CLASSIC DANCER assumed command under a hold along the back straight, rolled along smoothly unchallenged through the turn, edged away will never asked at the furlong pole, was tapped once right-handed in deep stretch improving the advantage late and basically won under a hand ride going gate to wire. ROYAL QUALITY was unhurried seeing the field in the beginning, improved on the fence at the half mile marker, sat on the rail waiting for the cue to go just behind the pacesetter around the bend, lacked a clear path on the fence drafting behind the leader at the top of the lane but when getting clear was no match for the winner who had plenty left in the late running. YOU AND ME BABY chased the frontrunner outside down the backstretch, continued to try to close on the pacesetter around the turn but was making little headway, shifted to the two-path turning for home in the hunt for a share but stalled at the furlong marker and did not switch leads until deep stretch finishing up a clear third in the end. CATHOLIC JACKIE had a stalking trip near the rear early on, could see the field by the half, lagged behind the pack taking the short way around the bend, shifted out widest in the five-path turning for home and managed to pass a tiring inside rival by the sixteenth pole for a minor share. SOUPER ICONIC travelled in midfield three deep early on, dropped back slightly unable to keep up to the lead trio around the oval and had little to give, tiring in the four path by mid-stretch.

BUFF BAY was loose on the lead down the backstretch, opened up even more going in hand around the bend,, shifted just off the fence well in control at the head of the lane and comfortably won at the finish line for the frontrunning score. TOTALLY IN CHARGE broke inwards on the break, had a tracking position watching the front duo in the early going, started to gather more speed three wide outside of rivals when asked for more midway around the turn,, angled out in the five oath in the mix, drifted inwards when switching leads battling for the runners up share at the furlong marker and bested the rest in the end for the secondary award at the finish line. ALMASTY'S LUST had inside position from another travelling in the second flight, crept up on the fence around the oval, shifted out three wide turning for home in the battle for the runners up share in upper stretch with the winner well on his way by then and finished up mildly to be a clear third at the wire. JAPONKA broke outwards getting the worse of the exchanging of bumps from the outside foe at the start, recover to chase the leader down the backstretch, still kept trying but could not make up any ground on the winner through the turn, shifted four wide in the battle for a minor share at the top of the stretch, was in tight losing its path plus momentum at the furlong pole and ran on well enough to last for a minor placing in the end. FREE CHARGING co-trailed on the outside, was urged at the five sixteenths pole making little movement around the turn, angled to the four path and caught a rival right at the wire getting the nod on the outside. MAXINE MAGIC shared the rear on the inside, was roused in midturn unable to make any gains, hugged the fence at the top of the stretch but could not be a factor in the drive to the wire.

DONTGOBACKONURWORD began sluggishly and trailed the field, began to close into the turn and caught the back markers into the stretch, split rivals at the eighth pole, caught the leader by the forty yard marker and inched away late without ever changing leads. TEMPLE HALL rushed through along the inside of the early leader after a sixteenth of a mile, had a clear lead into the turn and widened turning for home but could not hold the winner inside the final forty yards. SOUPER STRIDER settled off the pace and raced outside a rival throughout, closed in the two path around the turn and down the lane to nail the show spot down in the final stages. ISAAC LEO broke on top, was challenged inside down the backstretch, tracked that same rival into the stretch but failed to get by that one and lost the show spot in the shadow of the wire. KNOWING off the pace and inside a rival down the backside, closed with that one around the turn and down the lane without threatening the top finishers. BIG LEW sat nicely inside while chasing a dueling pair, tipped out into the six path turning for home but lacked a closing response.

