MID DAY IMAGE was patiently handled, in hand moving well within himself pressing the pace on the rail along the backside, shook loose saving ground into the turn to have a clear advantage with five sixteenths remaining, had company outside while two wide straightening out for the drive, was finally asked for more run at the furlong pole, quickly repelling the challenger with a sixteenth to go and comfortably held safe for the win at the finish line. COLONEL MUSTARD had a stalking role, ahead of a couple of runners along the back straight, started to get into gear circling around foes four wide two furlongs from home, found his best stride in the four path in mid-stretch, could not threaten the winner late but closed in well to best the rest for the runners up share. GALVASTON was part of the mix on the front end leaving the gate, took back at the nine sixteenths marker to have a good spot isolated watching the engaged trio by the half, closed in sharply three wide midway on the turn to loom boldly on the outside, three wide turning for home, fought on down the lane but could not get to the winner by the sixteenth pole and faded in the late stages to settle for a clear third at the wire. ROYAL QUALITY co-trailed on the inside in the early going, narrowed the margin beginning to lengthen stride inside runners at the quarter pole, split runners three wide in upper stretch and ran on mildly down the lane to be a fringe player in the end. ACTION POINT shared the rear while outside foes along the backside, made no progression around the bend to be at the rear with a quarter mile from home, swung out widest in the five path at the top of the lane but could only manage to pass the tiring rivals that were softened up dueling for the lead in the early going at the furlong marker. PANYARD TAP vied between horses up front down the wind aided backstretch, was the first of the three rivals up top to give way at the five sixteenths pole, retreated through the turn and was empty in the two path by upper stretch. TRICKY MAGICIAN contested the early pace going three deep outside runners along the back straight, chased the frontrunner in vain with rivals on either side by midturn, was holding on for a small share just off the fence at the top of the lane, had little left in the late running and folded inside horses by the furlong marker.

INDY ONE was content to sit outside off the frontrunners flank down the back straight, sat poised just behind the leader waiting for the cue throughout the turn, pounced three wide outside at the top of the stretch, seized control leaving the eighth pole and was kept to the task late to hold safe for the win at the finish line. UNCAPTURED MOMENT had a good spot tracking the front pair early on, travelled in the second flight outside another watching the lead duo around the bend, shifted to the four path between horses at the top of the lane and closed in belatedly to be second best on this day. KINETIC STONE had a slim advantage on the rail down the backside, edged away unchallenged in the running around the turn, had company outside while in the two path turning for home, fought on until the furlong pole unable to withstand the winners charge late and was nabbed outside nearing the wire for the second place share. HIGHLY FLAMMABLE travelled outside a couple of horses settling in mid-pack, kept pace with rivals while running three wide around the oval, moved out to the five path in with a chance for a share of the prize in upper stretch but could only finish up one paced down the lane for a minor placing in the end. JAMIESTA was unhurried seeing the field at the half, lagged behind on the turn, closed the gap on rivals with a quarter mile to run, passed a rival five wide in upper stretch and picked up another foe inside with seventy yards still to run. MASTER SPY settled in mid-division inside rivals along the backside, had to be checked, in tight trying to dart through on the fence at the seven sixteenths pole, lost momentum travelling around the bend and could not factor in the stretch running.

