CIUNAS settled into a good rhythm outside another in mid-pack, edged up slightly outside down the backstretch tracking the engaged duo by the half, was roused for more with the leader slipping away briefly at the three eighths pole, closed in measuring the pacesetter on the far turn, pounced three wide on the outside at the head of the lane and had plenty to give, drawing off with authority when asked for more at the furlong pole. DEWOLF was well placed on the outside keeping a close eye on the frontrunner, moved in down the backside to force the issue outside at the half, opened up comfortably at the three furlong pole, rolled along unopposed around the last oval, had the two path clinging up front with the winner closing in at the head of the lane, was no match by the eighth pole but still ran strongly to easily best the rest for the runners up share. PALACE VIEW (IRE) had the rail sharing the rear in the early stages, lagged behind the group down the backstretch as well as through the far turn, swung out widest in the six path in upper stretch and finished up strongly finding his best stride late to be a clear but non-threatening third at the wire. CALL ME SUE co-trailed on the outside going three wide on the initial bend, took closer order outside down the backstretch by the half, started to pick up the bit four wide circling a couple of challengers at the five sixteenths pole, shifted to the five path turning for home, stayed on the incorrect lead throughout the drive and finished up evenly between foes for a minor placing in the end. UNBRIDLED WEATHER was eager on the rail pulling at the rider tracking the frontrunner inside another on the first bend, had the fence in the second flight along the back straight with the eventual winner to his outside, shifted out at the five sixteenths pole off a tiring rival coming with a good rally, moved to the two path getting into third place by mid-stretch but could not sustain the run and flattened out in the final seventy yards. STRATUS was brushed on the inside on the break, had the rail position sitting in midfield early on, dropped back a touch at the half, made no headway between horses through the last turn, shifted to the three path for the drive but could only manage to pass the leg weary early leader in mid-stretch. CLASSIC DANCER broke out at the start, cleared crossing over getting to the rail loose up top into the first turn, had company outside by the half mile marker, gave way unable to keep up to the new leader with three furlongs from home, was under a drive trying to hold position on the fence in the final bend and ran out of gas due to his early efforts

folding inside runners at the furlong marker.

RED PHARAOH broke out to begin, recovered to press the issue outside down the backstretch, continued outside hounding the pacesetter around the oval, moved in three wide at the top of the lane seizing control, did not switch leads in the stretch run, dug in determinedly having rivals bearing down on either side with a sixteenth to go and prevailed at the wire for the gutsy win. HARPER CITY had the fence keeping tabs on the leader, was urged to go after the front duo two wide at the quarter pole, moved out to the four path in the thick of things in upper stretch, finished gradually outside but could not get to the winner late and got up for the place share timing the nod perfectly at the wire. DISSECTOLOGIST travelled in the third flight isolated on the rail, opted to wait on the turn taking the shortest way around behind horses, darted through shaving the corner to be in the mix at the top of the stretch, but needed more late unable to threaten the winner in dep stretch and just getting nabbed outside for the place share at the finish line outside. BANKER'S HOURS broke in at the start, shared the rear inside another with a half mile still to run, took the short way on the turn advancing inside a couple of horses at the five sixteenths

pole, angled to the two path for the stretch run and finished up with good late energy to settle on the fringes in the end. GRAN SPIRITED was bumped by the outside foe at the start, had the rail in mid-division along the backside, kept pace shift out two wide in midturn and ran on one paced in the stretch battling for a minor share between foe while never switching leads throughout. BIG BABY HENRY broke inwards on the break, settled into stride outside in the middle of the pack along the back straight, offered a brief run three wide at the quarter pole closing in, swung out widest in the six path in contention for a piece of the prize at the top of the lane but stalled outside foes in the last eighth. BOLD RELOAD broke in at the start, recouped to have a narrow advantage inside down the backstretch, inched away increasing the lead at the half, offered no resistance when collared outside on the turn at the quarter pole and yielded between foes by the sixteenth pole. JAMIESTA was in tight between horses on the break, co-trailed outside at the half, could see the field while travelling three wide around the bend, angled to the four path straightening out for home and could only pass tired rivals in the drive to the finish line. AWE INSPIRED had a good spot tracking the duo outside, was hard ridden two wide on the turn chasing the leaders in vain, angled to the three path for the derive to the wire but flattened out between horses in the final furlong. SNOOKERED stalked three deep on the outside of two others down the backstretch, made little impact between horses on the turn, was relegated to the rear with a quarter mile from home and could not factor in the stretch running.

