SPRINGER had the rail from the onset tracking the engaged duo in the early stages, waited patiently on the fence behind the leader in midturn, scraped paint rallying up the rail in the stretch drive at the furlong pole and got up in the final few strides for the late running win. BIG LEW dueled on the inside along the backstretch, edged away taking sole ownership of the lead on the fence at the midpoint through the turn, had the two path holding on up front midway down the lane with the field coming on in every direction, still was up top looking for the wire with at the sixteenth pole but was just nabbed on the inside late for the win by his stablemate while lasting at the wire for the place share in a flurry of a finish. ALFRED BELLOWWS was brushed by the inside rival on the start, trailing the group along the backside, saved all the ground still at the rear in the turn running, shifted to the two path uncorking a run and surged between horses late in deep stretch to get the show money. FILM ACADEMY broke out slightly at the start, had a stalking role ahead of only one runner down the backside, made little movement around the bend, shifted out three wide at the quarter pole commencing a rally, swung out widest in the five path taking the corner and finished up gradually outside foes in a compact finish just missing the nod for the third place share. LEMON TWIST narrowly had the front end outside down the backstretch, lost the lead inside by the five sixteenths pole, angled three wide in upper stretch with runners on either side still in the hunt, was closing in with the rest of the field in the final furlong but it was not enough at the finish line. GUN COURT travelled in the second flight outside, took closer order three wide through the oval making a bid outside at the quarter pole, shifted to the four path with the field spread across the track at the top of the lane but was outkicked in a blanket finish at the wire.

ALBIE FIRST was hustled on the inside from the start getting into the race pressing the pace on the inside, tracked the loose frontrunner down the backside with an outside foe, started to come with a run at the three furlong marker, reached for more ground picking up speed when urged right handed at the quarter pole, was carried out six wide by the pacesetter straightening out for the drive and powered past by the furlong to win going away in the end. FLIGHTMARE had a slim lead between horses heading into the first bend, shook loose along the back straightaway slowing the tempo down in the process, had a dwindling advantage on the rail on the far turn by the quarter pole, was allowed to drift out five wide brushing the winner at the top of the stretch but could not match strides in the final furlong being a distant but clear second best at the wire. RACE DAY CHANCE was unhurried at the back of the pack around the initial bend, travelled three deep making little progression outside along the backstretch, shared the rear inside another throughout the final turn, hugged the rail at the top of the lane and won the show battle inside by the furlong pole. PRECIOUS KID bobbled on the break, recovered to prompt the pace three wide outside around the first turn, tracked the lone speed leader outside of the eventual winner down the backstretch, dropped back unable to keep up to the front two rivals by the three eighths pole, dueled outside for the third place share turning for home but emptied out in the final furlong.

ISAAC LEO broke in at the start, assumed the front controlling a soft pace left alone down the backside, rolled along up top with little pressure applied by outside rivals while quickening the tempo slightly around the bend, hugged the rail cutting the corner, had rivals outside bearing down late but under a well reserved and rationed out ride just lasted in a photo at the wire. MAC GOWAN was brushed outside on the start, had the fence being content to sit back off the pacesetter down the backstretch, inched closer still drafting behind the leader on the turn, shifted to the two path between rivals posing the main threat straightening out for home, kept edging up in deep stretch, surged right at the finish line but was denied by the slimmest of margins. RED D travelled in midfield outside having the three path down the backstretch, made some gradual gains three wide around the turn by the quarter pole, moved out to the four path in with a chance for a piece of the prize between foes, was closing in on the lead pair in deep stretch but could not get there in time settling for a solid and clear third in the end. WAHEELA broke a step slow, had a stalking position inside having only one runner beaten down the back straightaway, took the short way around making little progression on the turn,, shifted out to the five path off the leaders getting a clear run by mid-stretch and ran on with good late energy settling on the fringes unable to threaten the lead three at the finish line. DEVIL'S TONGUE chased the pacesetter outside down the backside, continued to go after the frontrunner two wide throughout the oval, shifted to the three path in the battle between horses in upper stretch for the lead but faded in the final eighth of a mile. HALCON NEGRO settled at the back of the pack in the early stages, could see the field lagging well behind still through the bend, shifted to the three path turning for home, narrowed the margin on the group down the stretch but could not get involved.

VOLCANIC exchanged incidental contact after the start, settled mid-pack inside, switched out past the nine-sixteenths racing two then three wide on the far turn, struck the lead leaving that bend, came into upper stretch four wide, drifted out in upper- to mid-stretch, was no match for the winner. RED WEAVER was under a snug hold on the rail just up top down the backstretch from two others, edged away for a clear advantage in midturn, shifted out to the two path at the head of the lane, had rivals on either side coming on in upper stretch, appeared to have lost the lead briefly bobbing heads with the inside rival seventy yards from the line but fought back and inched away at the wire for the gritty win. RIDE FOR THE PURSE was well placed on the rail watching the engaged trio early in the backstretch running, inched up on the lead pair inside at the quarter pole, skimmed the fence threatening at the top of the lane, darted up inside at the sixteenth pole going nose to nose in deep stretch with the winner but just lost the battle at the wire in a close finish. HIGHLAND BLUE broke in at the start, pressed the issue three deep outside leaving the gate and through the backstretch, shadowed the frontrunner outside around the bend, angled to the three path dueling outside two others at the top of the stretch but could not continue on with the front pair in the final furlong and easily bested the others for the show award. SWITCHIN' TO GLIDE settled on the outside in mid-division, was relegated to the rear while two wide at the three eighths pole, started to come on inside runners turning for home and ran on mildly inside rivals to get the nod at the wire for a minor share. BEE ME had the rear outside of the compact group at the half mile marker, made little headway for position three wide on the turn but closed the gap at the quarter pole, swung out widest in the five path turning for home but could only finish up one paced losing the duel outside for the minors. CATEGORY FIVE vied between runners in the early going, dropped back off the lead group by the half, came under a ride between horses in midfield around the turn, shifted four wide for the drive to the wire but tired with runners on each side at the furlong pole.

