SILENT SECRET broke slowly spotting the field down the backside while traveling off the fence, started to lengthen stride coming on at the three eighths pole, rallied throughout the turn under a hustling ride to bid between horses three wide at the quarter marker, shifted to the four path getting a neck in front on the two inside rivals at the top of the lane and pulled away on the outside with a sixteenth to go to be clear at the wire for the win. WELL LIT broke out a touch at the start, was nudged along on the fence improving down the backside to seize control inside the early leader at the half, narrowly continued up top inside on the turn with a host of rivals bearing down by the quarter pole, dug in stubbornly when collared outside by the winner at the top of the stretch, fought on valiantly until the sixteenth then giving way but still finished up a clear second best crossing the finish line. DEEP POCKETS pulled the rider outside to have a slim advantage down the backside in the beginning, remained hard held relinquishing the lead to an inside challenger at the half, shadowed the pacesetter on the turn, vied between horses two wide with four abreast at the quarter pole, shifted to the three path in the thick of things in upper stretch but was no match for the top pair with a sixteenth to go and safely settled for the show money. UP N THE ANTE was brushed slightly by the inside foe on the start, argued between rivals in the three path part of the early mix, closed in around the bend going three to four wide, dueled outside three runners fighting up top with a quarter mile to go, was fanned out giving way five wide straightening out for the drive and flattened out at the furlong marker holding on to be a fringe player in the end. AWESOME MALIBU had the three path with horses on either side being part of the early scramble leaving the gate, dropped back outside of foes to be at the rear with a half mile remaining, lagged well behind the group on the oval, shifted to the five path turning for home, could not factor late but did run on in the late going trying to garner a minor share at the finish line.

JIM'S HOPE was taken a hold of in tight between foes with the inside rival breaking out at the start, progressed on the rail into the turn sitting behind the pacesetter, settled on the fence in mid-division along the backside, made little movement when scrubbed on at the five sixteenths pole, scraped paint advancing turning for home, gathered more speed drifting out four wide getting a clear lane in upper stretch, switched back to the incorrect lead while still moving up to the front by the sixteenth pole and held sway for the win ayt the wire. PROUD RONIN broke inwards but was quickly straightening out, settled at the rear unhurried finding its stride in the early stages, closed in smartly on the far turn, had to wait behind a trio of runners at the quarter pole, weaved through horses getting a seam in the three path with a sixteenth making a good rally but it was not enough to threaten the winner at the finish line. NINJA STAR was pushed out five wide by the inside rival on the first turn, remained outside three deep tracking the lead pair along the backstretch, was hard ridden in the two path between foes but making little gain on the embattled duo through the final bend, angled out to the five path in the mix turning for home and ran on willingly to be a clear third at the finish. BUTTONWOOD TREE bobbled breaking out at the start, recouped to have the lead on the fence in the initial turn, controlled an even tempo while hounded outside down the backstretch, had the rail being headed at the quarter pole, still was holding on two wide inside another in upper stretch, kept trying while on the wrong lead shortening stride clinging up top with a sixteenth to run but faded on the rail in deep stretch only capturing a minor award in the end. ALLEY OOP JOHNNY was allowed to drift out four wide tracking the pacesetter around the first turn, took closer order sitting outside shadowing the frontrunner down the back straight, bid for the lead outside at the quarter pole, dueled outside in the three path straightening out for home, kept battled down the lane until the sixteenth pole and could not find more late wilting in deep stretch. PRINCE OF THIEVES travelled outside runners going six wide ahead of only one runner on the first of two turns, made no progress going outside foes in the three path along the back straight, offered a brief spurt three wide on the second bend at the quarter pole, swung out widest to the six path at the top of the lane but was empty for the stretch drive.

BULLET JOURNAL moved up to inherit the lead just off the fence inside the early leader under a snug hold at the five eighths pole, cruised around the bend with the rider still in the saddle opening up at the will by the quarter pole setting a lively pace, continued to increase the advantage turning for home well within himself and coasted on home unopposed for the dominant win. FLEURY settled in the middle of the pack while three deep outside a couple of rivals, improved three wide circling horses throughout the turn and closed in belatedly to easily best the rest for the runners up share but well behind the overpowering winner. BEAUTIFUL THINGS was hard held flanking the leader outside midway down the backstretch, was scrubbed on for more but the winner was getting away in midturn, continued to give futile chase in the four path down the lane, weakened in the final sixteenth of a mile and just lasted on the outside for the show award. APPRECIATIVELY had horses on both sides sitting in midfield down the backside, was roused but made little headway between foes around the bend, shifted to the three path for the stretch run and showed interest inside coming on late but just missed getting up for the third-place share at the finish line. PARTY CENTRAL was void of early foot seeing the field down the backside, remained at the rear in the early parts of the turn running, shifted to the four path catching up to runners by the quarter pole, angled to the five path for the drive to the wire but lacked a rally, failing to fire in the final furlong. CANDY COATED had the rail sitting in midfield down the backstretch, came under a drive but was going in the wrong direction on the fence at the five sixteenths pole, hugged the rail but folded in upper stretch.

