FISH MOONEY was nestled on the rail in mid-pack watching the lead twosome around the initial bend, galloped along rating kindly drafting behind the pacesetter down the backside, had horse waiting for the cue to go on the fence midpoint of the final bend, shifted outside to the two path coming to the leader in upper stretch, battled outside for the top spot at the sixteenth pole and just got the better from the unyielding frontrunner inside in the final seventy yards to edge away late for the win. TWISTING PISTONS was loose on the lead having the rail setting a pedestrian pace into the first turn, controlled the slow tempo unopposed along the backside, continued up top through the far turn well in hand on the lead, was headed outside at the sixteenth pole by the winner, dug in to the wire but stubbornly gave way inside in the final seven yards. FOXY DIVA travelled three wide trailing this compact group in the beginning, stalked three deep keeping a close eye on the front pair at the half, kept pace with runners going outside, three wide on the last turn to be in the mix outside the battling front duo at the top of the lane and finished up mildly to be a clear but non threatening third at the wire. MIZZEN ASH settled near the back between runners, could see the field entering the backstretch, was unable to make any gain going three wide trying to circle around rivals on the far turn and ran on one paced down the lane to be well back settling for a minor share in the end. DESTINY RO had an outside tracking position for the first half of this two turn event, was roused for more between horses with five sixteenths to go when the pace started to quicken, offered little response around the final bend and wilted three wide in upper stretch.

MY CASH FACTOR settled in mid-division while four deep, rallied five wide circling horses at the quarter marker, was full of run outside rivals steadily going by runners down the lane on the incorrect lead, switched gears and leads at the seventy yard pole battling on the front end and edged clear for the win at the finish line. CINNAMON BITS was forwardly placed early on watching the lead foursome, inched closer on the rail midturn, had a chance in the two path for a piece of the prize at the top of the stretch, switched out, off the tiring leader three wide at the furlong marker and with one final late burst, got up for the runners up share outside right at the wire. LADY MOONSHINE had the rail sitting just back watching the pacesetter down the backside, was isolated on the turn following the embattled duo with five sixteenths from home, moved out three wide in the thick of things straightening out for the drive, poked her head in front with a sixteenth of a mile remaining but needed more late, surrendering the lead to the winner at the seventy yard pole and then just getting nosed out at the finish line for the second placing as well. ZEENA SWIFT was loose up front down the backstretch, relinquished the front end when an outside rival made an early quick move at the three eighths marker, kept fighting back inside having the fence through the turn to still be in the mix in upper stretch and finished with interest inside horses to settle in the fringes in the end. NO VISOR had a stalking role ahead of just one runner along the back straight, mounted a rally bursting between horses at the five sixteenths pole, angled to the four path behind foes looking for a seam having run, lacked room at the furlong marker, shifted out six wide finally getting a clear lane with seventy yards to go, surged late but could not get to the leaders in time. HOLIDAY ROSE was unhurried seeing the field early on, began to make a move four wide picking up runners at the quarter pole, swung out widest with momentum in the six path at the top of the lane and found her best stride late passing runners outside in deep stretch. GREAT KATE broke a step slow at the start, recovered down the backstretch to sit in midfield on the fence by the half, regressed inside of rivals around the oval and passed tired runners while having the rail in the final furlong. CRUMLIN BEAST chased the frontrunner while just off the rail down the backside, backed away being passed by rivals on both sides midway around the bend, shifted to the four path for the stretch drive but failed to menace through the lane. VERI GIZMO tracked the loose pacesetter three deep along the back straight, made an early move outside taking over control at the three furlong pole, opened up on the field two wide turning for home, had little left for the late running and folded between horses at the sixteenth pole. ALA TURKA settled in mid-division with runners on each side down the backstretch, offered a brief run three wide at the three eighths marker to be in the hunt four wide at the top of the lane, could not sustain the rally fading up top by the furlong marker, was then checked between foes at the sixteenth pole and could not factor afterwards.

STIRLING CASTLE broke inwards but was quickly straightened out on the break, seized command from the onset under a hustling ride leaving the chute, was nudged along maintaining the front end around the turn with little pressure applied from the nearest outside rival, kept finding more in the two path when encouraged left handed in mid-stretch and held safe at the wire for the front end score. DIVA'S GHOST was void of early foot, lagging behind down the back straight, started to reach for more ground passing a runner inside on the rail with five sixteenths from home, gathered more speed making a slingshot move from the fence swinging out five wide full of run turning for home outside horses, came with a strong charge through the lane passing foes at the furlong marker and powered past at the sixteenth pole taking control to win going away when crossing the finish line. COME ON BIG LOU shot clear when the gate opened up to have an uncontested lead in the early going, rolled along increasing the advantage while still in hand through the bend, maintained a comfortable lead in mid-stretch, offered little resistance when the winner stormed on by at the sixteenth pole and safely held on to best the rest for the runners up placing at the wire. IRISH DEPUTY travelled in mid-division going four deep down the backside, was going in the wrong direction by the three eighths marker to be at the back of the pack with a quarter mile still to run, shifted three wide at the top of the stretch and resurged smartly in the final sixteenth, picking up tired rivals to capture the show money at the finish line. DOADSTER settled between foes in the three path in midfield, made little progression on the leader three wide outside two others in the running around the turn, angled out four wide for the drive to the wire and finished up better than some others for a minor role in the end. GO JIMMY GO had rail position keeping a close eye on the leader down the backstretch, was urged to go after the pacesetter inside a couple of rivals in midturn, offered little response on the fence by the quarter pole and weakened inside horses by the furlong pole. NIKITA'S GEM had the rail rating nicely inside runners in the second flight, started to make a rally reeling in the frontrunner at the five sixteenths pole, bid three wide on the outside in upper stretch, could not go by by the furlong pole with the leader edging slightly away, determinedly rebid again outside at the sixteenth pole and inched away in deep stretch for the win. JUICY HANNA had the fence stalking near the rear in the beginning, had little movement inside foes down the backside, took the short way around the far turn narrowing the margin picking up the bit at the quarter pole and had a good late charge skimming the fence through the stretch drive to get up just before the wire for the second place share while making in a game run for the win as well. ADORABLE ANGEL assumed command setting a slow pace in the beginning, continued up top with an even tempo along the backside, moved well still

quite in control through the far turn, repelled the initial challenge from the winner outside in upper stretch, was headed again by the sixteenth pole but was unable to find more this time surrendering the lead and faded in deep stretch to settle for the third place award at the wire. TOTALLY IN CHARGE kept a close eye on the frontrunner sitting between rivals in the early stages, could not keep up with others when the pace quickened at the three eighths pole, re-rallied on the fence at the quarter marker to be in the mix three wide in upper stretch and finished up mildly to settle on the fringes in the end. DESIGN DIVA co-trailed between rivals early on, settled at the back of the pack with a half mile still to run, could not advance while outside another around the last turn and passed tired foes when widest in the six path in upper stretch. RELOAD EH shared the rear outside of a couple of rivals while going three wide in the first of two turns, closed the gap improving outside horses down the backside to sit in midfield at the three furlong marker, offered a mild run three wide on the outside by the quarter pole but yielded four wide between foes in upper stretch.
