NAUGHTY DESTINY was under a snug hold taking command on the fence midway along the backside, opened up while in hand slowing the tempo down throughout the turn, was well in control on the rail in mid-stretch and held sway prevailing on the front end by a diminishing margin at the wire. DANCIN MARY MARIE had a good spot on the outside in the second flight, started to get into gear when nudged for run midway around the bend, posed the only threat just off the fence straightening out for home and was gaining steadily at the furlong but it wasn?t enough to get to the winner at the finish line. SERIOUS GREEN stalked in the early going having rivals on either side, began to lengthen stride edging up between foes at the five sixteenths pole to be in the mix three wide at the top of the lane and finished up willingly to be a non threatening third in the end. HYPER HOLIDAY settled close the the back, having only one runner beaten in the early stages, made little impression around the bend, angled to the six path gathering momentum and ran on willingly outside rivals to be a fringe player when crossing the finish line. NOYZEE GIRL was situated in midfield, three deep outside challengers down the backside, made little progression going outside foes three wide in the running around the turn, had a chance for a piece of the prize between horses in the four path at the top of the stretch but could only finish up one paced through the lane. SWEET VALENTINE advanced inside of horses along the backside, stalled with the run shifting outside at the five sixteenths pole, angled out to the three path in upper stretch and lacked a rally on the rail in the final furlong of the stretch running. REALLOVEISLUCKY travelled in the three path, unhurried at rear down the back straight, continued at the back end going three wide making little impact around the oval, swung out widest in the six path at the top of the lane and passed weary runners outside by the sixteenth pole. CRUMLIN BEACH broke a step slow seeing the field at the start, improved on the fence down the backside to track the front two inside another at the half, took the short way around the turn keeping pace, had to be throttled down for a few strides lacking running room coming up to a tiring rival at the quarter pole, hugged the rail turning for home and had little to offer inside runners down the lane. NO LAYUPS pressed the pace inside until the half mile marker, chased the frontrunner on the fence but was losing ground at the midturn point, had little left for the drive to the wire and wilted in the two path in upper stretch.

WICO (IRE) was on the outside of a rival in the second tier tracking the lead twosome down the backside, closed the gap outside another on the turn by the quarter pole, was coming to the leader in the four path in upper stretch, dueled with a furlong from home for the top spot and edged clear on the outside in deep stretch for the win. GROOT had rail position inside another down the backside in mid-division, crept closer at the quarter pole taking the short way around the bend, loomed in the two path between foes at the top of the stretch, vied with runners on both sides battling up front at the furlong pole, ran on determinedly to the wire but was outkicked by the winner outsiside in the final seventy yards. RY PIE travelled close the the back with rivals on each side down the back straight, was relegated to the rear at the half, began to pick up the bit three wide around horses at the five sixteenths marker, swung out widest in the six path straightening out for the drive and finished up with good late energy to capture the show money in deep stretch. CRUCIAL TAUNT broke a touch slow at the start to see the field early on, had the fence stalking ahead of only one rival by the half mile marker, was looking for running room behind runners on the rail in midturn, found a seam four wide, following the eventual winner in upper stretch and ran on mildly in the last furlong to garner a minor placing in the end. LOVE YOU LIPPY broke sharp, angling inwards quickly getting to the fence by the nine sixteenths pole, rolled along well in hand with the rider quiet in the saddle around the turn increasing the advantage at the quarter pole, was set down for more at the furlong marker and coasted home in deep stretch for the dominant gate to wire score. MITOLE POWER shared the rear inside with a half mile remaining, could see the field saving ground throughout the bend, had a good turn of foot mounting a rally angling out between horses four wide turning for home and closed in belatedly outside rivals in the final furlong to be a distant second best at the finish line. QUIET MADDELENA was away alertly, forcing the pace inside in the beginning, took back when reined in on the fence at the half to sit in midfield, started to make a run inside foes at the quarter pole, kept on coming in the two path at the top of the stretch and had a good late surge on the fence inside horses with a sixteenth left to go capturing the show money at the wire. ONDINE LADY was roused down the backstretch improving from the rear to chase the pacesetter inside another with four furlongs still to go, kept pace with the leader having the fence around the oval, hugged the rail in the hunt turning for home, drifted to the two path by the furlong pole and evened out in the late drive to settle for a minor placing in the end. SHAMRA travelled outside horses four deep in mid-pack down the backstretch, was urged to go after the frontrunner making a rally three wide around rivals at the five sixteenths pole, had the three path in the mix at the top of the lane, could not find more late and weakened between rivals in the final

sixteenth of a mile. BLAZING SKY co-trailed on the outside at the half mile marker, travelled three wide through the bend having little movement, angled out to the five path for the stretch drive but could not get involved in the late running. TREVESS tracked the frontrunner outside down the back straight, gave way midway on the turn when rivals on either side went past when starting to make a rally, had little to offer turning for home and emptied out four wide in upper stretch.

DRAKE DRIVE hopped slightly on the break, poked his head in front on the inside down the backstretch, edged away for a clear advantage on the turn with a quarter mile to go, scraped paint spurting away from his closest pursuers in mid-stretch and kept to the task in the final furlong to just prevail at the wire for the front end win. PRINCE ALMASTY was away slowly at the break to stalk on the rail down the backside, shifted out at the five sixteenths pole starting to come with a rally, angled five wide between rivals at the top of the lane and was full of run in the final furlong closing in sharply but was denied for the victory, ending up just shy of the winner outside at the finish line. CONN SMYTHE (GB) was brushed on the inside on the start, settled outside of runners in midfield along the backside, moved in through the turn narrowing the margin smartly by the quarter pole, posed the main threat three wide between foes in upper stretch, dueled up top with a sixteenth of a mile remaining but was no match for the front two runners in deep stretch while easily holding for the tird place share in the end. SILENT KNIGHT broke outwards on the start, was void of early foot trailing in the early going, lagged well behind the group through the turn, swung out widest in the six path at the top of the stretch and finished up mildly to pass a couple of weary foes down the lane. SWITZLER JAMMIN contested the pace outside down the backstretch, was scrubbed on for more but could not match strides with the winner by the quarter pole, chased in vain two wide in upper stretch and faltered on the fence by the sixteenth pole. LIVININTHEFASTLANE vied between runners in the beginning, settled inside another rivals keeping a close eye on the engaged duo at the half, was asked for run midturn but could not gain on the lead pair around the bend, had little left for the drive and folded on the fence at the furlong marker.
