AUSSIE HYPER settled on the inside of another sitting in mid-division, co-trailed on the inside with a half mile from home, began to edge up at the five sixteenths pole reaching for more ground, shifted out at the quarter pole, split foes coming with a strong burst four wide in upper stretch and determinedly chased down the frontrunner in the shadow of the wire to get up for the win by the slimmest of margins at the finish. MCKENZIE ROAD broke inwards on the start, cleared and crossed over assuming command heading into the first of two turns, loped along slowing things down even further up top down the backside, still moved very comfortably dictating a soft pace on the last bend, was holding on having the fence in upper stretch but the winner was starting to close the gap at the furlong pole, just had a head in front inside with seventy yards to go, dug in late but just missed going wire to wire losing a close photo for the win at the finish line. BELLA CLASSICA was in tight having to be checked trailing the field under the wire for the first time, shared the rear outside at the half with the eventual winner, rallied three wide circling horses midway around the final turn, shifted out widest in the five path but was no match for the lead pair by mid-stretch and stilled show grit to the very end, coming on late right at the finish line on the outside to win the duel for the third place share. LADIES RUM was fractious behind the gate unseating the rider, had a good spot tucked in on the rail behind the pacesetter in the early stages of this route race, travelled just off the rail around the far turn but was unable to quicken with the lead duo by the quarter pole and stalled with a sixteenth left to run getting nabbed on the outside right on the line for the show money. MOVENTOTHECOUNTRY was pushed in by the outside foe on the break, stalked near the rear on the outside in the early stages, made a move ranging three deep outside of runners with the pace slowing down along the backside, chased the winner but to no avail around the final turn, still remained in the mix for a piece of the prize three wide turning for home but had little left, flattening out between foes at the furlong marker. NO VISOR was content to sit off the leader, tracking on the outside, continued to be forwardly placed keeping a close

eye on the frontrunner between rivals at the half, dropped back through the field on the final turn unable to keep up to the pacesetter at the three eighths pole and was empty for the drive while in the three path down the lane. BEAUTIFUL SKY settled on the outside of another in midfield around the first of two turns, offered little movement down the backside travelling between horses, retreated through the second bend seeing the field at the five sixteenths pole and could not be a factor in the stretch running.

SUNNYVILLE broke inwards on the start, prompted the pace in the early going, poked his head in front on the fence by the half, edged clear opening up slightly around the oval with a quarter mile to go and while just off the rail was kept busy throughout the lane to hold safe for the win at the wire. BUTTERFLY BILLIE was unhurried at the rear of this compact group at the break, improved on the fence to sit behind the engaged duo midway down the backstretch, inched up saving all the ground on the turn at the quarter pole, shifted out three wide posing the only threat outside at the head of the lane but could not get by the stubborn winner in the stretch running. GLINT IN AMY'S EYE had a slim lead on the lead at the start, pressed the frontrunner on the outside with a half mile to run along the backside, regressed in midturn unable to keep up to the leader as well as being passed on the inside by a rival at the five sixteenths pole and ran on mildly to be a distant third well behind the top two runners who had it to themselves in the stretch drive. TRISTAR FURY prior to the break was washy heading into the gate, travelled three deep on the outside watching the front twosome initially, dropped back galloping along very low headed seeing the field at the half, lost touch with the pack by the quarter pole, was not persevered with down the lane and was basically eased up when crossing the finish line.

DEWOLF flanked the pacesetter on the outside around the first turn, seized control outside heading into the backstretch, opened up at will setting an even tempo by the three eighths marker, rolled along unopposed through the last bend and impressively coasted home for the win under wraps winning by a good margin when at the wire. AWESOME RAINBOW broke inwards to begin, settled on the fence in midfield in tandem with another rival around the initial bend as well as along the back straight, shifted to the three path between horses at the top of the stretch and had good late energy to be a clear second best behind the runaway winner when crossing the finish line. HOLIDAY SNOOZE pressed the issue three wide in the beginning stages, was then wrangled back to sit in the second flight watching the engaged duo up top into the backstretch, could not close the gap on the winner through the last turn, angled out four wide battling for a small share in upper stretch and ran on mildly down the lane to get up late for the show award. BANKINGONAMIRACLE had a narrow advantage on the rail in the beginning, surrendered the lead to the outside rival entering the backstretch, chased the winner in vain throughout the last turn, still was holding for the secondary share in mid-stretch but needed more late when fading on the rail with a sixteenth from the line to settle only for a minor role in the end. PRIVATE LABEL was squeezed at the start, stalked on the rail ahead of only one runner around the first bend, shared the back end on the inside of another with three furlongs still to run, made no gain on challengers travelling just off the fence on the final turn, hugged the rail turning for home but could not get involved. QUIET VISTA hopped on the break trailing the field early on, took closer order along the backside going four deep catching up to the pack outside by the three eighths pole, had little to offer outside of rivals in the running around the far turn and failed to menace having the three path in the stretch drive.

