KING ROSSO was away alertly having the early lead, co-shared the front letting a rival engage inside midway on the first turn, settled into a good rhythm hounding the frontrunner outside three deep down the backside, moved in to force the issue on the far bend, tenaciously dueled outside down the whole stretch and just got the nose down at the right time at the wire for the hard fought win. HELLO STRANGER broke a step slow to trail in the beginning, advanced sharply under a tight hold on the rail around the first turn to sit behind the pacesetter down the backside, shot through when having an opening on the fence to seize control at the half, maintained a slim advantage up top around the final turn, was unvielding battling inside for the win down the entire stretch but was denied by a tight photo at the finish line, losing the nod. ROYAL PRESENCE travelled three wide outside two others watching the front pair early on, tracked in midfield, four deep outside foes down the back straight, remained in the second flight continuing three wide outside rivals on the last turn, angled to the five path at the top of the lane, was no match for the lead twosome who were a fight of their own at the furlong pole but determinedly dug in outside to edge away at the finish line capturing the show money. SWIFTLET edged up with the rail open to co-lead inside midway on the initial turn, narrowly dictated terms just off the fence while shadowed outside by the eventual winner down the backstretch, relinquished the front end letting a rival dart through inside at the half, dropped back slightly off the lead duo around the second turn, shifted out four wide in mix for a piece of the prize turning for home between runners, fought on inside for the third place share at the furlong marker but had to settle for a minor role in the end. LOVER BOY MO settled between rivals tracking the front duo heading into the first turn, had little movement down the back straight, closed the gap smartly on the far turn having the fence at the quarter pole, was in the hunt hugging the rail at the top of the stretch but could not continue with others outside and was outkicked in the final furlong. TORONTO CITY was antsy in the stall prior to the start, stalked outside another in the two path heading into the first turn, trailed the field along the backside, made little headway still at the rear around the final bend, angled to the four path for the drive but could not get involved in the late stages.

BIG BABY HENRY hopped up at the break, sat in midfield outside another down the backside, mounted a rally four wide at the quarter marker to loom boldly in the five path between horses turning for home, moved in to take control outside at the sixteenth pole and had enough late to just hold off an oncoming rival at the finish line. LITTLE RED DOMI tracked the lead foursome while travelling three deep outside at the half, made little gain when scrubbed for more initially at the five sixteenths pole, was fanned out six wide moving with the eventual winner on the inside at the top of the lane, was edging up with every stride late but could not get to the winner in time at the wire. HEAT MERCHANT settled into stride in the two path keeping a close eye on the front foursome down the backside, offered a good run when urged for more making a bid four wide outside runners for the front end with a quarter mile to go, was clinging onto the lead between horses in upper stretch, could not fend off the winner outside at the sixteenth pole and faded in deep stretch to be a clear third in the end. FAIRWAY TO HEAVEN travelled in the second flight inside watching the lead rivals early on, waited in the two path to move still behind the quartet throughout the turn, angled to the four path looking for a seam behind the leaders at the top of the lane and finished up willingly in the final furlong to settle in the fringes, well back of the front three at the finish line. MIDNIGHT ARKLE hopped on the break seeing the field leaving the chute, improved smartly outside foes down the back straight, had a good turn of foot closing in considerably around the turn, angled out widest in the seven path for the drive to wire, could not sustain the lengthy run and evened out in the final furlong. CABERNAYDO stalked near the rear inside foes at the half, had no movement travelling just off the rail around the oval and had to weave through runners in the two path in mid-stretch while finishing with interest in the final furlong. TOURIST'S DREAM was unhurried, trailing the strung out group down the backside, took the short way around the turn making no progression, split rivals five wide picking up horses at the top of the stretch and kept on coming gradually down the lane. COMPUTER HACKER leapt up on the break, recovered to watch the front trio while four deep shadowing the leaders at the half, moved in four wide around the bend poking his head in front for a fleeting moment at the quarter pole, still was in the conversation on the front end in the three path at the top of the stretch, could not find more late and tired between foes at the furlong marker. MAGIC SLIPS travelled inside another in mid-division, narrowed the margin on the contesting leaders around the turn, was looking for a clear path while four wide at the guarter pole, had clear run two wide in mid-stretch but failed to fire in the late running. FASCINATION STREET broke sharp having the early advantage, had company up front on the inside at the half, regained a slim lead three wide between runners in midturn, was still hard ridden inside rivals two wide in the thick of things turning for home, could not quicken with others through the stretch and tired at the furlong marker. SHINIGAMI assumed command setting only a moderate pace uncontested down the backside, rolled along comfortably with the rider statuesque in the saddle around the turn having little pressure applied by any rivals, was let out a notch at the top of the lane, burst away to a commanding lead by the eighth pole and proved much the best increasing the winning margin when crossing the finish line. SOUPER ICONIC travelled inside a rival in midfield at the half, had the fence waiting for the cue while drafting behind the frontrunner midway on the bend, shifted out in the two path posing the only threat straightening out for home, could not keep up to the overpowering winner by the eighth pole and ran on well enough to best the rest for the place share at the finish. AWE INSPIRED stalked down the backside ahead of only one other rival, started to reach for more ground closing the gap on rivals three wide at the quarter pole, kept on coming three wide in upper stretch, found another gear when switching leads at the furlong pole and ran on belatedly, being a clear third at the wire. BENLION was void of early foot speed to trail in the early stages, made little impression around the bend, angled to the four path outside foes for the stretch drive and caught a couple of tiring inside runners in the final seventy yards for a minor role in the end. GUARD OF HONOUR chased the loose pacesetter down the backstretch, had rivals in either side tracking the leader on the oval, dropped back unable to hold position between foes two wide at the quarter mile pole and weakened on the rail in the final furlong. QUANDALE settled outside another travelling in midfield, made a sharp move three wide at the three furlong pole around rivals to briefly press the winner outside by the quarter marker, was quickly repelled while in the three path at the top of the lane and faltered between horses with a sixteenth of a mile still remaining.

