RELOADED FORM broke inwards on the start, travelled three wide near the rear outside in the first of two turns, edged up three deep down the backside, ranged up on the secondary bend, had a sharp turn of foot at the quarter pole to loom boldly outside in the four-path turning for home and drove by at the sixteenth pole and held on at the wire from the late closing outside runner. CASTLE HARBOUR had the rail sitting in midfield in the early stages, was scrubbed on for more midway through the far turn two wide chasing the lead duo while the eventual winner was outside commencing a rally as well, lacked a lane in the three path behind rivals at the top of the stretch, shifted out getting clear run finally five wide at the furlong pole, did not switch leads throughout the stretch drive but still kept coming on in the late stages but could not get to the winner in time at the finish line. GLORIOUS REVENGE had the lead on the fence using the inside advantage around the first turn, continued up top narrowly inside down the backstretch, dueled on the rail with an outside rival throughout the far turn coming under a ride at the five sixteenths pole just to stay up top, countered briefly regaining control taking the corner for the stretch run, could not find more in reserve late and faded inside of horses with a sixteenth left to run just lasting at the wire for the show honors. CARRICK ON STAGE bobbled then was jostled between runners on the break trailing in the early going, closed the gap on the rail down the backside by the half, improved inside of runners at the three-furlong marker, scraped paint in the mix at the head of the lane, had the two-path caught behind horses lacking running room, finally got clear with just a sixteenth remaining and had a good late surge coming to the finish line to almost get up for the show award in the end. HIGH BEAM was under a snug hold pressing the pace outside, relaxed smartly flanking the leader outside down the backstretch, moved in while still in hand to bid outside at the five sixteenths pole, got a head in front briefly with a quarter mile to run, dueled between horses in upper stretch but could not find more late and wilted between foes at the furlong marker. BACK STREET DRIVER settled on the outside of another in mid-pack, retreated three wide into the last bend when unable to quicken with the two inside rivals who were starting to make a run at the three eighths pole and emptied out by upper stretch.

QUIET MADDELENA was hustled leaving the gate getting the early advantage, continued to control the pace getting a slight breather tempo wise up top while having some pressure applied by the outside rival in midturn, had more when called upon spurting away in the two path turning for home and was kept to the task late comfortably holding for the gate to wire score. JUST FOLLOW ME had a stalking trip outside another having only one foe beaten along the backstretch, offered a solid sustained rally circling horses smartly three to four wide on the turn, posed the main threat outside of rivals at the head of the lane but could only chase the winner home in vain. SAUCY NAME shadowed the frontrunner outside in the early going, continued outside the leader but could not close in throughout the turn, shifted three wide still in the mix for a share with the winner spurting away in upper stretch between rivals and ran on willingly in the final furlong just holding for the third-place share at the finish line. APRIL DE VELP was brushed by the outside foe on the break, sat isolated in midfield midway down the back straight, retreated two wide when runners on both sides went by making a rally at the three furlong pole, shifted to the five path at the top of the stretch and had her best stride late outside runners in the final furlong almost getting up at the wire for the show award. GIZMO'S B F F tracked the front pair while outside another in the second flight, was roused just off the rail between foes holding position through the turn, moved to the

three path at the top of the lane but could not pose a threat in the drive finishing up one paced in the last fiurlong. GRETNA GREEN was well placed under a snug hold on the rail watching the engaged duo through the backstretch as well as along the bend, skimmed the fence having a clear run in upper stretch but failed to fire inside of runners in the late going. BLAZING SKY stalked close to the back on the fence, inched up taking the short way around the oval closing the gap by the quarter pole, angled out to the four-path straightening out for home but lacked a rally in the stretch drive. SLOANS SKY broke inwards on the start trailing the field down the backside, continued to lag well behind the pack on the turn running, swung out widest in the six path for the stretch drive but had little to offer down the lane outside.