TURBO CHARGED settled off the pace outside a rival, moved closer early up the backstretch but still off the leaders racing outside in the clear, was encouraged three wide on the far turn, gained steadily to take charge past the furlong marker and drew clear under steady handling. SPIRITUAL MAN was forwardly-positioned inside heading to the first turn, switched outside the leader late on that bend to stalk from outside, moved on the far turn taking the lead by the top of the stretch, was no match for the winner but clearly second best. HOT POTATO broke a bit awkwardly, settled toward the back inside, came out for the second turn, moved out further in deep stretch while running on well and bumping with a rival in the process, got up from between foes for show. PRETTY GOOD JOKE was brushed on the inside but still was away alertly having the early advantage, relinquished the front to the inside rival at the half, re-engaged on the turn to seize control once again by the quarter pole, spurted away leaving the furlong pole and held on by a diminishing margin of victory at the wire. ADORABLE ANGEL was void of early foot seeing the field along the backside, closed the gap sharply taking the shortest route around the turn, scraped the fence coming with a good rally, shifted out in the two path finding a seam between rivals at the furlong marker and was coming to the winner in the late going but just could not get there in time. KIMBERLINA raced in tandem with an outside foe in midfield down the backside, edged up saving all the ground running around the bend, shifted to the three path in the hunt between horses in upper stretch and had a good rally with runners on either side in the late going just missing out for the second money share in a three way photo at the wire. ATLANTIC PASSAGE exchanged brushed with the outside rival on the start, settled on the outside of another in the middle of the pack at the half, had the two path between rivals in midturn but could not quicken with a quarter mile from home, swung out widest in the five path with clear run and finished with good energy outside in the conversation at the finish line for the runners up share but had to settle on the fringes in the end. LAZIO was forwardly placed in the two path in the early going, drafted behind the frontrunner on the fence heading into the turn, shifted out coming with a run at the quarter pole, was pushed out by the pacesetter to be four wide between horses turning for home and drove on by at the furlong pole for the lead and won going away impressively. SOUPER SUNDAY broke sharp on the outside initially, stalked going five deep outside runners by the half, shared the rear traveling outside another while going three wide around the bend, started to make a rally at the quarter pole, darted to the fence have plenty on room inside the contesting trio in upper stretch and finished up with a solid late run behind the dominant winner to be a clear second best at the wire. HIGHLAND LIFE was part of the mix up front having the two path behind the early leader, chased between horses on the turn, was forced out in the five path in thick of things at the top of the stretch and ran on willingly with horses on both side to win the three way battle for the show money by a photo. COTTON was positioned in midfield while three deep on the outside, kept a close eye on the frontrunner outside two others travelling three wide around the oval, was floated out six wide by the inside runners in the mix in upper stretch and finished with intent but lost the nod at the wire for the show money, getting a minor placing in the end. FIFTY B M G broke with the field but took an awkward step soon afterwards, rushed up from last to first on the rail inside horses to have the front end by the half, rambled on loose on the engine throughout the turn, was allowed to drift out at the quarter pole taking a few rivals wide when heading three wide at the top of the stretch clinging onto the lead, had little left late and tired in deep stretch. PRINCE OF THIEVES was at the back getting to the fence by the half, settled on the inside of another foe co-trailing on the turn just off the rail, scraped paint at the head of the lane but failed to menace

in the stretch running.

BOURBONONAHOLIDAY galloped along at the back end finding his stride down the backstretch, started to reach for more ground circling around runners three wide at the three furlong pole, shifted out to the seven path full of run in upper stretch and powered past under steady left handed encouragement outside of the leaders in deep stretch for the late charging win. MISS D'S PRIDE was nestled on the fence watching the lead threesome, began to inch up just off the rail around the bend, was coming to the leader in the two path under a busy ride midway down the stretch, poked his head in front briefly with seventy yards to go but could not withstand the strong late charge by the winner outside in the late going. MIAH SAID had the lead on the rail along the

backside, continued to set the pace by a narrow margin while hounded outside throughout the turn, edged away from the pesky early speed foe straightening out for home but could not find something in reserve late being caught on the outside by a couple of late closing rivals in deep stretch. DJOSER reared up in the gate prior to the start, settled all alone in midfield down the backside, started to make a move picking up the bit two wide in midturn, shifted to the three path in the hunt between challengers at the top of the lane, finished up gradually for a minor role in the end but was in the thick of the battle until the seventy-yard marker. MY BOY BRUCE stalked on the inside of another with a half mile still to go, was relegated to the tail end on the rail with three eighths from home, skimmed the fence at the top of the lane and had good late energy inside runners in the final furlong. SPRINGER prompted the issue three deep down the backstretch, chased the engaged twosome under a vigorous through the bend, shifted to the four path for the drive to the finish line but faded in the final eighth of a mile. GINGER'S HOLIDAY had a stalking role outside foes at the half, made little progress between horses two wide in the turn running, swung out widest having the eight path in upper stretch but lacked a rally down the lane. BAHAMA VILLAGE had a tracking spot three deep watching the front three, was scrubbed on just off the rail along the turn but was going the wrong way being passed on both sides by the quarter pole and faltered at the top of the stretch. COOLCOLLECTED pressed the pace between rivals in the beginning, continued to force the issue outside off the leaders flank around the turn, had nothing left coming up empty three wide in upper stretch and was not persevered with in the final furlong.
