DAZZLING CRUISER had the rail position ahead of only one runner in the beginning stages, pull the rider closer improving on the fence along the backside sitting just behind the pacesetter, waited under a hard hold measuring the contesting trio on the last turn at the quarter pole, had a big opening scraping paint turning for home, shot through in mid-stretch battling inside runners to the wire and under a well-timed surge got the nod perfectly at the finish line to get the win inside another. Z TRAIN (IRE) settled in midfield on the outside going three wide around the first of two turns, continued down the backstretch rating kindly waiting for the cue to go, closed in sharply prompting the pace three wide at the five sixteenths pole, angled out to the four-path fighting outside two others in early stretch for the lead, battled head-to-head in the late running but was denied at the wire in a tight finish. GO GIFFEN settled at the rear in the first turn, co-trailed shifting to the outside down the backstretch, travelled three wide at the back end but the field was tightly bunched at the midway point of the last turn, swung out widest in the five-path straightening out home well within striking distance in upper stretch and closed in belatedly outside getting the show money. JUST MAGNIFICENT travelled between horses in mid-division, dropped back to share the rear inside down the backstretch, started to inch up having the rail on the far bend, skimmed the fence taking the corner and had late energy getting up on the last jump for a minor placing. SPUN AROUND pressed the pace on the outside in the beginning, took back slightly content to track the frontrunner outside along the back straight, took closer order vying between foes for the front end at the five sixteenths pole, dueled in the three path with runners on either side in upper stretch, could not find more in the late drive though and faded with a sixteenth left to run just getting caught losing the photo for the minors. BLAMELESS GHOST had a slim lead on the rail around the first turn, edged away for a clear advantage down the backstretch, continued up top narrowly taking the short way around the final bend, was engulfed by runners on both sides two wide turning for home and emptied out by the sixteenth pole.

MAYNARD'S SONG was unhurried galloping along finding his stride trailing the field on the fence down the backside, saved all the ground still lagging behind the group in the turn running, skimmed the fence picking up speed turning for home and stormed home on the rail in the final furlong to get up for the last to first win in the final few jumps. LAKE COMO HEIST had a slim lead on the inside of another while controlling the pace just off the fence, continued to keep ahead in front still in the two path around the bend, shifted out two to three wide holding off rivals in upper stretch, stayed on the incorrect lead throughout the stretch run and was nabbed by the charging winner inside in the shadow of the wire. ASHUKA prompted the pace outside down the backstretch, continued to be a thorn in the frontrunners right side hounding the pace throughout the turn, shifted to the three path in mix at the top of the lane and finished up willingly to be a clear but distant third in the end. CASTLE HARBOUR stalked close to the back between horses, shifted out three wide at the quarter pole picking up the bit, moved out widest in the in the six path getting a clear lane for the drive to the wire but could only run on mildly passing tired foes settling on the fringes but could not threaten the top three at the finish line. GLORIOUS REVENGE had a good spot drafting behind the frontrunner under a snug hold down the backstretch, continued to sit back just off the leader on the turn waiting for the cue to go, had the two path in the mix at the top of the stretch but failed to fire in the final furlong. POILIEVRE was well positioned between runners keeping a close eye of the front duo down the backstretch, remained between foes sitting just back off the contested twosome around the oval, had the three path at the head of the lane but lacked a finishing rally with challengers on either side in the stretch drive. IMPERIAL WAR travelled four deep outside foes down the backstretch by the half, tracked the dueling pair taking the outside route going three wide on the bend, angled out to the five path giving way to others tiring in upper stretch and could not play a role in the last eighth of a mile. ENCORE MO was outside of rivals near the rear end in the early running, travelled three to four wide but was going in

the wrong direction by the quarter pole, shifted five wide trailing the field in upper stretch but could not factor in the running down the lane.

