JUSTINE broke sharp but then was reined deep ever so softly content on letting the outside foe take command midway down the backstretch, shifted outside the pacesetter at the half, re-engaged two wide with the inside leader by the three eighths pole, pounced when finally set down in the two path at the furlong pole and wore down the game frontrunner in the last sixteenth of a mile to edge clear for the win in deep stretch. SCARY SPEEDY was hustled at the start clearing and crossing over to the fence having the outright lead at the half, rolled along maintaining a slim advantage inside on the rail in the turn running, continued to dig in clinging onto the front end with a furlong to go but gave way grudgingly in deep stretch unable to withstand the constant pressure by the winner through the drive. SPA PROSPECTOR had the rail tucked in sitting in midfield, was roused through the bend keeping pace taking the shortest way around the turn, moved out to the two path at the head of the lane and finished up willingly inside others to be a non-threatening third at the wire. SUPER SICILY kept a close eye of the lead pair while outside in the three path, was driven on three wide in midturn but the lead duo were starting to slip further away by the quarter pole, remained in the three path straightening out for the drive and finished up mildly for a minor placing in the end. FORESTERS EXEC was situated near the rear having the two path with rivals on each side, ran on evenly going two wide around the oval, angled out four wide off of horses losing some momentum briefly in upper stretch but when clear in the final furlong failed to fire. BREEZERO travelled four deep close to the back end, could not get anything going spinning his wheels three wide around the turn outside rivals, swung out widest to the five path turning for home

but lacked a rally through the lane. WOOTEN WARRIOR (IRE) was in tight having the three path between horses having to be checked coming up to the seven sixteenths pole, lagged well behind around the turn, moved out to the two path for the stretch run but could not recover enough to get involved in the late going.
