AMAZIN QUEEN had a stalking trip ahead of only one runner in the early stages, closed the gap at the half, started to make a run moving up of the fence by the quarter pole, scraped paint reaching for more ground turning for home and surged inside the pacesetter in the final furlong to edge away for the win crossing the finish line. MOVENTOTHECOUNTRY controlled a tepid pace just off the rail in the early going, narrowly maintained control inside down the backstretch, scooted away disposing of the early pace rival by the five sixteenths pole, still was holding on in the three path midway down the stretch but could not find more late and was unable to repel the winners charge inside in the final seventy yards. MAKAYLA had a good spot nestled on the rail drafting behind the leader, rated kindly on the fence watching the engaged duo along the backside, rallied on the rail on the far turn, shifted out coming with a run at the quarter pole to be in the hunt three wide straightening out for home, was no match for the top duo in the final furlong but still ran on well enough to be a clear third at the finish line. BEAUTIFUL SKY broke a touch slow on the start, trailed the field on the first turn, remained in last with the field tightly compacted at the half mile marker, took the short way on the final bend making little headway, skimmed the fence passing an outside foe turning for home and had good late interest up the rail to settle on the fringes. THATSITTHATSALL settled in mid-division for the first part of this two-turn race, offered a good rally three wide circling around foes on the far turn, angled to the five path for the drive to the wire but had no finishing kick to offer in the late going. SIGHT TO SEE broke a touch slow on the start, tracked the leader three wide on the outside in the first turn, took closer order flanking the frontrunner outside down the back straightaway, was roused but could not keep up to rivals when being passed by foes on both sides midway through the final turn and emptied out in the four path at the top of the lane.

SOUPER SUNDAY settled into a rhythm co-trailing on the outside down the backstretch, started to get into gear well in hand gliding up inside at the quarter pole, pounced three wide finding a seam between horses in upper stretch, seized control leaving the furlong pole staying on the incorrect lead but in did not make any difference in the end and won going away smartly at the finish line. EMPTY GESTURE settled in midfield in the three path along the back straight, travelled two wide inside another tracking the engaged duo throughout the turn, angled out in the five path at the head of the lane, finished up solidly in the drive but was just second best behind the overpowering winner. PRIMA shared the rear inside another, lagged well behind the field around the oval, shifted just outside to the two path for the stretch drive and finished up with intent in the final eighth of a mile to be a clear third at the wire. EXECUTIVE SUCCESS pressed the issue outside the front runner, battled outside going head-to-head around the bend, inched away for the outright briefly between runners two wide in upper stretch, offered no resistance when the winner powered past in mid-stretch and had little left to give in the late running, wilting inside of horses in the final sixteenth. QUIET MADDELENA was in the middle of the pack outside a runner having the four path along the backside, travelled three wide on the turn making little gain on the lead twosome, shifted out widest in the five path for the stretch drive but had no finish to give in the late running. SUMMER SNOW had a slim lead on the inside, dueled on the fence with a pesky outside foe through the turn, was collared outside by runners straightening out for the drive and came up empty, folded up on the fence by mid-stretch.

MIDNITE SADIE was under a snug hold loose on the lead down the backstretch, rolled along unopposed throughout the turn, had a commanding lead moving well at the top of the lane, was kept to the task with a rival closing in on the outside and prevailed by a diminishing margin at the finish line for the frontrunning score. JINX ME broke out at the start, was content sitting back off the lone speed in the early going, chased the frontrunner on the turn inching closer by the quarter pole, posed the only threat three wide turning for home, closed in late to make it interesting in deep stretch but could not get to the winner in time. SERIOUS GREEN was bumped on the inside at the start, travelled three deep in midfield at the half mile marker, narrowed the margin at the quarter pole closing in two to three wide around the bend, shifted to the four path finishing up mildly in the stretch drive to easily hold for the show money with the field quite spread out crossing the finish line. WUNHAPPY WABBIT was checked between horses spotting the field many down the backstretch, started to come with a rally three wide in midturn passing an inside foe by the quarter pole, swung out widest in the six path turning for home, did not switch leads until late and could not get involved in the final furlong settling for a minor share in the end. LA BELVA pressed the issue inside in the beginning, took back at the five eighths pole being checked slightly letting the leader go on with things, was hard ridden going the wrong way taking the shortest path through the turn, trailed the group well back taking the stretch corner and cantered home in the final furlong.

