BRAVO KATE assumed command loping along setting a soft early pace, remained on the front end loose still setting a tepid pace down the backside, had a narrow advantage with the field bunching up at the quarter poll dictating an even but pedestrian tempo on the far turn and under a well rationed out ride just had enough to stave off the late closer nearing the finish line outside for the wire to wire tally. TALENT SHOW tossed her head slightly on the break, was in tight on the rail behind runners midway around the first of two turns, sat at the back of the pack well in range of the compact group along the back straight, was looking for a seam two to three wide on the second bend with a quarter mile to run, was stymied in upper stretch lacking running room, finally got clear run shifting out three wide at the sixteenth pole and surged in the very late going but just missed getting to the winner outside at the finish line. PICKFORD SWEET was tucked in on the rail behind the leader in the beginning, kept a close eye on the frontrunner inside another along the back straightaway, sat behind the engaged duo around the last turn at the quarter pole, took closer order skimming the fence turning for home but was outkicked by the front pair in the late going settling for the show money at the wire. TWISTING PISTONS broke out on the start, had an outside tracking position for the first half of this route race, moved in to battle for the front end outside the pacesetter at the three eighths marker, duelled outside in the three path in upper stretch but evened out in the final furlong to settle on the fringes. PURRFECT GIRL settled between horses close to the back of the pack, was under a snug hold status unchanged down the backside, was nudged on at the quarter pole moving closer taking aim on the embattled duo for wide straightening out for the stretch run but failed to fire in the later stages. THAT GIRL ARTEMUS was pushed out by the inside foe at the start, travelled four wide near the rear on the first turn, improved going three deep pulling the rider closer along the backside, was scrubbed on at the five sixteenths pole three wide on the last turn in mid-pack making little progress outside of rivals, swung out widest in the five path for the drive but had no finish to give in the final furlong.

CHANCHITO was unhurried at the rear down the backstretch, lagged behind taking the short way around the turn, hugged the rail gathering more speed in upper stretch and was full of run shifting outside off the leader three wide at the eighth pole for clear run, did not switch leads through the stretch run but it did not matter because he still drove by with authority in deep stretch for the late finishing win. MASTER STEAL had a slim lead three deep on the outside, duled three wide outside a couple of runners for the top spot around the oval, inched away slightly at the quarter pole, was holding up top running just off the fence in mid-stretch but could not fend off the overpowering late burst by the winner outside in the final sixteenth of a mile. UP N THE ANTE had a stalking trip early on ahead of only one runner which was to be the eventual winner, rallied three wide starting to uncork a run in midturn circling rivals, swung out widest in the six path closing in, the rider was having difficulty keeping a straight path when drifting inwards even through under left handed encouragement on the wrong lead midway down the stretch, finally figured things out switching leads at the sixteenth pole and had a strong late charge but it was just too late. ATERYA vied between runners in the early going, chased the pacesetter inside through the turn, fought back stubbornly inside in upper stretch but had little left late and faded in the final furlong to hold for a minor share. JOLTED had a good set-up watching the lead trio fight for the lead down the backside, was asked for more but could not keep up to the leaders at the three furlong pole, angled to the five path at the head of the lane but could not get involved. SCREEN SCENE pressed the pace on the rail early on, was the first of the battling trio up top to give way on the fence midway around the bend and shifted to the four-path faltering in upper stretch.

SOUPED UP was on the engine cruising on the lead just off the rail early down the backside, had company inside by the half, was confidently handled moving smoothly being nursed along having a slim advantage outside throughout the turn and drew off smartly when asked for run in deep stretch for the effortless win. BAXLEY settled on the rail in midfield to begin, moved in down the backstretch to force the issue inside the leader by the half, was hard ridden inside fighting for the lead around the oval, tried valiantly on the fence to keep up to the winner in upper stretch but was no match late and comfortably bested the rest for the runners up share at the finish line. GILT EDGE tracked the engaged duo on the outside with a half mile from home, chased the battling lead pair but to no avail going three wide around the bend, shifted to the four-path turning for home but could not threaten the top two in the final furlong easily securing the show money award when crossing the wire. RAT PORTAGE had a stalking position ahead of one rival down the backstretch, kept pace saving all the ground on the fence throughout the turn, angled out slightly in the three path in upper stretch but could only finish up evenly down the lane holding for a minor placing only in the end. IRONSTONE threw his head on the break seeing the field outside of runners down the backstretch, made little headway around the turn while going three wide outside of horses, shifted out to the five path at the head of the lane but could not factor in the stretch running.

SIDE STREET had a nice trip nestled on the rail behind the pacesetter, moved in when urged shifting out coming to the leader at the quarter pole, loomed three wide being the only one who could threaten the frontrunner in upper stretch, poked his head in front outside with a furlong still to go and under a busy ride began to edge clear for the win when crossing the finish line. ASHLEY'S ARCHER was all alone controlling the pace around the first turn as well as down the back straightaway, continued to roll along up top uncontested on the far turn moving well within himself, was collared outside by the winner at the furlong pole, fought on to the very end but gave way grudgingly in deep stretch. BAYTOWN DREAMER stalked near the rear but had trouble navigating the first turn drifting out three to four wide on the heels behind a runner, shared the rear inside another down the backside, was urged on right-handed midway on the far turn but could not improve position, shifted off tiring horses four wide at the furlong pole coming on and closed belatedly to be a distant third at the finish line. PERFECTWORKS was forced out at least four wide by the erratic inside rival heading into the first turn, co-trailed on the outside down the backstretch, circled around runners making a brief move three wide at the three eighths marker, angled to the five path at the head of the lane but stalled in the final furlong settling on the fringes in the end. ZUCCHERO was content to track the loose leader for the first half of this two-turn race, came under a drive but could not keep pace with the lead duo with a quarter mile still to run and had little left for the late going when wilting inside of horses in the final furlong. BLIND RIVER travelled four to five wide while possibly getting his heels clipped from the behind rival heading into the first turn, settled on the outside of another in mid-division down the backside, retreated quickly between horses at the three furlong pole, was eased through the far turn and left via equine ambulance.

