CRUMLIN TROUBLE was loose up top setting a mild pace into the wind just off the rail, comfortably travelled in hand well in control around the turn, opened up at the top of the lane when let out a notch and cruised home for the frontrunning score. SIL'S GAMBLE had the inside position stalking down the back straight, was throttled down briefly coming up to a tiring rival midway on the turn, shifted to the four path for the drive, was full of run down the stretch and got up just before the finish line to best the rest for the runners up share. CLOUD RIDER chased on the rail in the early stages, still kept trying on the fence down the stretch, could not get to the winner by the furlong pole and faded slightly late being nabbed at the wire for the second place share. TANDHONEYWITHANE was unhurried seeing the field at the half, lagged at the rear shifting out in midturn, swung out widest in the five path turning for home and had good late energy in the final eighth of a mile to be a fringe player outside foes at the wire. DANCETOTHERHYTHM kept a close eye on the frontrunner with rivals on either side in the early going, was roused but could not keep up with the lead three runners at the five sixteenths pole, scraped paint dueling for the show money in upper stretch but evened out inside in the final seventy yards. PRINCESSONAMISSION travelled three deep watching the pacesetter, was still three wide taking closer order on the turn by the quarter pole, fought on in the mix just off the fence for a share at the top of the lane but folded by the sixteenth pole. BAYTOWN STORM had an outside stalking role down the backside, was scrubbed three wide at the five sixteenths pole making little progression around the turn, stayed on the incorrect lead down the lane and could not get involved between foes in the final furlong.

DAZZLING CRUISER shared the rear inside another while just off the rail, settled on the fence near the back along the backside, began to pick up the bit when roused at the three furlong pole, shifted out coming with a run at the quarter marker, angled out three wide for the stretch run, had a solid stretch kick to the finish line and got up in the shadow of the wire outside for the late running win. SALTED was loose on the lead angling in getting to the rail heading into the first turn, continued on the front end setting a lively pace all alone down the backside, opened up on the far turn still in hand, remained in control on the fence but was beginning to shorten stride at the furlong marker and could not fend off the late charge by the winner in deep stretch. ONEHOTMESS had the rail watching the pacesetter, took up the chase making no gain through the far turn, could not threaten the top pair who had it to themselves in the stretch drive but did run on mildly to be a clear but distant third in the end. TUNED OUT had the rail settling in mid-division, regressed a bit to stalk on the outside of others at the half, saved ground making little headway on the far turn and finished up evenly on the rail through the stretch to be a long way back of the winner but setting on the fringes at the wire. TIZ READY watched the pacesetter while between runners, came under a ride but could not keep up to the leaders through the last turn and weakened in the two path in the drive to the wire. D'AURUM broke a step slow, recovered to track the leader three wide outside two others around the first of two turns, settled into stride staying three deep outside foes tracking down the back straight, was going the wrong way outside horses three wide midway on the second bend, angled out to the five path at the top of the lane and had nothing to offer outside rivals in the late running. RIDEAU FALLS co-trailed on the outside three wide on the initial bend, was well behind the group along the backside, labored seeing the field around the final turn and made no impression galloping down the stretch

PHILIP BANKS seized command right from the get-go, moved well within himself unopposed in control throughout the turn, pulled further away with the rider still in the saddle down the stretch and was dominant increasing the winning margin at the finish line. PAYNES SPIRIT travelled outside another in the middle of the pack, started to get into gear four wide between rivals a quarter mile from home, shifted out in the five path making a stretch charge and closed in belatedly in the last eighth to be second best behind the runaway winner. DARK DANGER had the rail settling in midfield down the backside, still remained on the fence waiting for the cue to move behind the tracking threesome at the five sixteenths pole, dueled inside runners scraping paint for the secondary share in upper stretch with the winner long gone and fought on well enough to garner the show award at the finish line. CUBAN THUNDER (IRE) was void of early foot seeing the field on the fence, took the short way around still at the back of the pack in the running around the turn, was looking for running room two furlongs from home behind a wall of four runners, narrowed the margin two wide at the top of the stretch and ran on willingly in the final furlong to get up for a minor role in the last jump. SPEEDY BEAR drafted behind the frontrunner along the backside under a snug hold, shifted outside at the quarter pole, could not match strides with the winner getting away at the top of the lane, stayed on the wrong lead through the stretch and faded between foes in the final seventy yards. RED WEAVER stalked close to the back on the outside of horses, mounted a rally circling rivals three wide initially midway on the bend, was fanned out widest in the six path turning for home, could not sustain the run and flattened out by the furlong marker. KOKOMO was situated three deep watching the loose leader down the back straight, chased outside two others midway around the bend, moved out to be four wide in upper stretch, had little for the drive to the wire

