BLONDINA'S BOY assumed the lead on the fence setting a moderate pace in the beginning, continued galloping up top having a narrow advantage setting an even tempo along the backside, was well rationed out being nurses along still having a slim lead saving all the ground around the final bend, had company bearing down outside in upper stretch but had just a little more in reserve late to edge away again at the finish line. **LOST STAR** co-trailed on the outside down the backstretch, advanced three deep down the backside at the half, closed in circling around three wide on the second turn, shifted to the three path posing the only threat to the winner at the top of the lane, battled nose to nose outside down the stretch but was denied the win in a tight finish. **YOU'RE SO LUCKY** had the rail position sitting in midfield for the first half of this two-turn race, could not quicken with the lead trio at the five sixteenths when roused, hugged the rail still plugging away inside runners, found another gear at the furlong pole and rallied late to get up bearing a distant third in the end. **RACHAEL'S WAGON** tracked the pacesetter three wide on the initial turn, moved in to hound the inside frontrunner down the backstretch, vied between horses for the top spot midway through the last bend, could not keep up with the lead pair by the quarter pole and finished up one paced staying on the incorrect lead down the lane to settle on the fringes. **WAHEELA** settled on the outside of another in the middle of the pack, retreated slightly between foes at the half, made a brief move around horses three wide at the quarter pole, swung out widest in with a chance for a small share in upper stretch but lacked a finishing kick in the final furlong. **HIGHLAND PEAK** was unhurried at the rear in the early stages, could see the field but wasn't that far off the leader with a half mile remaining, could not make any progression on rivals in the running around the far turn and offered little three wide in the stretch drive.

THANKS YOUR HONOUR was hustled leaving the chute inside of runners to have the lead entering the backstretch, had company to the outside heading into the turn, just held on up top dueling inside another throughout the bend, cleared off taking complete control when asked for more at the furlong pole and held safe for the frontrunning tally at the wire. CATCH THE ACE tracked the pacesetter outside heading into the back straightaway, closed in to force the issue outside heading into the turn, argued for the lead with the inside leader around the bend, could not keep up fighting for the win by the furlong pole but still ran on well enough to easily best the rest for the runners up share at the wire. GO GO ALEXANDER had a good spot drafting behind the pacesetter down the backside, chased the embattled duo throughout the turn but could not make any gains, shifted to the two path for the drive to the wire and ran on willingly to be a non-threatening third at the finish line. CAPSAICIN settled close to the back between runners in the beginning, was scrubbed on keeping pace with others at the five sixteenths pole, skimmed the fence improving turning for home and ran on mildly inside of rivals to capture a minor placing in the

end. BROCKWELL broke a step slow trailing on the start, was on hold, having to be throttled down for a stride or two in tight on the rail nearing the three eighths pole, shifted out two wide at the quarter pole and finished up evenly down the stretch in the three path. AUDI'S WORLD dropped back near the rear along the backside, had to wait behind a wall of runners at the three-furlong pole, made a mild rally passing outside rivals at the five sixteenths pole, shifted out with a quarter mile from home, angled outside to be widest in the six-path turning for home, did not switch leads in the entire stretch drive and failed to fire in the late going. CAT'S FURY was situated in mid-division having horses on either side in the early going, stalked in the third flight outside runners making little headway around the oval, shifted to the four path straightening out for the drive but lacked a rally in the final furlong. RAPPORTEUR stalked near the rear travelling four deep at the half, was going in the wrong direction taking the outside path going three wide around the bend and failed to be a menace just off the fence in the stretch drive. T. DOMI settled on the outside of runners watching the lead twosome, had little to offer under a ride retreating between foes on the turn to be in the last place position by the quarter pole, emptied out at the top of the stretch and was not persevered with late.

POWELL RIVER was roused having a narrow lead travelling three wide heading into the first of two turns, crossed over and cleared y the three quarters pole loose up top, galloped along up top with only mild pressure applied outside down the backstretch, was nudged along holding off the outside rival who under a ride through the second turn, spurted away when just tapped right handed a couple of times at the furlong pole and held safe for the wire to wire score. VERY SPECIAL tracked in the second pair while having the outside was asked for more run midway along the final bend beginning to inch up on the lead duo, shifted to the two path in upper stretch and found more late, digging in between horses in the final sixteenth of a mile to win the three-way photo for the place share at the finish line. PROUD PAINTER held the fence running ahead of a couple of rivals in the beginning, made little change staying on the rail along the backside, shifted out at the three furlong pole passing a tiring rival, moved back inside scraping paint at the head of the lane taking closer order and had a rally late to get the right at the wire for the show money. BUIUM stalked near the rear having the outside, rated kindly finding a rhythm down the backstretch, started to uncork a run three wide at the three eighths marker, angled out widest in the five path in the hunt outside the leaders at the top of the stretch but could not sustain the rally and stalled in the final sixteenth losing the three way battle for the place share at the wire. WILLFUL WARRIOR pressed the pace having the inside under the wire for the first time, was reined back to let the pacesetter go ahead with things with three quarters still to run, shadowed the frontrunner outside at the half, dueled outside throughout the final turn going head to head, could not match strides with the winner giving way up top by the furlong pole and faded between foes in the two path in the late going. GELATO was unhurried seeing the field in the early going, showed some energy picking up a weary straggler outside at the quarter pole but could not get involved any further in the drive to the finish line. DWIGHT hopped at the start, was under a snug hold in the second flight inside a rival in the early stages, was encouraged right-handed but was back peddling at the three-furlong pole, stopped at the quarter marker and cantered home down the stretch.

