MISTY EYED was under a snug hold prompting the pace inside down the back straight, coasted to the lead with the rider still in the saddle entering the turn, was set down for run hearing runners bearing down outside at the top of the lane, shot clear in the two path in mid-stretch and was kept to the task under left handed urging in the late going to win comfortably at the finish line. LEMONCELLA SPRITZ had the rail, inside another sitting in mid-division, saved ground keeping pace with rivals inside around the bend, skimmed the rail in upper stretch, shifted out for clear run soon afterwards in the two path, was no match for the winner at the furlong pole but did dig in late inside to fend off the oncoming rival at the wire besting the rest for the runners up share. BUFF BAY broke a touch slow at the start seeing the field leaving the chute, began to pick up rivals outside at the three eighths pole commencing a run, swung out widest gathering speed in the six path outside foes at the top of the stretch, could not threaten the winner who had plenty in reserve at the furlong pole, duelled outside for the place share in deep stretch but settled for the show money at the finish line. SAVE THE DATE settled on the outside in midfield, was the first runner to make a move, rallying three wide outside horses at the three eighths marker, loomed in the five path between foes straightening out for home, could not sustain the rally and stalled at the furlong pole. ROOKIE COURT was isolated, tracking the engaged pair down the backside, was scrubbed on for more at the five sixteenths pole closing the gap on the front pair on the turn to be in the mix three wide between horses turning for home, had little kick in the drive to the wire and weakened at the furlong marker. LA BELVA stalked near the rear on the fence in the beginning, was checked inside having tight quarters while coming up to the half mile marker down the backside, trailed the field midway around the turn while under a ride on the rail and could only pass a weary early leader inside at the top of the lane. HYPER ANGEL had a slim lead on the outside down the back straight, relinquished the front end at the three-furlong pole, was roused for more run at the quarter marker with the winner getting away, offered little response and emptied out being passed by rivals on either side while in the four path in upper stretch.

READY TO BATTLE bumped with a rival at the start, moved forward inside then shifted out past the three-quarters, stalked from outside, advanced shifting out from three to five wide commencing a bid, came into upper stretch six wide engaging in a duel, edged away late. NEENAH was caught three to four wide on the first turn gaining forward position to stalk, moved nearer to force the pace putting a head in front at the four- and one-half, dueled with the inside rival, edged to the lead near the quarter pole but was soon joined by an outside rival, dueled with that one but was no match. MIKELLE got away well, ceded the lead to track inside in hand and in behind the leaders, moved out while being asked for more coming past the quarter pole, ran on evenly and lacked the needed late kick. ONTARIO bumped with a foe at the start, settled mid-pack, raced outside foes up the backstretch, fanned eight wide turning for home, gained steadily outside. PERIWINKLE shifted in early, moved up to mid-pack inside, asked for run about the five-sixteenths, shifted seven wide into upper

stretch, ran on mildly late. PRINCESS JADE soon led moving in to set the pace nearer the inside, was prompted midway up the backstretch, dueled with the outside rival, was clearly overtaken leaving the far turn, came up empty in the stretch. RATINGS UPGRADE (IRE) angled in at the start, was reserved at the rear, swung six wide into upper stretch and passed tired foes. STARSHIP SERENITY was checked early racing three to four wide between foes into the first turn, was encouraged between foes on the far turn but failed to rally. FLIP FLOPS steadied early racing outside foes four to five wide, failed to menace. SNATCHED shifted in, saved some ground both turns, was ridden along inside three furlongs out but was not a factor.

BRAVO KATE had a narrow lead outside three deep in the beginning, shifted inwards getting a clear advantage on the fence heading into the bend, was nudged along unchallenged through the turn setting an even tempo, was urged in the two path in upper stretch, spurted away slightly at the furlong pole under right-handed asking and held safe under a well rated ride while keeping busy in late stages. STEALIN'TIME pressed the pace inside while in the two path down the back straight, was geared down giving up the fence to the leader who was angling in when entering the turn, narrowed the margin when roused for more shifting out at the quarter pole, posed the only opposition to the winner in the three path at the top of the lane, stayed on the wrong lead down the stretch, was edging closer late but could not threaten at the wire. I'M TENACIOUS was situated on the rail close to the back of the pack, made a good move advancing on the fence through the turn from the three furlong pole to the quarter marker, angled out four wide for the stretch run, could not gain on the lead duo by the furlong pole and ran on well enough to be a clear but non threatening third at the wire. MOVENTOTHECOUNTRY broke with the field initially, was taken back from the outer post to stalk outside of runners down the backside, was on hold going four wide at the three furlong pole, mounted a rally having to around horses five wide with a quarter mile to run, swung out widest in the six path at the top of the lane and finished up mildly outside runners to capture a minor placing in the final seventy yards. WORLD SHOWCASE settled inside another in midfield, got shuffled back between runners three wide at the three-furlong pole to be at the rear midway on the turn, scraped paint at the top of the stretch and finished with some interest inside horses while dueling for a minor role in the late stages. KNOTTY AND NICE bobbled on the break to trail the field into the backstretch, caught up to runners

