BACKSTREET EMMA stalked close to the tail end with rivals on both sides, inched up between foes going two wide through the bend, was scrubbed on for more looming boldly four to five wide at the top of the stretch, pounced on the inside rivals at the furlong pole seizing control and won going away impressively. WHISKEY OVER WINE prompted the pace outside initially, took back outside still keeping a close eye on the pacesetter midway down the backstretch, continued to have aim on the frontrunner between rivals throughout the oval, shifted out to the three path with horses on either side making a bid at the top of the lane, could not match strides with the winner outside by the furlong pole for the win but did dig in nearing the wire to get the nod outside in a tight finish for the runners up share. ALEATORIC was well placed nestled on the rail behind the pack setter down the back straightaway, sat poised on the fence on the fence waiting for instructions by the rider when to make a move, shaved the corner to be in the conversation battling up front by the quarter pole, was no match for the winner in the final furlong and finished up willingly just missing inside needing a picture to determine the second place runner at the finish line. PERFECT RING had a good spot on the outside tracking the front two in the second flight, travelled three wide on the bend closing at the three eighths pole outside, swung out widest in the five path unable to quicken with the leaders in upper stretch and finished up one paced in the last eighth of a mile holding for a minor placing. NO FRILLS settled on the fence near the rear, dropped back to last with the field bunching up some onthe turn at the half mile marker, had the two path passing an outside foe straightening up for home but lacked any further of a rally in the stretch drive. HOLY ANITA was unhurried travelling three deep at the back of the pack in the early stages, made no headway going outside of horses trying to circle three to four wide around the bend, had the four path for the stretch drive and could only manage to pass the tiring early frontrunner in the final furlong. BALLET BEAUTY narrowly had the advantage inside in the beginning, shook clear setting the pace by the three quarters marker still under a snug along the backside, remained up top with little pressure from the outside rivals while getting a slight breather slowing the tempo down a touch on the turn running, was collared

on both sides clinging up front in the two path at the head of the lane but had little left late folding between horses by the furlong marker.

MY BOY BRUCE had one runner beaten sitting on the outside near the rear in the beginning, took closer order going three deep down the back straight at the half, crept closer under a hustling ride three wide on the far turn, shifted to the five path in the hunt fighting with a few inside rivals for the front end straightening out for the drive and determinedly edged away between horses in deep stretch for the gutsy win. MONDAY MORNING stalked in the third flight inside another who happened to be the eventual winner on the first turn, had to be throttled down on the rail at the half with the field bunching up, shifted out two wide midway around the last bend looking for a clear path, moved between horses in the four oath in the thick of things turning for home, battled on gamely inside to the wire but was outkicked by the winner outside in the final seventy yards. BALBONI'S CREW chased the frontrunner two wide between foes on the initial bend, lost forward position getting shuffled back at the half, co-trailed inside another midway through the final bend, shifted out from the two path in upper stretch to have a clear run on the duelling pair four wide with a furlong remaining and had a strong late surge in deep stretch but was on the wrong end of a three way finish outside at the wire for the win. LOUIS THE CHAMP travelled three wide tracking the lone speed leader around the first turn and as well as down the backstretch, was roused picking up the bit by the five sixteenths pole, seized control outside getting a head in front a quarter mile from home, had the three path maintaining a slim lead between challengers in upper stretch but faded inside of horses at the sixteenth pole to settle on the fringes. MAYNARD'S SONG had the rail position watching the frontrunner with a couple of rivals to her outside, kept pace needing running room on the rail through the far turn, skimmed the fence in with a shot for a piece of the prize inside a host of runners by mid-stretch but could not find more late and yielded inside to rivals in rage final sixteenth of a mile. MIAH SAID had her neck bowed controlling the pace on the rail unopposed for the first half of this two turn race, slowed the tempo down around the far turn, offered little resistance when collared outside by the quarter pole, surrendered the lead by the top of the stretch between runners and wilted in the final furlong having little left for the late going. PROFESSOR RELOAD was allowed to settle into

stride galloping on the fence at the back of the pack in the early stages, narrowed the margins shifting outside at the half mile marker, travelled three to four wide on the turn but was spinning her wheels making little progress outside of horses on the final bend, angled to the five path for the drive to the wire but could not factor in the stretch running outside.