LIBERTY BEACH was fleet footed seizing control inside by the time they entered the backstretch, dictated terms up top unchallenged around the bend, spurted away just off the rail when called upon for more at the head of the lane and was kept to the task holding safely for the frontrunning score at the finish line. MARCH veered in sharply on the break, recovered being a little keen inside having to be throttled down behind the stablemate midway along the backstretch, took the short way around following the leader on the turn, shifted to the two-path posing the main threat at the top of the lane, kept coming on relentlessly separating herself from the rest of the field for the secondary position in the stretch drive, closed in slightly on the winner in the final furlong but just could not get there in time. SUNDAY FINERY broke out at the start, had a good spot outside another while watching the lead duo down the back straight, was urged midturn coming with a run four wide making a bid at the quarter pole, angled to the five-path turning for home and finished up mildly to win the show battle albeit a distant third behind the front pair at the wire. TOBERMORY was on the outside of the pacesetter keeping a close eye down the backstretch, chased determinedly around the turn keeping the frontrunner well within range, shifted to the three path in the hunt in upper stretch but evened out in the final furlong and just got nabbed on the outside in a tight finish for third settling on the fringes in the end. BITTER BULLET had the rail while sitting in mid-division, started to make a move closing the margin smartly three wide between foes at the quarter marker, moved to the four path between horses in with a chance for a piece of the prize but stalled in the last eighth of a mile. MANDALENA shared the rear on the outside, was roused but could not make any impression around the oval, shifted out in the four path for the drive to the finish line but could not get involved in the stretch running. ZAHARI co-trailed on the inside down the backside, saved ground making little progression throughout the turn, skimmed the fence at the top of the stretch but could only pass

a weary outside runner in the final furlong. CHINOOK shied away from the outside rival that broke out at the start, had a stalking trip outside ahead of only a couple of rivals along the backside, offered a mild run on the turn narrowing the gap four wide at the quarter pole, could not sustain the rally and faltered between horses by the furlong marker.

MOBULA was roused outside right from the get-go, took the lead clearing off and getting over to the rail loose up top by the half while trying to conserve her speed, controlled the pace unopposed moving smoothly around the turn, increased the advantage just off the fence when asked for more in mid-stretch and was kept busy late to easily win in frontrunning fashion at the wire. ARYA'S QUEST was allowed to settle at the back, took the short way around the oval but could not make up any ground on her rivals in the turn running, scraped paint turning for home but failed to offer a finishing kick inside foes in the last furlong.

TIZ PRACTICAL had the two path in the middle of the pack with many runners at the half, was scrubbed on in midturn making little gain, started to get into gear three wide with aim on the embattled duo in upper stretch and wore down the lead pair in the stretch drive to get up late on the outside of the dueling pair for the stretch running win. HEADSPIN dueled on the inside down the back straight, had a slim lead throwing it down inside another on the bend setting a rapid pace, kept digging in holding on inside in the stretch drive, edged away from the early speed rival by the sixteenth pole but could not fend off the late charge by the winner outside in deep stretch, nonetheless a gutsy effort on the front end being second best on this day. FLYING SCHULZY broke inwards on the start, battled outside for the lead down the back straightaway, continued to slug it out on the outside of the frontrunner in their own little match race around the turn under a brisk pace, shifted to the three path still fighting on between runners in the final furlong but needed more late faded slightly in deep stretch to be a clear third on the wrong end of a three way finish for the win at the wire. LIVE EACH DAY was in tight trailing at the break, improved inside rivals to sit in the middle of the pack with three outside foes at the half mile pole, could not get into gear on the turn only having one rival beaten, shifted to the three path at the top of the stretch, moved back inside at the furlong pole then angled out again four wide in the final sixteenth coming on to be a fringe [player in the end. GOLDEN SUNSET was in no hurry seeing the field at the half, lagged behind while travelling two to three wide around the bend, shifted to the five-path turning for home, moved to the inside two wide in the final furlong and passed a couple of weary foes in the late going. CHANELFORHER settled four deep outside runners in mid-division with a half mile remaining, travelled three wide but could not gain on the pair up front who had a private duel to themselves around the oval and gave way in the four path in upper stretch having little to offer for the drive to the finish line. SMOLDERING had a head in front at the start leaving the chute, dropped back at the half to sit in midfield in the three path with horses on either side, came under a busy ride making no gain throughout the turn, swung out widest in the six path at the head of the lane but came up empty for the drive.

TAP MY DESIRE settled in the middle of the pack in tight surroundings between rivals along the back straight, was shuffled back slightly lacking running room at the half, started to commence a run just off the rail at the five sixteenths pole, cut the corner gathering more momentum coming on at the top of the lane, shifted out to the two path with a sixteenth remaining having her sights set on the frontrunner and charged home late to get up in the last jump outside for the stretch running victory. ALEATORIC had the rail up top setting a moderate pace on the engine down the backstretch, was nursed along setting an even tempo on the fence around the bend with company bearing down outside with a quarter mile still left to go, shot away two wide at the top of the lane finding more when confronted, moved well still in control with a furlong to go but just could not find more in the shadow of the wire and got nabbed right on the line outside for the win. MRS. G tracked the pacesetter outside early on, moved in when forced to hold position by the outside rival coming with a run in midturn to fight between runners for the lead at the quarter pole, shifted to the three path very much in the mix between horses in upper stretch, was no match for the lead twosome who had it to themselves in the final eighth but did show grit to win the show money duel inside in deep stretch. DADDY'S THE

BOSS was forwardly placed in the three path keeping a close eye on the lead two runners down the backside, closed in going three wide on the oval to bid outside two others for the front end at the quarter pole, remained in the thick of things still in the three path straightening out for home, evened out in the final furlong unable to threaten the lead duo at the furlong pole and lost out to an inside rival in the battle for the show money nearing the finish line. DEANNA stalked close to the back initially, was well in range seeing the field with the group tightly packed at the half, made a premature move swooping around horses for wide midway around the oval, loomed outside in the five path at the top of the stretch, could not sustain the rally and stalled at the furlong marker.