CLASSIC DANCER was forwardly-positioned stalking the leader from off the rail, ground on under steady hand urging in the stretch to take the lead a sixteenth out, edged clear and held. ONE MORE BREW stalked from outside racing three wide, was asked to pick it up past the quarter pole, shifted out in mid-stretch racing six deep, kept on in the lane but needed more. EL KABONG settled outside a foe mid-pack two to three wide, was encouraged leaving the far turn swinging five wide into upper stretch, was forced out a couple paths in mid-stretch, gained late. C MY MEISTER broke a step slowly, settled at the rear outside a foe, fanned six wide into upper stretch, gained too late. PEJA DU was coaxed at the start, quickly moved clear and shifted in, was a bit keen in the early going setting the pace inside, was overtaken a sixteenth out and faded. MASON'S GAMBLE settled at the back inside, came off the rail on the far turn, failed to rally. AMERICAN DECISION saved ground inside mid-pack, was under urging past the five-sixteenths, weakened in the stretch.

ANGEL DANIELLE had the lead outside a few runners leaving the gate, cleared away finally shaking loose on the rail by the half, dictated terms up top unopposed running smoothly around the turn, spurted away once again under a well rationed out ride when urged right-handed by mid-stretch and was kept to the task to the end holding safely for the frontrunning score. LORRAINE'S BEAUTY chased the pacesetter outside down the backstretch, continued to go after the pacesetter inside another throughout the turn, shifted to the three path in the thick of things between horses straightening out for the home, never gave in running on up gamely through the stretch drive but was just second best to the winner on this day. MIGHTY TANNER pressed the pace inside initially, was reined in to sit in mid-division on the fence by the half, took the shortest way around the oval keeping pace with outside foes, lengthened stride coming on hugging the rail at the top of the stretch and finished up mildly between runners in the late going to capture the show money. HYMN TO HER was void of early foot leaving the gate at the back of the pack, improved slightly down the backside, had the two path between horses but was relegated back to the rear in midturn, shifted to the three path looking for seam coming on with a rally at the head of the lane and finished up gradually four wide in the final furlong to be a fringe player in the end. REGAL AFFAIR was unhurried along the backside seeing the group at the half mile pole, offered a brief turn of foot circling three to four wide from the three eighths pole until the quarter marker, was floated out in the six path with the field bunching up turning for home, could not sustain the rally in the drive and wilted in the final furlong. LADY IONA had the outside sitting in mid-pack with a half mile still to run, closed in to track the leader three wide at the three-furlong pole, shifted to the five path in with a chance still for a piece of the prize well in range at the top of the stretch

but could not find more late and faltered in the final eighth of a mile outside rivals.

COOL TIMES dueled inside through the first turn, shook clear opening up by many down the backstretch setting a lively tempo, had a diminishing lead galloping along getting a breather midway along the turn, was shook up at the quarter pole hearing the outside rival bearing down, quickly responded increasing the advantage once again at the top of the lane and cruised in for the frontrunning score. YORKTON'S TAFFY edged up improving on the rail in the first turn, dropped back on the fence along the backside to be part of the rear trio at the half,had no room being forced to wait at the three furlong pole, shot through making a sharp move splitting foes with a quick turn of foot at the quarter pole, angled to the three path for the stretch drive and was the only one to offer a good finishing kick to the wire besting the rest for the runners up share behind the dominant winner. UNFORGETTABLE FACE (IRE) veered in on the break but was quickly corrected, settled in mid-pack between rivals on the first bend, regressed slightly in the two path along the back straight, inched up on the fence at the five sixteenths pole, shifted outside three wide passing a tired runner at the quarter pole, kept plugging away in the four path down the entire stretch and got up in the last jump outside another for the show money. INESCAPABLE had the fence watching the engaged duo, began to reach for more ground at the half going after the frontrunner, closed in resolutely two wide on the far turn taking a shot at the winner at the quarter pole, could not keep up by the three sixteenths pole and flattened out inside of runners in the final seventy yards losing a couple of placings late and settled on the fringes instead in the end. WHISKEY OVER WINE co-trailed on the inside having the two path in the early stages, lagged behind foes on the backside, started to come with a mild move three wide outside rivals midway through the final bend, angled to the four-path battling for a minor share in upper stretch with rivals on either side but stalled on the rail at the furlong marker.. WINNING AGENDA co-trailed going four wide outside of foes on the first bend, made little movement three deep down the backstretch, was relegated to the rear three wide with three furlongs still to run, caught a tired runner turning for home and could only manage to pick up another straggler in the late running. DAKOTAH BLUE went three wide outside of horses in the first bend sitting in mid-pack, continued to gallop in a good rhythm finding her stride down the backside, was urged on the far turn at the quarter pole coming with a solid run, had a full head of steam in the six path in upper stretch, moved in sharply under a vigorous ride with a furlong to go, got her head in front with seventy yards from the prize and tenaciously held off the late charge outside by the runner up. BANDIAGARA (GB) was allowed to settle into stride on the fence trailing for the first half of this two turn route race, started to gather momentum shifting out two wide at the five sixteenth pole passing a tired runner, skimmed the fence at the head of the lane, switched leads shifting out opting to go widest for clear run in the seven path at the furlong pole full of run and rushed home on the outside but could not get to the winner in time. FLOWERHEAD (IRE) travelled in midfield just off the fence, closed the gap mildly down the backside, waited for the cue to go in the second flight outside the engaged duo

