BIG IMAGINATION (JPN) was quick to take the lead and shift in setting the pace in the clear, faced pressure up the backstretch, shook free of rivals into the far turn, extended the advantage slightly turning into upper stretch, held sway under steady handling. LITA MARIE was forwardly-positioned two to three wide stalking the eventual winner, took closer order to press from between runners past the five-eighths, lost some ground on the leader into the first turn, loomed a threat to close the gap but needed more late. STRATOSPHERIC was a bit rank inside and behind rivals on the first turn, settled down to stalk up the backstretch, advanced between foes passing the quarter pole, ran on to be best of the rest. BOSS LADY J settled at the rear from the start, saved ground, came out four to five wide at the top of the stretch, failed to menace. MALIBU BETTY was urged from the start, chased inside, steadily weakened. HAILEYS OLIVIA was caught outside foes into the first turn mostly four wide, advanced between foes early up the backstretch briefly pressing and in striking distance, soon retreated back off the leaders continuing four to five wide, swung out a bit wider for the drive, failed to rally. ALNESSA altered outside rivals entering the first turn, made an early advance five wide up the backstretch briefly reaching striking distance, faltered and faded.