LUZ DE LA LUNA stalked near the rear just off the rail, glided closer while in hand on the fence at the three eighths marker, sharply burst between runners when called upon finding a seam in the two path with a quarter mile to go, was full of run reaching for more ground four wide in upper stretch having aim on the frontrunner, powered past under left handed urging at the seventy yards marker and was drawing clear for the win at the wire. SHIFTY emerged from the early scramble leaving the chute to have a head in front into the backstretch, rolled along in control through the turn, had company pressing outside at the quarter pole, spurted away on the rail repelling that challenger in upper stretch, started to shorten stride at the furlong marker and could not find something in reserve to fend off the winner in deep stretch. CRYSTAL VISIONS was unhurried outside at the back in the beginning, tried to make a circling rally four wide outside horses midway on the turn but to no avail, shifted out widest for the drive in the five path, had a good late run outside rivals in the final furlong to capture the third place share and all the while just coming up short of closing in for the runners up placing as well. PURR FACTOR had the inside position tracking the engaged pair, came under a ride on the fence unable to gain on the front twosome around the bend, hugged the rail in the mix for a minor share at the top of the lane and finished up one paced inside horses getting up late for a minor share in the end. BOTTA SWING sat off the outside flank on the pacesetter down the backside, was urged for more at the five sixteenths pole moving in to apply pressure outside with a quarter mile to run, could not keep up to the lead duo by the furlong pole and faded between foes in the two path with a sixteenth still to run. ECSTASY travelled in the second flight outside another in the early going, was hard ridden in the three path between foes but was back pedaling midway on the turn, shifted in to the two path for the drive, had little to give and folded by the furlong marker.

BOREALIS TRAIL was bumped inside at the start, gathered himself trailing in the early going, made little progression along the backside, began to reach for more ground inside runners at the five sixteenths pole, moved back outside at the quarter marker, had a full head of steam between rivals in the three path coming to the eighth pole, switched leads finding another gear dueling outside the leader with a sixteenth still to run and drove by to win going away in the end. MANSETTI broke out on the start, had the lead just off the fence setting a moderate pace, continued up top narrowly inside runners down the backstretch, shook loose at the half mile marker rationing out his speed, had a diminishing advantage at the quarter pole trying to get a breather on the far turn, spurted away mildly in the two path in upper stretch, drifted out fighting inside up front with a sixteenth from home but could not withstand the late charge outside by the winner in deep stretch. WAGSTAFF settled on the outside of another tracking the lead threesome, loped along in mid-pack outside foes down the back straight, made a sharp move circling four wide at the quarter pole, loomed in the four path at the top of the lane, was no match for the lead duo who had it to themselves at the furlong pole and finished up evenly, just lasting for the third place share in a tight finish. HE'S NOT JOKING had a stalking trip on the fence in the early stages, was nudged for run at the five sixteenths pole, could not quicken with the eventual winner inside two furlongs from home, angled to the five path turning for home, kept on fighting to the end unable to get to the lead pair but dug in late just missing the nod for the show award. SPECIAL SESSION was forwardly placed prompting the leader outside, three wide on the first turn, pulled the rider even closer three deep

