EARENDEL rated kindly, content to sit outside under a hold hounding the frontrunner, cruised up outside two wide making a bid midway around the last turn, spurred away in upper stretch to have a clear advantage on the rail by the furlong pole and was kept to the task late safely holding for the win at the finish line. ENGLISH JUBILEE had a stalking trip near the rear having only the troubled starter beaten, began to uncork a run two wide bursting through horses at the furlong marker, could not get to the winner in the late going but got up nearing the wire on the inside to best the rest for the secondary prize. I'M TENACIOUS had the rail position sitting in the middle of the pack, made little movement along the backside, began to pick up the bit when coaxed two wide between runners at the quarter pole, angled to the four path for the stretch run but was just outdueled late by the inside foe for the place share while still finishing up a clear third at the wire. PRETTY LIZA tracked in tandem with an inside foe while in midfield in the early stages, shifted outside off a couple on runners three wide at the five sixteenths pole making no headway, was fanned out widest in the five path turning for home and ran on mildly in the last eighth of a mile to settle on the fringes. MCKENZIE ROAD travelled outside another in the second flight keeping tabs on the lead twosome, was roused on the far turn beginning to lengthen stride by the quarter pole, shifted to the three path in the mix between rivals for a small share in upper stretch but stalled with a furlong left to run. CAYENNE KISS had the lead on the fence utilizing the inside post on the first turn, continued up top slowing the tempo down slightly while shadowed outside by the eventual winner along the backstretch, offered no resistance when scrubbed for more relinquishing the lead by the

five sixteenths pole inside, could not find anything in reserve in the stretch drive and wilted between runners in the two path by the sixteenth pole. ARYA'S QUEST had a good spot on the fence keeping a close eye on the lead duo on the first turn as well as along the back straight, was roused on the rail for more but could not keep up to others on the final bend by the quarter pole and yielded inside of horses by the furlong marker. POETIC AMY was away slowly then tossing its head as well leaving the gate spotting the field in the beginning, remained at the rear down the backstretch, had little to offer through the far turn and could not factor in the stretch running.

HENNA GAL bumped a rival just after the start, soon led, set the pace near the inside, was shadowed by foes through the far turn, kicked clear at the top of the stretch, held safe while kept to task. FULLY COMPLETELY stalked from outside three to four wide, made a mild advance into the far turn, was within range and encouraged along at the five-sixteenths, was no match for the winner but kept on to hold the place. DON'T SAY A WORD shifted in early heading into the first turn, rated off the pace saving ground both turns, came out at the top of the stretch, ran on with mild late interest but was not enough to garner second. LADY DAYRELLS stalked the eventual winner from just outside, shifted in and was urged along entering the far turn, had no response. RACE DAY CHANCE shifted in heading to the first turn racing two to three wide and sometimes between foes, failed to rally. FLIGHTMARE bumped a rival at the start, moved nearer the rail tracking the leader in behind under light rating tactics, shifted out leaving the backstretch, fanned five wide into upper stretch, failed to threaten. MAXIMUM REACTION tossed her head and was forced out at the start, was a bit keen racing outside four to five wide, floated eight wide into upper stretch, was never near enough to threaten. ALNESSA was bumped both sides and checked at the start, trailed inside, swung five to six wide, failed to make a bid.

ROCK HARD ROSE was in the mix arguing for the front end between rivals early on, went on with it clearing up top getting to the rail heading into the turn, rolled along unopposed setting an even pace throughout the oval and under a well rated ride was kept busy in deep stretch to just have enough late to stave off the fast closing runner up outside at the wire. SUPER SICILY was off a step slow on the break, was slightly eager at the rear pulling at the rider who was trying to throttle her down behind a wall of horses at the half, shifted out four wide reaching for ground at the quarter mile marker, swung out widest in the six path full of run at the top of the stretch, charged home outside late but could not get tithe winner in time. HARD TO CAPTURE settled into stride close to the

