ARMINO was unhurried settling into a rhythm near the rear isolated while stalking the leader having only one runner beaten early on, improved outside down the backstretch to run in tandem with an inside foe by the half, pounced quickly going three wide sensing the soft pace getting a head in front of the two inside rivals at the midpoint of the second bend, dueled outside with the stubborn frontrunner coming back fighting on down the entire lane and just got the better in a lengthy stretch duel getting the head down at the wire for the hard fought victory. ALLEY OOP JOHNNY had the rail settling a pedestrian pace on the first of two turns, continued up top but hounded outside still going at a snails pace along the backstretch, relinquished the lead inside of two others when the winner made a sharp circling move at the five sixteenths pole, countered in the two path going battling head to head between foes in the final furlong but was denied the win losing the nod at the finish line. PET SOUNDS had a good spot well placed nestled onthe fence behind the engaged duo, could not quicken with the lead trio at the five sixteenths pole, skimmed the fence at the top of the stretch commencing an inside rally, was gradually inching up on the rail trying to join the embattled pair in deep stretch but needed more late unable to threaten the top two rivals at the finish line. GOOD SIN was off just a step slow at the start, moved up keeping a close eye on the pacesetter outside on the first turn, ranged closer to force the issue outside under a gallop down the backstretch, vied two wide between runners in the heat of battle at the midway point of the far turn, was the first to give way unable to remain up front by the quarter pole and finished up one paced down the lane holding for a minor placing. JAMIELSTA broke sharp in the mix at the beginning outside, dropped back to last heading into the initial bend, lagged well behind the pack down the backside, closed the gap somewhat around the final turn but was still at the rear turning for home and could not close in late never factoring in the stretch running.

LOST STAR had the fence part of the back trio in the early stages, could see the field at the half, slipped up the rail avoiding all the commotion heading into the final turn, shifted out three wide with five sixteenths from the line, had the three path picking up the bit turning for home , weaved inside getting to the fence for the final eighth of a mile push and powered past inside in deep stretch for the score. SOL DE VERANO was part of the back threesome between horses, edged closer by the half mile marker with runners still on both sides, bid for the lead outside two wide with three eighths remaining, spurted clear in upper stretch to have a good advantage up top by the furlong marker but simply could not fend off the winners charge inside in the final seventy yards. TURBO CHARGED broke with the field then had to be roused to stay interested trailing the group soon after the break, improved outside foes running three deep along the backstretch to sit in mid-pack by the half, could not make any headway on the new leader coming under a ride three wide through the final bend, remained in the three path for the stretch drive and ran on mildly to be a clear third but could not threaten the front two in the late going. LOUIS THE CHAMP had the rail position sitting just back behind the pacesetter, had to be checked avoiding the troubled runner at half, was at rear well within striking distance on the far turn, swung out widest in the four path at the head of the lane and finished up one paced in the drive capturing only a minor placing. PROFESSOR RELOAD was forwardly placed on the outside tracking the leader, moved in to press the pace outside at the half, inherited the lead from the troubled frontrunner at the seven sixteenths pole, was hard ridden inside when surrendering the top spot midway through the final bend and emptied out skimming the fence in upper stretch. KAMASI assumed the front just off the rail galloping along setting a soft early pace, took a misstep stumbling at the half mile marker, was eased, being pulled up by the rider by the seven sixteenths pole and left via equine ambulance.

YOSHII settled into stride then made an early move to press the leader at the three-quarters, allowed that rival to go on passing the five-eighths settling in behind to stalk, advanced late on the far turn sweeping to the lead at the top of the stretch, shot clear and held under just mild encouragement. NEXT PITCH unhurriedly brought up the rear switching out off the rail leaving the first turn, began to advance outside a rival up the backstretch, fanned six wide into upper stretch, was no threat to the winner but kept on to gain the place outside. PRIVATE LABEL , who was caught outside foes three wide in the early going, advanced some up the backstretch, was urged along by the five-sixteenths, swung five wide into upper stretch, ran on and was outfinished for second. FRAC RIGHT got away well but was a bit rank heading to the first turn setting the pace from off the rail, faced pressure at the three-quarters then edged clear by the nine-sixteenths, extended the margin into the far turn, was headed at the top of the stretch and weakened. AWESOME RAINBOW saved ground inside, dropped back into the far turn, kept on one-paced and failed to rally. LEAN MUSIC MACHINE was taken back and rated two wide into and on the first turn under a hold, saved ground on the far turn, failed to rally.

