COST OF WAR was away alertly prompting the issue three deep down the backside, let the frontrunner go on with it while still keeping a close eye staying well in range throughout the turn, started to reel in the pacesetter at the quarter pole when called upon, moved in on the outside by the furlong pole and powered past at the sixteenth pole to win going away when crossing the finish line. SHAK TOWN had a slim lead on the fence in the beginning, shook loose up top moving comfortably around the oval, skimmed the fence holding the advantage in upper stretch, still was on top but by a diminishing margin with a rival bearing down at the furlong pole, had no answer when the swept past on the outside in deep stretch and still finished up well enough to easily best the rest for the runners up share. IMPULSIVE BID was void of any early foot trailing the engaged trio early on, lagged behind the group on the turn, shifted out to the three-path turning for home and showed some late interest picking up the tired inside foe by the sixteenth pole to be a distant third in the end. CAJUN INFLUENCE vied between horses leaving the gate, took back off the contesting pair at the half, tried to keep up to the front twosome on the turn but was retreating by the quarter marker and wilted on the fence in mid-stretch.

BREAK THE SPELL broke a step slowly and was in tight after the start, settled toward the back inside foes, saved ground on the turn, tipped out four wide in upper- to mid-stretch, drove past. CLASSIC DANCER was quick to take the lead, set the pace inside shadowed by an outside foe, shook clear in upper- to mid-stretch, was caught late. ALWAYS A WAY tracked the leading pair from just off the rail and all alone, was encouraged along passing the

three-eighths, loomed a threat in upper stretch but needed more. BIG BABY HENRY was bumped sideways at the start, settled near mid-pack inside heading into the turn, switched outside a rival three wide past the three-eighths, floated five wide into upper stretch and ran on. BANKER'S HOURS was bumped into a rival and steadied slightly at the start, unhurriedly brought up the rear, saved ground advancing inside foes, came out a path in the stretch and improved. TAZMAN broke through the gate before other participants, pressed the pace from outside, was ridden along at the five-sixteenths, weakened in the stretch. HAPPY QUAD bumped the inside rival at the start, pursued from outside near mid-pack going three to five wide, failed to menace. QUIET INTENT was bumped into a rival at the start, raced outside a foe toward the rear early, was between runners on the turn, failed to rally. SILENT FORTUNE was outside rivals three to four wide through the turn and failed to menace. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS' INQUIRY INTO THE START IT WAS DETERMINED TAZMAN RECEIVED AN UNFAIR ADVANTAGE WITH WAGERS THEREFORE REFUNDED.

ENDRICK comfortably assumed command on the fence midway along the back straight, cruised around the turn taking the short way with the ride still in the saddle up front, opened up at will under a hand ride by the furlong pole and coasted home winning in dominant fashion. VAMOS VIEJO co-trailed on the inside down the backside, lagged behind the pack throughout the oval saving all the ground, swung out widest in the five path having clear run and offered a solid late charge outside of rivals to best the rest for the runners up share well behind the overpowering winner. EL ALACRAN was under a snug hold pulling the rider while forcing the issue on the outside in the early going, hounded the frontrunner outside throughout the turn, could not go with the winner straightening out for the drive two wide, finished up mildly in the final furlong getting nabbed for the place share outside late but just lasted between foes holding for the show money. CIRCLE BACK JACK had the rail being part to the trio watching the engaged front pair with still a half mile to run, made little headway on the fence around the bend and finished up gradually inside of runners down the lane just losing the finish for the third spot in the end. ECHO WITH LAUGHTER could see the field while running three deep on the outside of others, offered a brief turn of foot circling around horses three wide in midturn, remained in the three path in the mix in upper stretch but stalled between rivals in the last sixteenth. UNCAPTURED MOMENT was nudged along tracking the lead duo down the backstretch, retreated on the turn being passed on both sides at the five sixteenths marker, shifted to the three path at the head of the lane but came up empty for the stretch drive.

POCKET SPEED vied between runners in the early going, gave way arguing up top by the half, had little to offer on the turn when dropping back between horses at the five sixteenths pole seeing the field by the quarter marker and cantered home well back through the lane with the field quite strung out at the finish line.

MAGNA TIME stalked ahead of only a couple of runners for the first half of this route race, began to lengthen stride smoothly cruising horses three wide midway around the final turn, had clear aim on the leader four wide in mid-stretch outside rivals, charged outside in the late going under a vigorous ride and surged in deep stretch to edge away for the win. TWO OUT HERO was settled in the second flight on the outside rating kindly, narrowed the gap moving in three wide at the quarter pole, posed a threat between foes in the three path at the furlong pole, dueled between horses with a sixteenth to run battling head-to-head but was just outfinished by the outside winner late while still digging in at the wire to get the nod for second best. FIRST EMPIRE had the lead getting to the rail heading into the first of two turns, slowed the tempo down while being pressed outside down the back straight, still set the pace having a slim advantage inside around the second bend, scraped paint spurting clear turning for home, gave it all he had to the wire but could not fend off the late charge by the winner and then just got nodded out on the outside for the place share in a photo as well. IRONSTONE co-trailed on the outside, began to reach for more ground three wide outside foes at the quarter marker, shifted out to the five-path turning for home and showed good late energy closing well for a minor share while not that far off the top three in the end. DARK SCREEN sat all alone in midfield, stalked in the third flight inside the eventual winner