travelling three deep at the half, made an early move for forward position three wide at the three furlong pole, chased the front pair in midturn but had to little to show between runners at the top of the stretch and retreated in the five path turning for home. LEZIATE tracked the front twosome while going three deep on the outside at the half, watched the loose leader while still between foes at the three furlong pole, was hard ridden in the three path but was going the wrong way in midturn, could not keep up to rivals going by on either side at the quarter pole and had nothing left to offer in the five path at the top of the stretch.

MOONLIGHT PROMISES quickly moved through to the lead, edged clear after the opening quarter, was challenged in upper stretch, fought on, was outkicked. CAIRO GIRL settled off the pace, moved out from four to six wide turning into upper stretch, finished best to be gaining but too late. MEW N ME tossed the head slightly at the start, moved forward inside tracking while saving ground, ran on evenly. HIBISCUS got away well, stalked from outside, was mostly three to four wide, lacked the needed late kick. TAP MY DESIRE broke awkwardly and slowly, raced outside at the back, came into upper stretch five wide, failed to menace. GALLEY HEAD had a good spot nestled on the rail keeping a close eye on the pacesetter, had an even better trip when isolated behind the embattled pair poised through the far turn, shifted out pouncing four wide between horses turning for home, took control at the furlong pole, stayed on the incorrect lead down the stretch and held on by a diminishing margin for the win at the wire. VOICE FROM ABOVE travelled in midfield inside paired up with another in the first part of this route race, was on hold in last behind a trio of runners at the three eighths marker, closed the gap sharply three wide at the quarter pole while in hand but was still looking for running room, angled inside just off the rail at the top of the stretch, finally had a clear path moving out three wide at the furlong marker and was gaining on the winner in deep stretch but could not get there in time with one final late surge. CANDID CANDACE settled on the inside in the second flight, was shuffled back losing positioning at the three-furlong pole with outside runners making a move, came with a rally inside horses midway on the final bend, shifted out at the quarter pole to bid between rivals six wide turning for home, determinedly kept fighting on through the lane and captured the show money while not that far off the winner in the end. GREY PRINCESS broke in but was quickly corrected at the start, trailed the field unhurried in the early stages, caught rivals outside by the half mile marker, ranged up passing foes three wide around the final bend, was fanned out seven wide in the hunt at the top of the stretch, kept on coming down the lane and was inching up outside in deep stretch to settle on the fringes while not beaten

that much at the finish line. I HAVE AN IDEA was roused slightly after the break clearing from the outer post to get the rail dictating the pace into the first turn, galloped along evenly settling into a good rhythm down the backstretch up top, was asked for more having to be urged to maintain the lead with an outside rival making an early move at the three furlong pole, repelled the challenger on the far turn by the quarter pole, was clinging onto the lead with a host of runners outside moving in, surrendered the front end softened up from the battle on the far turn, still fought on gamely inside horses until the seventy yard marker and faded late losing a couple of placings in deep stretch. P. S. RISING STAR stalked ahead of only one runner in the beginning, made a premature move at the half quickly progressing outside runners four deep, was hard ridden in the two path outside the frontrunner forcing the issue on the last turn, could not sustain the lengthy rally and wilted between foes in the four path straightening out for home. OLD FASHIONED GIRL settled outside another in mid-pack, could not keep up between horses on the far turn at the three furlong pole, could see the field with a quarter mile to run and passed a tired foe while in the four path in upper stretch. DOMER ALLURE had an outside tracking position watching the lead duo, dropped back at the three-furlong pole while under encouragement, retreated through the far turn and emptied out in the two path at the top of the lane.