KEEPMYPOWDERDRY moved soon to a narrow lead, set the pace inside on or just off the rail facing increased pressure early up the backstretch, edged away willingly past the five-sixteenths, was asked for run past the quarter pole coming to the top of the stretch and kicked clear turning into upper stretch, held sway while kept to task. CRYSTAL PEARL settled in behind the leading trio to track from inside saving ground, was asked for more past the five-sixteenths, tipped out at the top of the stretch, drifted out in mid-stretch under an all-out drive, closed the gap but was only second best. TORONTO CITY settled at the rear inside saving ground, was encouraged five-sixteenths from home still saving ground, was no match for the top pair but best of the rest. BEYOND ADVERSITY was forwardly-placed stalking outside three to four deep just outside and off the lead, applied a bit more pressure passing the five-eighths, was encouraged along at the five-sixteenths, failed to rally. SUPER TOM broke a step slowly, settled outside at the rear, was ridden along passing the half mile marker, edged closer outside foes three to four deep on the far turn, came into upper stretch five wide and ran on. PROUD PAINTER broke a bit awkwardly but was still away well, pressed the eventual winner from between foes, was under urging by the seven-sixteenths but had no late response and faded in the lane. ERIE SHORES stalked outside a foe mid-division two to three wide up the backstretch, was ridden three furlongs out, shifted in while dropping back and faded thereafter.

CATTRALL broke inwards but was quickly corrected at the start, assumed command in hand up top in the early stages, had the rail moving well within herself dictating the pace around the oval, opened up when called upon for more at the furlong more, did not switch leads throughout the drive and still held safe for the frontrunning score at the wire. BOUNCE BACK was brushed by the outside foe on the break, settled in the four path sitting in mid-division fighting the riders restraint down the backside, ranged up three wide narrowing the gap around the bend, angled to the five path very much in the mix at the top of the lengthy lane and had a solid late charge in the final eighth of a mile but just could not get to the winner at the finish line. ANY OSCAR sat in the middle of the pack while five deep outside foes, kept pace and position while travelling four wide around the bend, moved out to the seven-path straightening out foe the stretch drive, kept grinding away and finished up willingly outside in the late going getting up for the show money. WORLDLY CHARM trailed the tightly bunched group at the five eighths pole along the backside, saved ground seeing the field through the bend, swung out widest in the nine-path gathering momentum turning for home and stormed on home with an impressive late turn of foot in the final eighth of amile to get up outside at

the wire to be a fringe player. HOPE IS A BREEZE chased the frontrunner outside down the back straight, continued to go after the leader actually getting on even terms on the outside with five sixteenths from the finish, could not keep up to the pacesetting winner inside midway down the lane and faded inside horses in deep stretch just getting picked up outside losing a minor placing. KARAT GOLD sat five deep close to the back end in the early stages, tried to circle around runners going four wide on the bend but making little headway, moved to the seven path at the head of the lane and showed some late interest passing some tiring foes in the final furlong. MATOAKA was forwardly placed being situated between horses in the three path in midfield, closed the gap outside another on the turn watching the contesting pair, battled for the show award inside at the top of the stretch but could not continue the run and stalled by the furlong marker. SUNDAY FINERY settled in the three-path close to the tail end inside two others rivals midway along the backstretch, improved for a brief moment two wide on the turn taking closer order at the three eighths pole, shifted to the four path in upper stretch but could not get into contention between runners in the late going. FROM TIME TO TIME stalked close to the back with runners on either side, came under a drive going three wide on the turn making little progression, moved to the five path for the stretch run but lacked a rally between foes in the drive. WINNING JEWEL broke out at the start, improved on the fence to actually for the pace inside at the five eighths pole, had to be checked in tight getting shuffled back with many outside rivals bearing in heading into the turn, travelled in mid-pack around the bend, had the fence hear the rear at the top of the stretch and could not get involved. CRAZY BUSY (JPN) was content sitting just off the leader inside down the backstretch, sat poised on the rail through the turn watching the front dup slug it out, skimmed the fence well within striking distance turning for home but came up empty inside of horses in the stretch drive.