BARGER was prominent early then ceded the lead and took back to track in behind inside, came out for a seam at the top of the stretch, moved willingly to the lead by mid-stretch and drew clear under just mild hand urging. SILENT KEY was coaxed forward between runners to the lead, set the pace near the inside, was off the rail in upper stretch, overtaken in mid-stretch, fought on but was no match. PRINCE SHAMAN steadied slightly in behind passing the half, raced at the back inside into the turn, kept on along the inside in the stretch. TOO FAB FOR YOU pressed the pace from outside, came into upper stretch four wide, got the nod for fourth. STREET SAVANT settled outside off the pace, advance under urging leaving the turn fanning six wide into upper stretch, was outfinished for a minor award. H C GAMBLE switched out off the inside in the early going, came into upper stretch five wide, weakened.

BOOTSONTHEGROUND was content rating kindly sitting off the frontrunner outside down the back straight, was spurred on by the rider to go after the leader at the five sixteenths pole, shifted to the three path in the hunt at the top of the stretch, grinded away outside keeping it tight on the inside rivals in the late going and with relentless pursuit in deep stretch pulled away for the win in the final seventy yards. MUNNYSTRUCK emerged from the early scramble loose up top well in hand into the backside by the five eights marker, opened up even further by the half, cruised along untouched through the bend, had a comfortable advantage just off the fence in upper stretch, kept finding more when urged still holding on with a furlong to run but gave way to the determined winner outside in the final seventy yards while holding inside for the place share from the tough-tripped rival at the wire. BONGINO WARRIOR had the rail position sitting in the middle of the pack, inched up moving well on the fence through the bend, scraped paint in the conversation up top straightening out for the drive, lacked a clear lane in tight between the dueling leaders at the furlong pole to basically the wire and finished up a troubled but clear third in the end. YORKTON'S LEGACY was unhurried seeing the field in the early stages, tried to make a four wide circling move around rivals in midturn, swung out widest in the six path in upper stretch, could not sustain the rally and finished up mildly outside another getting only a minor placing in the end. DEEP POCKETS settled outside another in mid-division, was scrubbed on for more run starting to make a rally at the five sixteenths pole three wide, angled to the four path still in the mix turning for home but idled between horses by the furlong marker. MALTESE WARRIOR had a stalking role down the backside ahead of only one runner, travelled two wide on the turn closing the gap by the quarter pole unable to improve position though, stayed inside rivals in the stretch drive but could not offer a finishing kick in the last furlong.

HEMLO GOLD bumped a rival after the start, was forwardly-placed stalking from outside, edged closer into the far turn, took over the lead coming to the top of the stretch, drew clear in mid-stretch, held safe. THIS DUDE A BREEZE exchanged a light brush at the break then was bumped into a rival just after, shifted in early racing at the back, advanced along the rail up the backstretch, came out six wide for the stretch run, was gaining too late. CORNWALL was caught five wide into and on the first turn, advanced outside foes early up the backstretch moving in from five to four deep and stalking outside a foe in the second flight into the far turn, came out a bit for the drive, kept on evenly. JIM'S HOPE brushed with a foe at the start then was bumped soon after, settled toward the rear three to four wide, came out turning for home, was carried out seven wide in upper- to mid-stretch, ran on but needed more. KOKOMO was away alertly having the early lead leaving the gate, smartly took back sitting all alone rating kindly off the contesting duo at the half, was nudged along on the fence creeping closer in midturn, shifted out at the quarter pole, pounced three wide in upper stretch on the softened-up leader, seized complete control opening up by the furlong pole and held sway for the win at the finish line. FINE STYLE was under a good hold on the rail keeping a close eye on the lead three at the half, was coaxed along holding position just off the rail around the oval, shifted out three to four wide in the hunt turning for home, closed in by the furlong marker posing a menacing presence, switched back to the wrong lead losing momentum by the sixteenth pole though and finished up a non-threatening second best at the wire. SILENT SECRET was allowed to settle into stride seeing the field along the backside, came under a ride progressing on the turn taking the shortest way around, hugged the rail continued the sustained rally taking the corner and had good late energy finishing up with intent getting up late outside for the show money. CAJUN INFLUENCE bobbed slightly on the break, did not miss a step getting a neck in front by the five eighths marker, had company outside pressing the pace by the half, disposed of the early outside speed foe by the five sixteenths marker, had no answer when the winner powered past in mid-stretch and wilted inside of runners with a sixteenth remaining losing a couple of positions late. WAR LEGEND stalked near the rear between runners initially, was relegated to the back end with a half mile still to run, started to commence a rally three wide at the three eighths marker passing the stablemate, shifted to the four path at the quarter pole still coming on, split foes five wide at the top of the stretch in the

