ROSIEPOSIE was away alertly getting to the rail easily setting the pace all alone down the backstretch, rolled along unchallenged under an even tempo through the turn, had company bearing down outside midway down the lane and was kept to the task in the late going to hold comfortably in the end for the front running score. MIGHT BEE TROUBLE stalked near the rear having the fence, trailed the group running on the rail throughout the oval, cut the corner scraping paint turning for home uncorking a rally and closed in belatedly inside of horses to best the rest for the runners up share at the finish line. GIZMO'S B F F had the rail tracking the pacesetter along the back straight, had to be checked getting shuffled back in tight with outside foes angling inwards heading into the turn, shifted out three wide at the quarter pole getting back into stride and ran on willingly in the final furlong being a clear third while getting outkicked late for the second place position inside. BLAZING SKY lacked early foot seeing the field while situated just off the fence along the backside, offered a brief spurt improving three wide around runners at the three furlong pole, swung out widest in the six path at the head of the lane, could only finish up one paced in the drive but did manage to nab an inside foe just before the wire to get the nod settling on the fringes in the end. WORLD SHOWCASE settled between runners in the second flight well in range of the leader, tracked the frontrunner following her path saving all the ground around the bend, shifted to the four path at the top of the stretch but lacked a rally through the lane just getting caught late losing out on a minor share. FOUNDER'S DAY travelled three deep keeping a close eye outside on the lone speed, chased the pacesetter on the turn inching up by the quarter pole, moved in outside two wide bidding for the front end at the furlong marker, took an awkward step unseating the rider coming up to the sixteenth pole and left via equine ambulance.STEWARDS GENERAL INQUIRY IN THE STRETCH RESULTED IN NO CHANGE

KEYTOTHEPARK moved forward between runners to the lead heading to the first turn and clear, set the pace inside, was asked in upper stretch, was stoutly urged in deep stretch and just held. BACKSTREET EMMA was taken hold racing mid-pack inside and in hand early, switched out for the run up the backstretch, advanced three wide on the far turn, continued to gain steadily through the stretch but just missed. PERFECT RING was unhurried at the back near the inside, came out five to six wide in the stretch, kept on to get up for show. REALLY BIG SHOW settled mid-pack inside through the early going, moved out on the far turn advancing outside a foe three wide at the five-sixteenths, came out further in mid-stretch and ran on. BUTTERFLY BILLIE tracked up close from inside, weakened. MALIBU BETTY bumped a rival lightly at the start, shifted in entering the first turn racing outside a rival two to three deep, moved in tandem with that rival four wide midway on the far turn but failed to rally in the stretch. FUN TIME was lightly bumped at the start, stalked from outside two to three wide, dropped back and faded. KITTABARTA switched out entering the first turn racing four wide and dropping back to the rear soon after, was never a threat.

HOPE SHE FIRES broke out on the start, settled in the second flight with runners on either side in the early going, began to lengthen stride two wide on the turn passing an outside foe at the quarter pole, shifted to the four path in the hunt straightening out for home, closed in by the furlong marker and drove past seizing control by the sixteenth pole holding on comfortably for the win. I LOVE PRESENTS had a stalking trip ahead of only the troubled starters down the backstretch, kept pace around the turn, angled to the five path commencing a run in with a chance at the head of the lane, finished up strongly but could not get to the winner while clearly second best at the finish line. SYMPATICO travelled three deep outside a couple of rivals keeping a close eye on the pacesetter midway along the backstretch, offered a sharp move circling horses three to four wide throughout the oval, had a head in front by mid-stretch between foes, could not sustain the rally in deep stretch unable to fend off the front pair late and just lasted at the finish line for the show money. KEEPING THE VOW had a good spot nestled on the rail watching the engaged front duo, kept a close eye on the frontrunner travelling in the rail at the half, shifted out

two wide in midturn coming with a run, dueled between rivals up top in upper stretch but evened out inside foes in the final eighth of a mile losing the tight photo for third at the wire. SHOOT had a head in front initially, relinquished the lead tracking the new leader outside with a half mile still to run, could not quicken when passed on both sides two wide at the quarter pole and could only manage to pass the tired early frontrunner who ran out of gas in the final furlong. CALL ME MISSLUCKY prompted the early pace on the inside, shook clear on the front end by the half, set a brisk tempo in control on the turn, was collared outside offering no resistance when turning for home and emptied out on the rail, wilting by the furlong pole. FULLY COMPLETELY had all sorts of problems on the break, was restless in the stall prior to the start, then broke slowly followed up by being bumped by the inside foe to co-trail the field inside another down the early backstretch, made little impact ahead of only the other troubled starter around the bend, skimmed the fence turning for home but had no finish to offer down the lane inside of horses. DON'T SAY A WORD broke inwards then was jostled around between horses at the start sharing the rear outside in the beginning, lagged well behind throughout the turn, shifted to the three path for the stretch drive but could no factor in the late running.

