CLASSIC DANCER assumed command under a hold along the back straight, rolled along smoothly unchallenged through the turn, edged away will never asked at the furlong pole, was tapped once right-handed in deep stretch improving the advantage late and basically won under a hand ride going gate to wire. ROYAL QUALITY was unhurried seeing the field in the beginning, improved on the fence at the half mile marker, sat on the rail waiting for the cue to go just behind the pacesetter around the bend, lacked a clear path on the fence drafting behind the leader at the top of the lane but when getting clear was no match for the winner who had plenty left in the late running. YOU AND ME BABY chased the frontrunner outside down the backstretch, continued to try to close on the pacesetter around the turn but was making little headway, shifted to the two-path turning for home in the hunt for a share but stalled at the furlong marker and did not switch leads until deep stretch finishing up a clear third in the end. CATHOLIC JACKIE had a stalking trip near the rear early on, could see the field by the half, lagged behind the pack taking the short way around the bend, shifted out widest in the five-path turning for home and managed to pass a tiring inside rival by the sixteenth pole for a minor share. SOUPER ICONIC travelled in midfield three deep early on, dropped back slightly unable to keep up to the lead trio around the oval and had little to give, tiring in the four path by mid-stretch.