ENDRICK had the front end setting only a moderate pace while unchallenged both down the backside and throughout the turn, cruised home at the top of the lane, opened up even further in the final furlong and proved much the best at the wire. UNCAPTURED MOMENT had the two path between horses part of the tracking foursome down the backstretch, separated himself from the others giving futile chase on the winner around the bend, posed the only threat for a fleeting moment at the top of the lane, could not keep up by the furlong pole but still ran on with determination holding at the wire, besting the rest for the runners up share. BREAK THE SPELL was allowed to settle into stride trailing the field along the backstretch, started to pick up the bit when scrubbed for more shifting out four wide on the turn at the quarter pole, swung out widest in the five path for the drive and offered a solid stretch run, could not get to the winner but did finish up smartly just missing out closing in for the place share at the wire. ECHO WITH LAUGHTER was away slowly in last at the break, pulled the rider even though hard held up the fence improving inside horses to sit just behind the leader at the half mile marker, settled in midfield saving all the ground around the oval, hugged the rail improving position briefly turning for home but evened out in the final furlong settling on the fringes in the end. CIRCLE BACK JACK had the three path with rivals on both sides while sitting in mid-pack down the backside, could not keep up between runners midway through the turn, trailed the field three wide in upper stretch and only was able to catch a leg weary outside straggler at the sixteenth pole. VAMOS VIEJO travelled four deep part of the quartet in midfield early down the backside, had a four wide trip narrowing the margin in the leader on the turn making a brief rally at the quarter pole, could not sustain the run and wilted between foes in the final furlong.

CELEBRITY RO was forwardly-positioned early settling in to stalk while switching out off the inside, went two to three deep on the turn, came out a bit further at the top of the stretch, swept past near the sixteenth pole and drew clear. SIPPING HISTORY came out at the start, stalked from outside, advanced two to three wide on the turn, bid at the three-sixteenths, edged just clear past the furlong marker but was overtaken soon after and only second best. VEGAS ROAD bumped a rival lightly at the start, got away alertly and quickly went to the lead moving clear after a furlong, shifted in to set the pace on or just off the rail, was outkicked. SANS DANCER was lightly bumped at the break, settled off the pace and off the rail racing in the two path on the turn, split foes in upper stretch, kept on but needed more. VELOCITA was lightly bumped at the start, settled last but one, raced outside a foe on the turn, came out six wide in the stretch and passed tired rivals. ALLURING AMY chased from outside going three to four wide on the turn, failed to rally. HOT POTATO was allowed to find his stride trailing just off the fence in the early stages, had one runner beaten at the half, began to reach for more ground

two wide at the midpoint of the last turn, opted to go inside on the rail but having no running room losing momentum straightening out for home, angled out to the three path getting a clear lane at the furlong pole and came with a quick surge in deep stretch outside to get up in the final few strides. FOG D'ORO broke out at the start then was in tight from the inside foe a few jumps from the gate, stalked between runners close to the back, advanced smartly on the fence with a half mile remaining, squeezed through a narrow seam two wide at the five sixteenths pole uncorking a run, was in the hunt in the three path at the top of the lane, got to the lead on the rail with a sixteenth from home but could not fend off the winners late charge nearing the wire. CARRICK ON STAGE was brushed on the inside at the start, had a tracking position on the leader inside of a couple of rivals in the first of two turns, settled nicely on the rail watching the lead three horses at the half, had a sharp turn of foot rallying three wide between foes at the quarter pole, got his head in front in the four path at the top of the stretch, was collared by the inside challenger at the sixteenth pole relinquishing the lead but still stayed on strongly to the finish line to be a clear third. SUMMER TRAIN had the fence ahead of only the eventual winner in the beginning, sat at the back of the pack along the back straightaway, began to get into gear passing an outside runner on the turn at the three eighths pole, shifted out off rivals in the five path by mid-stretch for clear run and finished with intent on the outside getting the nod at the wire for the minors. RELOADED FORM stalked near the rear three wide on the first bend, improved outside foes along the backstretch to sit in midfield by the half, tried to circle around horses four to five wide through the last turn, was in the mix outside in the five path in upper stretch but stalled in the final furlong. BACK STREET DRIVER settled between runners keeping a close eye on the pacesetter, had the inside position tracking the frontrunner at the half, was going the wrong way unable to quicken with outside rivals at the quarter pole and tired on the fence in the stretch drive. A REAL WAR STORY was loose on the lead on the initial bend, continued up top unopposed along the back straight, remained up front midway through the second turn, had no response when engulfed by outside runners turning for home and folded on the fence by the furlong marker. LOVE PUDDLES had the rail sitting in midfield early on, was checked on the fence entering the backstretch, dropped back at the half, could not keep up to the field around the final bend and managed to pass only a troubled straggler in deep stretch. FIRSTGENERAL NIKAO was forwardly placed chasing the leader four wide in the first turn, tracked in the second flight outside down the backstretch, closed in midway through the far turn, could not keep up with the outside rivals who were coming with a run at the quarter pole and gave way losing his path three wide to the winner while having to be checked at the furlong pole.