SHAK TOWN had a poor start compromised by the assistant starter not being fully ready when the gates opened up and tossing its head in the process as well, recovered smartly to prompt the pace five deep down the backside, cleared off, crossing over loose on the lead by the three eighths pole, rolled along thorough the turn moving smartly on the front end, was well in control on the fence with a furlong to go and held on under a busy ride at the wire. ZIO CAVALLLO had a narrow lead with horses on either side at the break, surrendered the front end at the seven sixteenths pole, chased the leader two wide on the turn, posed the only threat just off the rail at the head of the lane, was inching closer in the late going but it wasn't enough to get to the winner at the wire. EXTRAORDINARY ONE (GB) trailed the bunched-up group at the half mile marker, remained at the back seeing the field throughout the turn, angled to the three path finding his best stride late down the lane and closed in sharply in deep stretch to capture the show award all the while not that far off the winner at the finish line too. FINE STYLE had a stalking role four deep outside of runners with the field tightly knitted at the half, offered a mild run two to three wide around horses on the oval, shifted to the five path for the stretch run and finished up gradually in the late going to settle on the fringes in the end. UNBRIDLED WEATHER was part of the early mix between foes in the three path, tracked the pacesetter outside another with three furlongs still to run, kept pace three wide on the turn but was ridden hard to do so, shifted to the two path in mix for a share in upper stretch but faded on the rail in the final seventy yards losing a couple of positions late. IMPULSIVE BID had the rail part of the early scrum, took back being reined in unable to hold inside position at the seven sixteenths pole, saved ground but made little impact around the turn, hugged the rail at the top of the stretch but could not factor in the last eighth of a mile. STEWARD'S INQUIRY AT THE START WAS DEEMED THAT #6 SHAK TOWN DID NOT RECEIVE A FAIR START BUT OVERCAME THE ISSUE WINNING THE RACE STILL AND NO CHANGE WAS REQUIRED

INDY ONE was coaxed quickly to the lead, set a pressured pace inside dueling on the turn, put away the sparring partner but found a new challenger to the outside, was headed past the furlong marker, fought back to regain command nearing the wire. INDIAN PEAK was lightly bumped at the start, tracked inside the second flight, moved out three then four wide past the quarter pole under urging, struck a narrow lead past the eighth pole while coming in a bit, was outfinished. POSEIDON STEEL lacked early speed racing last but one and outside, moved nearer the fence early on the turn saving some ground, came out a bit in the stretch and rallied between foes near the sixteenth pole to get up for show honors. PINE KNOLL chased from outside going three to four wide on the turn, was one-paced and failed to rally. ARABIAN PRINCE pressed the eventual winner, moved closer to duel on the turn drawing nearly even at the five-sixteenths and encouraged soon after, faltered and weakened in the stretch. REGAL MOMENT had the rail position sitting in the middle of the pack, shifted to the two path making no movement just galloping along rating kindly under a good hold between foes down the backside, was nudged to pick up the bit two wide at the quarter pole, found a seam three wide switching leads bursting between runners leaving the furlong pole and edged clear for the win ridden out at the finish line. BOUND TO BE TRUE tracked the pacesetter on the outside, took closer order moving in down the backstretch, bid for the lead outside with three eighths remaining, poked her head in front between foes at the furlong marker but could not withstand the winners late burst in deep stretch outside and gave way grudgingly in the final few strides. RETAIL THERAPIST was unhurried co-trailing on the outside initially, improved slightly outside foes down the backstretch by the half mile marker, continued to range up circling horses three wide on the final bend, shifted to the four path in the conversation turning for home, was outkicked in the late going for the top two spots but still ran on willingly to capture the show award at the wire. TANDHONEYWITHANE shared the rear on the inside on the first turn, could see the field along the backside, lagged at the back still in the running around the final bend, shifted off the leaders four wide turning for home and offered a good late run outside closing in sharply late for a minor award. STROKE OF GENIUS had a good spot drafting just back behind the pacesetter in the early stages, sat poised on the rail behind the engaged duo at the quarter pole waiting to make a run, had the fence in upper stretch just behind the leaders looking for room but when clear could not offer a finishing rally in deep stretch. WHISKEY N ICE assumed command just off the rail into the first of two turns, remained up top unchallenged slowing the tempo down along the backside, had company outside at the three furlong pole, dueled in the two path inside clinging onto the front end in upper stretch, could not find more in reserve late and folded on the fence in deep stretch.