RAPID GREY switched outside the leader and was coaxed forward in pursuit of that one, stalked three wide into the turn, was asked at the top of the stretch, kept on and surged between runners late to prevail in a blanket finish. PIN BOY stalked from outside, went four wide on the turn, was ridden along past the five-sixteenths, came into upper stretch six wide, kept on late but just missed. HEAVEN'S CHAMPION settled at the back inside, took closer order on the turn, came out leaving that bend seeking room, found it four wide between foes in the stretch, bid for the lead seventy yards out but was outfinished. CRUCIAL TAUNT broke a step slowly, advanced between foes at the half, raced in behind the leaders and between the second flight coming to the top of the stretch, altered out seven wide for room in upper stretch, kept on to gain steadily late. CUT'EM LOOSE was urged clear from the start, set the pace from off the rail, yielded late. ALPHA KADIN broke outwardly, moved up inside tracking the leaders, saved ground on the turn, was within range coming into upper stretch but lacked the needed late kick. AGILE DANCER switched out off the inside in the early going, trailed into the turn then advance some on that bend racing outside foes, fanned seven wide into upper stretch, flattened out.

TRACY ARM travelled three deep outside a couple of runners tracking the lead duo, inched closer going three wide around the oval, pounced four wide at the quarter pole when called upon for more run, battled eye to eye with a stubborn inside leader with a furlong from the wire, edged away slightly by the sixteenth pole and prevailed in the stretch duel with runners bearing down on both sides still at the finish line. WINNING AGENDA was content initially shadowing the pacesetter outside, moved in at the three quarters pole going he d to head up top on the outside, continued to throw it down with the inside rival unrelenting around the turn, had the three path between horses finally getting the better of the inside speed rival straightening out for the drive, gamely braced for the new challenge outs by the winner at the furlong pole,gave way grudgingly with a sixteenth to go but then found something more and tried to counter inside late but was denied and settled for second best at the wire. CLASSIC DISCOVERY was situated outside another having one runner beaten down the back straight, travelled two wide between rivals part of the tail end trio through the turn,, started to make a rally three wide at the three eighths marker, angled out to the five path very much in the mix turning for home, was gaining steadily on the embattled twosome with a furlong from the finish line but simply ran out of ground and came up just shy at the wire outside. SUVARI (FR) settled in kid-division with horses on either side, kept pace just off the dueling pair rating kindly between foes around the bend, shifted to the three path in upper stretch in with a chance for a small share of the prize but could only run on mildly in the final stages unable to threaten the top three late while holding at the wire for a minor placing in the end. SPUN FOR FLATTER had a good set up tucked in on the fence watching the engaged duo, scraped paint in the mix at the five sixteenths pole, had to shift out two wide losing her path

with a quarter mile to go and failed to menance, lacking a rally between horses in the final eighth of a mile. KISS ME BABY tossed its head soon after the break seeing the field down the backside, travelled three wide at the half mile marker with the field quite compact while in the back trio on the turn, shifted to the four oath at the head of the Kane but could only manage to pass a couple of weary rivals in the stretch running. MRS. G settled on the inside close to the back end having only one runner beaten down the backside, saved ground through the bend being part of the rear three in the turn running, had the two path at the head of the lane, shifted out abruptly six wide wanting clear run at the three sixteenths pole but had little to show for unable to offer a finishing kick in the final furlong. CANDY COATED was hard held loose up top on the rail in the beginning, had company outside forcing the pace by the three quarters pole,duelled inside throughout the turn, had the two path between foes in upper stretch still in the heat of battle up front, moved to the rail at the quarter pole still fighting on inside but had little left late and folded on the fence with a furlong remaining.

MALIBU BETTY settled mid-pack shifting in racing three wide into the turn, moved out swinging seven deep into upper stretch, gained steadily outside but missed second. SYMPATICO stalked from outside going three then four wide on the turn, made a brief bid past the quarter pole, was carried out by the eventual winner in mid-stretch, flattened out late. READY TO COLLECT pressed the pace on the rail under a good hold early on, darted up the fence taking over control by the quarter pole getting a head in front still well in hand, moved out two wide having lots left increasing the advantage by the furlong marker and comfortably cruised in for the score in deep stretch. BREEZERO had the rail position keeping tabs on the contesting duo down the backstretch, rallied with a sharp turn of foot on the fence lengthening stride smartly midway around the bend, shifted out to the two path posing the main threat in upper stretch but could only chase the winner home in vain while besting the rest for the secondary share. GAROFOLI had a neck in front on the outside down the backstretch, had no answer two wide between foes unable to match strides when the winner surged up the rail seizing command at the quarter pole, shifted to the three path at the head of the lane, kept fighting on for a share through the drive and finished up willingly being a clear third while just getting out battled late inside for the place award. URBAN LEGEND was on the outside in mid-pack while going four deep, came under a ride three wide at the three eighths pole but could not keep up to the lead trio through the turn, angled out to the four path in upper stretch and finished up evenly to be a fringe player well back of the front three when crossing the finish line. YODDHA had the three path between rivals while sitting in midfield, offered a brief run circling around horses three wide while in the conversation arguing for the lead midway around the turn, moved out widest in the five path giving way fighting on the front end at the top of the stretch and faded even further having little left in reserve in the final furlong. INDY ONE settled in midfield with runners on both sides down the backstretch, dropped back unable to

quicken with outside foes who were commencing a rally at the seven sixteenths marker, had little to offer two wide going around the turn, hugged the rail taking the corner, failed to menace in the stretch run and was checked coming up inside another nearing the wire. SILENT RESERVE was void of early foot seeing the field while travelling just off the fence down the backside, made little impact running three wide around the oval, moved out to the four path for the stretch drive but could not get involved.

