NO NAY HUDSON (IRE) was forced out into a rival at the start, was taken up at that juncture and settled while on hold at the rear, began to advance outside foes on the turn, fanned six wide into upper stretch, drifted in gradually through the lane, struck the lead past the sixteenth pole and edged away late. NOBALS was bumped outward at the start, advanced outside in pursuit mid-division into the turn, came into upper stretch four wide under urging and with aim on the leaders, bid near the sixteenth pole but was outkicked. WESTERN WHIRL contested the pace inside, dueled through the turn, took a narrow command approaching the furlong grounds, was outkicked. THE STRIKIN VIKING (IRE) broke out a bit, chased but was outsprinted early, raced between rivals briefly then outside a foe on the turn, came into upper stretch five deep, tipped out six to seven wide switching outside the eventual winner, kept on but needed more. LIGHT THE LAMP was outpaced early chasing from inside toward the back, came out five wide gradually through the stretch and ran on. ITS TIME TO SHINE chased from mid-pack inside, came out four wide for the drive, went evenly. BRING THEBAND HOME veered out at the start bothering rivals, dueled from outside, faltered in upper stretch and faded.