DE LA RENTA quickly moved clear, set the pace inside on or just off the rail well in hand and going easy, was asked in upper stretch, responded to hold sway while being kept to the task. KING'S COUNSEL chased the eventual winner from outside racing mostly three to four wide, could make no headway but was clearly second best. HOOPS switched out a bit heading up the backstretch racing close up between foes in the second flight, dropped back racing in behind and outside on the second flight, went three wide on the turn, kept on in the stretch to secure show honors. WHATTA MOVE chased from outside midpack up the backstretch, shifted in heading into the turn, saved ground inside, tipped out a path or two in the lane, was outfinished for third but best of the rest. VINA ARANA (IRE) was allowed to settle at the back of the pack galloping along off the rail on the first of two turns, still could see the field along the backstretch, was nudged on the rail having a quick turn of foot response passing outside rivals sharply at the three eighths marker, glided between horses shifting out three wide at the five sixteenths marker coming with a brisk move, effortlessly took control four wide at the head of the lane and was kept to the task in the final furlong coasting home all alone at the finish line for the eye catching win. EQUITAS kept a close eye on the pacesetter while having runners on either side on the first turn, tracked the leader with an outside foe down the back straight while under a snug hold, had to wait on the rail in the far turn behind the pacesetter with outside foes getting the jump on her at the quarter pole, shifted to the three path for the drive to the wire but the winner was bursting away by mid-stretch and still finished up strongly nonetheless to best the rest for the runners up share albeit a distant second at the finish line. SULTANA had the fence position tracking the loose leader early on, sat all alone in midfield moving well along the backside, was roused four wide but could not match strides with the inside winner making a move at the five sixteenths pole and ran on mildly in the four path outside foes to get up in the late going for the third place share. BESSIE ABO TT (IRE) travelled three wide outside two others tracking the lone speed, settled in the second flight outside a fellow rival down the backstretch, moved in through the far turn vying between horses up top with a quarter mile still to run, could not sustain the rally in the stretch drive and evened out in the two path at the furlong pole to settle on the fringes in the end. FIERY LUCY (GB) had a stalking trip near the rear in the early stages ahead of only one runner who happened to be the eventual winner, closed to gap with a brief spurt three wide at the three-furlong pole outside rivals still at the back though, could not keep up to challengers on the far turn by the quarter marker but managed picked up a leg weary early frontrunner who ran out of steam in the final furlong. QUADRUPLE (GB) got to the lead from the outside post running keenly just off the fence into the first turn, continued to be headstrong even with the efforts of the rider trying to ration the early speed down the backside travelling loose up top under a brisk pace, had a slim advantage inside on the far turn, offered no resistance when the winner soared on by outside at the quarter pole, could not find more through the lane being used up from her early efforts and yielded to outside foes by the furlong pole.