CELEBRITY WARRIOR (IRE) was coaxed to a forward position early stalking the leader from outside three to four wide, applied mild pressure early up the backstretch then settled back off the leader stalking, edged nearer willingly into the far turn, took a narrow lead past the quarter pole, was asked at the three-sixteenths, drew clear in mid-stretch, held sway under steady handling. DYNA appeared to exchange incidental contact at the start, moved forward stalking between foes in the second flight through the early going racing two to three wide, took closer order heading to the far turn racing just off the rail, was encouraged along past the five-sixteenths, came out a bit for the drive now under stronger urging with aim on the leader, could make no headway in the lane but was second best. ASHLEE B brushed lightly with the outside rival at the break, tucked in settling toward the rear inside saving ground, bided time still racing well back into the far turn, moved out late on that bend swinging out and pushing through between foes, swung eight wide into upper stretch, gained steadily but too little too late. LAPIN DE PLAGE was urged to the lead, set the pace inside on or just off the rail, faced moderate pressure early up the backstretch and increased pressure early on the far turn, was ridden along past the five-sixteenths, headed leaving the far turn, kept on then weakened the final furlong. DE LA RENTA had the four-path part of the early mix in the beginning, tracked the embattled trio while outside another having a nice set up in the turn running, started to come with a run four to five wide on the turn at the five sixteenths pole, could not match strides with the outside rival who had a full head of steam outside at the top of the lane taking control, never wavered in the drive, laid in even under left handed encouragement while still stubbornly chasing the leader at the furlong pole, the rider put away the crop in the last sixteenth of a mile and under a vigorous hand rdie kept a straight path in deep strech to get up right at the finish line outside for the gutsy victory. SPEAKER'S SPEECH had a slow start on the break, spotted the field by many while being roused by the rider to stay interested, on a good note sat well behind a rapid pace duel by the rest of the competitors down the backstretch, made a premature rally when scrubbed for more at the half mile marker, boldly swooped around the entire field going five to six wide on the turn at the three eighths marker, sat widest in the six path straightening out for home taking control drifting in when clearing off up top by the quarter marker, was shortening stride looking for the wire just off the fence with a sixteenth remaining under a busy ride but could not sustain the lengthy rally in the end getting nailed right at the finish line for the win outside. QUIPSTER pressed the pace on the rail down the backstretch, was the first to drop out of the battle for the front inside two others midway around the bend, rallied making a rebid three wide at the quarter pole in the mix again at the top of the lane and ran on mildly to clearly capture the show money at the wire. HUMBLE AND KIND hopped then bobbled coming down on the break, vied between runners down the backside, continued to battle with rivals outside throughout the turn, disposed on the early speed foes loose up top briefly at the five sixteenths pole braced for the oncoming closing in runners outside at the head of the lane but offered no resistance due to being softened up in the beginning and faded in the final

sixteenth of a mile settling on the fringes. UNCLE DODO had the two path inside another watching the contesting threesome, continued to have a good position on the outside this time early in the turn watching the front three still fighting it out, moved to the four path with the field clustered across the course turning for home but could not find more for the stretch drive and unable to be a factor in the late stages. THROUGH THE YEARS (IRE) travelled five deep on the outside part off the early scrum for the front end down the backside, still had an overland route fighting three wide on the turn for the top spot, gave way arguing for the lead with five sixteenths left to run and emptied out in the two path by upper stretch.