ASK IN MY NAME was allowed to settle at the back finding his stride, started to mount a rally passing a challenger outside at the five sixteenths pole, had a full head of steam six wide at the top of the stretch, closed in sharply by the furlong pole, drove past taking control with a sixteenth still to run and won going away crossing the finish line. BLAZING BO cleared from the outer post to be loose on the lead on the rail midway down the backstretch, set an even pace while pressed outside on the turn, was headed outside three wide in upper stretch, dug in to fend of that challenger at the sixteenth pole but could not withstand the late charge by the winner which was further outside in deep stretch and determinedly lasted at the wire holding for the runners up share. BREAK THE SPELL stalked, having one beaten down the backside, was relegated to last when the eventual winner went by on the outside at the five sixteenths pole, skimmed the fence at the top of the lane, closed in having clear run on the rail through the stretch, surged inside to capture third and threatened late for the place share as well in the end. ECHO WITH LAUGHTER was content to sit outside just off the flank of the pacesetter in the beginning, took closer order by the three eighths pole, turned up the pressure forcing the issue outside with a quarter mile remaining, battled initially outside in upper stretch then gave way between horses with the winner charging by on the outside at the sixteenth pole and saved for a minor placing at the wire. SECRET STORM travelled in mid-pack on the outside early on, still had the outside teamed up in the second flight around the turn with another rival, swung out in the five path between foes having clear run in with a chance turning for home but could not offer a finish and yielded to others inside at the eighth pole. MANNIX (IRE) had the rail keeping a close eye on the lead pair down the backside, settled inside another while in the second pairing behind the

CHAMBERS tracked on the outside early on, moved into force the issue outside midway around the bend, pounced three wide taking control on the outside at the top of the stretch and drew away convincingly in the last eighth of a mile for the victory. RHUMBABA broke slowly on the start, recovered quickly to sit behind the pacesetter down the backstretch, rated kindly, waiting behind the contesting duo at the five sixteenths pole, moved out three wide in the hunt in upper stretch, could not get to the winner by the furlong pole but finished up well enough to best the rest comfortably for the place share in the end. MYMATHES CORRECT broke sharp to be alone up top down the backside, had company outside at the midpoint of the turn, surrendered the lead to the winner outside while two wide at the top of the lane, kept on trying to the end and narrowly held on for the show money inside at the wire. SOL DE VERANO was away sluggishly on the start having the rear down the backside, lagged behind through the bend, swung out widest in the six path at the top of the lane, found his best stride late and rallied outside in deep stretch just missing for the third place share at the wire. RIDE FOR THE PURSE improved on the fence though the backstretch to sit in the middle of the pack at the half, kept paced with others on the turn, shifted out three wide at the quarter pole gathering speed, moved back in two wide in upper stretch, finished up with energy in the final furlong but was on the losing end of a tight three way duel for the third place prize at the finish line. MONDAY MORNING stalked three deep close to the back, made little impact going three wide around the oval, angled to the four path for the drive for home and ran on one paced unable to get involved in the late stages. ALPHA KADIN stalked near the rear between horses, had little change running just off the rail around the bend, and offered little inside rivals in the stretch running. PIN BOY settled between runners in the three path sitting in mid-division down the backside, offered a brief run three wide on the turn narrowing the margin at the quarter pole, was in the mix four wide in upper stretch, stayed on the wrong lead through the lane shortening stride and folded by the furlong marker. ARAMI'S SPEIGHSTER travelled in midfield four deep outside foes, was hard rid