SPEEDY FREEZE settled off the pace shifting in racing last but one up the backstretch, advanced midway on the turn racing in behind runners coming into upper stretch, shifted out seven wide in mid-stretch, kept on rallying outside to drive past late. GRADE A moved up racing between foes in the second flight, was a bit keen between runners at the five-eighths fighting restraint, went three wide on the turn moving out for room in upper stretch, bid between foes late but was outfinished. VEERY was quick to take the lead, set the pace from off the rail, drifted out in late stretch and was outfinished. WAR SIGNAL got away well but was soon overtaken, shadowed the pacesetter from up close and to the outside going three wide on the turn, steadied in late stretch as that rival came out in front. NANTUCKETS DAY dropped back trail from off the inside, swung seven to eight wide into upper stretch and passed tired rivals. PURR FACTOR steadied slightly at the start, moved up outside to race mid-pack four wide into the turn, was asked by the five-sixteenths, swung seven wide into upper stretch, faded thereafter. ROMANTICA tracked inside racing up close saving ground, came up empty. DELTA FORCE had the rail position keeping a close eye on the lone speed pacesetter, rated kindly still drafting behind the leader down the back

straightaway, shifted out coming with a rally while yet to be set down at the quarter pole between foes, bid three wide posing the main opposition straightening out for the drive to the wire and under a vigorous ride with left handed urging pulled away for the win in deep stretch outside. SEMPER LIBER broke in at the start, was loose up top two wide taking the field around the first turn, controlled the pace slowing things down quite a bit down the backstretch, continued on up top nudged along with little pressure applied by outside foes through the second bend, was confronted outside by the eventual winner taking the final corner, fought on stubbornly down the lane but conceded the win inside in the final seventy yards. SILVER RALEIGH settled in mid-division outside but having to go four wide to do so early on, improved outside down the backstretch to sit in the second flight watching the lead duo by the half, kept pace with the leader three wide around the final bend,, shifted out to the five path in the mix at the top of the stretch, ran on well having good late energy through the lane but could only finish up a clear but distant third behind the front duo who had it to themselves in the last furlong. GO GO ALEXANDER was brushed by an outside foe on the break, had the fence sitting in mid-pack around the first turn as well as down the back straightaway, waited for the cue to go two wide around the last turn, had a chance for a piece of the prize getting back to the rail in upper stretch and ran on mildly inside another to get up in deep stretch for a minor award. BELIEVEIN tracked the frontrunner three wide initially, edged up to hound the pace outside running along the backside, chased the leader between rivals two wide in the far turn at the quarter pole, had the four path at the head of the lane, battled for a minor share only while two wide outside another a furlong from home but weakened late. FILM ACADEMY was checked very briefly between foes close to the tail end entering the first turn, had no change in position along the backstretch, was in tight having no room with rivals on both sides on the final turn at the quarter pole, drifted out from the two path at the head of the lane making contact with the outside foe on a few occasions around the furlong pole and could not get to contention in the late running while still getting out. SLUGGERNAUT was away sluggishly settling into stride near the rear two wide on the first bend, made no movement with the pace slowing down considerably along the backside, bobbled two wide possibly catching a heel of the rival in front at the five sixteenths pole, shaved the corner turning for home but had no rally inside horses down the lane while under very little coaxing in the final eighth of a mile. HOT POTATO had a slow start then was taken hold of with outside rivals bearing in soon after leaving the gate having only one runner beaten in the beginning, advanced up the rail by the half, waited on the fence for running room inside many runners along the last bend, shifted out to the three path for the drive to the wire but when clear failed to fire in the final furlong. HOLY RAMBO veered sharply inwards on the break, settled between runners in midfield in the early stages of this two turn event, was scrubbed on for more but could not gain on horses going three wide on the last bend, had the four path down the lane, was bumped a couple of times by the inside foe drifting out a leaving the furlong pole and could not get into contention in the late going. WAITINGFORAHOLIDAY stalked close to the back while going three wide around the first turn, regressed slightly outside of runners along the back straight, showed little throughout the second bend while trying to go around rivals four wide, shifted to the five path in upper stretch but had no finish to give in the stretch running.
