SERENADING AMAYA was allowed to patiently settle into stride seeing the field in the early stages, took closer order with the group bunching up at the half, inched up around the far turn looking for a seam, opted to shift out sharply pouncing four wide in upper stretch and determinedly wore down the contesting lead duo inside down the lane to pull away for the win at the finish line. RELOAD EH had a good position on the fence keeping an eye on the pacesetter, sat poised waiting for the cue to go on the rail through the last bend, shifted to the two path in the thick of things in upper stretch, closed in to get a head in front between horses for a fleeting moment at the sixteenth pole but could not fend off the winners late charge outside in the late going. DIXIE DOLL veered out on the break, recovered to be loose up top on the first of two turns, had a narrow advantage with an outside foe prompting the issue at the half, was nudged on for more holding inside up top around the second bend, disposed of the brief challenger when spurted away on the fence in upper stretch, raced greenly through the lane switching leads numerous times when urged by the rider with the crop trying to fend off the outside runners bearing down at the furlong pole but could not find more late inside fading in deep stretch to be a clear third at the wire. SUNNYVILLE stumbled breaking inwards at the start, stalked close to the back end outside another on the first turn, co-trailed outside with the eventual winner at the half, was hard ridden going three to four wide making no gain on the far turn, was floated out widest in the six-path turning for home and could not be a factor in the late going. ALMASTY'S LUST tracked the frontrunner in tandem with an inside foe to begin, moved in at the half flanking the leader outside, travelled two wide forcing the pace around the last bend, shifted to the three-path giving way fighting up front at the top of the lane and wilted even further in the final eighth of a mile. TAKE CHANCES was taken a hold of when the outside runner was bearing in at the start, settled near the rear on the inside early on, shifted to the outside making little headway down the back straight, was asked right-handed in midfield at the five sixteenths pole for more run offering no response and failed to menace in the stretch drive.

TWISTING PISTONS had an ideal trip rating smartly on the fence drafting behind the leader throughout, shifted outside off the pacesetter at the head of the lane, pounced three wide with a furlong to go and drove past a stubborn frontrunner in deep stretch for the win. COLLECT DATTT was brushed on the outside on the start, recovered to be loose on the lead in the first turn on the fence, got a breather up top unchallenged down the backside, continued to roll along with no pressure applied by rivals on the last turn, had something left just off the fence for the drive kicking away briefly at the furlong marker but could not hold off the winner late grudgingly giving way inside for the win in deep stretch. MY GIRL SKY broke inwards, shared the rear inside on the rail in the early stages, was roused taking the short way around the final bend coming on at the quarter pole, stayed inside at the top of the lane and finished up willingly on the rail in the final furlong getting the show money albeit well back of the front two who had it to themselves late. MAGIC MODIE was content to sit outside keeping a close eye on the leader, was scrubbed for more going after the pacesetter midway around the last bend, shifted to the four-path unable to keep up to the inside contesting duo in upper stretch and finished up one paced between runners in the last eighth settling for only a minor share in the end. MRS. HOT SHOT had the rail sitting midfield early on, had to be checked coming up on heels midway thru the initial bend, settled into stride between horses in the third flight stalking down the backside, edged up in hand two wide at the five sixteenths pole to have a chance shifting to the five path for a share at the top of the stretch but flattened out in the final furlong. PICKFORD SWEET tossed her head at the break, settle on the outside in the middle of the pack, made little movement travelling three deep along the backside, was under a drive three wide on the far turn but could not gain on rivals, swung out to the six-path turning for home but failed to fire in the stretch running. BRAVO KATE was unhurried co-trailing on the outside, lagged behind the group

unable to get into gear down the backside, was asked for more but could not get inspired in the running around the final bend and galloped down the lane never getting involved in the race.

