AWESOME GRACE took control when nudged for run entering the backstretch, set a moderate pace unopposed under a snug hold down the backstretch, roll along with little pressure applied from challenging rivals while setting an even tempo around the oval, opened up when urged right handed by the furlong pole and just had enough left in the tank holding on for the win by a quickly diminishing margin. STUNNINGLY PERFECT settled near the rear initially, ranged up in the two path down the backside watching the frontrunner between horses at the half, chased the leader with challengers on both sides throughout the bend, angled to the three path in hunt turning for home, found another gear in the last sixteenth of a mile and charged home sharply in deep stretch to make it interesting at the wire but had to settle for second best on this day. LOVELY RAINBOW had a good spot drafting behind the frontrunner, continued to sit poised waiting behind the leader around the bend waiting to make a move, shifted outside in the two path posing the main threat between foes at the top of the lane, stalled giving way fighting up front to the rivals on either side by the furlong pole and ran on well enough to be a clear but well back in third at the end. SWIFTY KIM stalked close to the back ahead of only one runner when the field was sorting themselves out midway along the backside, was scrubbed on at the three eighths pole to go after the lead group but was making little headway around the bend, shifted to the four path turning for home and finished up one paced capturing a minor placing. CLOCKWORK ANGEL was brushed outside then stumbled on the break, settled close to the back between runners in the beginning, moved up quickly in the three path along the backside to track the frontrunner by the half, travelled three wide chasing the pace outside but could not manage to keep up to the front three foes by the quarter pole and had little left weakening in the three path in the stretch drive. FEELING SUPERSONIC was void of early foot lagging behind runners remaining off the rail, travelled three wide around the turn making a little move catching up to an inside runner by the half, swung out widest in lane five at the top of the stretch but had little to offer in the stretch running. MARIETTA BABE had an outside tracking position early on, dropped back outside of rivals four deep by the half mile, made no impact just off the rail around the oval and came up empty in the four path through the lane.

CATCH THE ACE assumed control from the onset travelling just off the fence, was left alone setting a moderate pace along the backside, moved strongly well in command around the final turn, was urged left handed in upper stretch switching leads, pulled away by the furlong pole and increased the winning margin at the finish line. PADDY HOLIDAY had the rail keeping a close eye on the frontrunner, travelled inside in the second flight down the backstretch behind the loose leader, quickened on the fence at the three furlong pole, posed the main threat two wide straightening out for the drive, was no match for the top spot by the furlong pole and just lasted inside at the wire for the place award. BEYOND ADVERSITY had a good position tracking the pacesetter outside in the early stages, dropped back between rivals slightly at the three furlong pole, came back on skimming the fence at the top of the lane, shifted out in the three path in the final furlong, could not get to the long gone winner but did show grit almost closing in right at the wire for the runners up share. TORONTO CITY was allowed to settle at the back of the pack, shared the rear outside another down the back straightaway, began to reach for more ground passing an inside runner three wide at the quarter pole, angled out five wide clear off all runners turning for home and had good late energy closing in to be mentioned in the battle late for the place and show award but settled on the fringes in the end. TONY FROM ANGUS settled in the middle of the pack going three wide around the initial bend, took closer order ranging up three deep down the backstretch, chased the winner outside another on the last turn, remained in the mix outside at the top of the stretch but could not carry on with rivals through the drive and faded between foes in the final furlong. LOTTA GEMS the rail position in midfield, came under a ride on the far turn making little impression and was not involved in the drive to the wire. WHO

GOES THERE stalked near the rear having the two path, settled outside of runners in midfield along the back straight, kept pace going two wide on the far turn while hard ridden just keeping up to rivals and lacked a rally down the stretch. APELDOORN buckled on the break, stalked in the early going having only one runner beaten, co-trailed on the inside along the backstretch, lagged well behind on the final turn, lost touch by the time he turned for home and cantered down the stretch crossing the wire.

SAKPE improved leaving the gate to track the frontrunner outside at the midway point along the backstretch, moved in smartly through the turn just off the rail, pounced outside in the two path straightening out for the drive and battled outside throwing it down in the final furlong and just got the better of the inside challenger when inching away at the finish line for the win. CATTRALL was away alertly loose on the engine down the backside, rolled along in the turn travelling smoothly up front dictating the pace, was collared outside by the stablemate at the head of the lane, fought on stubbornly to the very end but lost the nod inside at the wire. BUDDHA'S DELIGHT had the rail close to the back having only the very slow starter beaten, commenced a rail rally passing two outside runners at the quarter pole, carried its momentum three wide at the top of the stretch and closed in belatedly to be a clear but distant third. FLATTER ZIP stalked in the third flight with runners on both sides down the backstretch, improved slightly around the turn still between horses, shifted to the four path at the top of the stretch and finished up one paced capturing a minor placing in the end. LOGAN'S THUNDER kept a close eye on the pacesetter while tucked in on the rail, chased but could not match strides with the lead duo around the bend by the quarter pole, had little left for the late running and wilted on the fence at the furlong marker. JUJU DREAM was away very slowly losing all chance spotting the field by many down the backstretch, closed the gap on some rivals in the turn running and managed to pass leg weary foe in the stretch run. SLOVAN was under a hustling ride four deep down the backstretch but making little headway by the half, offered a mild spurt running three wide around horses at the three furlong pole, was weakening when getting out slightly at the quarter marker and had nothing more to offer in the stretch drive.

