ARMADA RISING (IRE) rated kindly content sitting on the outside flank of the pacesetter along the backside, edged up well in hand two wide on the turn, seized control with little resistance from the inside leader by the quarter pole and when asked for more run in mid-stretch pulled away smartly to win comfortably when crossing the finish line. TAKE CHANCES travelled in the three path keeping a close eye on the lead duo early on, remained three wide keeping pace with the front pair around the oval, shifted out to the four path posing the only threat in upper stretch, chased the winner to no avail through the lane while still securing the runners up share outside at the wire. ALMASTY'S LUST had the rail sitting in mid-division accompanied by two outside rivals at the half, took the short way around the bend holding position, moved out slightly two wide in tight briefly splitting runners coming with a rally in upper stretch and finished up willingly inching up dueling inside for the place share but settling for the show money at the finish line. SERENADING AMAYA hesitated then hopped up at the break spotting the field quite a bit in the early stages, lagged well behind in the turn running, angled to the four path reaching for more ground at the top of the stretch and had good late energy securing a minor placing in the end while not that far off trying to close in late for the place and show money as well. JAPONKA had runners on either side sitting in midpack down the backstretch, made no headway still between horses around the turn, shifted to the two path having little for the drive and only passed tired runners down the lane. SILVERDART settled three deep on the outside of two others tracking the front trio down the back straight, was under a ride continuing a three wide journey making no progression outside throughout the bend, swung out widest in the five path turning for home but failed to menace in the stretch running. CHARGETHATMOUNTAIN assumed command on the rail setting a moderate pace, dictated the pace while hounded outside early in the running around the turn, had no answer inside when the

winner moved in at the quarter pole outside and had nothing left for the stretch drive folding on the fence by the furlong marker.

SCARY SPEEDY broke out brushing a foe lightly but quickly moved clear to dictate terms, was asked in upper stretch, held sway while kept to task. REACH FOR THE TOP switched out off the inside, raced between foes two to three wide into the turn stalking off the leader, came out in the stretch, kept on but was second best. AVA'S PRINCESS chased the eventual winner from inside, was under urging by the late on the turn, held show honors. ENCHANTED FOREST settled mid-division outside going three to four wide on the turn, came into upper stretch five deep, moved out a bit in mid- to late-stretch and ran on. MONTY'S INN bumped with the inside foe at the start, settled off the pace in behind, advanced between foes three wide coming to the quarter pole but could only run on evenly. MRS. C was bumped between foes and squeezed back at the start, moved inwards and tracked inside, was taken back a bit late up the backstretch, saved ground on the turn, swung four to five wide into upper stretch, moved out seven to eight deep soon after, needed more late. SILICIUM (FR) was bumped into a rival at the start, shifted in up the backstretch, saved ground advancing up the rail on the turn but failed to rally in the stretch. TANZANITE LILY was unprepared at the start, trailed, and was declared a non-starter. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS' INQUIRY INTO THE START

IT WAS DETERMINED TANZANITE LILY DID NOT RECEIVE A FAIR START, WOULD BE CONSIDERED A NON-STARTER AND HAVE WAGERS INVOLVING THAT RUNNER REFUNDED.

WILD CARD had a good spot nestled on the rail watching the engaged twosome along the backside, patiently sat poised saving all the ground behind the front duo around the bend, shifted to the two path looking for running room behind the leaders in upper stretch, burst through rivals getting a spilt at the furlong pole, seized control by the seventy yard marker and just prevailed in a blanket finish for the win. NAVY STREET prompted the pace outside in the beginning, was reined back off the contesting pair at the half, travelled on the outside in the second flight keeping a close eye on the lead pair while keeping the eventual winner hemmed in the fence in the turn running, angled out three wide in the hunt turning for home, fought on determinedly to the end inching up in the final few jumps but was denied at the finish line outside. MY COVENANT set the pace narrowly inside another in the early going, dueled on the fence head to head around the turn for the top spot, shifted slightly off the fence clinging on the front end in upper stretch, gave way grudgingly to the winner outside with seventy yards from home and was nabbed late for the place prize while only a neck back at the wire for the win, losing a three way photo. SPEIGHTS WILL had the rail position stalking on the inside with the field basically paired up down the backstretch, was at the back end with the group bunching up at the half, started to make a inside rally in midturn, shifted out three wide lengthening stride at the quarter pole, moved to the four path midway down the stretch gradually gaining but could not get involved with the front three in deep stretch settling on the fringes in the end. POLITICAL WARFARE travelled in the second flight on the outside initially, moved into force the issue outside at the half, argued bobbing heads for the front end two wide with the inside rival through the bend, battled in the three path with runners on either side in upper stretch until the furlong marker but had little left late and wilted in the late going. PARADISE PERFECT was void of early foot seeing the field after the break, made a premature move taking closer order three deep with the field becoming clustered at the half, retreated outside being relegated back to last three wide with three furlongs remaining, shifted in from four wide at the