BITTER BULLET settled well off the loose leader but ahead of the rest, began edging closer late on the turn, was encouraged along past the quarter pole, took the lead in upper stretch, drew clear in mid-stretch, held sway under steady handling. BENKA broke inwardly, advanced inside foes up the backstretch, was asked for a bit more at the seven-sixteenths, came out at the top of the stretch, ran on and held place. NEXT OF KIN got away well but was outsprinted early, raced mid-pack outside a foe into the turn racing three to four wide and encouraged along past the three-eighths, came out further in mid-stretch, kept on and got show honors. MANDALENA bumped a rival lightly at the start, settled outside at the back racing three to four wide into the turn, came into upper stretch six wide, moved out another path or two in mid-stretch, kept on outside to get up for fourth. HOT GYAL MOSSOP broke a half-step slowly, raced outside up the backstretch at the rear, shifted in and moved up between foes early on the turn, ran on mildly in the stretch. MOLLY'S CORNER was lightly bumped after the start, chased in behind, shifted in leaving the backstretch, saved ground on the turn, failed to rally. HAVE RESPECT sped clear to set the pace well in front, gave way in the stretch.

CHARMING JACKIE broke inwards on the start, was fleet footed seizing control while in hand loose up top by the five eighths marker, moved very comfortable with no rivals making a challenge around the oval, increased the advantage when finally called upon in mid-stretch and cruised on home for the front end score. SARATOGA GOLD was away alertly on the start, took back being reined in to sit in mid-division on the outside three deep with a half still to run, made a solid rally circling around foes three wide on the oval to be in the conversation up top at the head of the lane, finished up well enough besting the rest getting up for the runners up share late outside but was well back of the winner at the finish line. CHINOOK had a good spot forwardly placed on the outside tracking the frontrunner, chased the winner in vain around the turn, shifted to the three path being no match to the winner by the furlong pole and faded slightly in the final sixteenth losing the battle for the secondary award inside. MR BOND was bumped by the outside rival on the break, had the rail sitting in midfield under a snug hold at the half mile pole, was shuffled back being checked briefly on the fence at the seven sixteenths marker, moved to the

three path for the stretch run and showed late interest to be all alone at the wire for a minor award. IRON WEAVE tracked the leader between runners at the five furlong marker, dropped back unable to hold position by the half, was hard ridden on the rail just keeping pace, moved to the four path straightening out for home and finished up mildly but could not get involved in the late going. FLATTER SUCCESS travelled on the inside of another near the rear, made little impression taking the short way around the turn, hugged the rail taking the corner but could not offer a finishing kick in the stretch drive. HYPNOTIZM settled close to the back end on the outside, offered a mild run improving outside a couple of runners on the turn, swung out widest in the five path turning for home but could not factor late. MARIETTA BABE was nudged for more on the fence advancing inside runners to sit just behind the front pair at the half, had little left to offer being urged on in midturn when backing away and came up empty in the drive due to his early efforts down the backside. ASTRAL hopped at the break spotting the field many along the backside, continued to trail the pack around the bend, lagged behind in the stretch drive but did almost catch an inside weary rival at the finish line.

LAMIRADA seized command quickly inside when entering the backstretch, opened up at will in hand around the turn, drew off with authority with the rider statuesque at the furlong pole and won under only a hand ride overpowering the field down the stretch. CLASSIC LINES travelled three deep watching the engaged duo down the backside, made a good circling rally three wide around horses through the bend, closed belatedly in the four path outside and won the battle for the secondary share but well behind the runaway winner at the wire. LOUNROBIN had the rail sitting in mid-pack watching the lead twosome, came under a drive holding position inside through the turn, skimmed the fence still fighting on inside of horses in mid-stretch, shifted to the two path off a runner in the late going and surged between rivals right at the finish line getting the head down for third place. EXILE had runners on both sides while in sitting in the middle of the pack, ran on evenly keeping up with others throughout the bend while being roused for more, shifted to the three path in the stretch drive but needed more outside two others in deep stretch just getting out nodded at the wire in a tight three way finish for the show award. KLASSEN veered out on the break while still getting the lead leaving the gate, relinquished the front into the backstretch, hounded the pacesetter outside at the half, gave futile chase with the winner increasing the advantage around the oval, tried to fight on inside holding for the runners up share in the final furlong but faded slightly in deep stretch on the fence losing the three way picture at the wire for the show money. EARLY BLOSSOM broke slowly, co-trailing outside with the other rival who had a poor beginning, made little movement outside a runner around the turn and showed little in the drive to the finish line. GLENORCHY had a slow start sharing the rear inside with the other sluggish beginner down the backside, could not make up any ground on the fence throughout the turn and failed to menace in the stretch running inside another.

