INSTANT RESPONSE had a head in front on the inside leaving the chute, was confidently reined back letting the outside foe take the lead by the half, shifted out two wide resurgent outside at the quarter marker, loomed boldly in the four path in upper stretch, powered past at the eighth pole and won going away. IMPERIAL WAR broke in at the break, tracked between foes in the beginning, got a neck in front while in hand by the half mile pole, opened up smartly on the turn getting to the fence by the three eighths marker, was allowed to drift out to the three path in upper stretch, had no answer when collared by the winner with a furlong from the prize and safely held at the wire being second best on this day. LAKE COMO HEIST was bumped outside on the start, tracked the engaged duo sitting between runners midway down the backside, shifted out three wide coming on at the quarter pole with runners on either side, angled to the five path in the mix at the top of the stretch and ran on willingly getting up late to be a non-threatening third at the finish line. FULL STAR broke in at the start, trailed the very compact group having to be throttled down behind runners at the nine sixteenths pole, saved ground inching up around the oval, had the two-path straightening out for home and finished up mildly on the rail in the last furlong to settle on the fringes. ASHUKA was under a hustling ride outside through the chute, travelled four deep outside a few runners angling in making contact with the inside rival nearing the half mile pole being knocked off stride briefly, travelled three wide on the turn but was being pushed out further to the four path by inside foes at the quarter pole, swung out widest six wide turning for home but could only run on one paced down the lane. OCEANOGRAPHY edged up on the inside to sit on the rail in midfield by the half mile marker, dropped back unable to quicken with outside rivals making a rally at the three furlong pole, shifted to the three path for the stretch drive but had little to offer fading by the furlong pole inside foes. SMARTER STILL was bumped by the outside foe on the break, had tight quarters eventually being checked in the three-path trying to hold for forward position with the outside rival angling coming up to the half, lagged behind the group going three wide around the bend and could not factor in the stretch running.

COUNTRYBOYSURVIVE had a good position isolated watching the lead trio early on, pulled the rider in the three path with the pace tempo slowing down considerably into the backstretch to have a brief lead outside at the five eighths pole, settled into a good rhythm relinquishing the front end tracking the new leader outside at the half, was forced to move between horses getting the lead a quarter mile from home and while in the three path inb the stretch drive won going away impressively at the finish line. PROUD RONIN was unhurried trailing in the early stages settling into stride, took the short way around the final bend making little progress, scraped paint taking the corner coming with a run, had a sharp turn of foot inside horses at the eighth pole but was no match for the winner and finished up well enough to be easily second best at the wire. EVER DANGEROUS was in the conversation inside two others dueling up top on the first bend, drafted on the rail taken another hold off with the pace slowing down early in the backstretch, sat poised on the rail waiting for the cue on the second turn, shifted to the three path turning for home and closed in belatedly getting up for the show award late. AMERICAN DECISION broke in at the start, was hard ridden being tapped on continuously on the right shoulder by the jockey intent on getting the lead, advanced five wide outside two others on the first turn getting the sole lead clearing and crossing over to the rail, was then taken a hold of slowing the pace down stacking up the field heading into the backstretch briefly relegated to the second place share at the five eighths pole inside, resurged taking control again by the half, was allowed to drift out at the seven sixteenths pole with the rider looking numerous times inside on the turn having a slim lead with an outside foe bearing down, surrendered the top spot to the winner outside at the head of the lane and wilted between others by the sixteenth pole. COMPTON was crowded on the break being taken up for a moment, stalked near the rear on the outside on the first turn, improved slightly going four deep down the backstretch, had a good rally circling three to four wide outside foes on the second bend making a bid for the lead outside by the quarter marker, could not sustain the run in mid-stretch though and flattened out at the sixteenth pole. YORKTON'S HONOUR vied between horses in the four path up front going into the initial bend,

tracked between runners under a hard hold along the backside being in the second flight watching the lead duo by the half, was nudged on for more but could not hold position with foes making a move on either side at the midpoint of the far turn and came up empty four wide in upper stretch.

