QUEEN JUNO dueled inside two foes down the backside, took back on the turn, angled out three to four wide turning for home to re-engage the pace survivor and got by that rival at the seventy yard pole, pulling away late. ALPHA GAMMA GIRL dueled between runners down the backstretch, had the front around the turn and into the stretch but could not hold off the winner inside the final stages, second best today. DOWNTOWN RO broke on top before being allowed to settle in midpack, advanced three wide on the turn into range but was only able to mildly close up for the show spot without threatening the top pair. SOUPER GIN'S WORLD off the pace early, drifted out into the six path at the top of the stretch with only one rival beaten, closed determinedly down the lane most effectively in the final sixteenth. WRITTEN PAGES was bumped by a rival at the start, chased the three duelers along the inside down the backstretch, still in range turning for home but levelled off in the final seventy yards. MAKE A DIFFERENCE came out and bumped a rival at the start, rushed up to press two duelers down the backside, began to leak oil into the stretch and lost positions down the lane. CANDY COATED trailed throughout, noticeably green down the lane while shifting about and seemingly figuring it out somewhat.