NO WHAMMIE shared the rear while on the outside of another early on, closed in going three wide around horses on the turn, angled out widest in the six path full of run at the top of the lane, seized control with a sixteenth to run and held outside in a tight finish at the wire. MI TORMENTA co-trailed on the inside down the back straight, edged up taking the shortest route around the bend, scraped paint to be in the conversation up top straightening out for home, darted through inside at the sixteenth pole but just missed with a late surge, losing the head nod at the finish line. VICTORIA ELIZABETH vied between runners early on, had a tracking position watching the engaged duo at the half, waited for the cue to move keeping a close eye on the lead pair on the turn, shifted out in the five path for the drive, was in tight between rivals in early upper stretch, had clear run in the hunt at the furlong pole, could not keep up to the top two horses late but did manage to win the battle for the third place share in a photo at the finish. REALLY THIRSTY had the rail narrowly up front down the backside in the beginning, dueled inside around the oval, edged away disposing of the early speed rival while in the two path at the top of the stretch, still was clinging onto the front with a furlong to go having rivals bearing down on each side and faded between horses in the final sixteenth, just missing holding for the show money at the wire. VANDOO settled on the outside in mid-pack, was relegated to the rear between horses at the three furlong marker, narrowed the margin slightly through the bend to be in within striking distance three wide in upper stretch, had little for the late running and could only pass a weary foe in deep stretch. SASSY MELISSA battled outside down the backstretch, continued to duel outside bobbing heads up top throughout the turn, had enough giving way in the four path between rivals turning for home and folded by the furlong marker.

FORESTERS EXEC travelled in the second flight outside down the back straight, began to reel in the embattled duo by midturn, pounced four wide taking the lead in upper stretch, kept finding more when called upon in the stretch drive and just lasted inside others for the win at the wire. REACH FOR THE TOP broke outwards on the start, stalked near the rear at the half mile marker, co-trailed on the outside of another challenger through the turn, had a full head of steam six wide at the top of the stretch outside rivals, grinded away down the lane and had one final push late but was nosed out at the finish line. ENCHANTED FOREST lagged behind the field early on, settled on the rail in the third pairing around the bend, rallied four wide with the speed horses coming back at the top of the stretch, fought on gamely between the stablemates in the final sixteenth up front but was on the losing end of a three way finish for the win. CRUMLIN TROUBLE travelled inside others in midfield, kept pace hugging the fence around the turn, scraped paint straightening out for the drive, shot through inside with clear run leaving the furlong marker and got up late for a minor role in the end. SUIGU BELLE broke alertly for the early advantage, had company outside at the half, battled on the fence going head to head around the bend, continued inside in the mix turning for home and faltered while drifting out slightly at the furlong pole. RHAENYRA was bumped inside on the break, recovered quickly to force the issue down the backside, dueled outside throughout the turn, still remained in the hunt in the two path between foes at the top of the lane, stopped at the furlong marker and cantered across the finish line.

SOUPER STRIDER got to the rail setting in mid-pack by the half, waited behind runners at the five sixteenths pole inside looking for a seam, skimmed the fence shooting through in upper stretch to seize command, edged away at the furlong pole and just held on from a relentless rival coming back on outside at the wire. WOODGLEN COURT was forwardly placed on the fence keeping a close eye on the lead threesome down the back straight, advanced on the rail around the bend to battle inside up top by the quarter pole, drifted out two wide letting the winner slip up the fence for the lead in upper stretch, tenaciously fought back in the final seventy yards resurging late but came up just shy on the outside at the finish line. ASHUKA settled on the outside of another in mid-division by the half, inched up around rivals taking the overland route going three to four wide on the turn, angled out five wide for the drive to the wire and had a goid late run to be a clear but non threatening third when crossing the finish line. DEVIL'S TONGUE had the rail dictating the pace down the back straight, was collared on each side at the quarter pole, tried to battle back between foes in upper stretch, yielded inside runners at the furlong marker but did run on to save for a minor share in the end. BIG LEW travelled three deep watching the lead pair, rallied smartly around foes three wide on the turn to bid for the lead at the quarter pole, angled to the four path in the thick of it all outside foes in upper stretch, could not continue the run and wilted between rivals by the sixteenth pole. Z HUB stalked ahead of only the troubled starter in the early going, made no headway on the group throughout the turn, shifted to the

four path at the top of the lane and managed to pass a straggler outside in the final sixteenth of a mile. GERALD chased the pacesetter outside down the backside, retreated three wide running around the turn and could not factor inside rivals having the two path in the stretch drive. PUREHEARTS BANDIT was away awkwardly spotting the field many lengths down the backside, lost touch with the pack around the turn and galloped home, crossing the finish line
