DEPUTY GHOST veered out on the break, settled in midfield outside others down the back straight, mounted a three wide rally at the three eighths pole measuring the lead duo around the turn, pounced four wide turning for home and drew away with authority in the final furlong. QUADZILLA was content to sit outside watching the pacesetter in the beginning, was scrubbed on three furlongs out closing in on the bend to battle outside by the quarter marker getting a head in front, vied between runners in the three path in upper stretch but was no match for the overpowering winner in the final furlong. IKNOWYOUCANWAIT had a stalking trip ahead of only the troubled start in the early going, started to get into gear reaching for more ground shifting off the fence with five sixteenths from home, moved out to the four path for the drive to the wire and ran on willingly not switching leads to be a distant third in the end. KEY CORNERSTONE was off a touch slow, recovered quickly to be loose up top by the five eighths marker, had a shrinking advantage by the midpoint of the turn, was collared outside by a couple of rivals hugging the rail at the top of the stretch, could not continue on and faded at the furlong marker, staying on the incorrect lead right through to the finish line. DRI SADDLE was situated on the rail sitting a few lengths behind the pacesetter along the backside, was roused for more but was going the wrong way in midturn, angled to the four path but came up empty for the drive. ROSE FOR CARRICK was away slowly spotting the field by many down the backside, made no headway throughout the turn and could not recover from the poor start to be a factor in the late running. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.

MADAM GWEN was tucked in on the rail under a snug hold behind the frontrunner, settled inside another in the second flight down the backstretch rating kindly, drafted behind the lead trio waiting for the cue to go on the last turn, burst through rivals in the two path entering the stretch, was full of run four wide driving by at the furlong pole and held safe from a fast closing outside foe in deep stretch. MAGICAL TRICK had the inside spot siting in the middle of the pack, stalked near the rear on the rail down the back straight, began to pick up the bit three wide with three eighths remaining, made a big circling run, widest in the six path straightening out for home, closed in sharply down the lane but was drifting out under a left handed crop at the furlong pole and had one final late surge outside but just missed getting to the winner at the wire. PEACE POSEY was unhurried trailing in the early stages, took the short way around the last turn making little movement, started to come with a run on the rail turning for home, angled off the tiring early leader two wide at the eighth pole and had a good late finish to get up for the show money. SHE TAKES CASH broke outwards on the start, had the outside position in midfield on the first turn, improved down the backside on the outside to sit in the second flight at the half, mounted a run just off the fence at the five sixteenths marker, tried to swoop around runners four wide gathering speed at the quarter marker, loomed in the five path at the top of the stretch but needed more late when stalling in the final sixteenth of a mile. ANITA MARGARITA had the front end just off the rail setting a soft tempo, remained up top still going at a pedestrian pace along the backside, saved ground maintaining a slim advantage around the second turn, hugged the rail clinging onto the front end at the top of the lane, had no answer with rivals closing outside at the furlong pole and wilted inside runners in the last sixteenth of a mile. THATSITTHATSALL tracked outside on the initial bend, took closer order to hound the leader outside at the half, prompted the pace with rivals on either side through the far turn and