AUSSIE HYPER stalked up close mostly three wide, bid between foes in late stretch but was outfinished. CATCH THE DRIFT moved clear to set the pace near but off the rail, was asked at the top of the stretch, fought on but was outfinished. FOXY DIVA shifted in tucking in behind the leader to track from inside, was urged along passing the five-sixteenths, found room up the rail in the stretch, drew nearly even and kept on. ENGLISH JUBILEE steadied on heels early, raced between foes into the first turn, continued at the rear inside a rival but off the fence into the far turn, shifted three to four wide in the stretch and ran on but needed more. FLYING BLACK broke a half-step slowly, switched out in the early going racing three wide into the first turn, settled at the rear, came out seven wide in mid-stretch, ran on evenly. LOVEUMISSUMEANIT stumbled and checked in the early going, saved ground racing inside, failed to rally. O WOW was outside foes four wide at the rear early, floated eight wide into upper stretch, failed to rally. MADAM GWEN shifted nearer but off the fence heading to the first turn racing in about the two to three path, angled seven deep at the top of the stretch, was never near enough to threaten.

TWISTING PISTONS pressed the issue in the inside leaving the chute, got her head in front on the rail by the half, edged clear from the early speed rival outside by the five sixteenths pole, remained in control on the rail with company bearing down outside in mid-stretch but had more in reserve under a well rated ride and burst away again when asked for run in the final eighth of a mile cruising on home when crossing the finish line for the win. THAT GIRL ARTEMUS lagged at the back of the pack in the beginning, shared the rear inside another with a half mile from home, started to reach more ground midway along the turn on the fence picking up outside rivals, hugged the rail in the conversation up top in upper stretch, shifted to the two path in the final furlong and determinedly got up winning the duel outside for the secondary share in a tight photo. LADY ON THE NILE shifted in from five to three wide entering the first turn, settled outside a foe mid-pack racing two to three deep into the far turn, swung five to six wide out of that bend and under urging, drove past inside the final sixteenth. SCAT HUMOR shifted in while moving forward into the first turn,

tracked the pace from inside, moved out midway on the far turn coming three then four wide toward the top of the stretch and advancing outside the leaders, struck the front past the three-sixteenths, led till past the sixteenth pole and was outkicked. DESIGN DIVA shifted in early, settled near mid-division inside, dropped back on the far turn waiting patiently, came out a bit in upper stretch then shifted back in rallying inside foes before tipping back out in deep stretch and was gaining late. GREENWICH PIKE got away well, settled in behind the leaders tracking inside and saving ground, came out for the drive, ran on. ATLANTIC PASSAGE switched out into the first turn to stalk the leader from outside two to three wide, moved to challenge midway on the far turn, took the lead by the quarter pole, was overtaken in upper stretch and weakened. RATINGS UPGRADE (IRE) bumped the inside rival lightly at the start, raced inside well off the pace early, moved out off the fence on the far turn, fanned seven wide into upper stretch, lugged in a bit in mid-stretch, came back out and improved position. MIA MITOLE was floated four to five wide into the first turn, settled outside off the pace, fanned nine wide into upper stretch, ran on evenly. TABEL switched out off the inside early racing toward the back in the two to three path, advanced outside foes on the far turn four wide moving out eight deep into upper stretch, flattened out in the lane. MOMANDA moved to the lead quickly, set the pace on or just off the rail, was challenged nearing the five-sixteenths, lost the lead soon after, faltered in the stretch. RELOAD BABA stalked up close and outside three to four wide, dropped back and faded. HEBRIDEAN MISS was bumped and steadied at the start, lacked speed racing far back, was pulled up in the stretch and transported off the track via equine ambulance.

