SILICIUM (FR) was well behind in the second flight outside tracking the embattled duo down the backside, sat isolated in third getting to the fence measuring the front twosome around the bend, scraped paint closing the gap smartly at the top of the stretch, darted up inside taking control with a sixteenth from home and was pulling away for the win at the finish line. SCARY SPEEDY had a head in front setting a swift pace along the backside, narrowly had control inside while hounded on the turn by a pesky speed rival, spurted clear two wide disposing of the early challenger in upper stretch, remained up top at the furlong marker but having rivals bearing down on each side, could not fend off the winner on the fence in the final sixteenth of a mile while lasting for the runners up share at the wire. PRETTY LIZA settled near the rear on the inside, trailed the pack by midturn, shifted to the three path looking for running room in upper stretch and when having a clear lane with a sixteenth remaining surged between runners late to win the battle in a three way photo for the show money. WORRY LESS travelled five deep part of the quintet chasing the engaged twosome down the backside, made a good rally when scrubbed along three wide outside of horses throughout the turn, angled out widest in the five path in with a chance for a piece of the prize straightening out for home, had good late energy outside of foes in deep stretch but lost the nod for the third place share at the wire. UNHEARD settled in the three path in midfield down the backside, crept closer going two wide around the bend at the quarter pole, shifted to the three path in the hunt at the top of the lane but could not find more late, stalling in deep stretch and was on the losing end inside for the three way battle for the show award. I'M TENACIOUS had the rail watching contesting duo down the backstretch, regressed taking the short way around the turn being passed by a couple of outside rivals at the five sixteenths pole, hugged the rail taking the corner but had no finish to offer in the stretch drive. CITORI pressed the frontrunner outside along the back straightaway, continued to battle outside under a lively pace around the oval, gave way four wide fighting up top at the head of the lane and folded by the furlong marker, used up from her early efforts duelling for the lead.