mix for a small share but stalled at the furlong marker. IMPULSIVE BID veered out on the break, improved three deep down the backstretch to sit in midfield by the half, had a brief turn of foot narrowing the margin three wide midway through the bend, shifted widest in the six-path having a chance for a piece of the prize in upper stretch but yielded in the final furlong. SKAAL had runners on either side sitting in midfield down the backstretch, retreated steadily while under a ride showing little around the turn, trailed the group at the head of the lane and could only pass a straggler who was being wrapped up in the final furlong. TWO OUT HERO settled in behind runners near the inside off the pace, split rivals in mid-stretch, tipped out with aim on the leader and momentum, surged past late. WAR STRATEGY sped clear setting the pace from off the rail, extended the margin into the turn, weakened some and was collared late. WAR BOMBER (IRE) bumped a rival just after the start, switched out off the inside in the early going settling mid-pack racing two to three wide into the turn,

swung six wide leaving that bend, gained late. FOXTROTANNA was forwardly-placed up the backstretch racing outside a foe on the turn in pursuit of the loose leader, kept on late to preserve a minor award. SPEEDY BEAR was under a tight hold having a neck in front from the outside rival down the backside, maintained a slim lead on the fence around the oval with a host of challengers bearing down outside by the quarter pole, spurted clear in the two path straightening out for the drive when asked for more, did not switch leads through the lane, drifted out considerably even though under right-handed asking in the final furlong but still held on gamely for the frontrunning score at the wire. UNCAPTURED MOMENT was forwardly placed flanking the leader outside down the backstretch, was scrubbed on keeping the pacesetter honest two wide at the quarter pole between foes, had the three path still in thick of things straightening out for home, chased the winner in earnest down the stretch but could not get to the winner late. FRACEN MACHO stalked on the fence ahead of only the troubled starter, co-trailed between rivals part of the back trio in midturn, angled to the six path taking closer order at the top of the lane and closed in belatedly outside to win the show award while almost surging late for the place share as well. LAST AMERICAN EXIT had a good spot going comfortably on the rail behind the engaged duo, drafted behind the leaders into the turn, dropped back under a drive inside at the five sixteenths pole, skimmed the fence shaving the corner for the stretch drive and finished mildly inside of horses resurgent late for a minor share. HUMBER RIVER tracked the front pair outside another along the back straight, travelled three wide around the bend in pursuit of the frontrunner, moved to the four path in with a shot in upper stretch but evened out in the final furlong and could not get involved at the finish line. RAT PORTAGE travelled three deep in mid-division with a half mile still to run, edged up around horses four wide in the turn closing in making a bid outside three rivals by quarter pole, shifted to the five path for the stretch drive but flattened out by the furlong

marker. MAGIC POWER took an awkward step shortly after leaving the gate spotting the field leaving the chute and through the backstretch, tried to make a run outside horses three to four wide on the turn but with little success, was floated out widest in the seven-path turning for home and could not be a factor in the late running.

