STONKS settled off the pace, saved ground inside, came out turning for home then again further in the stretch with aim, rallied strongly to drive past seventy

yards from home and cleared. TIGER TOWN got away well, came in early while quickly moving clear, set the pace in hand and with daylight behind, was asked in upper stretch, was inhaled past the sixteenth pole but was clearly second best. CATHOLIC JACKIE was mid-pack near but just off the fence, moved out on the turn swinging eight wide, kept on. SOL DE VERANO exchanged bumps at the start and was put in tight, settled toward the back off the rail, rallied mildly inside in the stretch to improve. GLINTINDADDYSEYE broke outwardly, lacked early speed settling outside dropping back, fanned nine wide into upper stretch and gained late. MAXIMUS MAGIC was forced in at the start bumping with a rival, chased outside a foe off the leading pair into the turn, floated six to seven wide turning for home, failed to rally. COLONEL MUSTARD settled off the pace, was mostly three to five wide throughout, ran on in the lane. PROUD RONIN chased the pacesetting runner-up in the clear from off the inside, ask all out by the quarter pole, faltered and faded. CHILL THE J brk in, pursued the leading pair from inside, saved some ground on the turn, was encouraged along outside the three-eighths, came out for the stretch run, had no response. TOURIST'S DREAM exchanged bumps and was bumped inwardly at the start, raced toward the rear, was never a threat.
