SUPER SICILY stalked inside of runners down the back straight, patiently waited on the fence behind the chasing rivals on the turn, shifted out at the five sixteenths pole finding a seam two wide coming with a run, loomed boldly in the four path at the top of the stretch in full stride, wore down the frontrunner through the lane and drove by at the sixteenth pole for the win. KIKITSA assumed command unchallenged along the backstretch, moved well in hand opening up midway around the bend, continued to travel comfortably up top at the head of the lane, was asked for more with the winner bearing down outside at the furlong marker, could not fend off the outside rival any longer at the sixteenth pole relinquishing the lead and ran on to be second best at the finish line. VERDEJO settled between horses keeping a close eye on the leader, chased between rivals making little gain on the turn, shifted out three wide in the thick of things for a share between foes in upper stretch, ran on mildly but was being outkicked by the lead pair at the furlong marker and finished up to be a clear third at the wire. TABLOID MATERIAL was under a snug hold tracking the frontrunner down the backside, kept pace holding position through the bend, skimmed the fence still in the mix at the top of the stretch and finished up one paced holding safely for a minor role in the end. INDIAN PEAK was unhurried, settling in the last position in the beginning, ranged up on the fence into the turn closing the gap smartly, shifted out coming to the contesting trio four wide in upper stretch, dueled for the front end under left handed urging at the eighth pole and drew off in the late stages for the win. CAUGHT SPEEDING was under a tight hold edging away for a clear lead inside at the nine sixteenths pole down the backside, maintained a slim advantage saving ground around the turn, spurted away slightly at the top of the lane, was collared outside by the winner at the furlong pole unable to match strides late but finished up solidly for the runners up share in the end. PRICELESS WILL was part of the rear trio stalking between runners, was scrubbed on in the three path in midturn starting to make a move, angled out five wide with a chance while reaching for more ground turning for home and ran on willingly to be a non-threatening third at the wire. SOUPER SUCCESS shadowed the leader outside initially, prompted the issue three wide outside two others throughout the turn battling up top, still was in the conversation three wide at the head of the lane, could not find more in mid-stretch and yielded at the furlong marker. BACHELOR PAD was isolated tracking the front duo early on, became headstrong midway down the backstretch and drove up in tight between foes at the half mile marker, vied with runners on both sides for the lead around the oval, continued in the mix two wide with the field spread across at the top of the stretch, could not offer a finishing kick and wilted inside horses in the final furlong. HIGHLAND LIFE travelled three deep sharing the rear outside two others in the beginning, made little impact still outside, at least three wide around the turn, swung out widest with the field six abreast turning for home but had little to show in the stretch running.

FIRE AND WINE was hustled from the onset getting loose on the lead going around the first turn, slowed the tempo down along the backstretch but was increasing the advantage at the half, rambled along opening up at will around the far turn and strolled in down the lane for the dominant front running win. TREVALLY tracked the pacesetter three wide on the initial bend, settled into stride rating kindly watching the front two down the backside, tried to mount a rally going after the loose leader three wide at the five sixteenths pole, angled to the four path with the winner long gone by then and closed belatedly to get up late, winning the duel outside for the runners up share. MAKER'S FLATTER had the rail keeping an eye on the frontrunner, was reined in heading into the backstretch to sit behind the lead threesome at the half, was urged on the fence making a mild rally inside rivals at the midway point of the turn with the field spread out, had no chance at the winner who was very much in control at the top of the lane, got into the second position hugging the rail in upper stretch but could not hold on inside battling for the place share in deep stretch. FOG D'ORO hopped slightly on the break, settled inside rivals close to the back early on, made little progression having the fence down the backstretch, picked up the bit when asked for more run at the five sixteenths pole, angled to the three path at the top of the lane and offered a good late finish to capture a minor placing at the wire. HOLY RAMBO travelled in mid-division on the rail making little headway down the backside, offered a brief burst on the fence at the five sixteenths pole to have a chance for a piece of the prize at the top of