SOUPED UP stalked or pressed from just off and outside the pacesetter, raced two to three wide on the turn edging closer leaving that bend and asked for more, drew even past the furlong marker dueling for the lead outside the pacesetter, dug in late and prevailed. WESTERN WHIRL went to the fore to set the pace just off the inside, edged just clear briefly at the seven-sixteenths but was soon under more pressure from the outside rival, put to urging coming past the quarter pole, dueled from mid-stretch still in an all-out battle while coming out a bit, was ultimately denied in a head-bobbing finish. NOTORIOUS GANGSTER broke a half-step slowly, tucked in behind runners just after the start, bumped a foe after the opening furlong, moved up in pursuit outside mid-pack, was forced about four then five wide through the turn and encouraged along past the five-sixteenths, was asked for more leaving the bend, kept on in the stretch but needed more late. ITS BOURBON THIRTY shifted in early settling inside and dropping back off the leaders heading the turn, was patiently handled racing just off the fence through that bend, came out six then eight wide in mid-stretch, gained well outside but too late. POULIN IN O T was just a bit reluctant to load, broke a half-step slowly then was urged forward between runners, tracked in behind along the inside into and on the turn, waited briefly past the quarter pole, was asked in upper- to mid-stretch as room along the rail presented itself but could only run on evenly. AWESOME

BOURBON switched out a bit in the early going, was bumped at the five- and one-half, chased from between foes up the backstretch and on the turn, came past the quarter pole four wide and under urging, lacked the needed late kick. BAXLEY was outsprinted early, switched out for the turn advancing outside foes coming five to six wide past the quarter pole under urging and within range but could not sustain the effort.

PROCTOR STREET was unhurried sharing the rear finding her feet inside around the first turn, continued to bide her time travelling smoothly down the backstretch, inched up on the fence looking for a seam at the quarter pole ready to make a move, rallied splitting runners getting a seam three wide in upper stretch, was finally set down at the eighth pole reaching for more ground sharply coming to the lead duo and finished up outside determinedly getting the nod at the wire for the stretch running tally. MELONI bobbled into a rival at the start spotting the field several lengths, was unhurried after this incident settling at the rear, advanced outside a foe three wide early on the turn, willingly edged closer in behind runners on that bend bidding time, angled seven wide coming to the top of the stretch and was asked for run, rallied strongly while drifting in having taken the lead past the three-sixteenths, drew clear and was kept to the task late. ROYAL FOXTROT tracked

the pace from inside a rival, saved ground on the turn, came out three wide leaving that bend moving out four wide just after and under a drive, kept on late to get up for second over MRS D, who got away well, pressed the pace from the outside well in hand, took the lead about the five-sixteenths, was asked for run at the top of the stretch, was no match for the winner and lost place late. SARAYU settled into stride dropping back off the leading quartet, stalked from outside foes three to four wide on the turn, came into upper stretch five to six deep under a ride, altered outside the drifting leader near the furlong grounds, kept on late to gain mildly. EPIC AFFAIR was bumped by the inside then outside foes at the start, steadily moved forward inside up the backstretch but steadied slightly at the nine-sixteenths, continued about mid-division through the turn saving ground, ran on evenly in the lane. LUSTER was away alertly arguing up top on the rail in the beginning, was reined back off the rapid pace under the wire for the first time, moved well in hand drafting on the fence keeping a close eye on the front runner on the first turn, sat poised travelling smoothly waiting for the cue to go by the rider down the backstretch, nudged along being called upon for more shifting out two wide picking up the bit at the three furlong pole, sauntered four wide taking the lead with the jockey statuesque in the saddle leaving the quarter pole, had the three path pulling away with a furlong to go with little asking, was tapped once on the right shoulder to keep interested with no rivals around in the late going and increased the winning margin while geared down crossing the finish line for the dominant win. MILITARY TIME settled in mid-division going three wide on the first bend, made little headway along the backside, offered a strong move circling horses boldly four to five wide around the far turn, posed the only opposition to the leader in upper stretch having the five path but was no match by the furlong pole, still finished up solidly and easily bested the rest for the runners up share at the wire. FIRE AND WINE was on a mission making his

