight, tried to circle foes going four wide around the far turn, swung out widest to the seven path for the drive and finished gradually outside of horses in the final furlong. SEMPER LIBER had the rail sitting in midfield on the first turn, settled near the rear angling inwards to the fence when entering the back straight, dropped back a touch by the half, was slightly checked for a stride or two being shuffled inside at the five sixteenths pole, shifted to the two path straightening out for home but lacked sufficient running room unable to get fully into gear stuck behind foes in mid-stretch. IMYOURMEDICINEMAN had a tracking position just off the rail to begin, vied between runners taking closer order down the backside by the half, got a head in front between foes with five sixteenths from home, dueled three wide straightening out for the drive with the early leader still trying to come back on inside, drifted in slightly under a drive at the furlong pole battling in the mix up top but had little left late and tired in the final sixteenth of a mile. CONNOR was eager on the outside going three wide on the first turn chasing the pace, moved closer to prompt the issue three deep down the backside, was under a busy ride three wide still trying to keep up with the lead pair on the far turn at the quarter pole, shifted to the five path at the head of the lane but folded between horses in the final furlong. LONNY'S GAMBLE had a stalking position on the rail ahead of a couple of runners to begin, was checked on the rail coming to a halt when in tight with outside horses coming over early on down the backstretch, trailed the field by the half, lagged behind on the far turn, shifted out seven wide at the top of the stretch but did manage to pass another trouble runner in the late going. DRAW BOOT crossed over clearing to the rail setting a lively pace heading into the first turn, slowed the tempo down with the wind his back having a slim advantage inside a couple of rivals down the backstretch, was collared outside midway on the far turn, weakened in the two path in upper stretch relinquishing the lead, had to be steadied in tight on the fence at the furlong pole losing all action and dropped back through the field quickly thereafter.