SPELLCHECK was well placed tracking outside down the back straight, continued outside two wide measuring the leader on the turn, was urged for more under a right-handed crop at the quarter pole, took closer order in the heat of the battle outside three wide in upper stretch for the top spot and under a vigorous ride in the final furlong got up in the shadow of the wire winning the bob at the finish line. MATHEMATICAL sat all alone well held on the fence keeping a close eye on the frontrunner, patiently waited for the cue to go rating kindly behind the leader on the bend, shifted out off the pacesetter looming a menacing presence between foes in upper stretch, fought on determinedly between horses arguing up top on the last eighth of a mile but was denied for the win at the wire by a head nod. REGAL AFFAIR was brushed by the outside rival on the start, settled into stride seeing the field midway down the backside, travelled three wide on the turn catching up to runners by the quarter pole, moved from the three path in upper stretch getting to the rail with a sixteenth to run and exploded on the fence in the late going but just came up shy getting to the winner at the finish line. VEGAS ROAD stumbled breaking out on the start, recovered while hard held assuming command loose up top by the five eighths pole, cruised along unopposed in hand around the turn, still was

stubbornly holding on inside in mid-stretch, was asking for the wire with runners bearing down on both sides while in the two path with a sixteenth remaining but faded between runners in very deep stretch lasting at the wire for a minor placing. DEFINITE DIVA had one beaten along the backside, travelled four wide around foes foe making little impact through the turn, swung out widest in the six-path finding her best stride late outside of runners at the top of the lane and closed in late almost getting up for a minor share in the end. LORRAINE'S BEAUTY had a slow start trailing in the beginning, rushed up along the backside then was taken a hold of at the half sitting behind the front three runners, was scrubbed on for more run but could not keep up to the leaders on the turn at the five sixteenths pole, shifted to the four path for the drive but could only run on evenly making little impact in the final furlong. SCAT HUMOR settled on the outside of two others in midfield, offered a brief turn of foot three wide on the turn from the three eighths pole until the quarter marker, angled to the five path straightening out for home but stalled between runners in the final furlong. LET'S GO SOUPER stumbled to her knees losing her footing soon after leaving the gate, recouped to sit in midfield between runners at the half, retreated throughout the turn under little coaxing, well relegated to the rear on the rail at the top of the lane and was wrapped up inside of runners by the sixteenth pole.

KATIE'S GRACE travelled three wide at the back finding her feet on the first turn, closed the gap on the field getting into the bridle by the half, shifted out three wide at the five sixteenths pole unleashing a rally, loomed boldly having a solid turn of foot outside in the four path at the top of the lane, drove by outside leaving the furlong pole reaching for more ground and won going away impressively crossing the finish line. BOLD TIME was well placed sitting on the fence drafting behind the frontrunner throughout this two-turn event, waited for the opportune time inside at the quarter pole to make her move, skimmed the fence having a clear lane at the top of the stretch, seized control briefly inside with a furlong remaining but could not match strides with the winner a sixteenth of a mile from the prize but still finished up strong enough holding for the place share. BOSSY CANDY was hustled in the beginning getting the lead on the rail around the first turn, galloped along setting an even tempo being unchallenged down the backstretch, travelled just off the fence moving well up top around the final bend, drifted out to the three path turning for home holding on in upper stretch, was no match for the winner who powered past outside leaving the furlong pole, battling on with inside foe still showing grit trying to counter for the place share in deep stretch but having to settle for a clear third at the wire instead. GLITTER AND GLOW travelled three wide on the initial bend tracking the pacesetter outside, made no movement content sitting on the outside of the leader down the backstretch with the group bunching up by the half, was scrubbed on for more with the pace quickening but could not keep up to rivals on either side at the five sixteenths pole, retreated to the rear by the quarter marker, tired in upper stretch and galloping on home.