intentions known early setting a brisk pace on top, continued up front slowing the pace down somewhat but still lively for the half, was under a drive being swarmed by multiple outside runners at the quarter pole, surrendered the front to the overpowering winner by the top of the lane but dug in gamely inside foes trying to hold for a piece of the prize in deep stretch and lasted at the wire for the show award inside. DIXIE LAW was brushed on the outside on the start, settled between runners having the eventual winner to his inside part of the tracking quartet watching the loose leader around the first corner, stalked in the third flight outside down the backstretch, came under a busy ride three wide midway on the last turn but was getting passed on both sides by foes making a rally, had to be checked in tight surroundings at the quarter pole, got back into gear seven wide straightening out for home and finished with intent outside two others almost getting up in the shadow of the wire for the third place share. DON IQUE broke inwards on the break and was quickly corrected, had the fence under a snug hold near the rear, co-trailed on the inside down the back straightaway, was relegated to the back end with three furlongs still to run, rallied three wide at the quarter pole looking for a seam with the field tightly bunched, had clear run in the five path at the top of the lane and finished up gradually with runners on both sides but was on the wrong end of a tight three way finish for the third place share at the wire. BOND MARKET hopped then veered out on the break, lagged at the tail end going four wide around the first turn, shared the rear outside down the backstretch, had a sharp turn of foot darting between foes under a hustling ride three wide at the three eighths marker to be in contention four wide with a quarter mile from the prize, had a chance for a share down the lane but could not sustain the rally and stalled inside rivals at the sixteenth pole. IMYOURMEDICINEMAN was hard held near the rear in the early going while going three wide between foes on the first bend, only had a couple of runners beaten with a half mile remaining, was roused for more two wide at the three furlong pole commencing a run, had to be checked dropping back at the five sixteenths marker losing all its run, trailed by the quarter pole being checked again, swung out widest in the eight path in upper stretch and showed some gumption passing some runners down the lane. BRACHETTO travelled three wide ahead of only one runner in the first bend, stalked three deep making little change down the backstretch, took the overland route going four to five wide on the last bend but was going in the wrong direction by the five sixteenths pole, was in tight between foes in the six path turning for home and failed to fire in the stretch drive. HIGHWAYTOTHEMOON settled inside foes in midfield for the first half of this two-turn event, made a brief run improving on the fence smartly from the three eighths pole to the quarter marker, was in tight jostled between horses four wide in upper stretch and wilted in the last eighth of a mile. BAAEED ALYNNA had the rail sitting close to the back end initially, made little progression for position but did close the gap down the backstretch by the half mile marker, had a brief spurt advancing smartly at the five sixteenths pole, had to be steadied on the rail losing all its momentum and could not get back into gear for the stretch run being wrapped up running on the wrong lead in the two path by the furlong marker. MAGICAL FACTOR travelled three wide watching the lead pair, still was forwardly positioned in the three path along the backstretch keeping a close eye on the lead duo along the back straight, closed the gap three wide making a bid at the quarter pole but had little left for the stretch drive and folded between horses in the two path by mid-stretch. VERY SPECIAL tracked the lone speed outside in the early going, chased the pacesetter between foe down the backside, had to be hard ridden just trying to hold forward position on the final bend at the three eighths pole, was engulfed by outside runners drifting inwards to the rail at the quarter pole and emptied out on the fence by the furlong marker.

GAS ME UP broke out a bit, settled off the leaders racing between foes on the first turn, inched closer on the far turn still off the inside in about the three path, moved out further turning into upper stretch and was set down for the drive, was carried out a bit and continued to drift out through mid- to late-stretch under stout left-handed urging, kept on grinding away and just got the nod. PIPER'S FACTOR sped clear setting the tempo from well off the inside heading into the first turn, shifted in a bit but still kept removed from the rail and with a clear advantage heading to the far turn, came out a bit in upper stretch and was put to urging, fought on with challengers well inside and out down to the wire but just missed. IRISH ACES was reserved off the pace early racing inside foes but off the rail, advanced past a tiring rival on the far turn moving out while continuing to gain leaving that bend, came into upper stretch five wide then altered in nearer the fence to avoid the drifting leader, kept on strongly inside making a bid past the sixteenth pole but just missed in a head-bobbing finish. DECADENT DANISH broke outwards at the start, had a good spot drafting behind the frontrunner on the first turn, tracked inside down the backstretch, shifted out two wide coming with a rally midway on the last turn, dueled stubbornly between foes in the final furlong and was tenacious with runners on either side surging in deep stretch just getting up at the wire in a tight three way win picture. PRINCE ALMASTY had a slim lead on the rail into the first turn, rolled along loose up top down the backside, continued to freewheel well rated up top on the final bend, had more spurting away two wide at the top of the

