PROFESSOR RELOAD was jostled between rivals on the break, travelled five wide at the rear outside heading into the first of two turns, improved around horses through the initial bend, galloped along in midfield by the half, made a sharp move swooping outside horses four wide at the three eighths pole to get his head in front with a quarter mile from home, opened up slightly at the furlong pole and held safe albeit by a shrinking margin at the wire. CARRICK ON STAGE had the rail keeping a close eye on the frontrunner, settled into stride inside another in the second flight down the back straight, edged up on the rail having three furlongs still to run, waited to move at the quarter pole behind the engaged trio, shifted to the three path in the thick of things turning for home and ran on willingly between rivals getting closer to the winner late but settling for second best at the finish. SOUPER VINNIE had a tracking spot between runners, rated kindly outside in the second pairing down the backstretch, began to lengthen stride when urged on midway around the far turn to be three wide in the mix at the top of the stretch and finished up gradually outside foes in the final furlong to settle for the show money in the end. FRIENDLY settled close to the back inside in the beginning, stalked ahead of only one runner down the back straight, was scrubbed on for more at the three furlong pole offering little response around the final bend, angled out five wide turning for home and was one paced down the lane but did manage to catch the leg weary frontrunner in the shadow of the wire for a minor role. PLEASE DON'T GO cleared from the outer post getting to the rail taking this field around the first turn, narrowly had the lead inside down the backstretch, edged away at the three furlong pole, was collared outside by the winner with a quarter mile remaining, tried to counter on the fence briefly in upper stretch and wilted inside horses in the final sixteenth. GINGER'S HOLIDAY was bumped on the outside shortly after leaving the gate, settled close to the back in the four path between rivals early on, could see the field along the backside and throughout the final bend, moved to the four path for the drive to the wire but could not get involved. ARRAKASTA IZAN watched the leader while going three wide on the first turn outside foes, took closer order down the backstretch to shadow the pace at the half, was roused at the five sixteenths pole for more but could not quicken with rivals on either side making a run at the quarter marker and folded widest in the six path at the top of the lane.

AUDAX MINOR travelled four wide in midfield, took closer order to the pacesetter four deep at the five eighths marker, dropped back midway on the last turn, hugged the rail beginning to reach for more ground in upper stretch, moved out to the three path having a clear lane coming on at the furlong marker, switched leads late coming to the sixteenth pole finding another gear in deep stretch and surged in the final seventy yards to best the rest for the runners up share. DEPUTY CURLIN travelled three wide taking over command outside midway around the initial turn, dictated the easy pace while hounded outside down the backstretch, edged away from the early challenger with three furlongs still to run getting a slight breather through the final turn, was finally set down while runners closing in outside at the top of the lane and under a well rationed out ride had more when called upon to draw away again late for the win. EL CAPO was taken a strong hold off when eager inside fighting the rider relinquishing the front-end midway on the first of two turns, settled into a good rhythm inside foes in the middle of the pack at the half mile marker,, sat poised on the rail waiting for the cue behind the pacesetter on the fence through the second bend, shifted outside in the two path looking the main threat between rivals at the top of the stretch, tried to get to the winner at the furlong pole closing in mildly, was repelled with the winner having more by the sixteenth pole and ran on to be easily be second best on this day. PRINCECREST trailed the field early on going three wide around the first bend, had the outside position in the three path while in midfield down the back straight, offered a brief spurt three wide around horses at the five sixteenths pole, could not sustain the rally in the four path by upper stretch posing little threat to the front pair, battled outside for the show money in the final furlong but had to settle on the fringes in the end. MIND AND MUSCLE stalked near the rear settling in the two path in the beginning, galloped behind the soft pace seeing the tightly bunched group along the backside, could not advance on the far turn with the pace quickening at the quarter pole and could not be a factor on the fence in the late running.