GUERRA was away alertly getting the jump between horses at the start, galloped along loose on the lead on the first turn, remained unchallenged slowing the already soft pace down even further down the backstretch, was nudged for more holding inside with company bearing down at the quarter pole, under a well rationed ride had more when confronted outside in upper stretch to spurt away slightly at the furlong marker and was hard ridden on the fence in deep stretch clinging onto the lead and found just enough to last at the finish line inside for the front end tally. PRETTY CAPABLE veered out on the break, was content to sit off the frontrunner applying very little pressure outside under a dawdling pace, moved in two wide outside at the five sixteenths pole forcing the issue, loomed boldly in the two path turning for home, drifted inwards for a couple of strides under right handed urging having to be straightened out losing momentum briefly at the furlong pole, determinedly resurged between runners in the very late going but was second best by a slim margin in a thrilling blanket finish at the wire. SHESHIMAINTENANCE was all alone well back off the leader on the first turn, continued to keep in range of the lone speed frontrunner down the backstretch, began to chip away at the pacesetters advantage when roused to go on at the five sixteenths pole, shifted to the two path closing in under a measuring ride at the top of the stretch, drove by with a furlong to go and won going away at the wire. PURR FACTOR was loose up top setting an honest pace n the rail in the beginning, continued to freewheel it well in control setting an even tempo along the backside, scraped paint hearing hoofbeats still up top but by a quickly diminishing margin in upper stretch, had no answer inside when the winner stormed past leaving the furlong pole and dug in late just saving the runners up share from two outside rivals at the finish line. ZISISIT (IRE) had the fence inside another settling in mid-division, made little change by the half, took the shortest away around but could not gain on the lead pair of runners in the second bend, shifted to the two path in mid-stretch and captured the third place share between rivals in a tight finish for the secondary positions. NIKITA'S GEM bobble slightly on the break, shared the rear inside around the first bend as well as throughout the backside, could see the field at the three furlong pole, began to pickup the bit coming with a three wide run at the quarter marker, had the four path finding her best stride late but had to settle on the fringes losing a three way tussle outside for the place and show money. RETAIL THERAPIST co-trailed on the outside for the first part of this two turn event, started to uncork a rally circling horses three wide around the far turn, shifted to the four path straightening out for the drive, could not sustain the run and wilted between runners in the last sixteenth of a mile. READY TO BATTLE travelled on the outside of another sitting in midfield in the early stages, was roused but could not keep up between horses who were making a rally at the quarter pole and had little left to offer just off the fence in the stretch running.

SCREEN SCENE as brushed on the inside at the start, improved along the backstretch to sit in midfield with runners on either side at the half, crept closer inside of rivals at the five sixteenths pole while well in hand, shifted to the three path looming a menacing presence at the top of the lane, burst between foes taking control just after the eighth pole and was kept to the task holding off a late inside charge in deep stretch. BLACK THUNDER was part of the back trio having the outside path in the beginning, advanced in the three path to be in the middle of the pack between foes at the half, lacked running room three wide on the turn dropping back from the five sixteenths pole until the quarter mile marker, had the two path still looking for a seam at the head of the lane, finally had clear run coming on with a smart turn of foot at the furlong pole and determinedly battled on the rail in the final sixteenth but was held off by the

winner at the wire. SMARTER STILL was situated in mid-pack three deep on the outside watching the engaged trio, travelled four wide around the bend but was inching up by the quarter pole outside of runners, had the five path in the mix turning for home between rivals and ran on willingly through the lane to be all alone at the finish line for the show award. NYCELY broke out at the start, trailed the field by the half, made a rally around horses four wide at the quarter pole , swung out widest in the six path in upper stretch and ran on mildly in the stretch drive to garner a minor placing in the end. AWESOME MALIBU had the rail sitting in midfield down the backstretch, was hard ridden but was backing away on the fence through the turn to be at the back of the pack by the quarter pole, improved position skimming the fence at the top of the stretch , shifted two wide off the stopping early leader at the furlong marker but could not factor in the late running. ROYAL FONZ stumbled on the start, recovered quickly between horses vying for the front end along the backstretch, chased the leader two wide inside rivals around the oval, shifted to the four path but could not hold forward position between foes shortening stride in upper stretch and failed to menace tiring in the final furlong. CROSBY was hustled on the inside of two others dueling for the front down the back straight, edged clear on the fence by midturn, hugged the rail just holding on turning for home, offered no resistance to the winner by the furlong marker, could not find more late and folded inside of horses by the sixteenth pole. HARD RELOAD argued on the front end three deep outside a couple of runners in the early stages, still was travelling three wide on the turn but gave way unable to go with others on either side with a quarter mile left to run and emptied out by the time they hit the stretch run.