midpoint of the final turn, angled to the four path posing a threat between rivals at the top of the stretch, fought on determinedly in the thick of things until deep stretch but was just outkicked by the top two runners while capturing the show award not that far off the winner at the finish line. CREED'S GOLD got away well, eased back from between the early leaders to stalk from the two path, saved ground on the turn, tipped out at the top of the stretch and was set down for the drive, struck the lead in mid-stretch and drew clear. TIME TO DAZZLE got away well, settled off the pace, was forced four wide on the turn, drifted out in the stretch but held the place. REAGAN'S FLAME was bumped at the start, settled at the rear, moved up outside foes four

wide on the turn, floated wider into upper stretch then shifted in near the sixteenth pole and kept on to secure show honors. UPHILL DANCE settled mid-pack inside, saved ground on the turn, came out a path or two for the drive and ran on evenly. KEHOE BEACH vied for the early lead taking charge and moving clear to dictate terms from off the rail by the half, weakened in the stretch. FANTASTICAL broke out slightly on the start, was then pushed out five wide between foes from the troubled inside rival into the first turn, after all that relaxed smartly in midfield outside another down the backstretch, sat poised inching up three wide outside foes around the final bend, had the three path in the hunt starting to make a rally with runners on both sides in upper stretch, moved four wide in the heat of battle outside the leader and closed in tenaciously late to get up for the win in the final jump. LUPA (IRE) was one of only a few that broke alertly having the lead inside early on, pulled at the rider who was trying to soften the pace while loose up top down the backstretch, settled into stride moving well up top around the far turn, hugged the rail holding on at the top of the lane, spurted away at the furlong pole when feeling pressure outside, kept fighting to the very end but just got caught right at the finish

line losing in tight photo for the all the money inside. FORTYFIVESEVENTY broke inwards getting tangled up with the inside foe on the start, recouped to have a good spot tucked in on the rail well in hand watching the lead front pair, sat forwardly placed watching the front three down the backside, inched up in hand at the five sixteenths pole, had the two path in the mix at the top of the stretch, dueled between foes three wide at the furlong pole, surged in deep stretch but was on the losing end on a close three way photo for the win. GOLDEN SUNSHINE broke out on the start, settled on the outside close to the back end, had only one runner beaten along the backside, started to uncork a run inside two others on the rail with five sixteenths left to go, shifted out widest in the six path coming on, found more switching leads and gears at the furlong marker and charged home sharply in the late stages settling only on the fringes while just back off the front three at the finish line. RASHMI was away well content to sit off the lone speed in the early stages, glided two wide outside to the frontrunner on the far turn, loomed boldly making a bid just off the pacesetter straightening out for the drive, was asked for more by the rider left-handed at the furlong pole very much in the conversation for the top spot but failed to fire late and was outfinished in deep stretch. DESIGN was sandwiched between runners trailing at the start, lagged behind the pack down the backside, took the short way around the far turn still seeing the field, cut the corner passing outside foes turning for home and finished up with interest closing the margin on runners in the final furlong. CRYSTAL VISIONS was well placed outside keeping an eye of the lead two runners, remained in the second flight outside down the backstretch, was roused for more at the five sixteenths pole keeping pace on along the final bend, shifted to the four path for the drive to the wire but wilted between foes by mid-stretch. SCAT GIRL tossed her head soon after leaving the gate, was forced out six wide on the initial bend, stalked in the three path outside horses along the back straightaway, was urged right-handed three wide at the three eighths pole unable to offer a rally and was fanned out six wide again by an inside foe turning for home giving way in upper stretch. HURRICANE CLAIR hopped up and over to the right getting mixed up with the outside rival on the break, became rank behind foes getting the kickback just before the turn veering out sharply four wide with the rider trying to hold his lane into the first turn, had a couple beaten along the backstretch, was hard ridden making no gain at the three furlong pole and weakened moving out to the five path at the top of the lane.