the lane on the rail, was checked in tight quarters coming to the eighth pole losing momentum and evened out in the late running. FULLY COMPLETELY stalked near the rear on the outside, improved smartly outside rivals down the back straight, continued to edge closer on the last bend to be in with a shot for a small share four wide turning for home, could not sustain the lengthy rally and stalled by the furlong marker. SANHEDRIN watched the frontrunner with rivals on either side tracking in the first turn, chased the winner in vain down the backside and throughout the last turn, had little left for the stretch run and wilted in the two path between horses in mid-stretch. TIZ THE POWER could see the field going into the first turn, lagged well behind down the back straight, picked up a rival inside at the three eighths marker, angled out five wide for the drive but could not play a factor in the stretch running. RUM TALK settled outside another in midfield in the first turn, regressed between runners midway down the backstretch, labored behind the field on the final bend, lost touch with the group at the top of the lane and cantered across the wire.

PARAMOUNT PRINCE was hustled at the start getting a clear advantage on the rail into the first turn, settled into a good rhythm dictating a modest pace while quickening the tempo slightly down the backside at the half, opened up at the five sixteenths pole disposing of a brief challenge from an outside rival early into the far turn, moved away with ease at the quarter pole and won under only a hand ride through to the finish line. LOOSE WIRE had the rail stalking on the first turn, watched the front two runners while nestled on the fence down the backside, tried to make a rally with the frontrunner getting away at the five sixteenths pole, could not match strides with the leader who had plenty left for the drive at the top of the lane and coasted in to be second best behind the overpowering winner. DRESDEN ROW shifted off the fence to track the lone speed outside early on, was content to gallop along just outside watching the pacesetter while offering little pressure down the backstretch, was scrubbed on for run at the three furlong pole but was quickly repelled by the winner midway on the last turn, faded by the quarter pole unable to go with then front pair at the top of the stretch and finished up on the rail to be a distant third in the end. LAC MACAZA was at the back three wide with the field compact heading into the first turn, could see the field still well in range at the half, could not quicken with runners at the midpoint of the final turn and while four wide in the lane could not get into contention, galloping home across the wire.

HUMBER RIVER broke sharp getting the lead after the start, was patiently handled dropping back slightly sitting behind the pacesetter at the half, continued to draft behind the leader nudged along waiting for the cue on the fence around the turn, moved to the lead finding a seam in the two path still in hand in upper stretch and when finally set down at the furlong pole, shot away very impressively for the victory. ClUNAS was isolated in midfield moving well within himself at the half, edged up four wide on the turn with the group compact at the quarter pole, loomed four wide outside runners at the top of the lane, charged home in the final furlong but was outkicked by the winner who had a sharp turn of foot in deep stretch when asked. COMMANDER WORSLEY settled close to the back on the rail ahead of only the poor starter, closed the gap on the fence in midturn, moved in three wide with the field bunching up at

the quarter pole and finished up willingly in the two path in the final furlong to be a non threatening third at the wire. DEWOLF tracked between horses in the beginning, took closer order to shadow the leader outside at the half, chased outside holding position throughout the bend, shifted to the three path in the mix between foes turning for home and finished up evenly in the last eighth of a mile to settle on the fringes in the end. BANKINGONAMIRACLE was brushed on the inside on the break, travelled well in hand all alone up front down the backstretch controlling the pace, continued on the front end setting an even tempo throughout the turn, began to shorten stride clinging up top on the fence in upper stretch. could not find more late and faded inside runners in the last furlong. DADDY HAS DIAMONDS tossed his headed leaping up at the start, gathered himself setting at the back of the pack down the backside, was hard ridden closing in sharply having to go six wide attempting to swoop around rivals at the quarter pole, shifted to the seven path, widest for the drive, could not sustain the quick burst and stalled at the furlong marker. SHADOW REALM bobbled, breaking outwards on the start, recovered quickly to advance down the backside to track the leader three deep at the half, was going the wrong way three wide with five sixteenths from home, backed away through the bend and could not get involved while in three path in the stretch drive. TUTTI CONTENTI had a stalking role between foes down the backside, made a brief run like many did at the quarter pole going five wide with rivals on either side narrowing the margin on the leader, emptied out soon afterwards in the six path turning for home and failed to menace in the late running.