GONE WITH DUWYN emerged from the pack assuming command leaving the chute setting a soft pace early on, rolled along unopposed at the half, moved strongly opening up from his closest perusers through the turn and under a well rationed out ride had plenty left in the tank winning easily when crossing the finish line for the gate to wire score. GLASWEIGIAN had runners on either side in the second flight behind the frontrunner down the backstretch, continued on between foes chasing determinedly but making little progression on the frontrunner on the turn, kept on trying through the stretch but the winner just had too much by the furlong marker and still finished up gamely between foes in the late going securing the runners up share. TWENTYTWO SOLES had the rail position keeping a close eye on the leader with two outside rivals as well, took the shortest route around the turn but could not close the gap on the pacesetter around the oval, battled inside for the place share with a furlong to go with the winner long gone and was just outkicked outside in the late going taking the show money instead at the finish line. NEXT PITCH had only one runner beaten down the backside who happened to be the troubled starter, stalked a round the turn but could not make up any ground on the leader through the bend, swung out widest in the five-path turning for home and finished up with good interest trying to get up late for the place or show award in deep stretch but just coming up short settling on the fringes instead at the wire. SUMMONYOURCOURAGE sat outside off two others watching the lone speed down the back straight, continued three wide with inside foes trying to close the gap on the leader but in vain around the bend and could not find more down the lane yielding in the four path by mid-stretch. LEAN MUSIC MACHINE broke a step slowly seeing the field along the backside, lagged well behind the pack in the turn running and could not get involved in the stretch drive.

SHESHIMAINTEANCE prompted the pace on the outside in the early stages, sat contently on the outside shadowing the pacesetter at the half, pounced outside with a quarter mile from the wire, began to pull away from the stubborn pacesetter by the furlong pole and drew off late for the win. STAR ATTRACTION was bumped by the outside foe to begin, had the inside position on two others watching the lead pair, settled into stride on the rail down the backstretch moving well, hugged the rail around the final turn keeping up with the lead duo, shifted to the two path in the mix in upper stretch and got up in the shadow of the wire for the runners up share. DAZZLING CRUISER was allowed to settle at the back of the pack on the first bend, still could see the field down the backside still well within striking distance, passed an inside rival starting to reach for more ground on the rail at the quarter pole and showed a good late run charging on the inside late to almost get the nod for second at the wire. BACKGAMMON had the lead inside early on, remained up front but by only a narrow advantage down the backstretch, was collared by the winner outside on the far turn with a quarter mile remaining, dug in trying to counter on the rail until the furlong pole but had little left in deep stretch and wilted between runners losing a couple of positions late. LA CULASSE bobbled breaking inwards at the start, tracked the front pair between foes on the first turn as well as down the back straight, travelled three wide running evenly keeping pace around the final bend, had a chance in the four path at the head of the lane but needed more late when outfinished by inside runners in the final seventy yards. AUSSIE HYPER tracked four wide around the initial bend, travelled three deep watching the lead duo down the backside, was roused offering no response three wide retreating on the far turn by the five sixteenths marker and emptied out for the drive.

RUNNING ON TIME had the early lead on the inside, bobbed heads up top down the backstretch while on the fence, began to edge away from the early speed rival at the quarter pole through the last turn and under a busy ride drew off with authority in the final furlong for basically the wire to wire tally. NIIGON'S LAW travelled three wide in the middle of the pack in the first of two bends, settled on the outside of another in the second flight with a half mile still to go, closed in three wide at the quarter pole to pose the only threat four wide straightening out for the drive but was no match for the winner in the final furlong and finished up well enough to safely hold for the secondary share at the wire. MAD WORLD travelled at the back of the pack with an outside foe, made no movement on the rail down the backstretch, stayed on the fence having little to offer running around the turn and could not get involved while in the two path in the drive to the wire. WEMBLEY AVENUE bore out on the break, trailed three wide around the first turn, share the rear outside another with the group running in pairs along the backside, continued in tandem with an inside foe on the last turn making no impression and in the four path could not factor in the stretch drive.