I LUCKED OUT was loose on the lead around the initial bend, continued to be unchallenged down the backside, opened up moving well in hand by the quarter pole to have a commanding lead turning for home but had to be kept busy by the rider in the late going with the runner up coming quick on the outside in deep stretch and just lasted at the wire for the frontrunning score. COMPTON stalked close to the back with runners on either side in the first half of this two turn race, was the only one making a rally coming with a strong move in the three path at the five sixteenths pole, shifted to the five path being the only one who had a chance at the winner turning for home and was gaining steadily throughout the drive to the wire making it a horse race late but just missed getting there outside at the finish line. SUNRISE DRIVE had good position watching the lead two runners in the beginning, was part of the chasing pack between rivals in the three path along the back straight, was asked for more left handed by the jockey fighting for then the place share at the quarter pole, kept plodding along down the stretch with the lead duo having it to themselves in the final furlong and held on for the show money at the finish line. ADAPTED had the fence near the rear, improved inside of runners by the half, lacked clear running room behind rivals from the three-furlong pole until the quarter marker and ran on mildly between rivals three wide in the stretch drive capturing a minor share in the end. CHANCE! settled three wide in midfield, continued in mid-pack while four deep along the back straight, could not get into gear four wide throughout the final bend and remained one paced unable to get involved in the stretch drive. C C'S KINGDOM travelled four wide around horses at the back of the pack, remained outside three deep part of the back trio down the backside, tried to circle runners again going four wide but to no avail on the last turn and came up empty at the top of the lane. SOUPER SPORTY had a nice position drafting behind the frontrunner on the fence while that rival was being hounded outside up top in the beginning, sat poised on the rail on the turn waiting for the cue to move, slid outside four wide gathering more momentum at the top of the stretch and basically under a vigorous hand ride drove past on the outside in the final seventy yards for the victory. SOUPER DIVA had the lead on the inside with a half mile to go, rolled along while pressured outside setting a lively pace throughout the turn up front by only a slim margin, shifted just off the rail with the two outside rivals bearing down in upper stretch, could not find more late to fend off the winners late outside charge but did fight on valiantly to come back for the place share in deep stretch. SIPPING HISTORY prompted the pace on the outside down the backstretch, threw it down making her intent clear dueling outside under a quick tempo for the lead around the bend, vied between horses in the heat of battle three wide turning for home but could not find another gear late and faded with runners on each side in the final seventy yards to settle for only the show money after a hard fought run. VEGAS ROAD was in tight quarters when the inside rival broke out on the start, settled three deep in the middle of the pack along the backside, came under a ride chasing the lead trio in midturn but was making little success, angled three wide straightening out for home and finished up willingly holding for a minor placing. ARTFUL DIAMOND was void of early foot seeing the group along the backside, shifted out three wide at the three furlong pole, was checked slightly darting back inside avoiding the horse that was bearing out midway along the turn, shifted to the three path at the head of the lane but had little to offer in the late going. MONEY HEIST was eager on the fence in mid-pack by the half, took the short way around the turn making little progression, skimmed the fence at the top of the stretch but lacked a rally inside of runners down the stretch. HOT STUFF BABY broke outwards on the break, settled in midfield between horses along the backside, bore out in midturn, was gathered back in by the rider getting control again by the quarter pole trailing the field but could not recover to be a factor in the stretch drive.

FRIENDLY GHOST settled off the pace outside at the rear, shifted in a bit saving ground near the rail on the turn, came out a touch to split rivals near the furlong marker still just off the inside, surged to take the lead and prevail. YACHT BOY settled off the pace, advanced inside on the turn, fanned six to seven wide leaving that bend, bid in mid-stretch taking a brief narrow lead, was outfinished but second best. WAGNER took hold clearing the gap then moved out off the rail just after, stalked about mid-pack racing two to three wide on the turn, angled seven to eight wide turning into upper stretch with much to do, finished well to get up outside for show honors. SHADOW REALM exchanged a very minor brush just after the start, made an early advance between foes

starting from the nine-sixteenths, stalked between runners two to three wide, made a mild brief bid at the top of the stretch racing four wide, lacked the needed kick and lost third late. BACHELOR PAD took the lead after the opening sixteenth, set the pace near the inside on or just off the rail, was challenged at the top of the stretch, weakened gradually thereafter. HUMBER RIVER stalked from outside three to four wide through the turn, failed to rally. POSEIDON STEEL exchanged a very light brush at the start, settled outside at the rear, raced four to seven wide throughout, made no impact. ZIO CAVALLO got away well and had a brief early lead, tracked the leader from inside, came up empty.