LUSTER travelled three wide tracking the pace, rated kindly measuring the frontrunner down the backstretch on the outside, sauntered to the lead between horses with three furlongs remaining, was unfazed with the rider statuesque in the saddle when company was trying to bear down outside at the quarter pole, opened up at will with just a wave of the right handed crop in upper stretch and won under a hand ride being geared down in the final seventy yards for the authoritative win. DIXIE LAW had the two path sitting just behind the front three rivals around the first bend, shifted three deep narrowing the margin outside foes at the half, closed in to bid three wide outside the winner into the far turn, battled outside until the quarter pole, could not keep up with the dominant winner who had plenty left for the drive in upper stretch but did fight on stubbornly late to best others at the wire for the runners up share outside. BOLD TIME tracked the pacesetter with runners on both sides in the early going, had inside position in the second flight behind the frontrunner down the back straight, came under a vigorous ride trying to get to the front pair on the far turn but to no avail, skimmed the fence in with a chance for a piece of the prize and settled or a clear third while outkicked by the outside runner in the final sixteenth of a mile for the place award. KATIE'S GRACE broke a step slow settling near the rear between foes early on, co-trailed on the inside down the backstretch at the half, began to lengthen stride when urged on three furlongs

from home, passed a weary runner inside at the quarter pole, shifted to the five path at the top of the lane and finished up willingly outside foes in deep stretch to be a fringe player in the end. PIPER'S GIFT was checked in tight on the fence heading into the first turn, stalked down the backside only ahead of a couple of rivals down the backstretch, made a brief rally three wide at the three eighths pole chasing the lead pair on the final bend until the quarter marker, could not sustain the rally by upper stretch and finished up only one paced in the final furlong. RED GUITAR settled close to the back going three wide on the first of two turns, shared the rear outside another along the back straightaway, lagged well behind showing little around the far turn with the field quickening at the three furlong pole but did show some gumption down the lane to catch a straggler in the final furlong. KINZIE GIRL had the two path loose up top around the first bend, remained up front uncontested slowing the tempo down along the backside, was roused at the three-furlong pole inside having no answer when the winner went by outside, backed away abruptly throughout the final turn and was not persevered with cantering home in the final furlong. STEWARDS INQUIRY INTO THE FIRST TURN IN THE VICINITY OF THE 15/16THS POLE REGARDING #1 PIPERS GIFT AND #2 DIXIE LAW RESULTED IN NO CHANGE

G T FIVE HUNDRED stalked several lengths back of the early leader racing inside a foe but in the three path, moved in to save ground on the far turn taking closer order, angled out and bumped a rival lightly at the top of stretch, ground on and was carried out a bit nearing the sixteenth when taking the lead, held. IRISH ACES settled outside a foe off the leaders two to three wide, swung six deep into upper stretch, was carried out a bit late while gaining on the leader and just missed. MAYCOCKS BAY was coaxed forward from the break, soon made the lead, sped clear on the first turn dictating terms inside on or just off the rail, was asked in upper stretch, came out past the furlong marker to meet a challenger, was overtaken nearing the sixteenth pole and yielded late. PIPER'S FACTOR stalked outside four wide in the early going, drew closer to the leader three deep on the far turn, was bumped lightly at the top of the stretch when in striking range, flattened out late. WYOMING BILL settled last but one along the inside, moved out up the backstretch, swung seven wide into

WAR LEGEND had the rail sitting in midfield, commenced a run on the fence at the five sixteenths slipping inside a runner, shifted outside two wide weaving through horses smartly at the quarter pole coming up to the leader, posed the only threat in the three path turning for home, stormed on by with a sixteenth left to run and won going away at the finish line. SUPER TOM was away slowly well behind the field but on a good note well ahead of the other poor starter down the backside, remained well back of the pack early in the turn running, rallied hugging the rail passing an outside foe at the quarter pole, shifted three wide at the top of the stretch full of run and closed in smartly down the lane, was unable to get to the winner late but determinedly dug in to win the runners up share at the finish wire with a strong late surge. AUNTIE'S BAMBINO had a stalking trip ahead of only the two troubled starters down the backstretch, swooped around horses going five wide on the bend at the quarter pole reaching for more ground, swung out widest in the seven path straightening out for home, kept on fighting outside until the end, could not threaten the winner late and just missed out to the inside foe at the wire in a photo for the place share. STARSHIP SALUTE was away alertly for a short lead into the backstretch, relinquished the top spot briefly to two inside runners by the half mile marker,