lane, kept fighting to the very end but just got nabbed right at the wire outside for the win. BIG SCREEN BOSS vied between foes in the beginning, took back watching the lead three rivals down the backside moving comfortably, began to inch up on the lead threesome at the quarter pole to be in the hunt straightening out for the drive and was coming on late, gaining on the front pair in deep stretch but did not have enough to get there in time at the finish line. CALL ME BOND stalked close to the back going three wide on the first bend, made no progression along the backside, could not get into gear going three wide on the final turn, shifted to the four path in with a chance for a piece of the prize turning for home, drifted inwards in the final furlong and got up late for a minor placing. AWESOME BEAT pressed the pace three wide early on, tracked the pacesetter outside down the backstretch, rallied, closing in on the far turn making a bid three wide at the quarter marker, loomed in the four path at the head of the lane but flattened out at the furlong marker. LONNY'S GAMBLE settled close to the back going two wide on the first of two turns, made no headway taking the shortest route around the last bend, skimmed the fence at the tip of the stretch, lacked running room in upper stretch, shifted out off rivals four wide at the furlong pole and had good late energy closing up a considerable amount of ground late. LITTLE THONIO was bumped by the inside foe on the break, settled on the rail in mid-division with an outside foe, came under a drive on the rail at the five sixteenth pole offering little response around the far turn, hugged the rail in upper stretch and failed to menace lacking a rally in the stretch drive. DEPUTY CURLIN stalked in tandem with an outside foe in the early stages, travelled in the two path keeping pace on the last bend, shifted to the three path turning for home, stayed on the wrong lead shortening stride at the furlong pole and could not get involved late. MASTERFUL MOMENT shared the rear on the inside, stalked close to the back down the backside, trailed the field at the three eighths pole and could not factor in the three-path driving to the finish line. THOR'S CAUSE co-trailed on the outside with another, sat alone seeing the field down the backstretch, shifted to the four path turning for home and came up empty in the stretch running.

ADIR was forwardly-positioned outside a foe stalking, advanced heading into the far turn, took a brief lead outside the five-sixteenths, steadied slightly at the top of the stretch outside the three-sixteenths, tipped out and was set down, gained steadily to re-bid at the sixteenth pole and edge clear. BEACH FACTOR settled off the pace shifting in and saving ground early, advanced steadily heading into the far turn, checked at the five-sixteenths, was blocked for a while after then checked again behind the faltering pacesetter near the quarter pole, got through along the rail and was urged along, advanced inside then tipped out in mid-stretch and was gaining but too late while just getting up for second. PADDY HOLIDAY was well-positioned shifting in and racing close up but off the early pace, took back and switched out leaving the first turn, settled near mid-pack, moved out a bit further and advanced rapidly four to five wide on the far turn taking the lead past the five-sixteenths and shifting to the rail leaving that bend with a clear advantage, lacked the needed late kick and lost place late. FORESTERS LASTLOVE was forced in a bit at the start, stalked from outside with good positioning just off the nearest pursuers of the pacesetter, advanced between foes nearing the quarter pole to be in contention, came into upper stretch four then five wide, weakened in the lane. PROUDLY CANADIAN settled off the pace outside mostly three to four wide in the early going, advanced outside foes on the far turn but was forced out five then six wide coming into upper stretch seven to eight deep, fought on outside foes for the minor awards but narrowly missed fourth. MUY GRACIAS settled off the pace outside about three wide early, steadily advanced between foes into and on the far turn three then four wide, evened out in the lane. MANN COURT broke awkwardly, raced well off the pace near the inside, fanned eight wide advancing outside foes leaving the far turn, shifted in a bit through the stretch and improved position. KEYNOTE SPEAKER broke a step slowly and steadied as a rival came out, tucked in nearer the rail trailing unhurriedly early, swung six wide into upper stretch, was guided out a bit further in mid-stretch, failed to menace.