WEMBLEY AVENUE was bumped and in tight at the start, settled at the rear inside, advanced inside foes on the far turn moving out to pass between runners leaving that bend, angled seven wide into upper stretch, maintained momentum and drove past a sixteenth out. BUIUM settled mid-pack shifting in near but just off the rail, was encouraged along passing the three-eighths, advanced leaving the far turn while swinging six wide into upper stretch, made a mild bid, kept on late to get up for second. COWBOY broke out lightly bumping a rival, settled well off the loose early leader but at the front of the pursuers, advanced willingly on that one through the far turn taking the lead past the quarter pole, was soon joined by outside foes, fought on along the inside but was outfinished. PROUD PAINTER was caught outside foes into the first turn racing three to four deep, advanced some four to five wide still outside on the far turn swinging eight wide turning into upper stretch, was not a threat to the top ones but was best of the rest. ERIE SHORES shifted in two to three wide heading to the first turn racing off the pace, improved position. HARD RIGHT was forwardly-placed in pursuit outside foes three to four wide, swung seven wide for the stretch run, failed to rally. IRISH MOJO was forced outside of foes four to five wide both turns, failed to menace. WHATEVER YOU WANT shifted in racing outside a foe at the rear, was well back of the leaders through the far turn, came out in the stretch, was never near enough to threaten. WONDERFUL QUALITY was lightly bumped into a rival at the start and urged forward, chased from near the inside, dropped back and faded in the stretch.

MISTER BLUE was reluctant to load, bumped lightly into a rival at the start, sped clear opening up a large lead on the field up the backstretch, weakened on the far turn, was overtaken coming to the top of the stretch, faltered and faded.

MARY GOODNIGHT was under a hard hold going three wide close to the back around the first of two turns, stalked outside rating kindly down the backstretch, started to uncork a rally three wide at the three-furlong pole, swooped around runners making a bold move four wide with a quarter mile from home, loomed a menacing presence widest in the six path at the top of the lane and powered past with authority by the sixteenth pole for the late running win. SCOTCH MIST was ahead of only the poor starter in the beginning, galloped along setting into a good rhythm down the backside, angled out being asked for more run three wide at the quarter marker, shifted five wide at the top of the lane and had a solid late rally passing inside runners driving to the finish line besting the rest for the place share. LAPIN DE PLAGES chased outside for the first half of this two-turn event, closed in forcing the pace outside two wide on the final bend by the quarter pole, grinded away in the battle between runners through the stretch drive and determinedly fought on late to get up for the show money in the shadow of the wire. SOUPER GIN'S WORLD cleared away getting to the rail heading into the first bend, was unchallenged slowing the pace down smartly along the back straight, was headed outside with five sixteenths to go, spurted away again scraping paint cutting the corner, offered no resistance when the winner charged past with a sixteenth to run then faded inside coming to the wire losing the place and show awards very late. TAP THIS WAY settled in midfield initially, dropped back slightly inside runners down the backstretch, had the fence with no room to lengthen stride behind runners at the three furlong pole, waited on the rail around the far turn, shifted just off the fence at the top of the stretch and finished with interest mildly

improving between horses in the final furlong. TRACY ARM travelled between horses in the middle of the pack, was urged for more two wide between runners making no progression on the second turn and lacked a rally in the three path down the lane. KOOL KAROLINE kept tabs on the front two going three wide in the early stages, made little movement three deep along the backside, was scrubbed on midway through the far turn making a gradual run, had a chance for a small share four wide straightening out for the drive but yielded to others between with a sixteenth remaining. SILVER GAL broke a step slow trailing the field in the early stages, narrowed the margin on the group around the last turn but could only manage to pick up a weary runner in the final furlong. LITA MARIE had a good spot nestled on the rail sitting just back off the leader around the first turn and throughout the backstretch running, saved ground being roused for more chasing but making no gain on the lead on the last turn, skimmed the fence turning for home but folded inside of rivals in the last furlong.

