CHANCEL comfortably cleared to the front crossing over getting to the fence loose up top when entering the backstretch, was left alone dictating the pace at the half, still cruised along unopposed quickening the tempo slightly around the bend and had plenty left for the drive when called upon at the eighth pole to win going away at the finish line for the gate to wire score. SUNRISE DRIVE travelled three deep outside in mid-division in the early going, chased three wide outside a couple of runners edging up on the turn by the quarter pole, shifted to the four path in the mix turning for home, was no match for the dominant winner with a furlong remaining but grinded away outside nevertheless and got up in the shadow of the wire for the place share. BIG BABY HENRY was forwardly placed watching the lone speed down the backside, tracked the pacesetter while between horses on the turn closing the gap with a quarter mile left to run, posed the main threat two to three wide at the head of the lane but could only run on mildly in the last furlong getting nabbed outside in deep stretch for the runners up position. SECRET STORM had the rail position sitting in mid-pack, took the short way around the bend taking closer on the leader by the quarter pole, was in tight two wide at the top of the lane very much in the hunt but could only finish up evenly on the rail in the late going lasting inside for a minor role. DELIAN LEAGUE was nudged to stay interested down the backside lagging at the rear, co-trailed outside with another three furlongs from home, moved from the two path in upper stretch to be widest closing in at the furlong pole five wide but could be a not factor when crossing the finish line. ALWAYS A WAY settled in midfield between rivals in the beginning, dropped back at the half having only one runner beaten, shared the rear inside with three eighths remaining, could see the field by the quarter pole, shifted from the rail to the four path at the furlong marker narrowing the margin between runners late but failed to menace at the finish line.

SOUPER EFFECT broke inwardly then was forwardly-positioned tracking in behind the leader racing near the inside in hand, moved out a bit on the turn and advanced to take the lead at the quarter pole, was asked in upper stretch and drew clear, was well clear and given moderate urging to the wire. KAIROS MOMENT shifted in early settled off the pace, saved ground on the turn edging nearer, came out off the fence leaving that bend but shifted back in toward the rail in mid-stretch, rallied inside to secure the place without threatening the winner. INSTANT RESPONSE bumped with a rival at the start, was well-positioned taking the lead after the opening quarter to dictate terms near the inside, weakened in the stretch. AUDI'S WORLD switched out off the inside, moved up advancing outside foes five wide on the turn, evened out in the stretch. BILDEAN broke outwardly, settled toward the back outside racing three to four wide into the turn, came out of that bend six to seven wide for the stretch run, was never near enough to threaten. UXBRIDGE ARMS (GB) was bumped at the start, shifted in and moved up two to three wide between runners to chase in behind, was ridden three furlongs out but had no response. BROCKWELL bumped with a foe at the start, was well-placed stalking outside, was under urging four wide and between foes passing the five-sixteenths, flattened out. TWENTY OVAS was forced out and into a rival at the start, dropped back to last, shifted in and saved ground on the turn, made no bid. LOVE PUDDLES broke outwardly, had the early lead from outside then pressed, was done by the three-eighths and retreated.

RIDE FOR THE PURSE broke a step slow then was taken hold of in tight losing his path soon after the start, improved down the backside to sit in mid-pack by the half, was roused at the five sixteenths pole making a good rally inside by the quarter marker, loomed boldly in the four path straightening out for the drive and powered past the frontrunner quickly at the sixteenth pole to win going away. TEMPLE HALL was hard held left alone on the engine in the early going, controlled the pace moving well in hand around the oval, began to shorten stride not switching leads at the furlong pole still holding on top, had nothing in reserve unable to counter the late charge by the winner outside at the sixteenth pole but still finished up well enough to be a solid second best at the wire. MAC GOWAN travelled three deep while sitting back off the leader at the half, crept closer going three wide outside two runners around the bend, made a bid for the lead in the three path still with horses on either side at the top of the stretch but stalled with its run in the final furlong capturing the show money. BEE ME had the fence position keeping an eye on the runaway leader down the back straight, kept pace while inside a couple of rivals throughout the turn, hugged the rail in the mix in upper stretch but could only finish up one paced in the late running settling on the fringes in the end. GUS'S DRUMBEET was forwardly placed initially travelling four deep outside of horses, dropped back to co- trail with an inside foe at the half, started to pick up the bit three wide in midturn, moved to the five-path taking the corner but failed to fire in the final furlong outside of rivals. SOMEKINDA MISCHIEF was unhurried at the rear in the early going, travelled three wide through the bend making no progression outside rivals, swung out widest in the six-path turning for home but could only manage to pass a leg weary inside runner at the head of the lane. THANKS YOUR HONOUR broke out on the start, had a good position between runners tracking the lone speed leader along the backside, was roused chasing the frontrunner midway on the turn but could not quicken

with rivals on either side who were commencing a run, angled to the four path at the top of the lane and folded in upper stretch.