LOVER BOY MO seized command from the rail right from the get-go, slowed things down loose up top along the backside, had a slim lead on the fence taking the short way around with a couple of rivals prompting the pace outside through the last turn, shot clear in an instant skimming the fence when called for more turning for home and coasted home comfortably for the frontrunning tally. CRYSTAL PEARL was allowed to settle into stride at the back of the pack around the first of two turns, shared the tail end outside down the backstretch, began to reach for more ground three wide at the three furlong pole, swung out widest gathering more speed six wide straightening out for the drive and rushed home outside runners in the final furling never switching leads but still was closing in resolutely in deep stretch to get up late for the runners up share. HELLO STRANGER was under a snug hold pulling at the rider while situated on the outside in the middle of the pack, took closer order to make his presence felt three wide at the three-furlong pole fighting for the lead outside of two others, shifted to the five path in the hunt in upper stretch, was no match for the winner who pulled away smartly by the eighth pole and just got nabbed outside by the late closing rival for the place share at the wire. APELDOORN was content tracking the lone speed outside initially, crept up on the leader outside down the backstretch by the half, vied between horses throwing it down around the second turn, had the three path between rivals in the mix at the head of the lane but the winner was beginning to slip away and faded on the rail at the furlong marker holding only for a minor placing in the end. LAKE NASSER was well held watching the lead two while having the fence on the first turn, sat in midfield on the rail still keeping an eye of the front duo at the half, remained poised behind the engaged trio at the quarter pole but could not close in late, lacking a finishing kick inside runners in the final furlong. WONDERFUL QUALITY had a stalking role ahead of only one runner in the beginning, co-trailed on the inside of another along the back straight, could see the field unable to get into gear at the three-furlong pole and could not be a factor in the stretch drive.

KAMASI quickly sped clear and shifted in, was pressed by an outside rival up the backstretch, shook clear going into upper stretch, held sway under steady handling. WHO GOES THERE was forced into a rival at the start, settled off the pace between foes into the first turn, moved nearer the fence on that bend, took closer order saving ground on the far turn, came out three then four wide in upper stretch moving between foes, was gaining steadily but too late. WILD CARD got away well, pressed the pace from outside two to three wide, lacked the needed late kick. LEAN MUSIC MACHINE brushed a rival lightly in the early going, settled off the pace near the inside, on or just off the rail, kept on inside in the stretch to improve. LUPA (IRE) was roused taking the lead from the start on the rail utilizing the inside position, was hard held down the backside isolated up top at the half, was let out a notch picking up the pace on the last turn keeping the outside runner at bay, edged away increasing the advantage at the furlong pole but was getting weary late and just lasted at the wire in a tight finish for the top three positions. CRYSTAL VISIONS had an outside tracking position in the beginning, offered only mild pressure keeping the leader honest outside down the backside, chased outside never letting the pacesetter get completely away on the final turn, was inching up in the two path throughout the stretch drive but just couldn't get there at the wire between rivals in a with one final late surge. DESIGN broke out at the start, settled between horses near the rear under a snug hold, began to reach for more ground coming up to rivals outside at the quarter pole and was gradually gaining on the embattled duo at the furlong pole to make it a three-way horse race at the wire but was unfortunately on the losing end of that photo at the finish line. NO MORE OPTIONS had a slim lead on the rail, continued up top running evenly down the backside inside of rivals, took the short way around the last bend holding off a host outside foes who were turning up the pressure, drifted out to the four path still clinging onto the front end and stubbornly never gave in to the finish line prevailing in the end for the wire to wire tally. EL COHETE had the rail watching the lead trio contest the pace, sat poised waiting behind the lead group of three around the last turn, shifted off their cover three wide at the quarter pole making a move, loomed six wide at the top of the stretch, kept plugging away outside gradually gaining with every stride down the lane but could not get to the winner in time. EVER DANGEROUS was forwardly placed in the fray up front going three wide in the first bend, kept a close eye outside on the pacesetter while three deep along the back straight, ranged up three wide making his presence felt even more on the far turn, shifted to the five path in the thick of things straightening out for home but needed more late when fading in deep stretch to be a clear third at the finish line. KING D'ORO stalked near the rear between horses, started to make a run bursting between rivals three wide at the quarter pole, darted inside from the five path in upper stretch to be two wide coming on at the furlong pole and got his nose down right at the finish line to settle on the fringes in the end. WHISKEY N SODA was close to the back of the pack inside, saved ground picking up the bit at the quarter pole, had a good rally showing late energy up the fence in the stretch run but was nosed out by the inside rival for a minor award. PALACE VIEW (IRE) was in the second flight going three wide on the first bend, made little headway three deep down the backside, tried to narrow the margin three wide on the final turn on the lead threesome while outside another, angled out with a chance in the seven path for a piece of the prize but evened out in the last sixteenth of a mile. SHERIF ALI was at the rear going into the first bend, still remained at the back end but was well in range at the half, was stuck behind a wall of runners three wide at the quarter pole, shifted to the six path turning for home but could only pass tired inside runners in the drive to the wire. NIIGON'S LAW was part of the group arguing up top between runners on the first turn, continued to battle for the lead with rivals on either side around the final oval, shifted to the three path in the mix at the top of the stretch had little left for the late running and yielded to others by the furlong pole. DON IQUE settled in midfield between runners for the first half of this route race, still showed no rally with runners on each side running around the far turn and wilted in the two path in upper stretch. NOBURU travelled three to four wide on the first of two turns sitting near the rear outside runners, made little movement along the backside, could not make up any ground still having to go three to four wide on the second turn as well and gave way in the seven path when turning for home.