rear in upper stretch to the rail with a furlong still to run and resurged inside foes closing in again late. VEERY was bumped outwardly into a rival at the start, was encouraged forward but caught wide outside foes into the first turn, edged clear and shifted in later on that bend, dictated terms up the backstretch, was encouraged passing the quarter pole, extended the advantage in upper stretch, weakened late but lasted. BOLD RIPASSO was forwardly-positioned heading to the first turn then eased back to track from inside, dropped back to mid-division early on the far turn, was asked at the quarter pole, rallied up the rail in late stretch. SO KATE was amongst the leaders heading to the first turn, steadied slightly when in tight early on that bend and shifted in, tracked the eventual winner from inside, came out three to four wide in mid-stretch and ran on. NORTH YORK controlled a moderate pace heading into the first turn on the fence, maintained a slim advantage travelling comfortably in hand inside a rival down the backstretch, began to creep away from the early speed rival by the quarter pole, edged clear two wide straightening out for home and was well rated finding more on the rail through the lane to prevail in the end for the wire to wire tally. LADY IZZY was well positioned tucked in on the rail drafting behind the frontrunner in the beginning, tracked the engaged pair while inside another along the backside, saved ground in the final bend waiting for the cue to go, shifted out to the two path coming to the furlong pole trying to commence a rally but could not get to the winner late while getting the nod inside at the wire for the runners up share. LADY RAINICORN was forwardly placed tracking the pacesetter outside, moved into to force the issue midway along the back straight, was scrubbed on for more two wide chasing the leader at the five sixteenths pole, shifted out to the four path with the field in a line of five at the furlong marker and finished up evenly holding for a minor share between horses. PIPINNA broke just a touch slow compared to the others, trailed the field in the early stages while well in range, travelled two wide around the final behind narrowing the margin on the group, swung out widest in the five path midway down the stretch and was closing in on rivals outside late but could not gain a position at the finish line.

CRUMLIN TROUBLE was away alertly loose on the engine moving comfortably when crossing over to the rail when entering the backstretch, quickened the tempo having company outside forcing the pace in the turn at the three furlong marker, opened up smartly when called upon skimming the fence taking the corner and was kept to the tasking winning handily at the finish line for the front running score. MOVENTOTHECOUNTRY was away slowly on the break, recovered by the time they entered the backstretch tracking the inside frontrunner between rivals, moved in to press the leader outside up front at the three eighths pole, could not match strides with the winner in the three path by the head of the lane and chased the winner home still besting the rest for the secondary share at the finish line. STERLING HEIGHTS travelled three deep in the middle of the pack, came under a busy ride three wide holding position keeping pace through the oval, angled out four wide at the top of the stretch and finished up willingly trying to close in late for second while holding for the show money when crossing the finish line. LADY MOONSHINE was on the outside keeping a close eye on the pacesetter, could not quicken at the five sixteenths pole with the lead duo getting away on the turn, shifted to the three path in the mix for a small share in mid-stretch and ran only mildly losing the duel for third in the late going. POETIC AMY shared the rear on the outside in the early going, lagged behind the pack at the half mile pole, travelled three wide on the bend catching up to an inside rival at the quarter marker, had the four path at the top of the lane but could not factor, showing little rally in the stretch run in the final furlong. SPEAK UP co-trailed on the inside of another down the backstretch, improved slightly by the half, had little to offer travelling just off the fence around the oval relegated to the rear with a quarter mile from the wire and could not get into contention unable to offer a finishing kick in the stretch drive inside of horses.

MISS CANDY GIRL settled inside another in mid-pack early on, waited for the cue to move behind the leaders at the midpoint through the bend, darted on through finding a big seam in the three path turning for home and was relentless in her pursuit in the final eighth of a mile wearing the the leader down by the seventy yard marker to win going away at the wire. FEATHERWEIGHT was forwardly placed sitting just back off the frontrunner on the fence, continued on the rail measuring the pacesetter on the turn, shifted out off the cover of the leader two wide at the quarter pole, pounced easily taking control outside in

upper stretch, dug in stubbornly in the final furlong but could not fend off the winners late charge in the final seventy yards outside. BROWN BUTTER SAGE was on the outside going three deep watching the front twosome midway along the backside, dropped back slightly three wide at the five sixteenths pole, moved in again to be in the conversation six wide between challengers at the top of the lane, was no match for the front duo who had it to themselves in the final furlong but ran on smartly to be a clear third in the end. SPORTY ANGELA had a slow beginning spotting the group at the start, had the fence passing an outside foe in mid-backstretch, saved all the ground but could not advance through the turn, skimmed the fence taking the corner and had good late energy inside of runners to settle on the fringes at the finish line. BELIEVE IN LUCK was on the outside of the eventual winner in midfield down the back straight, offered a brief turn of foot circling horses three wide at the five sixteenths pole to be widest in the seven path in the mix straightening out for the stretch drive, could not sustain the outside rally though and flattened out by the sixteenth pole. GIRL'S NITE OUT broke with the field but quickly dropped back to be last by the half mile marker, made little impact unable to progress around foes two wide throughout the bend, closed the gap three wide in upper stretch and did manage to pass a couple of leg weary rivals in the final furlong. DUCKSFLYTOGETHER hopped on the break, recovered between runners improving down the backside forcing the issue outside with a half mile remaining, chased the pacesetter while travelling two to three wide around the bend, shifted to the four path in upper stretch with a chance for a piece of the prize between rivals but gave way with runners on either side in the final furlong. YOU SIGNED IT emerged from the early scramble getting to the rail up top by the half, cleared away on the front end by midturn, hugged the rail but had no answer surrendering the lead turning for home and ran out of gas folding between horses two wide in mid-stretch.