at the three eighths pole, took the short way around the bend making no gain, angled out to the two path in upper stretch but could only finish up one paced in the drive. PINELAND was on the outside tracking the frontrunner, took closer order down the backstretch hounded the leader, continued to be a thorn in the inside pacesetters side throughout the final turn, could not continue on with others in upper stretch and wilted between horses two wide in the final furlong. MOHAYMEN DIAMOND shared the rear on the inside in the early stages, took the short way around the far turn showing little and could not factor in the stretch drive. GARDEN OF WAR had an inside tracking position on the rail in the first turn as well as throughout the backside, was scrubbed on for more at the quarter pole but could not quicken with the lead trio in the last bend and tired on the fence in the final eighth of a mile.

HURRICANE CLAIR had the early advantage on the fence around the initial bend, was unfazed giving up the front end slowing the pace down at the nine sixteenths pole, shifted outside at the half, was kept busy in pursuit through the final turn, shifted out in the three path chipping away at the pacesetter, never gave in down the lane and wore down the leader outside with seventy yards from home to edge away for the win under a very savvy ride. DESIGN settled near the rear on the fence for the first half of this two-turn race, moved well closing in two wide at the five sixteenths pole, shifted out three wide at the two-furlong pole with numerous runners getting in tight quarters bunching up, angled to the rail in upper stretch and rallied smartly in the two path to get up for the place share right at the wire. TAKEMETOTHEBEACH contently tracked the frontrunner on the outside early on, seized command outside midway down the backstretch, opened up at the half, rolled along unopposed throughout the last turn, had control on the rail in upper stretch but was caught by the resurging winner outside with seventy yards from the line and then was nabbed outside right at the wire for the runners up position as well. ELYSIAN FIELD had the rail position sitting in midfield, improved inside of rivals at the half, moved up closer on the fence midway around the far turn, shifted out at the quarter pole but had little for the stretch run and evened out in the two path in the final furlong. WAR PAINTER had a stalking role ahead of a couple of runners, started to make a move three wide when scrubbed on edging up midway along the far turn, shifted out widest in the six path straightening out for the drive but stalled in the final furlong. SCAT GIRL tossed her head to be at the rear leaving the gate, continued to do so still under the wire for the first time

with a circuit remaining, lagged behind the group down the backside as well as around the second turn, shifted just off the fence for the drive to the wire but could not get involved. NO TIME had a good spot watching the lead pair, kept pace under a ride on the last turn but was in tight three to four wide between and behind horses at the quarter pole unable to maneuver, clipped heels stumbling, almost unseating the rider losing the irons in the process and could not recover after the fact. EL KABONG travelled three wide keeping a close eye on the front twosome, narrowed the margin on the duo by the half, made a strong swooping move four wide under a busy ride at the quarter pole, shifted out in the six path gathering more speed at the top of the stretch, stormed past inside horses taking control at the furlong marker and was kept to the task late to hold for the win. C MY MEISTER missed the break slightly at the start seeing the field in the early stages, co-trailed on the inside with a half mile still to run, remained at the rear four wide starting to get into gear at the five sixteenths pole, swung out widest in the six path getting a clear lane straightening out for the drive and flew home in the last furlong to be second best just back of the winner at the finish line. MASON'S GAMBLE stalked close to the back between horses, shared the back end outside another at the half, rallied passing foes three wide midpoint of the far turn, shifted to the five path in upper stretch and with a good late burst in the final furlong closed in smartly but just lost the nod inside at the wire for the runners up share. HEMLO GOLD travelled with runners on either side watching the lead duo, closed the gap on the front pair by the half, rallied three wide making a bid between rivals at the quarter pole, shifted to the five path for the stretch run coming on midway down the lane but faded slightly and was outfinished in deep stretch settling on only a minor share in the end. PALIO settled in the middle of the pack being on the outside, made no movement down the backstretch, rallied just off the fence at the five sixteenths pole, angled to the four-path unable to find a seam in upper stretch, had to be steadied at the furlong pole losing all momentum and could not get back into gear in time to be a factor. GIVEMEMYTHEMUSIC had the fence tracking the lead two runners, inched up on the fence around the last bend, was in tight on the rail in upper stretch, finally darted through by the sixteenth pole but was outkicked losing some positions in deep stretch. JIM'S HOPE had the rail position sitting in mid-division, dropped back a touch on the fence at the half mile pole, saved ground making little progression on the final turn and could not get into contention through the stretch drive. SAILOR'S PASSION was part of the back trio while outside going three wide on the first of two turns, had the three path still outside close the rear along the backside, made little headway three wide on the second bend and failed to menace in the five path in the drive to the finish line. RED PHARAOH chased the pace in the first bend, continued to go after the pacesetter down the backside, vied for the lead two wide closing in between runners at the quarter pole but could not find more late and yielded in the three path in the last sixteenth of a mile. PEJA DU was loose on the lead setting a lively early pace, still remained up top on the fence clinging to the lead with a host of outside rivals bearing down at the quarter pole, had little left in the two for the drive in mid-stretch and folded in the final furlong.