regained control with three furlongs from home, opened up around the oval, shifted to the two path holding on well enough in upper stretch, gave way up front to the winner with a sixteenth still to run and wilted even further in deep stretch losing a couple of positions late to settle for only a minor role in the end. CLARKSBURG had a good spot on the outside watching the embattled foursome midway down the backside, was scrubbed on four wide in midturn making little headway between foes, angled to the six path in upper stretch but lacked a rally in the late running. FIGHTIN TO SURVIVE veered out sharply on the break spotting the field many lengths down the backside, closed the gap on runners around the bend, shifted out five wide at the top of lane catching up to rivals and managed to come on in the drive passing a few runners in the stretch drive. WILLFUL WARRIOR had the three path between horses part on the early scramble on the front end, was under a busy ride four wide just trying to hold position around the turn at the quarter pole, had little left for the drive to the finish line and tired in the final furlong. SLIGHTLY NAUGHTY was forwardly placed in the conversation up top on the fence, poked its head in front by the half, surrendered the lead by the three eights marker, could not keep up to the leader by midturn under right-handed encouragement, skimmed the fence turning for home and faltered inside foes in the last furlong. DWIGHT had a hustling ride from the onset dueling between runners at the half, was hard ridden retreating just off the fence throughout the turn, emptied out on the rail in upper stretch and cantered on it being wrapped up by the furlong pole.

BIG SCREEN BOSS got away alertly and went straight to the lead, set the pace inside shadowed by a foe, edged just clear in the stretch then held. FORESTERS LASTLOVE shifted in on the first turn, settled inside a foe in the second flight tracking the leading pair, angled out at the three-sixteenths, was gaining steadily late but needed more. BALTIC SEA moved forward and pressed the eventual winner from outside two to three wide, lacked the needed late kick. MISTER DUDE broke a step slowly then was sent forward but caught three to four wide into the first turn and taken back, stalked from outside, was ridden along passing the seven-sixteenths still three to four deep, came out a bit at the top of the stretch then immediately shifted in, ran on while coming out late. MISTER BEAN came in a bit at the start, lacked early speed, saved ground inside, came out a path or so for the stretch run, failed to rally. LITTLE THONIO travelled in the second flight outside down the back straight, moved in three wide circling foes on the turn to have a head in front briefly at the quarter pole, battled between runners in the three path but could not go on with the leader at the furlong marker, regained the front with the soon to be winner unseating the jockey coming up to the sixteenth pole and pulled away in deep stretch for the win. MR. PERFECT kept a close eye of the frontrunner tracking between horses in the early going, took closer order on the turn, vied between rivals up top by the five sixteenths pole, dueled inside two others having the two path in the stretch drive and evened out on the rail in the final furlong to be a clear second. TUCKERS TOWN was sandwiched between horses on the break trailing down the backstretch, still could see the field around the oval, caught up to an inside rival with a quarter mile from the prize, angled to the five-path showing good energy down the stretch, hurdled over the fallen jockey coming to the sixteenth pole, stayed on its feet and finished up

closing in for the show money. JOLTED broke inwards on the start, stalked close to the back end settling on the inside, was relegated to last inside another at the quarter pole, shifted to the four path for the stretch run and finished up mildly through the lane to garner a minor placing in the end. MESSY RIDING broke out at the start, recovered to track the lone speed on the rail down the backside, was roused at the five sixteenths pole shifting off the tiring leader by the quarter marker, moved to the three path in upper stretch between foes but had no finish to offer in the drive to the wire. SCREEN SCENE was fleet footed loose up top down the backstretch, had a dwindling advantage with many challenges coming on midway through the turn, gave way being engulfed by outside runners surrendering the lead at the quarter pole and ran out of gas stopping on the fence in upper stretch. BONGINO WARRIOR broke sharply in the beginning, dropped back near the rear outside down the backstretch, started to smoothly reach for more ground coming to the lead trio three to four wide outside around the bend, loomed a menacing presence in the hunt four wide at the quarter pole, took the lead clearing away outside under right-handed urging at the furlong pole, ducked out losing its rider shortly afterwards and walked off. STEWRDS GENERAL INQUIRY IN THE STRETCH RESULTED IN NO CHANGE