folded in tight between foes three wide at the top of the stretch. DUCKDUCK stumbled to his knees at the start, recovered smartly down the backside to watch the front three rivals at the half, had good outside position in the second flight in hand keeping a close eye on the embattled duo around the bend, moved in to be in the hunt four wide at the top of the stretch, captured the lead leaving the furlong marker between rivals and prevailed to the wire with an impressive game effort considering the start. MR. PERFECT travelled in the five path sitting in mid-division at the half, had a good turn of foot picking up inside runners three wide in midturn, moved out looming boldly five wide at the top of the stretch, drifted in at the furlong pole having to correct his course in the late running, could no go past the winner in deep stretch and just saved for the second place share at the wire. MILITARY FORCE was lightly bumped at the start, settled into stride off the leaders, went three to four wide on the turn and was encouraged nearing the five-sixteenths, fanned out six wide turning for home, kept on late to get up for place. BELLS OF PARADISE had inside position watching the frontrunner, inched up going outside to the two-path midway on the bend, moved to the leader three wide straightening out for home, took control with just a shake of the reins at the furlong marker, drifted in under right-handed encouragement at the sixteenth pole while clear and held sway at the finish line for the win. BOSSY CANDY had a stalking trip on the rail to begin, edged closer taking the short way around the bend, had to be put on hold behind runners having no room at the five sixteenths pole, found a seam skimming the fence at the top of the lane, darted through to be the main opposition for the winner at the furlong pole, angled out losing her path when the leader drifted in at the sixteenth pole, kept coming to the wire, could not get there in the end but easily bested the rest for the runners up share. MYSTICAL MAGIC travelled four deep near the rear in the early running, was a touch eager behind a wall of foes at the three-furlong pole seeing the field, had to check out slightly wanting to get outside horses in midturn, closed the gap sharply swinging out widest, seven abreast at the top of the stretch, ran greenly veering inwards for a moment in upper stretch, did not switch leads in the drive but still was closing belatedly down the lane and finished up to be a good but non threaten third at the wire. ALLURING AMY broke out on the start, had a tracking position three deep down the back straight, settled into stride on the outside of others in the second flight through the turn, was in the conversation up front four wide straightening out for the drive, could not quicken with the lead pair by the eighth pole and evened out late holding for a minor share in the end. VANISH was brushed outside on the start, tracked between rivals at the half, was shuffled back at the three furlong marker to be last at the guarter pole, angled to the three path for the drive to the wire and had good late energy improving inside foes in the final seventy yards. KNOCKONWOOD veered in on the break but was quickly corrected, sat in midfield in the early going, offered a brief run three wide at the three furlong pole until the top of the stretch five wide, could not continue on with others on each side and stalled with an eighth of a mile still to run. TWIST OF SUGAR was away alertly to be loose on the lead down the backside, rolled along unopposed around the oval, was collared on both sides in the

two path turning for home, had little left to give in the late running and faltered at the furlong pole. SIENNA AURA tossed her head at the start, stalked near the rear along the back straight, tried to circle around horses four wide around the turn, still was in with a chance a piece of the prize in the six path between rivals at the top of the lane, could not sustain the rally and wilted in the final furlong.

DANCETOTHERHYTHM was brushed on the inside at the start, sat unhurried seeing the field outside down the back straight, started to lengthen three wide outside foes into the turn, made a sharp circling rally four wide outside rivals at the five sixteenths pole, was in full flight outside the leaders at the top of the stretch, wore down rivals down the lane and drove by determinedly in the final seventy yards for the win. GRETNA GREEN tracked outside in the early going, edged up outside another foe on the bend to bid for the lead at the quarter pole, vied between foes in the three path straightening for home, fought on stubbornly to gain the lead briefly with a sixteenth remaining but could not fend off the late charge outside by the winner in deep stretch. SPELLCHECK had the outside trip in mid-pack down the back straight, took closer order with runners on either side on the turn at the five sixteenths pole, was in the thick of things four wide at the top of the stretch, could not quicken with the lead duo who had it to themselves in the final furlong but kept on trying to the end and captured the show money in deep stretch. MOBULA was forwardly placed watching the front trio at the half mile marker, got shuffled back having no room to go with the outside flow of runners making a rally in midturn, shifted to the three path turning for home then four wide getting clear run at the furlong pole and finished up mildly to capture the minor placing outside in the final few strides. BALLS IN UR COURT broke outwards on the start, was all alone dictating terms up top along the backside, narrowly remained on the front end inside when challenged at the quarter marker, still was holding on with outside rivals bearing down leaving the eighth pole but faded with a sixteenth to run, losing a couple of positions inside runners late. KIMBERLINA settled on the fence in midfield at the half, made little headway inside rivals on the turn, hugged the rail in upper stretch narrowing the margin but failed to fire in the final furlong. RUTHLESS ACTION settled on the outside close to the back of the pack, made little movement three wide between rivals on the turn, angled to be five wide at the top of the lane and showed little outside horses in the late running. GO GEMMA stalked near the rear on the inside, was passed by outside challengers to be in last position at the three furlong pole and around the oval, could not progress on the bend and while in the three path down the stretch drive could only pass a weary straggler in deep stretch. PRETTY GOOD JOKE had an inside tracking position down the backside, drafted behind the pacesetter on the fence
