WILD RED was unhurried co-trailing on the inside in the beginning, moved up along the backside improving position to track the engaged duo inside another by the half, ranged up three wide on the turn closing in by the quarter pole smartly, was set down for run outside at the furlong marker, drove by taking control at the sixteenth pole and won comfortably crossing the finish line. CLOSING APPEAL shared the rear on the outside, could see the field at the half mile marker, edged up when nudged for more inside of rivals in midturn, shifted to the four path in the mix at the top of the lane, found her best stride late and finished strongly being second best but could not get to the winner at the wire. COMPLEX SECRET pressed the pace in the two path between runners early on, sat on the outside flank of the leader hounding the pace around the bend, got a head in front at the quarter pole, was holding onto the front end in mid-stretch but had no answer when the winner stormed on by at the sixteenth pole giving away inside and had little left being caught late for the place share as well. TWIST OF SUGAR had a slim lead on the rail down the backside, continued to have the inside up top narrowly around the bend, was scrubbed on for more but relinquished the lead by the quarter pole, tried to counter on the rail in upper stretch but faded at the sixteenth pole lasting for a minor award in the end. PORSHAS RUN had runners on each side while in the three path being part of the early scramble, rated kindly taken back to track the engaged pair outside another at the half, was going in the wrong direction three wide at the quarter pole unable to keep up to rivals who were commencing a run and lacked a rally in the drive to the wire. SILENT SUNSHINE was forwardly placed going four deep on the outside, dropped back slightly at the half to sit in midfield, could not keep up to the pack by the three eighths marker, retreated even further around the oval and could not factor in the stretch drive.

YOU BE THE JUDGE broke out on the break trading bumps with the outside rival, recovered quickly to have a tracking position outside in the early stages, travelled smartly in hand edging up inside foes by midturn, shifted out three wide in tight losing her path straightening out for the drive, moved to the rail in upper stretch getting clear and rallied strongly in the last furlong to take control by the sixteenth pole and won going away. KIMBERLINA was one of only a couple runners who had an uneventful start, had a good spot on the fence watching the lead duo along the back straight, patiently waited for the cue to go taking the shortest way around the bend, scraped paint making a rally turning for home, seized control two wide in upper stretch but just could not find another gear late to fend off the winner and was second best on this day. CAMPUS QUEEN buckled going to her knees at the start trailing in the early stages, continued at the back on the turn finding her feet, started to get into gear shifting three wide at the five sixteenths pole, was stuck behind a wall of runners looking for a lane five wide turning for home, angled inside to the two path finally getting an unobstructed run reaching for more ground sharply and finished up being a clear third with a solid effort considering the eventful trip. FRAC IS THE JUDGE was away slowly on the break, settled into stride near the rear stalking inside under a snug hold, improved between runners three to four wide on the turn by the quarter pole, angled out to the five path in the mix at the top of the stretch with rivals on both sides and finished up mildly for a minor role but could not threaten the top three finishers. GOT A COMPLEX broke inwards exchanging bumps with the inside foe at the start, quickly recouped to prompt the pace outside down the backstretch, chased on the turn making headway by the five sixteenths pole to get a neck in front three wide leaving the quarter pole, had the three to four path with a host of runners bearing down in every direction in upper stretch and could not handle the pressure late folding by the furlong pole. SKYDIGGER broke out and was taken a hold off leaving the gate, stalked on the outside of another slow starter down the backside, offered a brief rally closing the gap making a good circling more

five wide on the bend at the quarter pole, was fanned out to the six path at the head of the lane in with a chance, could not sustain the run and idled in the final furlong outside runners. OOKPIK dictated the pace narrowly on the inside down the backstretch, opened up having a clear advantage by the three furlong pole, offered no resistance surrendering the top spot inside by the quarter pole, stopped in the two-path giving way in tight between foes in upper stretch and was not persevered with in the final furlong basically eased up when crossing the finish line.

REFINEMENT brushed with a foe at the start, shifted in to track in behind the leading pair, moved out three wide coming past the quarter pole, took aim on the leader, engaged that one a sixteenth out dueling for the lead and edged past under steady handling. ALPHA GAMMA GIRL broke in bumping a rival, pressed the leader up the backstretch into the turn, took the lead nearing the five-sixteenths, edged clear leaving the turn, was challenged about a sixteenth out, dueled but was outfinished. CHARMINGLY EVASIVE brushed with a rival at the start, lacked early speed shifting in and racing last but one, advanced between foes at the top of the stretch and was bumped by the outside one at that juncture, kept on late to gain slowly but was not a real threat to the top pair. LAKOTA LADY was reluctant to load, got away well but was outsprinted early content to stalk from outside, moved out from three to four wide on the turn, lugged in at the top of the stretch bumping a rival lightly, failed to rally thereafter. LOVELY SUMMER broke a step slowly, was lightly bumped and steadied at the start, switched out off the inside heading to the turn, raced in the two to three path, shifted in toward the rail in mid-stretch, ran on without threatening. SIENNA AURA was quick to take the lead, set a pressured pace inside, gave way.