GRAY DEE ONE assumed command heading into the backstretch, was well in control running in hand unopposed on the turn increasing the advantage by

the quarter marker, switched leads in the two-path finding more at the furlong marker, drifted out slightly in the late stages but still held safely for the front running score at the finish line. BLACK HAWK EAGLE travelled four deep in the third flight at the half mile marker, began to reach for more ground circling foes outside four wide at the five sixteenths pole, was in the hunt outside rivals in the four path straightening out for home, closed in belatedly behind the winner in the three path with a furlong remaining and just held on from a surging late challenger to best the rest for the place share. HEART TAP stumbled on the break to sit near the rear three deep outside foes down the backside, began to lengthen stride midpoint of the turn, angled out seven wide for the drive, flew home outside foes in the last eighth of a mile and was moving the fastest of all closing with a strong late rush to capture third money while just missing outside for the runners up share at the wire. WHISKEY OVER WINE tracked outside down the back straight, was hard ridden making no gain on the leader through the turn while outside another, battled between runners for the secondary share being no match for the winner at the eighth pole, stayed on the incorrect lead down the lane and faded in deep stretch to settle on the fringes in the end. SPUN FOR FLATTER drafted behind the pacesetter on the rail down the backstretch, came under a ride midway on the turn unable to close the gap on the frontrunner, dueled on the rail for the place prize at the furlong pole with the winner up top well in command, had little left late and weakened on the fence in the final seventy yards. SOCIALLY INTACT had a poor start, breaking in and brushing the gate at the start, settled in midfield inside foes at the half, had the rail in the third flight around the oval, shifted out to the two path at the quarter pole making a run, was in tight three wide between foes in upper stretch fighting for position, switched out sharply lacking running room to be in the five path at the furlong marker for clear run and finished up gradually but could not gear back in gear in time to threaten at the wire. GOLDEN GOOSE settled in the third tier having runners on each side down the back straight, kept pace when roused for more in midturn, was checked mildly losing momentum in tight between horses leaving the quarter pole and could not recover to factor in the late running. HAWBERRY was away slowly on the break well back of runners leaving the chute, caught up to the field on the rail at the three eighths pole, shifted out making a mild run at the five sixteenths pole, swung out widest in the eight path at the top of the lane and failed to menace in the drive to the wire. C C ATHENA broke inwards on the start, stalked close to the back inside two others at the half, kept pace running evenly taking the short way around the turn, skimmed the fence turning for home but had little to offer in the stretch running. LORRAINE'S BEAUTY settled between runners having a couple beaten down the backside, regressed through the turn, shifted out three wide in upper stretch and made little presence inside foes down the lane. HURRICANE AMELIA broke out on the start, settled in the third flight between horses at the half, dropped back unable to quicken with others on either side at the quarter pole and folded in the four path shortening stride in mid-stretch. ALBIE FIRST was hustled to get interested leaving the chute having a stalking role ahead of only one runner along the backside, was relegated to last at the three furlong pole, labored three wide around the turn and had nothing to offer in the stretch drive.

LITTLE TEDDY had the inside watching the front duo in the early stages, moved up smartly still in hand on the rail at the half, waited at the three furlong maker just behind the frontrunner, shifted outside midway on the far turn coming with a run, collared the leader outside three wide at the top of the stretch, switched leads reaching for more ground powering past going away at the eighth pole and was kept to business late to win comfortably when crossing the finish line. OLIVIA ROSE was on a mission opening up on the field going quickly through the first of two turns, rolled along unchallenged slowing the tempo

