CHAIRMAN BOB shared the back end outside another early down the backstretch, had the two path between rivals keeping a close eye sitting behind the lead trio with a half mile remaining, made little headway around the oval, shifted to the fence coming on at the furlong pole with the leader drifting out, darted up the rail at the sixteenth seizing control and won going away at the wire. JAMIESTA was unhurried co-trailing on the outside along the backstretch, closed in on the rail sitting behind the lead trio at the half, took the short way through the turn, scraped paint edging up at the top of the stretch, had to alter course outside two wide losing the rail path to the winner at the furlong pole, regained its run by the sixteenth pole and surged inside another at the wire getting the nod for the runners up share. CONACHER was in the mix leaving the gate, took back being reined in watching the front duo down the backstretch, sat poised isolated behind the contesting pair waiting for the cue to go from the rider , hugged the rail taking the corner, took the lead drifting out in the three path at the furlong pole, was no match for the charging winner inside by the sixteenth pole and just got nabbed at the wire inside for the place share. JMR SPEEDY ESCAPE prompted the pace between in the beginning, moved to the leader three deep at the half, forced the issue outside the frontrunner throughout the turn, shifted to the five path battling outside straightening out for home but had little kick in the late going and finished up one paced settling for a minor role in the end. SO CALLED VACATION was hustled having a brief advantage outside rivals down the chute, dropped back to last travelling three deep with a half mile still to run, kept pace under a ride but was going three wide around the bend, swung out widest in the six path turning for home and could only pick up the weary inside frontrunner at the finish line. CUTEEM LOOSE was scrubbed on at the start intent on getting the lead early on having a neck in front into the backstretch, had company on both sides at the half, dueled on the rail throughout the turn, shifted to the four-path clinging up top between rivals in upper stretch, stayed on the incorrect lead shortening stride down the lane and tired in the last sixteenth of a mile.