ROAD TO GLORY had a good trip on the fence watching the contesting duo in the early stages who had their own private little battle going on, began to reel in the pair midway around the turn, travelled two wide having his sights set on the frontrunner in upper stretch, grinded away under a busy ride down the lane and finally wore down the game leader inside in the final seventy yards. LONGSHOT LEO was away alertly up top leaving the gate, battled inside separating from the pack at the half mile marker up top, had a slim advantage on the rail around the bend, disposed of the early speed foe two wide at the top of the stretch, valiantly tried to dig in late but was unable to fend off the winner outside in deep stretch and weakened due to being softened up from fighting for the lead in the early running. IT WASN'T A BLUFF broke inwards leaning on the inside foe at the start, was roused going three deep down the backstretch just to stay interested while the leaders were opening up, started to uncork a rally two wide at the five sixteenths pole, angled to the five path turning for home and closed in belatedly to be a clear but distant third. FORZA veered in sharply having to be taken hold of spotting the field leaving the chute, lagged well behind with the field quite strung out through the turn, started to come with a rally three wide in mid-stretch and had good late energy between horses to settle on the fringes. LORD YORKTON was hustled early on dueling outside for the front end, continued to throw it down two wide with the inside rival around the bend, gave way fighting up top four wide at the head of the lane and ran out of gas yielding to others outside by the furlong pole. APPOINTED TALENT was bumped by the outside foe on the break, tracked the pacesetter on the outside by the half mile marker, was scrubbed on for more at the three furlong pole but the lead trio was getting away through the turn and had little to give just off the fence inside of horses in the stretch drive.

JUSTINE was prominent up top on the fence in the beginning, took back being reined in at the half off the lead pair, sat poised on the rail around the turn, bullied her way through two wide coming on at the top of the lane, seized control by the sixteenth pole and held safe but by a diminishing margin at the wire. BREEZERO was unhurried co-trailing inside down the back straight, advanced on the fence in the turn closing the gap on the lead trio by the quarter pole, shifted out to the five-path full of run in upper stretch and charged home outside the leaders in the final furlong almost getting to the winner at the finish line. CHROMEPLATED HEART rated kindly sitting isolated in midfield down the backstretch, started to uncork a run two wide outside a rival at the five sixteenths pole, angled to the four path in the hunt outside taking the corner, never wavered in the drive, kept trying when closing in between rivals in deep stretch but was on the wrong end of a photo for the top three spots. MIDNIGHT MARTINI pressed the pace on the outside, chased the pace on the turn under a vigorous ride making no gain, was pushed out three wide in the mix for a small share in upper stretch and ran on evenly the final eighth of a mile to settle on the fringes. RULE THE WAVES was roused between foes having a neck in front through the backside, edged away in midturn for the clear lead, hugged the rail holding on up top in upper stretch but had little in reserve late and wilted inside of runners by the sixteenth pole. XARABELLA shared the rear outside another down the backside, made no movement going two to three wide around the oval, was floated out six wide trying to make something happen straightening out for the stretch drive but could not factor in the late running.

LUDICROUS was allowed to settle into stride on the outside sharing the rear in the beginning, made a strong move around the turn with the rider still in the saddle circling runners three to four wide, loomed boldly widest in the six path at the top of the lane and charged home in the final furlong to get up in deep stretch to win going away in the end. MINIMUM FORTY was sandwiched between horses on the start, recovered to get the lead by the five eighths pole, had a narrow advantage on the fence inside of two others throughout the turn, spurted away slightly hugging the rail taking the final corner, kept fighting on to the very end but just got caught by the winner outside in the very late going. LUZ DE LA LUNA settled on the outside in mid-pack watching the lead duo, closed in three wide around the far turn to be in the mix in the four path in upper stretch and finished up willingly between runners to win the duel for the show money. GIVE ME THE BOOTS was keen while hard held drafting behind the pacesetter midway along the backside, had to wait behind runners on the fence with nowhere to go midway around the oval, shifted to the two path in upper stretch, then back to the rail trying to find clear running room and finally angling back to the two path late but could not get into gear in the late running. FORESTERS EXEC was bumped by the outside rival on the start, co-trailed inside another along the back straight, could see the field midway around the oval saving all the ground, shifted out to be five wide at the furlong pole having a clear lane and passed tired runners late. MISS DEMANDING veered in sharply causing a bumping chain reaction on the break, travelled in mid-division between horses down the backside, held position under a ride two ride throughout the bend, shifted to the five path straightening out for home but lacked a rally down the lane. GIRLS WEEKEND pressed the pace on the outside, vied between horses at the five sixteenths pole, remained in the conversation still

having the three path with runners on both sides at the head of the lane but faltered by the furlong pole.