TANZANITE LILY patiently tracked the leaders in behind inside, saved ground early on the turn, swung seven wide leaving that bend and was put to urging, drifted in through the stretch, struck the lead past the furlong marker and drove clear. CHARGETHATMOUNTAIN was quick to take the lead, set the pace inside shadowed by outside foes, kicked clear while coming off the rail turning into upper stretch, was collared in mid-stretch and no match but second best. SPEEDY FREEZE settled on the inside sitting in mid-pack, was roused picking up the bit just off the fence by midturn, shifted out four wide in full flight at the top of the lane and powered past the front three rivals one by one to edge clear for the late running win at the finish line. FOURFIFTYFOUR had a good spot on the rail watching the engaged duo down the backside, still sat poised taking the short way around the turn behind the lead pair waiting for the cue to move, scraped paint in the thick of things coming on straightening out for the drive, got the lead for a stride or two inside leaving the sixteenth pole but could not find another gear late and was unable to fend off the winners charge outside in deep stretch. DOLCE FORTUNA was under a tight hold having a slim lead inside down the backstretch, continued up top by a narrow advantage around the bend, shifted to the two path in upper stretch, maintained a slight lead with rivals bearing down on both sides at the furlong marker and was outkicked between horses in deep stretch to hold for the show money at the wire. I GOT MURPHED hounded the pacesetter on the outside along the back straight, continued to shadow the frontrunner still outside throughout the oval, angled to the three path in the hunt between runners in upper stretch but idled in the final eighth of a mile and settled on the fringes in the end. MIRAMICHI tossed her head on the break sharing the rear inside along with the other troubled starter, had to be throttled down coming up to horses at the half,, waited for running room two wide around the bend, made a brief rally at the quarter pole but could only finish up one paced in the three path for the stretch run never getting into contention in the late going. SUPER SICILY leapt up at the start to co-trail at the back end on the outside, tried to make a four wide circling move but with little progress under a vigorous ride around the turn and lacked a rally, widest in the five path in the stretch running. RARIFIED (IRE) travelled on the outside in midfield, was scrubbed on for more at the five sixteenths pole but had little response when retreating between horses seeing the field at the quarter marker and could not play a factor in the drive to the finish line.

MIDNITE SADIE had a good spot nestled on the rail watching the lead trio, began to reel in the pacesetter around the oval, pounced three wide on the outside turning for home, drifted inwards even though under left handed encouragement clearing off for the lead getting to the rail with an eighth of a mile to go and was kept to the task late, holding sway from the outside closing in rival at the wire. SILVERDART was situated on the outside in the middle of the pack going four deep, started to uncork a rally going four wide between runners at the quarter pole, shifted out five to six wide full of run, charged home

closing in the last furlong but just could not get to the winner in time. CAN'T ARGUE THAT hopped slightly then was taken up when in tight between horses soon after the break, trailed the field gathering herself down the backside, lagged behind on the the turn, began to pass inside runners three wide at the top of the lane, darted to the fence gaining momentum at the furlong pole and had a sharp late rally to get up in the last few jumps for the third place share. HEARTY CHRISTINI narrowly had the front end between rivals in the beginning, dropped slightly back with the outside rival making a quick move seizing command heading into the turn, chased the frontrunner on the rail through the turn, shifted to the two path in the mix still at the top of the stretch but was outfinished by rivals in the final sixteenth of a mile to settle for a minor placing in the end. ANELA KAI settled between runners in midfield down the backside, kept pace running evenly with horses on either side while going three wide around the bend, moved out to the four path straightening for home but faded in the final furlong . GIRL'S NITE OUT prompted the pace in the three path outside two others along the back straight, shot clear getting to the rail opening up at the three furlong pole, was collared outside by the winner while travelling two wide in upper stretch, had to be checked losing her path on the fence at the furlong marker and wilted thereafter. DARING DAME broke out on the start, settled close to the back inside runners early on, made a brief rally through the turn splitting runners two wide from the three eighths pole to the quarter marker, could not sustain the run in the drive and folded in the three path in the final furlong. I LOVE PRESENTS broke inwards on the start, stalked ahead of only one other runner while going four deep along the backside, could not advance trying to circle five wide around horses along the turn, shifted out widest in the seven path in upper stretch but came up empty, having little to offer in the running down the lane. SACRED PRAYER pressed the pace on the rail in the beginning, was in tight, checked repeatedly on the fence dropping back from the half mile pole until the midway point through the turn to be near the rear at the quarter marker, was checked again being brushed by the outside foe turning for home and could not make any impression inside in the drive to the finish line.