SHINING SILVER broke out on the start, seized control right from the get go bursting away down the backside, increased the lead rambling along quickening an already speedy pace around the oval, had a big advantage switching back to the incorrect lead when urged on right handed by the jockey at the furlong pole and won comfortably running them off their feet in a gate to wire tally. TOTALLY IN CHARGE settled between challengers watching the loose frontrunner down the back straight, dropped back at the half having only one runner beaten, started to re-rally four wide on the outside at the quarter mile marker and closed in just getting up in the late going to be a distant second behind the overpowering winner. ORIENT BEACH travelled three deep outside a couple of rivals in the second tier well back of the runaway leader, tried to close the gap outside another on the pacesetter but to no avail around the bend, shifted just off the fence straightening out for home holding for the place share with the winner well ahead by the furlong marker but conceded dueling inside for the runners up share in deep stretch. OLIVIA'S MELODY was unhurried at the back of the pack in the early stages, started to gather more momentum shifting out off weakening foes three wide at the quarter pole, moved to the four path in upper stretch and ran on evenly through the drive but could not improve late and settled for a minor placing. SUNNYVILLE had the outside stalking near the rear, offered a mild run two wide between horses improving position briefly on the turn at the quarter marker but could finish up the run and showed little in the stretch drive having the two path. SEEKING MAGIC was off a step slow on the break, recovered quickly to have an inside tracking position on the lone speed leader down the backstretch, chased the rapid pace in tandem with an outside foe but the winner was opening up at will throughout the turn and tired inside off runners at the quarter pole giving way on the fence at the top of the lane.

STRATOSPHERIC was situated close to the back end galloping along on the fence, improved on the rail down the backstretch, shifted out three wide at the three eighths marker coming with a sharp turn of foot, loomed boldly swooping around foes six wide in the outside at the head of the lane and under a vigorous stretch ride drove by taking command outside at the seventy yard marker for the late running win. CHERVONARUTA had a nice set up on the rail watching the early speed duel, continued to draft behind the contesting pair still under a snug hold on the rail with a half mile remaining, sat posed waiting

for room to open up just off the fence in the far turn, found a lane darting through in the three path at the furlong marker taking the lead on the rail but with a sixteenth from the wire could not hold off the winner in deep stretch. STRAWBERRY WORLD was in the second pairing outside keeping tabs on the embattled twosome around the first turn as well as down the backside, ranged up three wide outside runners on the final turn to get to the front end four wide between rivals in upper stretch, was no match unable to quicken late with the top two horses by the sixteenth pole but did show grit digging in late just holding on for third place share outside at the finish line. PAT'S HOLIDAY had a poor beginning tossing its head, breaking inwards and having to be taken hold of for a few strides seeing the field by many in the early stages, caught up to the pack sharing the rear inside at the half, advanced smartly on the rail on the last bend, was in striking distance two wide turning for home looking for a seam, moved back to the rail in the final eighth of a mile and finished up strong enough but just got out noddled losing the fight for the show money inside. CHOCOLATECROISSANT (IRE) battled outside for the lead under a quick opening quarter, hounded the frontrunner on the outside flank down the backstretch, got a head in front two wide making a brief move at the five sixteenths pole between foes but could not find more late and faded with runners on either side in the two path by the furlong pole. DANISH COOKIE hopped on the break, settled on the fence getting to midfield around the first of two turns, closed the gap smartly between horses down the backstretch, was hard ridden two to three wide just off the lead group still forwardly placed around the second bend, shifted five wide with horses on either side at the top of the stretch in the mix of things, had to be checked in tight losing her path coming up to the furlong pole and could not recover to threaten afterwards. PHEW travelled on the outside of another in mid-pack, regressed through the field along the back straight lagging behind the group by the three eighths marker and showed a little interest inside only passing a couple of weary runners in the late going. ALNESSA stalked close to the back ahead of only one rival, co-trailed on the outside at the half mile pole, made little headway just off the rail around the final turn and in the four path failed to menace in the stretch running. NILE PASSAGE fought inside for the front end setting a brisk early pace, had a slim advantage on the fence slowing the pace along the backside, had little left from her early efforts offering no resistance when swarmed by multiple outside runners at the quarter pole giving way up top, stopped by the furlong marker inside foes and was wrapped up cantering across the finish line.