back three deep outside foes at the half, made a strong circling move four wide midway around the turn, shifted to the five path in the thick of things between challengers at the top of the lane and finished up willingly to be a clear third but could not threaten for the win in deep stretch. PRIMA dueled in the rail initially, took back off fighting on the front end midway down the backside, inched up taking the short way around the bend following the frontrunner, closed the gap by the quarter pole, shifted out two wide posing a threat in upper stretch but evened out in the final furlong lasting for a minor placing outside. VERDEJO was brushed by the outside foe on the break, recovered to be forwardly placed leaving the chute, settled inside of runners in midfield with a half mile still to run, edged up inside of runners midpoint through the bend skimmed the fence at the head of the lane but lacked a rally inside in the final furlong. GENIUS OF LOVE settled on the outside of two others in mid-pack at the half mile pole, offered a brief run three wide in midturn to four wide between runners at the top of the stretch, could not carry the momentum any further though and idled in the final furlong. MORE MONEY HUNNY prompted the pace outside in the beginning, chased but made little progression on the winner through the turn and had little left for the drive, faltering just off the fence at the head of the lane. DANCETOTHERHYTHM was away a touch slowly on the break, settled near the rear inside down the backstretch, could see the field unable to quicken around the bend at the five sixteenths marker, scraped paint picking up an outside weary rival turning for home but failed to menace in the stretch drive afterwards. ROCKET RILEY broke inwards on the start, vied between horses having the four path part of the early scrum into the backstretch, was reined back off the pace to sit in midfield with horses on either side with a half mile remaining, dropped back in tight between foes at the five sixteenths pole and came up empty three wide straightening out for the drive.

LADY ON THE NILE was brushed lightly in the early going, forced three to four wide racing off the pace, advanced leaving the backstretch reaching striking distance midway on the far turn, took over leaving that bend, drew clear in upper stretch then held. VRANA (IRE) broke just a half-step slowly, settled outside at the rear, advanced outside from the three-eighths racing four to five wide on the far turn, closed the gap but couldn't quite reach the winner. WORRY LESS moved forward inside to the lead and coming out a bit, dictated terms just off the rail, was headed leaving the far turn and under urging, kept on and held show honors. WUNHAPPY WABBIT was shuffled back after the break to co-trail on the outside, ranged up three deep by the seven sixteenths marker, offered a strong and sustained four wide rally circling horses on the turn, seized control outside getting a head in front in upper stretch and kept on finding more through the stretch drive to prevail for the win a tight three way tussle at the wire. SERIOUS GREEN had the rail sitting in midfield down the back straight, was stuck behind tiring runners having to tap on the brakes from the three eighths pole until shifting out off of them by the quarter marker, moved from the three path in upper stretch to the rail with a furlong to go coming with a run and surged inside in deep stretch but just missed getting the winner at the finish line. JINX ME pressed the pace on the outside leaving the gate, relaxed along the backstretch having a good spot isolated watching the contesting duo at the half, moved in getting a brief lead three wide at the five sixteenths pole, surrendered the lead unable to match strides with the winner outside straightening out for the drive, fought on determinedly between horses down the lane still in the hunt but faded a few jumps nearing the wire to be a clear third in the end. RYO AMAZING was unhurried sharing the rear inside the eventual winner entering the backstretch, raced well back of the pack by the half mile marker, closed in smartly outside through the turn, swung out widest in the four path turning for home, could not get to the lead trio who had in to themselves in the final furlong but still finished up well enough to be all alone at the wire for the minors. AMI'S CRY forced the issue on the inside in the beginning, continued to throw it down with an outside speed rival at the half, offered no resistance when engulfed by a couple of outside runners making a rally on the turn by the quarter pole and weakened even further on the fence through the stretch running. SEEKING MAGIC had a narrow advantage between rivals at the start, battled outside going head to head at the half, could not hold forward position giving way to runners on both sides at the five sixteenths pole and folded in the three path at the top of the stretch.