down slightly down the backside, remained up top but by shrinking advantage at the three-furlong marker, had a slim lead on the rail straightening out for the drive with the winner bearing down, offered no resistance by the furlong pole and kept going on late to easily hold for the runners up share at the wire. FASHIONABLY FAB sat all alone in midfield on the initial turn, took closer order at the half, was asked for more run on the rail picking up the bit at the quarter pole, shifted out to be two wide turning for home and finished up willingly for clear but non-threatening third at the wire. WAR PAINTER settled between runners near the rear, narrowed the margin having foes on each side at the half, closed in just off the rail at the three eighths pole, had to be throttled down for a moment lacking running room at the quarter marker, shifted out in the three path at the top of the lane and ran on mildly between rivals getting up for a minor share in deep stretch. SECRET LOAD had the fence stalking ahead of a quartet of runners on the first turn, co-trailed inside foes at the half, edged up saving ground on the last turn, hugged the rail at the top of the stretch and finished up with good energy rallying inside horses in the final furlong. MY GIRL SKY stalked near the rear going three wide on the first turn, had little movement through the backstretch outside horses, travelled in the three path with runners on either side making little headway on the final turn and ran on evenly between foes dueling for a minor share in the final furlong. VEERY hesitated on the break to trail at the start, moved up quickly while roused for run under the wire for the first time to watch the front pair three wide on the initial turn, tracked the loose pacesetter three deep at the half, was scrubbed on chasing the contesting twosome at the quarter pole, angled out in the four path for the drive to the wire but tired, yielding to inside runners in the final sixteenth of a mile. BEDAZZLE ME was taken a hold of when veering in on the break, trailed the field in the beginning, shared the rear three deep outside two others at the half, tried to circle around runners going four wide on the outside around the far turn, shifted out to the six path in upper stretch but failed to fire in the stretch drive. TALK TO YA LATER had the fence, stalking close to the back moving awkwardly for a few strides coming into the first turn, shared the rear with rivals on each side at the half, made little impression on the far turn relegated to last with a quarter mile to run and could not factor in the stretch running. LADY IN RED chased the brisk pacesetter on the first turn, narrowed the margin significantly on the leader down the backside by the half mile marker, drifted out slightly when giving way while outside the eventual winner at the five sixteenths pole and faltered between horses five wide in upper stretch. STEWARD'S GENERAL INQUIRY GOING INTO THE FIRST TURN RESULTED IN NO CHANGE

FLY THE W had a good set up, tucked in on the fence keeping a close eye on the front three runners in the early stages, moved in closer when asked for more at the five sixteenths pole, shot through finding a seam three wide to loom boldly in upper stretch and with a couple of taps with a right handed crop drew away convincingly for the win in the last sixteenth of a mile. EL KABONG was in hand loose up top around the first turn, rambled along uncontested down the backside, was nudged for more on the fence up top at the quarter pole hearing rivals closing in, narrowly was holding onto the lead inside two wide in upper stretch, had no answer when the winner charged outside at the sixteenth pole and just lasted at the wire for the runners up share. ARISTOTLE broke inwards on the start, stalked close to the back outside for the first half of this two-turn race, picked up the bit in the three path between runners moving in tandem with the outside foe at the three eighths pole, had a good chance five wide for a piece of the prize in upper stretch, never switched leads in the drive, kept on coming nonetheless, got up capturing the third money late at the seventy yard marker and almost caught up to the fading pacesetter at the wire for the runners up share as well. TOUR THE CITY had an overland route going five wide in midfield around the first turn, continued to move forward to track the lead pair three deep down the backside, crept closer going three wide outside the front twosome on the final bend, posed a threat in the four path outside the leaders turning for home but evened out in the final furlong to be a minor player in the end. POSTURING was unhurried trailing in the beginning, shared the rear outside at the half, mounted a rally swooping four wide around foes at the three furlong pole, angled out to be in the five path at the top of the lane, could not continue the run and stalled outside horses at the furlong marker. REALLY GOOD was jostled between runners on the break to be near the rear inside in the early going, co-trailed on the rail at the half, could not keep up with the field at the three furlong pole, began to get interested four wide with a quarter mile to run, swung out widest in the seven path at the top of the lane and passed a couple of weary foes in the stretch drive. FIGHTER IN THE WIN broke in at the start, was content to sit back off the pacesetter outside on the first turn and throughout the back straight, moved in to force the pace outside at the three-furlong pole, was hard ridden but could not maintain forward position three wide between rallying runners at the quarter pole and yielded in the three path to others by mid-stretch. FRIENDLY GHOST stumbled on the break, recovered to sit in midfield between horses on the first turn, had little movement on the rail along the backside, took the short way around the turn unable to narrow the margin on the leaders, shifted to the two path at the top of the stretch but flattened out on the rail at the furlong marker. SCUDERIA travelled four wide between horses in the middle of the pack in the first bend, continued in midfield outside at the half, backed away under drive with runners on each side at the five sixteenths pole and came up empty three wide at the top of the stretch.