ROAR OF THE CROWD had a good spot settling into stride comfortably watching the front pair early on, enjoyed what he saw isolated behind the embattled duo throughout the turn, took aim on the lead twosome three wide in upper stretch and relentlessly wore down the frontrunner in the shadow of the wire outside for the win. ISAAC LEO assumed command into the backstretch, dueled inside having a rival forcing the pace around the turn, had the fence disposing of the pesky outside foe by the furlong pole, determinedly kept on running to the wire but was unable to fend off the oncoming winner a few jumps before the finish line. CARNEW was quite content to sit back outside off the frontrunner along the backside, chased into the turn, turned up the pressure at the five sixteenths pole battling on the outside throwing it down the leader, stayed on the incorrect lead through the lane giving way fighting on the front end by the furlong marker and faded a touch late to easily hold for the show award at the finish line. CAPTIVATING NAME broke sharply at the start, dropped back to be in last leaving the chute, lagged behind runners at the half, started to pass rivals outside going three wide coming with a good run throughout the turn, shifted to the four path for the stretch drive but finished up evenly paced in the final furlong to settle on the fringes in the end. AETHELFLAED (IRE) was quickest out of the gate for the early advantage leaving the chute, dictated terms unchallenged along the backside, rambled along in hand setting a brisk tempo around the turn, switched leads in an instant just off the fence straightening out for the drive and was kept to the task late to safely hold for the gate to wire score with an impressive debut. PRIME EDGE stalked ahead of one runner three deep at the half, travelled three wide around horses making steady gain through the turn, shifted out four wide at the top of the lane, closed in smartly outside horses while never switching leads in the drive and got up for the place share in the last couple of jumps before the wire. TRIP ACES settled in the third flight having runners on each side early on, had little movement around the bend, angled to the three path in tight with the inside foe in at the top of the lane, found his best stride late at the furlong marker having a clear run and charged home in deep stretch just losing the nod for the runners up share inside at the finish line. KAMASI kept tabs on the frontrunner outside another down the backside, took closer order moving three wide on the turn to bid for the lead briefly at the quarter pole, chased the winner in vain in the three path down the stretch and faded inside rivals in the final seventy yards losing a couple of placings late. PARADISE PERFECT was under a snug hold having the rail in mid-pack, kept pace with runners while taking the short way around the oval when under encouragement, had to be throttled down for a few strides when behind a tiring rival coming to the quarter pole, moved out to the two path in upper stretch, dueled between horses for the show money with a sixteenth still to run but was outkicked in the late going. CHASING MEMORIES was under a tight rein tracking behind the frontrunner along the back straight, came under a ride but was being passed by an outside rival in midturn, was urged for more on the rail turning for home, had little to offer in the drive to the wire and yielded inside foes at the sixteenth pole. ACCELERANDO veered on the break, sat in midfield four deep into the backstretch, was relegated to last getting to the fence by the half, travelled two to three wide around the turn making little gain on runners and could not offer a finish in the late running in the three path.

THORNBURY bumped with a rival at the start, was quick to take the lead, set the pace in the clear, extended the advantage on the far turn swiftly opening up, held safe. HOLIDAY SNOOZE pursued from outside just off the leader, was encouraged from the seven-sixteenths, fought on outside to get the place. YORKTON'S HONOUR tracked from inside, came out in upper stretch, was outfinished for place. SPRUNG LOOSE broke a step slowly, shifted in early, saved ground both turns, ran on evenly. THOR'S CAUSE chased from mid-pack inside, came out eight wide in the stretch, ran on. AMERICAN DECISION brushed a rival at the start, was outside mid-pack three to four wide, steadily weakened. ITS IN THE CARDS bumped with a rival at the start, chased from between foes two to three wide, dropped back and faded. LOST STAR was brushed at the start, settled at the rear, made a mild advance up into rivals near the half, dropped back again soon after and faded in the stretch.

JAYHAWK hounded the pace outside in the four path through the first of two turns, kept a close eye never letting the frontrunner get away down the backstretch, was urged for more at the five sixteenths pole closing in, bid outside for the lead going head-to-head at the quarter pole, battled outside with a furlong to go and was unyielding in deep stretch when inching away between runners at the finish line for the hard fought victory. ENGLISH ACTOR had a slim lead on the inside going three wide on the first turn, galloped along up top just off the fence slowing the tempo down considerably along the backside, was collared outside at the quarter pole, fought on stubbornly nose to nose inside having the rail at the furlong marker never giving way and just missed in the very late stages with the winner edging ahead in the last few strides. MALIBU MAMBO was nestled on the rail watching the engaged pair on the first turn, followed the pacesetter sitting just behind down the back straight, drafted behind the contested duo coming under a ride through the far turn, shifted out off the lead pair in the three path at the furlong pole having a clear run, was coming on determinedly, creeping closer in the final sixteenth and took the show award between runners in a blanket finish for the four top spots at the finish line. SKYRO was under a snug hold outside watching the front three in the early stages, rallied three wide midway on the last turn narrowing the margin smartly on the lead pair by the quarter pole, threatened four wide very much in the thick of things outside the front trio at the top of the stretch, kept coming on willingly gaining outside with a sixteenth from home but had to settle for a minor share while not beaten that much for the top three positions in a thrilling late finish. WESTSIDE TIDE settled on the outside of a rival in mid-division, made little headway down the backside while three deep outside foes at the half, closed the gap three wide between runners at the quarter pole, angled five wide for the stretch drive with a chance for a piece of the prize in upper stretch but could only finish up one paced in the final eighth of a mile. LEGAL CATCH had inside position in the middle of the pack around the first bend, offered little change on the fence down the backstretch, saved ground holding his own through the last turn, shifted to the four path at the top of the lane but could not get involved in the late running. C MY MEISTER settled near the rear on the outside into the first turn, co-trailed inside another while in the three path down the back straight, could see the field through the final turn, shifted to the four path in upper stretch, angled inside at the furlong marker but made little impact in the late running. SEDBURYS GHOST leapt up at the break to trail on the fence in the beginning, shared the back end outside while in the four path at the half, offered a brief run trying to circle around horses four wide initially on the far turn, was fanned out widest in the six path turning for home and could not offer a rally outside foes through the lane.
