WILDFIRE was under a snug hold sitting behind the frontrunner in the beginning, waited to move watching the lead trio while on the fence around the bend, was asked for more at the quarter pole to be in the hunt hugging the rail in upper stretch, switched leads and gears at the sixteenth pole and got up in the final few strides for the win. BENNYS JETS was jostled between horses on the break, recovered through the backstretch to sit behind the engaged twosome at the half three deep, moved around horses comfortably coming to the leader midturn, pounced four wide taking over control at the top of the lane, was under a busy ride trying to hold off the winner inside in the final eighth of a mile but just missed in the shadow of the wire unable to secure the win. BUCYK was checked in tight quarters at the nine sixteenths pole, stalked near the rear but was headstrong at the half, advanced smartly in midturn, angled out at the quarter pole closing the gap, continued with the good rally five wide turning for home, was no match for the front duo with a furlong remaining but finished up well enough to be a clear third at the wire. ALPHA KADIN broke inwards on the start to see the field outside rivals down the backside, was forced out four wide trying to avoid the troubled runner at the three furlong pole, got back into gear with a quarter mile to run, angled to the five path at the top of the lane and had a good late finish outside horses in the final furlong to get up late to be a fringe player in the end. TIERNAN pulled the rider along the backstretch to press the pace outside by the half mile marker, chased the frontrunner between horses through the turn, was in the mix three wide at the top of the stretch but weakened with rivals on either side at the furlong marker. KNOWING bobbled on the break, was taken a hold of early in the

backstretch to be near the rear at the half, was checked when behind the troubled rival entering the turn losing all momentum and could not factor afterwards. SCARY SPEEDY broke sharp getting the early advantage, had company outside by the half, continued up top around the turn, was collared on each side two wide turning for home, offered little resistance and folded by the sixteenth pole. ANOTHER CHARLIE settled between rivals in mid-division along the backside, stumbled badly almost unseating the rider at the seven sixteenths pole, was eased around the turn four to five wide avoiding runners and galloped down the lane crossing the finish line. DIXIE LAW had the two-path watching the pacesetter in the early going, was reined in on the first turn to rate kindly outside another in midfield down the backstretch, started to mount a rally when only nudged on midway on the last turn, had a sharp turn of foot swooping four wide around horses at the quarter pole to take command turning for home, opened up at the furlong marker and was kept to the task late to hold safe for the victory. VANITY shared the back inside a runner on the first of two turns, made little movement along the backside, shifted off the rail starting to come with a run at the five sixteenths pole, angled out between runners five wide straightening out for home, stayed on incorrect lead down the lane but never wavered to the wire, still kept coming on to the end unable to get to the winner late while besting the rest for the runners up share at the finish line. KATIE'S GRACE broke just a step slow in the beginning to co-trail on the outside, stalked in the third tier outside down the back straight, edged up going three wide outside horses at the five sixteenths pole, was fanned out widest in the six path at the top of the lane and ran on with good late energy to be a clear third at the wire. BACKSTREET EMMA was rank on the rail fighting the rider tracking the leader on the first turn, settled down in the backstretch paired up in the second flight with the eventual winner on her outside, saved ground waiting for the cue to move watching the contesting duo on the far turn, scraped paint in the mix at the top of the stretch and finished up mildly inside runners for a minor placing in the end. BOLD TIME was loose on the lead in the three path on the first turn, dictated a slow and even pace while prompted outside by a rival, was scrubbed on having the fence narrowly up top with five sixteenths to go, had no answer when collared outside by the winner turning for home and wilted between horses at the sixteenth pole. DYNA travelled four wide into the first turn keeping a close eye on the frontrunner, moved in down the backstretch to shadow the pace outside, came under a ride trying to hold position vying up top midway around the final turn, had little to give by upper stretch and folded three wide at the top of the lane.

THE BIG CON (GB) was taken back off the leaders early heading to the first turn, fought a bit while steadying just slightly entering that bend, tracked under rating tactics in behind the leaders on or just off the rail, got through in the two path at the top of the stretch, took command in upper stretch and just moved clear, was asked past the furlong marker, responded late to hold an outside challenger at bay. SILENT TACTIC settled three wide between foes into the first turn, dropped back a bit up the backstretch, began to advance four then five wide on the far turn, gained to loom a threat outside the flank of the winner nearing the sixteenth pole but was turned away. WEMBLEY AVENUE settled inside at the rear, saved ground both turns getting through inside foes in upper- to mid-stretch, came off the fence a bit, kept on to be best of the rest. BUIUM settled outside at the rear, fanned six wide into the stretch gaining on the leaders but evened out thereafter. BIG TIME BOSS stalked from outside three to four wide, was ridden past the three-eighths, weakened in the stretch. GONE WITH DUWYN moved to the lead and clear into the first turn, set the pace from off the rail and was rated early up the backstretch slowing it down a bit, was challenged and overtaken in upper stretch and weakened in the lane. MADAGASCAR switched outside the leader past the seven-eighths to stalk from outside off the fence, was asked for more by the three-eighths, dropped back and faded.

