ARMINO was unhurried trailing in the beginning, shared the back end while inside another at the half, edged up just off the rail at the quarter pole, closed in shifting out under left-handed asking at the sixteenth pole getting clear run and nabbed the frontrunner outside in the shadow of the wire for the win. SHAMATEUR got to the rail having the lead entering the first of two turns, was nursed along up top while hounded outside down the back straightaway, maintained a slim advantage taking the short way around the second bend, finally inched away from the other speed rival skimming the fence turning for home, fought on gamely inside to the finish line but was just caught nearing the wire. THREE SONNY SIDEUP was bumped by the inside foe on the break, recovered to prompt outside around the initial bend, duelled outside head to head up front down the backstretch, continued to hound the pacesetter outside on the last turn, still remained in the hunt between foes in the two path but the leader was inching away in upper stretch and finished up evenly in the late going to be a clear third at the wire. ONENIGHTSTANDARDS stumbled on the break, then was aggressively ridden from the get-go on the outside stalking close to the back end, co-trailed with an inside rival down the back straight, travelled three wide at the three eighths pole under right handed encouragement through the last turn, shifted out widest in the five path turning for home and kept plodding along to garner a minor share in the end. TRINIDAD was nestled on the fence tracking the lead duo, shifted out in range two wide of the lead twosome at the quarter marker, angled to the three path at the head of the lane but did not switch leads in the stretch and faded in the final sixteenth of a mile. KENTUCKY BILL broke outwards bumping a rival on the start, recouped sitting in midfield between runners in the early stages, was asked for more midway around the last turn but was backpedaling by the quarter pole and offered no run in the stretch drive. GRANDE SOIREE stalked on the outside going three wide while in mid-pack, was scrubbed on for more chasing the front pair but making no gain around the final bend and emptied out in the four path in upper stretch.

YODDHA travelled outside another while tracking the lead duo, ranged up outside around the turn circling three wide, pounced in the four path at the top of the stretch, dueled outside with a furlong to go on the front end, switched leads and gears coming to the sixteenth pole and edged away for the victory at the finish line. ROAD TO VERSAILLES settled in the two path with runners on both sides watching the lead pair, sat poised between foes in midturn, closed in five wide at the head of the lane and was gaining steadily on the winner in the final furlong but it wasn't enough in the end. LEMON TWIST pressed the issue on the rail in the beginning, poked a head in front still on the fence at the half, remained up top by a slim margin around the oval, still was holding on inside another two wide at the furlong marker but was outkicked in the late going to be a clear third at the wire. SPRINGER broke slowly trailing the field while moving to the outside down the backstretch, lagged behind just off the fence running around the bend, swung out widest in the seven path in mid-stretch and finished with good late energy to settle on the fringes in the end. BIG LEW had a stalking trip ahead of only the slow starter, was on hold behind a wall of runners going two to three wide on the turn at the quarter pole, stayed on the wrong lead just off the fence in the stretch run and finished up one paced losing the battle for the minors between horses. MISS D'S PRIDE had the fence while keeping a close eye on the engaged duo down the backside, waited on the rail being nudged along through the turn, hugged the fence in with a chance for a piece of the prize straightening out for home but stalled inside of runners in the final sixteenth of a mile. ALFRED BELLOWES sat all alone in midfield having the three path along the backside, took closer order coming with a brief rally four wide with a quarter mile remaining but could not find more in the drive and flattened out in the six path in upper stretch. SWIFT ATTRACTION had a slim lead on the outside down the backstretch, vied between rivals around the oval, had little left four wide turning for home and

folded by mid-stretch.

CATCH THE DRIFT was void of early foot seeing the field along the backside, continued to be at the rear around the bend but was starting to make a move at the quarter pole, split foes coming with a rally three wide in upper stretch then burst between horses seizing command leaving the furlong marker and won going away when crossing the finish line. ARYA'S QUEST settled close to the back while in the three path down the backstretch, started to move up on the turn going three to four wide at the quarter pole, had a full head of steam shifting out widest in the six path at the top of the lane and was full of run in the late going but just was second best on this day. WORRY LESS settled on the inside having a tracking role watching the pacesetter, inched up on the turn by the quarter pole, shifted out four wide in the hunt battling between foes straightening out for the drive, was no match for the winner at the sixteenth pole and faded slightly in deep stretch to hold for the show award. REACH FOR THE TOP stalked between rivals early on, made little headway inside of horses on the bend, scraped paint beginning to lengthen stride smartly at the top of the lane but evened out in the final eighth of a mile to be a fringe player in the end. ENCHANTED FOREST had a stalking position on the rail, closed the gap in midturn while going three wide, shifted to the five path in tight between horses turning for home and could only manage to pass a weary runner in the late going. CRUMLIN TROUBLE broke out on the start, tracked the lone speed outside another down the backside, chased the frontrunner still outside a rival three wide on the turn with a quarter mile from home, shifted to the five path in the mix for a small share in upper stretch but tired in the final furlong. EARENDEL was bumped on the inside at the start, recovered quickly to be loose on the lead in the early going, freewheeled around the turn unchallenged up top but had a diminishing advantage just off the fence turning for home, had little left for the stretch drive and was engulfed by runners on both sides by the furlong marker.