TAN TOAST was in hand moving to the leader inside when leaving the chute, shook lose seizing complete control by the half travelling well, rolled along unchallenged around the oval, shifted to the two path switching leads opening up once again when asked for more by mid-stretch and coasted on home in the late going for the front end score. HEART TAP had the fence part of the rear group of three early in the running, improved inside by the half, edged up inside of runners two wide through the turn making a run at the quarter pole, had the three path posing the only threat to the winner in upper stretch but was no match in the final furlong while easily besting the rest at the wire for the runners up share. THAT'S A FACT travelled three deep outside two others co-trailing down the backside, made no progression trying to circle horses three wide around the bend, swung out widest finding her best stride in the drive in the six path and closed in belatedly to get the nod at the wire for the show money. NEW RENAISSANCE vied between horses entering the backstretch, was nudged along at the half with the leader opening up, was scrubbed on two wide between challengers in midturn trying to just hold position, angled out in the four path turning for home in with a chance for a piece of the prize between rivals but was outkicked by the outside foe for the third place share in deep stretch. TOAST THE GHOST was part of the back threesome travelling between horses in a stalking role, had the two path inside another throughout the turn waiting for running room behind a few rivals at the quarter pole, had clear run if good enough at the head of the lane but offered no rally inside foes while dueling for the third place share in deep stretch. HEARTY CHRISTINI was away alertly getting the early lead on the outside, tracked the pacesetter outside another by the half, closed the gap three wide on the winner outside a couple of rivals at the quarter pole, shifted to the five path for the drive but tired between runners by the furlong marker.

BOSS LADY J was allowed to settle into stride finding her feet at the back of the pack on the rail around the initial bend, galloped along still patiently seeing

the field down the backside, saved all the ground around the far turn closing the gap smartly by the quarter pole, stormed on home darting sharply up the rail in the final furlong taking the lead inside by the seventy yard pole and was geared down late with the rider celebrating their win prematurely before crossing the finish line. LITA MARIE bobbed on the break, recovered having a good spot tracking the engaged pair on the outside, uncorked a rally coming to the leaders three wide at the quarter pole, loomed boldly in the four path at the top of the lane, got a head in front by the furlong pole but could not fend off the quick turn of foot inside by the winner in deep stretch. HOLY ANITA dueled on the rail in the first turn, continued to stubbornly throw it down with an outside foe along the backstretch, remained unyielding clinging on up front with a host outside foes bearing down on the far turn, still kept finding at the eighth pole battling inside for the lead but faded between runners in the late going while lasting for the show award under a very game debut. CRUMLIN MOLLY settled outside of another in mid-division, was scrubbed on for more taking closer order around the final bend three wide with a quarter mile from the wire, angled to the five path between horses in with a chance but needed more in the late running and settled on the fringes in the end. BERMUDA BREW had the fence part of the early scramble under the wire with a circuit remaining, had to be checked losing all momentum in tight with outside runners coming over heading into the first turn, stalked near the rear having only the eventual winner beaten down the backside, travelled three wide making little progress around the final bend, swung out widest in the six path straightening out for home and finished up gradually outside of runners in a blanket finish for the second, third and fourth positions. CHERVONARUTA sat in midfield on the fence in the early stages rating kindly, waited for a lane while in the two path behind rivals at the quarter pole, shifted three wide trying to find a seam at the top of the lane, shifted back to the rail finally getting clear run and surged inside of runners late but really could not get into gear completely in time to threaten late. STRAWBERRY WORLD had a tracking position on the rail, remained in the second flight inside another watching the embattled duo down the backside, sat poised on the far turn behind the leaders looking for running room, hugged the rail turning for home, shifted out three wide at the furlong pole finally getting clear aim on the front pair but was outfinished in deep stretch with a mad scramble of horses in the final sixteenth of a mile. SEATTLE RISING battled outside around the first of two turns, continued to tussle with an inside rival up top down the backside, determinedly dug in still fighting between horses through the second turn but came up empty drifting inwards from the three path when tiring in upper stretch.