SPA PROSPECTOR dueled on the inside under the wire for the first time, shook clear on the rail in the first turn with the early speed foe having trouble taking the corner, rattled along unchallenged under a brisk pace down the backside, continued to freewheel on the last turn with little pressure applied by the rivals and had more in the drive to hold on from the fast closing runner up at the finish line while setting a track record in the process. AMERICATHEGREAT had the rail inside two others sitting in the middle of the pack, began to pick up the bit two wide at the five sixteenths pole, shifted to the four path gathering speed outside foes turning for home, was closing in with every stride in the final furlong but could not get to the winner in time. FAITH UNDERSTOOD was bumped by the inside foe trailing in the early stages, started to reach for more ground two wide at the quarter pole, shifted to the four path at the top of the stretch and finished with intent in the last eighth of a mile just getting up for the show money outside. MEW N ME veered out at the start, settled in midfield between rivals on the initial bend, had an inside tracking position well behind the loose frontrunner down the backstretch, inched up on the rail on the far turn by the quarter pole moving comfortably, angled to the two path with a chance to get the winner in upper stretch, but could not find more late and evened out with a sixteenth to run getting nabbed by the outside foe in the late running for the third place share. ADA CLARE broke out sharply at the start, took back near the rear going two wide on the first of two turns, progressed mildly on the rail down the backside, saved ground but could not make any headway on the second bend, angled to the rail for the final furlong and had some run late passing tired ones. NONNA'S LOVE battled on the outside initially, conceded the outright lead when forced to be throttled down having trouble to navigating the first turn, tracked the solo leader outside while well back at the half, narrowed the margin on the pacesetter two wide outside another on the last turn but was ridden on to do so, shifted to the three path giving way fighting up top in upper stretch and tired between horses at the furlong pole. SNOW FLOWER was bumped by the inside foe then had a domino effect bumping into the outer rival at the start, had trouble making the first turn going four to five wide, stalked close to the rear outside down the backstretch, made no gain while

three wide on the final bend and came up empty in the stretch run.

PARAMOUNT PRINCE moved to the lead and clear then shifted in to set the pace from inside, was shadowed by a rival up the backstretch into the far turn, challenged by the runner-up in mid-stretch but dug in and held that foe under steady handling. RUNAWAY AGAIN stalked from between runners in the second flight, tipped out three to four wide coming to the quarter pole in striking distance, was asked at the top of the stretch, drew nearly even a sixteenth out but was held off. SEDBURYS GHOST tracked the leading pair from inside the second flight, saved ground both turns, was asked at the quarter pole, kept on in the lane to get show honors without threatening the top pair. RAPID TEST settled off the pace outside a rival last but one, took the overland route

BRANDY AND ME had a slow start to begin, stalked three deep close to the back on the outside, made a sharp quick move swooping four wide around runners with ease at the quarter pole, posed the main threat still in the four path at the top of the lane took control under only a confident hand ride leaving the furlong marker and pulled away impressively late under little urging. LITTLE LOLA broke in at the start, settled inside another in midfield by the half, commenced a rally three wide at the quarter pole, swung out widest to the six path in upper stretch full of run and rushed on home in the last eighth of a mile

easily besting the rest for the place share but was no match for the winner who won going away at the wire. ONE SHOT SCOTT pressed the pace on the rail, took control inside by the half mile marker, opened up at the midpoint of the turn, travelled well enough two wide in command still by mid-stretch, had no answer though when the winner drove by leaving the furlong pole and finished up willingly to hold for the show money in the end. SUPERFLY CHICK settled on the outside of a rival in mid-division with the field sorting itself out by the half, rallied three wide between runners having the winner outside with a quarter mile remaining, was checked slightly coming into the lane, had a chance in the five path for a piece of the prize between horses in upper stretch and ran on one paced in the drive to the wire to settle on the fringes. PRETTY VICIOUS broke out at the start, was roused between runners being part of the early mix, took back reined in letting the lead trio go on with at the four-furlong pole, advanced on the rail when nudged for more on the bend at the quarter marker, closed in three wide in the hunt entering the stretch but stalled in the last furlong. WRITTEN PAGES broke in at the start having to be taken a hold of briefly, stalked near the rear inside down the back straight, was under a drive inching up on the fence midway around the oval, shaved the rail improving briefly turning for home but failed to fire inside horses in the late running. PLANTANITA was in tight at the start trailing down the backstretch, lagged behind the group around the turn, closed the gap still seeing the field five wide straightening out for the drive and could only pass a couple of inside stragglers in the last eighth of a mile. IVY'S MISSION was erratic at the start with the rider having trouble steering when veering out then angling in sharply leaving the gate, rushed up outside foes four deep through the backside to just sit off the lead duo by the half, chased the pacesetter three wide still being pushed on around the bend making up some ground, had the three path but gave way between rivals on the front group at the top of the stretch and ran out of gas laying in and folding by the furlong pole. RED SYMPHONY had a head in front outside of two others early on down the backside, relinquished the top spot by the half mile pole, retreated between horses in midturn, emptied out three wide in upper stretch and was wrapped up in the final furlong.