GONE HUNTING was brushed at the break but quick to take the lead, set a pressured pace inside, dueled to the wire and held a rival at bay under steady handling. BORDER FOX pressed the eventual winner from the outset, dueled but couldn't get past while second best. RAGING TIMBER broke a step slowly, moved forward outside but was caught four wide into the first turn easing back and shifting in a path, settled off the leaders bidding time, fanned wide while advancing late on the far turn coming into upper stretch seven deep, drifted in a bit in upper- to mid-stretch and gained steadily late but was not enough. CAPTIVATING NAME stalked on the rail in the third flight rating kindly, started to reach for more ground when asked at the five sixteenths pole, was on hold coming up behind a wall of runners three wide with a quarter mile left to run, still had no lane angling out to the six path at the top of the stretch, finally had clear run at the furlong marker outside and under a patiently handled ride surged quickly in deep stretch to just get up in time for the late charging win. ONENIGHTSTANDARDS settled close to the back going four wide on the beginning corner, had a stalking position ahead of only a couple of rivals down the back straightaway, commenced a rally splitting runners at the five sixteenths marker, loomed a menacing presence seven wide straightening out for home, drifted inwards under a drive down the lane taking the lead in the two path by the sixteenth pole but could not hold off the winner outside losing the nod at the wire. SHAMATEUR had a slim lead on the rail in the first turn, continued to lead narrowly while hounded outside by a couple of runners down the backstretch, edged away slightly at the half, kept a head in front still shadowed outside by runners through the final bend, scraped paint determinedly

clinging up top taking the final corner and gave way grudgingly inside in the final seventy yards taking the show award on the wrong end of a tight three way finish for the win at the wire. ETHNIC SOUL had a slow beginning seeing the field, continued to lag at the rear down the backstretch, started to make a move two wide passing an outside tiring foe at the quarter pole, skimmed the fence improving in upper stretch, had to alter course sharply coming up to the leader three wide leaving the eighth pole and ran on mildly in deep stretch garnering a minor placing in the end. SAILOR'S PASSION had a good spot drafting just behind the frontrunner on the rail under a snug hold in the early stages, sat poised looking for a seam ready to run at the quarter pole, shifted to the two path lacking running room in upper stretch, had to be checked losing its path to an inside runner veering out at the furlong pole and could not recover in time to factor at the finish line. BLONDINA'S BOY travelled three wide circling runners in midfield advancing through the first bend, took closer order down the backstretch prompting the issue outside the embattled pair by the half, argued for the lead three wide around the second turn with the two inside foes, remained in the mix between horses with many fanned across in upper stretch with a chance but had little to offer late wilting in the last furlong. CONACHER was forwardly placed between runners tracking the lead duo on the first of two turns, made little movement along the backside, chased the lead trio shifting out four wide in the second bend by the quarter pole, had a chance for a piece of the prize in the five path at the top of the lane but had little left late and weakened at the furlong marker. BOURBONONAHOLIDAY was floated out widest in the five path entering the first turn while near the rear, advanced three deep down the backside sitting in midfield by the half mile marker, travelled three wide on the far turn but was going in the wrong direction by the five sixteenths pole, folded four wide by the quarter pole but did pass a straggler in the stretch drive. SO CALLED VACATION was hustled right from the start forcing the pace outside, vied between horses down the backstretch, was still fighting in the mix up top two wide with runners on each side around the far turn, was the first of the lead three to give way dueling on the front end by the quarter pole and ran out of steam, faltering in the stretch by the furlong pole.

DROP YOUR GLOVES settled off the leading pair up the backstretch racing off the rail, edged closer leaving the turn, moved out five wide in upper stretch, drove past and clear. WAHEELA was a bit slow to gather but encouraged forward inside to mid-pack, came out six wide past the furlong marker, kept on well but was second best. DRAW BOOT bumped a rival at the start, settled off the pace racing outside, advanced three then four wide on the turn, swung out six to seven wide for the drive, gained late to secure show honors. DEVIL'S TONGUE was urged forward, dueled inside, ran on. BRITISH ARTILLERY took back off the early scramble to have the two path stalking close the tail end on the first bend, closed the gap strongly four deep outside early along the backstretch, dropped back again to be part of the rear trio outside with a half mile to run, came with a three to four wide circling charge outside horses around the last turn, had the four path turning for home and continued on with the long sustained rally outside to edge clear for the win in the shadow of the wire. ACCELERANDO was bumped by the inside runner on the break, recovered to have a nice set up isolated on the fence watching the embattled duo on the first turn, shifted out in the three path through the backside coming to the leaders entering the last turn, moved outside the frontrunner by the five sixteenths pole with a sharp rally, seized control by the quarter pole, edged clear in the two path by mid-stretch on the wrong lead, finally switched leads at the sixteenth pole but it was too late by that time with the winner driving past for the win outside. KING ROSSO broke outwards leaving the gate, then was hard ridden on the rail but could not match strides with the lead twosome instead settling in midfield in the early stages inside, saved all the ground on the last turn but was making little headway, began to gather momentum lengthening stride three wide at the top of the stretch, angled to the five path at the furlong pole for clearer run and finished up smartly getting up for third inside coming to the wire. TRUE SHOT was brushed on

