FINE STYLE had a very brief early lead, soon dropped back along the inside facing some traffic, came out five wide in the stretch, rallied past late. MANCHESTER ICE broke just a half-step slowly but was very quick to move to the fore, set a lively pace from just off the rail, was collared in deep stretch and no match but second best. INSTANT RESPONSE was strongly urged from the start, chased from between runners just off the flank of the early leader, lacked the needed late kick. BORDER FOX chased from outside, was getting out past the three-eighths, faded. RUM TALK lacked early speed and was outpaced.