PEPPER BROOKS broke out at the start, recovered quickly to have a narrow advantage inside down the backstretch, went nose to nose inside contesting the front-end pace around the oval, edged away getting the better of the pesky outside speed foe by the furlong pole and cruised in comfortably in deep stretch for the gutsy win. HARD RIGHT was unhurried settling near the rear having only the very troubled gate rival beaten down the backstretch, started to close in midway through the bend, made a sharp swooping move four wide around horses at the quarter pole, swung out widest carrying that momentum into the stretch run, was no match for the winner in the last furlong but still ran on gamely to be a clear second best at the wire. IDEOLOGIST vied between runners in the early going, moved in battling outside going head-to-head for the lead around the turn, gave way fighting for the front end outside to the winner by the furlong pole and was caught in deep stretch losing the runners up share inside. HAPPY TO BE HERE made a right-hand turn bearing out at the start spotting the field many lengths down the backside, closed the gap considerably on the pack in the turn running, shifted to the six path between horses catching up to runners by upper stretch and had a strong late charge between foes settling only on the fringes but a solid effort nonetheless considering the horrific beginning. CONNECT THE EMPIRE was jostled between runners on the break stalked close to the rear three deep hard held keen fighting the rider's restraint down the backside, made no movement three wide throughout the oval and had little to offer five wide in the stretch running. CHIEF MCQ WIN had the fence settling in midfield by the half, made a brief move on the rail at the five sixteenths pole, scraped the paint in the mix for a share of the prize in upper stretch but yielded inside to rivals in the final eighth of a mile. APOLLOMAN prompted the early pace three deep, could not match strides with the front two inside while three wide at the three-furlong pole, angled out in the five-path turning for home but had little to offer in the stretch drive and folded by mid-stretch. SLIGHTLY NAUGHTY sat all alone watching the lead three runners along the back straight moving well in hand, ranged up on the outside going three to four wide through the bend, had the three path in with a chance at the top of the lane but came up empty in the late running.

GRANDE SOIREE had a good spot up fairly close to the lone speed leader down the backside with the field spread out by the half, began to lengthen stride coming with a run on the fence around the bend at the quarter pole when asked for more, angled out four wide outside off the lead duo turning for home, powered past while staying on the incorrect lead down the stretch responding well under left handed encouragement taking the lead at the seventy yard marker and won going away at the finish line. COTTON had a good spot tracking the pacesetter between rivals, closed the gap sharply coming to the leader by the five sixteenths pole, shifted out to the four-path taking control outside at the top of the stretch, kept trying through the lane but could not fend off the winner closing in resolutely outside in the final seventy yards. SPRINGER had the rail position tracking the frontrunner, was urged on but could not quicken more to counter the new leader in upper stretch but faded inside of horses in the last furlong. ROYAL QUALITY had the fence close to the back end, could not gain on the field throughout the turn taking the shortest way around, moved out to the five path for the stretch run and had late interest finding his best running down the stretch. TIME ZAPPER travelled in the middle of the pack with runners on both sides, picked up the bit three wide between rivals at the five sixteenths pole coming with an energetic rally, remained in the three path for the stretch run but could not sustain the momentum and stalled by the furlong marker. YOU AND ME BABY settled four deep outside foes in mid-division at the half mile marker, made a brief rally outside circling four foes wide at the five sixteenths pole, shifted to the five path at the top of the lane not switching leads in the stretch drive and finished up one paced never getting into contention. OUT N OUT DISGRACE was unhurried lagging well behind the group getting to the fence down the backside, still could see the field around the oval, angled out to the six-path straightening out for home and had a determined stretch run passing many rivals through the lane. THREE SONNY SIDEUP stalked not that far off from the tail end three deep along the backside, was going three to four wide outside horses spinning his wheels in the turn running making little headway, moved out to the six path in upper stretch but was not a factor in the late going. ABSOLUTE CHAIRMAN settled three deep keeping a close eye on the loose leader down the back straight, edged up slightly three wide around the bend, had the five path at the top of the stretch but yielded to others on either side in the final furlong. MISS D'S PRIDE was forwardly placed going four deep down the backside watching the front quartet, came under a drive two wide but was going the wrong way through the bend, had the three path turning for home but could not get involved. COHERENCE had the rail sitting in midfield, was hard ridden but regressed on the fence in the turn running and folded on the rail by mid-stretch. LIEUTENANT STAN settled close to the back between runners, made no progression while travelling three wide around the bend and stopped by the furlong marker.