COOL KISS settled in the back half of the field racing just off the rail, was encouraged along at the seven-sixteenths as a rival passed inside, was forced to go wide advancing outside leaving the turn fanning seven wide into upper stretch under a drive, struck the lead past the three-sixteenths, drew clear and held well under steady handling. ARTEMUS CITYLIMITS was fleeted footed at the start while hand loose up top shortly after leaving the gate, rolled along throughout the turn just off the rail with little pressure applied from his chasing rivals, shifted out to the three path for the stretch run, edged away when urged on while staying on the incorrect lead at the furlong pole and still finished up smartly to hold sway for the frontrunning victory. Z Z'S broke in just a bit, attended the pace from outside, moved willingly to the lead nearing the five-sixteenths, edged clear leaving the turn, was asked in upper stretch, responded and began drawing off, drifted out nearing the sixteenth pole then received a right-handed correction from the crop and straightened out coasting to the wire under vigorous hand urging. FOURFIFTYFOUR bumped a rival and steadied at the start, settled outside off the pace, advanced four wide on the turn, ran on to gain the place without threatening the winner. MOBULA was urged forward from between runners to make the lead, set the pace near the inside shadowed by the eventual winner, was headed by that one nearing the five-sixteenths and ridden at that juncture, gave way in the stretch, lost place late. RARIFIED (IRE) hopped slightly at the start, settled off the pace and racing off the rail, advanced some on the turn seeking room between foes near the quarter pole, found it by upper stretch then angled out further, ran on without threatening. ANGEL DANIELLE was up close along the inside early, took back when in tight nearing the five-eighths, pursued from inside mid-division, saving ground on the turn, failed to rally. MIRAMICHI trailed early, paused slightly near the five-eighths in behind a runner and switched out, swung six wide into upper stretch, made no bid. EMPTY GESTURE was just lightly bumped at the start but close up, settled in behind the leading pair stalking from outside, went three wide on the turn, faded in the stretch.

MIA MITOLE advanced on the fence on the first bend to have a good spot down the backside tracking the front twosome while on the rail, sat behind the leader patiently being coaxed along waiting for the cue to move, shot through inside with a big opening in upper stretch, darted up the fence by the furlong taking the lead, veered out when urged by a left-handed crop at the seventy yards pole but was clearing off by then for the win. BIG IMAGINATION (JPN) tracked the frontrunner on the outside early on, continued to hound the leader outside down the back straight, closed in making a bid on the inside pacesetter at the quarter pole, dueled between foes in the four path down the lane, kept on fighting to the very end but was outkicked by the winner in the late going. TOTALLY IN CHARGE settled between runners for the first half of this two-turn event, was asked for more right-handed by the rider but could not

quicken with the front four at the quarter pole, shifted out widest moving to the six path for clear run at the furlong pole and had a good late surge in deep stretch to capture third while threaten at the wire for the place share as well. DESIGN DIVA took the overland route going five wide on the first turn sitting in midfield, progressed three deep down the backside keeping a close eye on the lead pair by the half, rallied outside going four wide on the far turn coming up the front duo by the quarter pole, shifted to the five path in the hunt at the head of the lane but stalled in deep stretch switching back to the incorrect lead shying away when the inside foe drifted out in the final seventy yards. RATINGS UPGRADE (IRE) shared the rear with the barn buddy inside on the initial turn, lagged behind down the backstretch on the outside, offered a mild spurt three wide passing a couple of rivals at the quarter pole, shifted out widest in the five path at the top of the stretch and finished up with some late interest. STRATOSPHERIC veered in sharply at the start, co-trailed with the stablemate outside on the first bend, improved slightly inside at the half, saved ground on the last bend at the quarter pole and offered a mild run on the rail in the stretch drive passing a couple of tiring foes. DAFINA was loose on the engine on the first turn, had company keeping him honest on the outside down the backstretch, was hard ridden being asked right handed trying to hold up front at the quarter pole, drifted out getting tired three wide in upper stretch when headed on both sides and folded while being checked mildly giving way between horses at the sixteenth pole. ALBIE FIRST had a poor beginning starting slow and breaking out leaving the gate, settled close to the back going four wide on the first turn, had a couple of runners beaten along the backside, showed little between foes part of the rear trio on the far turn and came up empty in the four path in upper stretch.