DARK SCREEN was content on the rail sitting just behind the frontrunner, became headstrong having to be hard held at the seven sixteenths pole, settled into stride again having a good spot on the rail keeping close tabs on the contesting pair around the oval, found a seam in the two path at the top of the stretch, burst through runners to take control leaving the furlong marker and drew away at the wire for the win. FORESTER'S FORTUNE co-trailed outside rivals travelling three deep early on, made a good rally circling around horses four wide through the bend, was full of run reaching for more ground in the five path in the drive to the wire, could not get to the winner late but finished up strongly nonetheless and captured the secondary share just before the finish line outside. ARTEMUS CITYLIMITS travelled three deep tracking the leader down the backstretch, moved in to prompt the issue outside around the bend, was in the hunt in the three path straightening out for the drive, could not quicken with the winner to his inside at the furlong pole and just missed holding for the runners up share inside nearing the wire. ONE TRUE GENTLEMAN bobbled on the break, sat between rivals part of the rear trio at the half, saved ground edging up inside horses through the turn, shifted out four wide with a chance in upper stretch and finished up one paced down the stretch for a minor placing in the end. SILENT RESERVE was hard ridden, intent on getting the lead down the backside, maintained a narrow advantage on the fence while pressed outside throughout the turn, had the rail just holding on up top in upper stretch, relinquished the lead to the winner outside at the furlong pole and could not

find more in deep stretch, fading in the final seventy yards. SHAKOO MAKOO watched the frontrunner between horses along the backstretch, still tracked the leader with rivals on each side making little headway in midturn, angled out to the four path at the top of the lane, had little for the stretch run and flattened out at the furlong marker. YODDHA was at the back of the pack with runners on either side down the back straight, made no progression on the turn seeing the field and failed to menace, unable to get involved in the stretch running. This race was originally hand timed and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate times.

ROI SOLEIL rated kindly going three deep outside foes seeing the field, glided up around horses four wide on the turn moving very strong at the quarter pole, had a quick turn of foot five wide at the top of the stretch having full run, went past rivals outside by the sixteenth pole and edged away at the finish line for the win. LIGHT THE LAMP had the rail position in the middle of the pack down the backstretch, had to be throttled down when eager pulling the rider closer at the half, had nowhere to go drafting behind the frontrunner inside rivals waiting for a seam to appear midway on the turn, scraped paint darting up the fence having a clear lane in mid-stretch and ran on determinedly unable to quicken with the winner who had full flight down the stretch but did finish up smartly inside rivals to be a troubled second best on this day. GO KART MOZART broke sharp to have the lead on the fence by the five eighths marker

while in hand, narrowly kept the advantage on the turn inside with the field bunching up at the five sixteenths pole, angled to the three path in upper stretch still having his head in front with rivals bearing down on either side, did not switch leads fighting up front down the lane, gave way to the winner outside with seventy yards to run and lasted at the finish to hold for the show money. I'M A GAMBLER (IRE) was unhurried inside two others stalking near the rear along the backside, was relegated to last at the quarter pole in the three path with the entire field separated by only a couple of lengths, angled out to the four path looking for a seam and ran on mildly in the stretch drive to get up late to settle on the fringes in the end. OLD CHESTNUT travelled in mid-division on the outside down the back straight, moved closer splitting runners three wide at the five sixteenths pole, charged outside in the four path to bid for the lead turning for home, could not sustain the rally and evened out in the last sixteenth of a mile just getting caught outside for the minor award. CRUMLIN LAD vied between runners early on, settled in midfield with the group very compact at the three eighths pole, was looking for running room on hold with the pack clustered at the quarter pole, was well within striking distance in upper stretch but had no kick to offer in the final furlong. TIME FOR TRUTH chased the pacesetter three deep down the backside, continued to keep a close eye on the front runner between foes not letting the leader get away in midturn, could not hold forward position three wide with runners rallying on both sides at the top of the stretch and had little left for the drive, faltering at the furlong marker.