MAC GOWAN tracked in behind the leading group first between runners then inside but off the fence two to three deep, floated out a path or so leaving the turn exchanging light brushes in the process, shifted in a bit once in upper stretch to rally between foes striking the lead a sixteenth from home and edging away late. MR. PERFECT moved forward inside to take a share of the lead up the backstretch, vied for that position into and on the turn saving ground on or juts off the rail, was headed late on that bend but fought back to retake a narrow advantage in upper stretch, was overtaken by the winner in deep stretch and proved no match but second best. BACCARO POINT vied between runners, dropped back to the second flight early on the turn chasing in behind the

leaders and outside a foe, fanned six wide into upper stretch exchanging incidental brushing in the process, kept on to secure show honors. UXBRIDGE ARMS (GB) broke a step slowly and steadied just slightly when in tight, lacked early speed bringing up the rear, saved some ground on the turn angling out five wide turning for home, moved out a bit further for room in later stretch and finished well but was not enough. INTERIM ANALYSIS was allowed to settle early dropping back off rivals and angling out at the five-eighths, advanced four wide into the turn, took a narrow lead near the quarter pole, could not sustain the effort and flattened out in the lane. SUMMER TRAIN chased from between foes early, dropped back but saved ground near the rail on the turn, kept on in the stretch just off the inside to improve. LAKE COMO HEIST vied between runners briefly for the early lead, dropped back between at the half, continued to chase near but off the rail running on one-paced. CARRICK ON STAGE lightly bumped a rival at the start, lacked early speed dropping back to last up the backstretch, raced outside a foe at the rear through the turn, came out nine wide at the top of the stretch, failed to menace. A REAL WAR STORY was just a bit restless in the gate, got away well and forced the pace from outside, vied with runners three wide on the turn racing between foes, came up empty in the stretch. BORDER FOX was lightly bumped at the start, chased the leaders briefly from close range then dropping back outside a foe heading into the turn, swung seven wide into upper stretch, was carried out a bit, faded.

ZISISIT (IRE) assumed command while in the three path up top inside a couple of runners heading into the first turn, rolled along loose up top down the backside, travelled smoothly quickening the tempo unopposed around the last turn, shifted just off the rail well in control at the top of the stretch and won comfortably for the wire to wire tally. GALLEY HEAD prompted the pace having to go five wide to do so in the beginning, tracked the frontrunner while outside two others down the backstretch, tried to move in chasing the leader around the far turn, stayed on the incorrect lead in the stretch drive but was unable to threaten the winner in the late going while easily besting the rest for the runners up share at the finish line. FLYING BLACK stumbled badly on the break, recovered quickly to force the pace between rivals four wide entering the initial bend, sat between horses watching the pacesetter at the half, was in the second flight on the outside keeping pace with the lead pair on the final turn, shifted out three wide dueling for a piece of the prize with the front duo having it to themselves in the final furlong and edged away outside winning the show money at the wire. ENGLISH JUBILEE had a good spot nestled on the rail watching the lead trio in the beginning, settled in the second flight inside another down the backstretch, took the short way around the last bend holding position, shifted to the two path battling between horses for the third place share at the top of the lane but was outfinished by the outside foe and settled on the fringes instead at the end. VOICE FROM ABOVE shared the rear on the inside, could see the field with a half mile remaining, saved ground on the last turn making some headway, skimmed the fence to be in the conversation for the show award in upper stretch but finished up one paced inside rivals in the final furlong. O WOW had a stalking position just off the rail ahead of a couple of runners, offered little progression three wide on the last bend by the quarter pole, angled to the four path for the drive to the finish line but could not get involved outside foes in the last eighth of a mile. MY GIRL SKY co-trailed on the

outside, improved position slightly at the half, was relegated again to the back of the pack outside rivals at the three-furlong pole and could not be a factor in the stretch running.