SPLASH OF BOURBON bobbled just slightly at the start, settled outside about mid-pack, advanced three wide on the turn, struck the lead past the furlong marker and was kept to task. ARIANNA'S TOUR tracked from inside, saved ground on the turn, rallied inside making a brief bid in mid-stretch but was second best. SOUPER SPORTY moved clear to set the pace near the inside, came out a bit in upper stretch, weakened in the lane. PAGEANT QUEEN broke a half-step slowly, settled last but one off the inside heading into the turn, fanned seven wide into upper stretch, kicked on mildly to improve position. MY TURN NOW broke outwardly lightly brushing a foe, raced off the pace inside rivals but in the two path, asked for run past the five-sixteenths, ran on evenly. ITSASTORMYMONDAY stalked in the middle of the pack but going five wide on the first bend, remained in midfield going outside three deep down the backstretch, started to pick up the bit circling rivals three wide at the five sixteenths pole, pounced five wide turning for home getting the jump on the inside leaders in upper stretch, battled outside in the last furlong and edged away for the hard fought stretch win at the wire. KEKOA relaxed on the rail in mid-division in the early stages, crept up on the fence at the three furlong marker, angled out three wide between rivals in the heat of the battle at the top of the lane, never wavered fighting up top with runners on both sides through the drive but was just denied at the wire for the win. SCORCHING prompted the pace in the beginning outside in the six path, seized control angling in shaving the corner on the first turn getting to the rail up top, slowed things down at the half, was nudged along holding on the front end having the rail on the last bend, continued to find more clinging onto the lead with a couple of outside rivals

HE'S NOT JOKING travelled between runners in the middle of the pack for the first half of this two-turn event, was urged for more having runners on both sides two wide offering little running around the far turn, shifted to the three path having a chance for a minor role dueling inside a couple of challengers through the stretch drive but could not kick on with others in deep stretch. LEGAL CATCH settled close to the back end, travelled in tandem with an inside foe at the rear down the backstretch, could see the field around the last turn and could only manage to pick up an inside rival in the late going. IRONSTONE trailed the field on the first turn, shared the rear on the inside at the half mile marker, had little impact taking the shortest route on the far bend, hugged the rail at the top of the lane but had no finish inside horses in the final furlong.

SOUTHERN STYLE settled on the outside in mid-division three wide around the initial turn, closed in four deep at the half moving well, circled runners three wide at the five sixteenths pole when roused to go, moved in taking the lead four wide at the top of the stretch on the outside, pulled away under a busy ride with a furlong to go and held on safely at the wire for the win. RUNNER EYES was inside another stalking in the third flight, edged closer on the rail at the half, shifted out three wide midway on the last turn, had a crisp move five wide circling rivals to be in the hunt at the top of the lane, closed in determinedly through the stretch run outside but could not get to the winner in time. PRINCE ALMASTY was well placed in the rail watching the contesting duo on the first turn, settled into stride tracking the lead trio in the two path down the backside, had to wait behind tiring runners ready to make a move at the quarter pole, shifted to the three-path coming with a run in the hunt straightening out for home and finished up willingly on the fence unable to threaten for the win late but capturing the show money at the finish line. DECADENT DANISH had the rail sitting in the middle of the pack, started to commence a rally shifting out off runners three wide at the quarter marker, moved to the four path behind the leaders looking for a seam, had clear run by the sixteenth pole and ran on mildly in deep stretch to settle on the fringes with another. FLIRTING WITH FIRE was part of the back quartet having the three path outside of runners on the first of two turns, offered no change down the back straight, started to come with a rally reaching for more ground three wide at the midpoint of the second turn, swung out widest in the six path coming on outside in upper stretch and had a sharp late turn of foot in the final sixteenth of a mile to dead heat for the minor award. FUN FELLA co-trailed on the outside for the first half of this route race, shifted out three wide on the far turn making little progression, moved to the six path turning for home and passed many runners outside in the stretch run but could not get into contention in the late going. THOR'S CAUSE had the fence stalking close to the back ahead of only a couple of runners around the first bend as well as through the backside, took the short way through the last turn but could not advance on rivals, angled to the three path at the top of the stretch, finished up with some interest but could not get involved. CALL ME BOND travelled outside another in the third flight, dropped back slightly at the half, came under a drive at the five sixteenths pole being passed on both side by rivals and could not factor in the three path down the lane. DELTA FORCE had a slim advantage on the rail in the beginning, relinquished the front end pressing the pace instead on the inside down the backstretch, drafted behind the pacesetter early on the last turn, lost momentum stuck behind the tiring leader by the quarter pole and failed to menace in the two path in the stretch drive. SEMPER LIBER had to go four wide tracking the lead duo early on the first bend, narrowed the gap shadowing the pacesetter outside in the three path down the back straight, rallied taking control between horses at the quarter pole, had no answer when three wide collared by the winner in upper stretch and had little left in the tank folding on the rail at the sixteenth pole. NOBURU was in tight soon after the break at the rear, shared the back on the rail at the half, lagged behind the pack on the far turn and could only pass a rival that came up empty inside of horses in the final furlong. KING RONIN argued for the lead three wide outside in the early going, had a head in front between foes along the backside, was engulfed surrendering the top spot on the rail at the five sixteenths pole, emptied out on the fence by upper stretch and was wrapped up by the final furlong.