GO OLIVIA was forwardly placed from the onset sitting back just off the frontrunner midway around the first of two turns well rated under a hard hold, drafted behind the pacesetter having the fence down the backside, waited for the cue to move having the rail measuring the pacesetter around the last bend, angled

out three wide straightening out for home pouncing outside by the furlong pole and with a quick late turn off foot won going away when crossing the finish line. ASHLEE B settled at the back of the pack outside two others while going six wide heading into the first turn, shared the rear on the outside down the backstretch, had one beaten going three wide midway on the final bend, swung out widest in the seven path for the drive and flew home in the final eighth of a mile to get up right at the finish line outside besting the rest for the runners up position. BAZOOKA JANE had the lead getting over to the two path setting a brisk early pace, slowed the tempo down unopposed by the half, inched away again up top by the quarter pole when let out a notch, was holding digging in on the rail at the furlong marker, could not go with the winner outside by the sixteenth pole giving way on the front end and just got nabbed outside for the place share right at the wire. DYNA was jostled between horses on the start, had the rail sharing the rear inside of two others in the early going, was under a snug hold unable to advance on the fence with the field clustered down the backside, inched up on the far turn having no room to lengthen stride inside of horses through the far turn, could not get clear run until four wide at the furlong pole and finished up mildly between rivals for a minor placing. AFLEET FLATTER broke inwards then having to be taken up for a stride or two in tight leaving the gate, had the four path between horses part of the back trio on the first turn, co-trailed inside down the backstretch, was relegated to solo last on the fence at the five sixteenths pole, rallied on the rail in upper stretch and found its best stride inside of rivals coming on late. BORIKA (IRE) veered out on the start, was floated out eight wide heading into the first turn part of the scramble up front, settled three deep near the rear down the back straight, kept pace four wide midway around the last turn, had the six path for the stretch run but could not quicken between runners in the furlong pole. PRINCESS RAINBOW was well spotted on the rail taking back off the lead fivesome that were arguing on the front end in the first turn, settled nicely on the fence in midfield down the backside, kept pace running evenly inside of runners through the last turn, scraped paint at the top of the lane moving into the third place share at the furlong pole but could not find more late and wilted between runners in the last seventy yards. CLASSIC DISCOVERY was checked going four wide trying to hold position close to the back between runners midway around the first bend, offered little change along the backstretch, made little headway with rivals on both sides through the second turn, shifted to the five path but lacked running room eventually losing its path coming up to the furlong pole and could not factor afterwards. MISS BRIT had the four path between horses in the mix up front heading into the first turn between rivals, chased the pacesetter down the backside and through the final turn, shifted out three wide in upper stretch, was no match for the lead pair by the furlong pole while still was dueling for a minor share but ran out of energy and folded between runners in the late going. ABDUL broke sharp on the fence then dropped back off the early mad scramble into the first turn sitting between runners in midfield, had little progression still with runners on either side down the backstretch in the middle of the pack, came under a ride just trying to hold position on the last oval and yielded to others in the four path by mid-stretch. SPICY BOURBON was part of the forwardly placed mix going seven wide with horses on each side on the first bend, travelled three deep keeping an eye on the lead three rivals while outside of horses along the back straight, kept even with runners while going three wide on the far bend, drifted out to the five path turning for home but emptied out between foes at the furlong marker.