down the backside, closed back in three wide in between rivals with a quarter mile to run, had little left at the top of the lane and weakened three wide between foes at the furlong marker. PRETTY CAPABLE was brushed on the inside at the break, had the rail nestled behind the engaged trio early on, travelled well under a good rhythm watching the lead three down the back straight, moved in at the three furlong pole, was scrubbed for more chasing the pacesetter inside two others at the quarter marker, could not continue on in the stretch drive and tired in the two path by upper stretch between horses. RUNAWAY AGAIN broke outwards on the start, pressed the issue with runners on each side on the first turn, vied between rivals under a tight hold down the backside, was urged for more at the three furlong marker, dropped back abruptly at the five sixteenths pole being engulfed by runners making a run, trailed the field at the top of the stretch and was not persevered with in the final furlong.

LUCKY SCORE was outpaced early, raced well back, angled seven wide turning for home beginning to advance, drove past in in mid-stretch and cleared. TWIN CITY settled mid-pack stalking outside, went four wide on the turn, came out further in the stretch, kept on late to get up for second. SOUPED UP shifted in early, tracked in behind the leaders inside, angled four wide coming to the quarter pole, bid in upper stretch in conjunction with other foes taking a narrow brief lead in mid-stretch, was outkicked and lost place. I'M A GAMBLER (IRE) settled off the pace, advanced inside on the turn, moved out in upper stretch making a mild bid between foes, was outkicked. BOURBONONAHOLIDAY was bumped on the inside on the start, recovered to improve smartly down the backside sitting outside rivals in midfield by the half, was roused continuing to gain steadily on the front duo through the turn, pounced widest in the six path at the top of the lane, took command outside leaving the furlong marker and held safe from the oncoming inside foe at the finish line. DROGON had a sluggish start settling close to the back midway down the backstretch, advanced sharply inside runners in midturn, had to tap on the brakes for a moment in the two path turning for home, darted between foes at the furlong pole, found a seam on the rail making a solid run late but just could not get to the winner who got the jump on him at the top of the stretch. HALCON NEGRO rated on the rail near the rear ahead of only a couple runners in the beginning, rallied on the fence when called upon for more at the quarter pole, shifted out finding a clear lane four wide in upper stretch coming with a run, split runners with a furlong to go and with a good stretch kick goot up with runners on each side for the show money at the finish line. ASHUKA had the inside settling into stride in the second flight along the backside, began to reel in the arguing co-leaders at the five sixteenths pole, bid between rivals three wide in upper stretch, poked his head in front for a fleeting moment coming to the furlong marker, could not fend off the late closers and faded with runners on either side in the final sixteenth to settle on the fringes in the end. AIM DON'T MISS had a good spot isolated in the third flight watching the front two pairings down the back straight, regressed midway on the turn under asking, shifted to the five path straightening out for the drive and came back on picking up tired runners in the last eighth of a mile. BIG LEW tracked the embattled pair on the outside, closed in on the front duo at the five sixteenths marker while outside another runner, was in the hunt five wide at the top of the lane between horses, could not continue on and flattened out at the furlong marker. CARRICK ON STAGE had a tracking trip in the beginning going four deep outside horses, dropped back to be in a stalking role outside another at the half, made little progression around the oval and showed little while in the six path in the late running. M C LUVIN was sandwiched at the start, had company inside seeing the field down the backstretch, remained paired up on the outside lagging well behind around the bend and passed a couple of stragglers in the stretch running outside. SOUPER STRIDER battled outside under a rapid pace for the first half, got the better of the other speed rival by the quarter pole, drifted to the rail from the three path turning for home, was engulfed outside by runners nearing the furlong pole and was wrapped up in the final sixteenth of a mile. CHIEF LIONHART veered out sharply on the break, co-trailed inside another down the backside, continued to share the rear around the bend and could only manage to pass the weary early leader in the last furlong. EARNING MY EARS dueled inside setting a suicidal pace throughout the turn, gave way up top leaving the quarter pole, was on empty on the rail at the top of the lane, ran out of gas stopping at the furlong marker and was eased up when crossing the finish line.
