RED WEAVER was allowed to settle into stride getting to the fence from the outside post trailing the field in the early stages, edged up on the rail avoiding the troubled runners at the three eighths pole, sharply narrowed the margin on the front pair on the turn by the quarter marker, swung outside in the three path looming boldly in upper stretch, took control outside by the eighth pole and won comfortably being geared down when crossing the finish line. SIGNATURE SIR pressed the issue inside at the start, took back shifting out at the half mile marker, chased outside through the turn closing in on the pacesetter, vied between horses two wide at the head of the lane fighting for the front end, could not quicken with the outside winner late but dug in at the finish line to get the nod for the place share. BIG BOLD AND FIRST had a slim lead on the outside in the beginning, shook clear getting to the fence midway down the backstretch, rolled along unopposed around the bend, hugged the rail in upper stretch with outside rivals bearing down, offered no answer when the winner powered past at the furlong pole and just missed lasting in a tight photo inside for the runner position at the wire. GLASWEIGIAN had the outside position in tandem with another keeping a close eye on the front two runners along the backside, was carried out by the troubled foe early through the turn losing all chance, recovered somehow getting back into gear on the rail well behind runners at the quarter pole but showed grit closing in considerably on the lead trio throughout the drive while still settling in the end on the fringes. ELGIN PARK was headstrong inside another on the rail in the second flight behind the lead pair midway down the backside, had broken equipment when the left rein snapped while trying to be checked behind runners at the nine sixteenths pole, bore out on the turn with the jockey unable to steer, unseated the rider in the process and walked off. STEWARDS GENERAL INQUIRY REGARDING #1 ELGIN DOWN THE BACKSTRETCH AND THROUGH THE TURN PARK RESULTED IN NO CHANGE

SPLIT STRIKE rated kindly in the second position content with the leader dictating the pace along the backside, moved well in hand edging up measuring the frontrunner through the turn, closed in making a bid outside two wide taking the corner, confidently battled outside in the drive under only a hand ride initially then took control when urged on for more under a right handed crop at the sixteenth pole to inch away from the stubborn pacesetter nearing the wire. REAL SAVVY moved well up top loose on the lead by the half, travelled well within himself still leading on the turn but had company closing in at the quarter pole outside, had the fence fighting on clinging to the top spot still at the furlong pole but gave way stubbornly to the winner outside in the final seventy yards. CAUGHT SPEEDING had a good spot sitting all alone watching the lead pair down the backstretch, kept pace with the leaders taking the short way around the oval, skimmed the fence very much in the conversation at the head of the lane inside rivals, could not threaten the front duo in the final furlong but determinedly fought back to regain third money by a bob at the finish line. ROI SOLEIL was unhurried sharing the rear on the inside, started to make a rally shifting out three wide at the quarter pole, angled to the four path posing a threat outside turning for home, could not continue on with the run by the furlong pole and stalled in the late going getting nosed out inside for third place. LAZIO broke in at the start, settled in midfield having the rail down the backside with a half mile to run, travelled three wide taking closer order on the bend outside in the second flight by the quarter marker, was in the hunt between horses in the three path at the top of the lane but could only finish up evenly with runners on both sides in the final furlong losing the duel for the show award. FORESTER'S FORTUNE was brushed by the outside foe on the break, co-trailed with an inside rival along the backside, could see the field in

midturn while urged on offering no response and was not factor in the stretch running on the fence.

CASH THE MONEY moved clear and shifted in to set the pace near the inside, faced mild pressure at the five-eighths then edged away again dictating terms, was asked passing the quarter pole, extended the advantage in mid-stretch, came out a bit in deep stretch and held sway under steady urging. SPRUNG LOOSE steadied passing the wire the first time, was taken under a tight hold and pulled a bit against the restraint racing inside in behind the leader, was close in behind leaving the far turn, tipped out at the top of the stretch and was put to urging, drifted out a bit further in mid-stretch, kept on but was second best. HAMMERHEAD switched out and was well-placed stalking the eventual winner from outside, edged closer briefly pressing at the five-eighths then continued pursuit from outside, was asked at the five-sixteenths, could make no headway and was carried out in mid- to late-stretch. MOHAYMEN DIAMOND steadied on heels early, settled inside at the rear, swung five wide into upper stretch, ran on evenly. REMARKABLY HUMAN settled outside off the pace, shifted in toward the rail in upper stretch and weakened.

SLAYSTER leapt ,brushing the inside part of the gate on the break, settled into stride close to the rear while inside another down the backstretch, began to reach for more ground three wide at the midpoint of the turn, angled to the four path posing a menacing presence outside straightening out for home and determinedly wore down a stubborn pacesetter in the late stages for the stretch running win. HOWSITGOINOWEN was one of only two runners getting a clean start breaking on top early on, dueled outside down the backstretch as well as around the turn setting a rapid pace while separating from the field, had nothing left in the tank giving way fighting for the lead two wide in upper stretch between horses and emptied out in the final furlong. AU CONTRAIRE hopped on the break, stalked near the rear outside another while in the three path along the back straight, could see the field when passed by an inside runner at the three eighths marker, had little to offer in the turn running, lost touch

with the group at the top of the lane and cantered in.

MISTER BEAN broke outwardly brushing a rival lightly, chased from inside, failed to menace. RURAL ROOTS broke outwardly, was devoid of early speed and never near enough to threaten. SILENT LEE broke a step slowly, advanced inside up the backstretch, veered out sharply nearing the half losing the rider. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS' INQUIRY NO ACTION WAS TAKEN.

CHAOS AGENT had a tardy break hopping at the start, ranged up patiently inside rivals down the backstretch to draft behind the pacesetter with a half mile from the wire, sat poised on the fence waiting for the cue to move on the bend, shaved the corner in the hunt at the three sixteenths pole, darted through on the fence with a furlong to go taking the lead and just held off the outside runner up at the finish line for the gutsy win. WILLIAM T broke a step slow co-trailing on the outside leaving the gate, advanced three deep outside of horses through the backstretch sitting in midfield by the half, made a gradual circling move three wide edging up around foes on the bend, shifted to the four path at the top of the stretch, grinded away outside inching closer in the final furlong but could not get to the winner at the finish line. TELEPORT (IRE) pressed the pace in the beginning outside, took back to track outside in the second tier midway down the backside, moved well in hand inching up to the frontrunner two wide through the turn to bid in the three path at the head of the lane, fought on up top between rivals until the sixteenth pole when needing more late and faded in the shadow of the wire holding for a clear third at the finish line. LOVER BOY MO settled in mid-division in the two path with runners on each side down the back straight, kept pace in tight quarters through the turn, remained two wide in the stretch run but was stuck behind the tiring frontrunner down the lane for most of the running never really lengthening stride, got clear late and finished up capturing a minor placing. BRIGHT ANGEL (IRE) was under a snug hold sharing the rear on the inside of another, could see the field three deep with a half mile left to run, saved ground but made little impact around the oval, shifted to the three path in upper stretch then angled out for a clear lane six wide at the furlong pole taking closer order but could only manage to pass the leg weary early leader in the final seventy yards. GOLDEN TRUTH had the early lead inside leaving the chute, was headed outside at the five eighths marker, shot away again for a clear advantage by the half mile pole, was under a good hold left alone up top throughout the turn moving well, shifted to the two path clinging onto the front end straightening out for home,

offered no resistance when swarmed on both sides at the furlong pole and folded in deep stretch.