ENGLISH ACTOR soon moved to the lead to set the pace near inside just off the rail, was asked at the top of the stretch, drifted out in mid- to late-stretch and held a foe. SIDE STREET was forwardly-placed stalking two to three wide, switched out for the run up the backstretch, edged closer four wide on the

second turn, chased the winner home while carried out by that one and was second best. SWIFT DELIVERY shifted in early to save ground through the first turn, was held up behind traffic leaving that bend then switched out heading down the stretch the first time and advanced outside foes three to five wide, continued three to four wide on subsequent turns, kept on between runners in the lane while carried out a bit late. SULTANA shifted in early settling off the pace inside through the first turn, switched out off the rail racing off the pace through the second and third turns, swung six wide into upper stretch and kept on late. DANCIN IN DA'NILE settled mid-pack inside early, switched out on the second turn, lost some ground on the third bend racing three to five wide, swung wider still for the drive and kept on one-paced in the lane to improve position but needed more. TRULY QUALITY was caught outside foes settling off the pace toward the rear, raced mostly three wide through the early going, swung eight deep for the drive and improved position outside. ROSCAR tracked from inside up close to and in behind the eventual winner, weakened in the stretch. FABER was well-placed stalking two to three wide early, shifted in and saved ground the remaining turns, failed to rally. JUNIPERO SERRA was a bit tight at the start and unhurried at the rear trailing while shifting in, saved ground to no avail. SUMMER CAUSE broke outwardly, was well-placed stalking the winner three wide, came up empty. TWOWAYCROSSING was outside foes off the pace toward the rear racing four to eight wide throughout, failed to menace.

DADDY'S THE BOSS hopped slightly on the break, recouped to have a good position on the rail tracking the loose leader early on, was asked for run on the fence in midturn, shifted out two wide at the quarter pole moving off the frontrunner coming on outside, bid in the two path at the head of the lane, was repelled briefly when the winner edged away at the furlong pole but was unyielding in herpursuit and came back on under a determined ride at the got the win getting the head down right when crossing the finish line. ONCE UPON A KISS was roused leaving the chute getting a clear advantage early down the backstretch, had company outside at the half, opened up again at the five sixteenths pole having the rail, cut the corner having a narrow lead inside straightening out for home, edged away for a second time at the furlong pole, kept finding on the lead in the late going but was nabbed outside by the winner right on the finish line. MONEY HEIST veered out on the break, stalked on the outside close to the back end, made a sharp move swooping around runners four the five wide on the turn at the quarter pole, swung out widest gathering more speed in the six path at the top of the stretch, kept coming on through the lane outside but could not get to the embattled pair at the finish line being a very clear third in the end. DEANNA settled at the rear getting to the

fence down the backside, saved all the ground closing the gap smartly by the quarter pole, shifted to the two path in with a chance for a small share in upper stretch and won the duel inside getting the photo to be a fringe player at the wire. GOING PLATINUM travelled well in hand shadowing the inside duo at the half, was hustled for more three wide trying to close in between runners on the bend at the quarter pole, angled out with rivals on either side in the five path turning for home but could only finish up evenly losing the battle outside for the minors by a nose. FRAC'S C E O had the fence being a part of the rear trio in the beginning, edged up shifting out between runners at the half mile marker, could not find more while being roused regressing between horses two wide in midturn, shifted to the rail seeing the group at the head of the lane and managed to pass a weary straggler inside at the furlong pole. MISS BRIT settled between runners in midfield, took closer order pressing the issue outside the leader at the half, chased in the two to three path hard ridden around the turn making no gain on the frontrunner, angled out to be three wide at the top of the stretch giving way fighting on the front end and emptied out in the last eighth of a mile.