the outside on the break, had only one runner beaten taking the first corner, co-trailed with rivals on both sides at the half, made little progress three wide on the far turn, shifted to the five path for the stretch run making up good ground, dueled outside for the show award in deep stretch but had to settle on the fringes instead losing the fight at the finish line. COMMANDER AT SEA was brushed on the outside to begin, trailed the field into the first turn, remaining at the back with two outside foes at the half, was relegated back to being the sole trailer on the last bend, hugged the rail making a move in upper stretch, shifted to the three path off the tiring early leader at the sixteenth pole and finished up with some late interest. FRAC RIGHT broke inwards on the start, contested the pace outside early on, vied between runners down the backstretch at the half, could not quicken with the front pair by the five sixteenths pole, shifted to the three-path finding something more coming back on briefly at the top of the lane but ran out of gas late fading in deep stretch. JMR SPEEDY ESCAPE sat all alone in the middle of the pack in the early running, took closer aim outside tracking the lead threesome at the half mile marker, was scrubbed on for more trying to hold position two wide through the last turn and had little to offer for the drive to the wire unable to get involved in the late going. BANKINGONAMIRACLE broke in at the start, had a head in front inside around the initial bend, inched away slightly on the fence by the half, was collared outside by the midpoint of the far turn, tried to counter again hugging the rail turning for home but could not continue on late and folded inside of horses by the sixteenth pole.

ALFRED BELLOWES was well spotted having the fence sitting back off the embattled threesome, slid through in tight splitting runners two wide at the quarter pole bullying his way through, had the rail closing the gap in upper stretch still well back of the leader though, shifted to the two path with aim on the tiring rival up front in the late stages, took control with seventy yards to go and just had enough left to hold on from the fast closing runner up outside at the wire. SOUPER STRIDER broke inwards at the start, settled at the rear running in tandem with an inside foe down the backstretch, started to gather speed two

wide passing a runner outside at the three eighths pole, moved to the six path at the head of the lane finding his best stride late and charged home in the last furlong just missing with one final late surge at the wire for the win. BIG LEW hounded the pace outside along the back straight, seized control getting a head in front going three wide into the turn, increased the advantage up top running around the bend, moved well still quite in control off the fence by mid-stretch but became leg weary in the final sixteenth of a mile only holding on for a clear third at the finish line. GOOD TO BE LUCKY was well positioned on the outside having the eventual winner hemmed in all the while watching the lead three do battle up front, ranged up smartly three wide around horses on the turn to be in the hunt turning for home but needed more late when evening out in the final furlong unable to threaten for the top three placings in deep stretch and settling on the fringes only in the end. GINGER'S HOLIDAY was crowded between rivals at the break, stalking outside the other troubled runner down the backside, came under a drive unable to make any advance around the turn, shifted to the five-path straightening out for the drive and finished up with some late interest passing foes but could not get into contention. MACH TWO BLUE veered out sharply on the break having to be taken a hold of quickly, co-trailed inside another in the early going, still lagged behind the field entering the oval, passed an inside foe by the five sixteenths pole trying to come with a run, swung out widest in the seven path at the top of the lane but could not get involved in the stretch running outside. CLIVE CROSS was sandwiched between horses on the break, stalked near the rear inside another down the backside, dropped back to last in midturn and could only manage to pass a couple of weakening runners who were used up fighting for the lead early on. LEMON TWIST pressed the pace between horses, was in tight having to be checked slightly between runners coming to the three eighths pole, tried to come back on making a brief rally three wide with a quarter mile from the prize, angled to the four path in upper stretch but tired in the last furlong. DILWAALA was roused on the fence having the early advantage, surrendered the lead inside at the seven sixteenths pole, gave futile chase on the rail through the turn with the leader getting away by the quarter pole and emptied out inside rivals by the furlong marker.