IMPERIAL GOLD was mildly coaxed to the lead and edged clear, set the pace inside, extended the advantage in upper stretch, held under steady urging. FRACEN MACHO settled just off the leader between runners, dropped back a bit into the turn then advanced two to three wide later on that bend, came in a bit near mid-stretch seeking room, was gaining but not quickly enough. PIN BOY bumped a rival at the start, settled off the pace outside runners, moved out from three to five wide on the turn, was encouraged along early on that bend, ran on outside to get up for show honors without threatening the top pair. TIME ZAPPER was bumped into a rival at the start, was forwardly-positioned just off the leaders and outside chasing three to four wide, ran on but lost third

late. CONACHER came out at the start and was bumped hard soon after, shifted in settling inside toward the back, angled seven wide in mid-stretch and improved position outside runners. ALPHA KADIN tracked the leader from inside, saved ground on the turn, was ridden along outside the quarter pole, steadied slightly when in tight near the furlong grounds, kept on inside. RAPID GREY was bumped between rivals and squeezed back just after the start, brought up the rear, moved out on the turn swinging seven wide into upper stretch before moving out further, ran on but was not a threat. HEAVEN'S CHAMPION chased up close two to three wide, faded. COMMANDER WORSLEY was bumped into a rival at the start, raced outside a rival off the pace going three wide on the turn and moving out late on that bend, came into upper stretch six deep, failed to menace.

TREVALLY broke inwards a touch on the start, made a savvy move getting to the rail watching the lone speed in the early going, travelled in the second flight inside keeping a close eye on the engaged duo down the backside, was nudged for more two wide to go after the leaders offering little gain by the quarter pole, rallied on the fence at the head of the lane under strong left handed encouragement, poked his head in front between horses at the sixteenth pole and held safe while drifting out slightly at the finish line for the win. FUN FELLA had a stalking trip ahead of only a couple runners for the first half of this route race, started to pick up the bit four wide circling around horses midway on the last turn, swung out widest gathering more momentum six wide straightening out for home and had a strong late surge outside rivals but just could not get to the winner in time. SILVER RALEIGH was forwardly placed outside the eventual winner tracking the leader, rallied smartly when called upon for more three wide at the quarter pole to loom boldly in the four-path turning for home, finished up willingly between the leaders in the final furlong but could not threaten in deep stretch for the win and settled for a clear third at the finish line. SOUTHERN STYLE was brushed by the outside foe on the start, settled on the rail in mid-division on the first of two turns, could not gain along the back straightaway, started to reach for more ground with runners on both sides at the quarter pole, shifted to the three path for the drive to the finish line and ran on with good late energy just off the fence in the last eighth to get up at the wire to be a fringe player. CONNOR utilized the inside position having the lead inside in the beginning, slowed the tempo down while having company outside down the backstretch at the half, dueled inside throughout the last turn, spurted away disposing of the early speed foe two wide in upper stretch, was still holding on at the furlong pole but needed more late when weakening inside of runners in the final seventy yards losing a minor share right at the wire. BALBON'S CREW had a stalking role on the fence, settled in the third tier on the rail along the backside making little movement, came under a ride taking the shortest path on the last turn but offered no response and lacked a rally on the rail in the final furlong. CATEGORY FIVE tracked the pacesetter on the outside, moved in to shadow the frontrunner still on the outside at the half, battled with the leader who had the rail throughout the last turn, gave way fighting up front three wide in upper stretch and wilted between horses at the furlong pole. LOUIS THE CHAMP was hustled early on trying to get better position between runners sitting in mid-pack in the beginning, made little change along the backside, closed the gap while three wide inside another foe on the final bend at the quarter marker, moved out four wide at the top of the stretch but failed to fire in the final furlong. STARVIN broke out but was quickly corrected by the rider, was allowed to settle at the back of the pack in the early stages, passed an inside runner at the half, narrowed the margin through the far turn two wide at the quarter pole, shifted to the four path turning for home, angled out further in the six path with a furlong to go but could only manage to catch one rival in the late going. LOST STAR advanced around rivals on the first turn going three to four wide, settled in midfield outside foes three deep down the backstretch, was under a drive but could only manage to hold position while three to four wide as well on the second bend and folded in the five path by the furlong marker. ALLBETSAREOFF was near the rear ahead of only one runner in the beginning, dropped back at the half seeing the field, lost touch with the pack by the five sixteenths pole, cantered through the lane well back when crossing the wire and walked home.
