AUDAX MINOR got away well, stalked just off the pace three to four wide, moved to the lead about the five-sixteenths, drew off when roused. ARMINO settled between foes two to three wide early, was urged along passing the five-sixteenths shifting out soon after, came into upper stretch five to six wide, kept on to get up for place without threatening the wniner. ARRAKASTA IZAN shifted in rating in behind the leading group, saved ground both turns cutting the corner to advance inside a foe past the quarter pole, came out a bit in upper stretch in pursuit of the leader, was no match for that one and lost place late. RUNAWAY MAXI was urged forward inside and moved clear on the first turn, set the pace inside or just off the rail but soon faced pressure up the

backstretch, was hounded into the far turn, overtaken by the five-sixteenths racing off the fence into upper stretch and continued to weaken. HALCON NEGRO bumped a rival lightly at the start, settled off the pace racing mostly three to four wide throughout, ran on in the lane to just miss for the minor award. GERALD was lightly bumped at the start, caught three wide early, fanned out five wide late on the far turn, failed to rally. ONE SMOOTH STONE was bumped at the start, tucked in saving ground along the rail off the pace, saved ground through the far turn, was never near enough to threaten. KING PUTT was keen to go forward two to three wide between foes into the first turn, stalked through that bend then took closer order pressing from between runners up the backstretch, was asked to keep up past the seven-sixteenths but had no response and retreated. GHOST BUSTED was caught five then four wide heading into the first turn but dropped back off rivals and shifted in a bit, raced last but one well back and off the inside, was never a factor. KAIROS MOMENT exchanged a bump at the start, lacked early speed dropping well back, was outpaced and not a factor.
