BEAUTIFUL SKY was unhurried co-trailing on the inside early on, improved along the backside to sit between foes in mid-division having a half mile still to run, was shuffled back through the final bend inside of runners to be in last place at the quarter pole, swung out widest, getting into gear in the six path in upper stretch, was in full flight reaching for more ground at the furlong pole and powered past in the final seventy yards outside to clear off for the win at the wire. MAXINE MAGIC rated kindly having the fence beside another watching the lead duo in the early stages, saved all the ground inching up around the far turn, angled three wide in the hunt with rivals on each side at the top of the lane, dueled stubbornly up top from the eighth pole home but was no match for the late charge from the winner in deep stretch. REMARKABLY HUMAN veered in on the start, dictated a soft pace ahead of rivals through the first turn, slowed the tempo down even further down the wind aided backstretch increasing the advantage slightly at the half, maintained the front spot around the last bend, narrowly remained up top two wide inside with runners bearing down at the head of the lane, gave way grudgingly being outkicked by the winner in the final seventy yards but did last in a tight finish for the show money. NICKI IS A BREEZE settled nicely under a snug hold on the outside in the second flight in the beginning, travelled three deep in midfield at the half, was gaining mildly three wide between foes to loom in the five path straightening out for the drive, could not find more in the late running and evened out to settle for a minor share in the end. LOVE STRIKE was content to track the pacesetter outside on the first of two turns, continued to sit outside shadowing the leader down the back straight, chased, but could not make any headway on the frontrunner in the second bend, still remained in the mix three wide for a share in upper stretch, had little left late and wilted in the final furlong. SPEAK UP was outside another runner sharing the back around the first turn, trailed the field at the half, offered a brief rally going four wide trying to swoop around horses from the five sixteenths pole until the quarter marker, could not sustain the run and folded in the five path at the top of the stretch.

HOLIDAY ROSE settled off the pace inside, moved out and was ridden past the three-eighths advancing three to four wide on the turn, was no match for the winner but second best. STERLING HEIGHTS had some bumps at the start and was in tight, settled toward the back off the inside, was roughly two wide on the turn racing up in behind foes, came out six wide in upper stretch, was along for show. LIAM'S AWESOME switched out off the inside early stalking between foes two to three wide, dropped back despite some encouragement on the turn, shifted in leaving that bend, kept on inside in the stretch to gain a better placing. SEVEN P R C was forwardly-placed early, settled to track in behind inside foes just off the rail, weakened on the turn and stretch. NO VISOR raced outside going four to five wide on the turn, came into upper stretch seven deep, failed to menace. TATOOSONMYSOUL broke very awkwardly and bumped a rival, moved forward between foes then stalked from outside runners just off the early leader, moved closer still three to four wide about the three-eighths, came up empty. MCGILL bumped a rival lightly at the start, dropped back between foes to trail into the turn, was asked to pick it up three furlongs out but had no response.

EM CHAMAS was lightly bumped at the start then coaxed to the lead soon after, set the pace near the inside, held sway while being kept to the task. STRIKE A NOTE settled mid-pack near the inside, paused momentarily past the five-sixteenths then was put to urging angling out leaving the turn, came

into upper stretch six wide, kept on to get up for the place without threatening the winner. SHE'S SO CROATIAN was bumped at the start, had forward position tracking inside, moved out when put to urging past the quarter pole, chased the winner home and lost place late. HER OBSESSION settled off the pace near mid-pack outside, took the overland route fanning ten wide into upper stretch, exchanged a light bump at the top of the lane, gained the minor award outside. DANISH COOKIE lacked early speed, saved ground inside at the back through the turn, improved inside. FROGINAPOND lacked early speed, was between foes two to three wide into the turn, ran on passing rivals to improve position. NOYZEE GIRL was forwardly-positioned chasing between foes early, dropped back heading into the turn, angled seven wide leaving that bend, ran on. DAISYCREST bumped a rival just lightly at the start, stalked from off the pace mid-pack, fanned eight to nine wide between foes turning for home, bumped a rival lightly at the top of the stretch, failed to produce a bid. CRUMLIN BEACH got away well, stalked from outside, was ridden past the seven-sixteenths, raced three to five wide, came up empty. AMI'S CRY bumped a rival at the start, dropped back racing outside at the rear into the turn, was not a factor.

P. S. RISING STAR improved inside of horses throughout the initial turn to have the rail sitting in mid-pack down the backstretch, travelled in the two path keeping pace with the lead duo around the second bend, loomed a menacing presence five wide at the top of the lane and grinded past on the outside in the final sixteenth for the win. CANDID CANDACE was isolated watching the loose leader around the first turn and through the backside, started to creep closer in the three path with a quarter mile from home, poked her head in front briefly with runners on each side at the furlong marker, could not fend off the winner in the final sixteenth but did dig in late to save for the place share inside at the wire. THAT GIRL ARTEMUS was brushed outside on the break, stalked just off the fence inside foes close to the back, had little progression inside challengers down the backside, saved ground narrowing the margin on the last bend, hugged the rail in the mix turning for home, shifted out off the lead trio five wide having clear run at the furlong pole and finished up with good late energy to get up for the show award outside. SARATOGA EMPRESS (GB) travelled three wide near the rear on the first turn outside foes, made little headway along the backside, was scrubbed for more picking up the bit three wide between horses at the quarter pole, shifted to the five path for the stretch drive and finished up willingly having runners on either side just losing the three way duel for the place share. MORAL TURPITUDE was hustled from the outside post to set the pace up top getting to the fence around the first bend, was unchallenged going at an even tempo down the back straight, held a slim

advantage clinging up front having the fence on the far turn, offered no resistance when rivals swept past at the eighth and yielded to others in the later stages. LAUGHING OUT LOUD was forced out five wide into the first turn seeing the field, remained at the rear three deep on the outside at the half, could not gain on rivals while going four wide on the last turn and had no finish to give in the stretch running. EMERALD LAKE tossed its head having to be taken up briefly at the start, recovered to track on the fence in the beginning still fighting the rider on the first turn, settled down on the outside to sit in midfield down the backside, was under a ride in the three path trying to just maintain position around the far turn and tired in upper stretch.

FOXY DIVA travelled in the second flight paired up with an outside rival, shifted out at the five sixteenths pole coming to the contesting twosome up front, had a sharp turn of foot three wide at the quarter pole to dart past the lead duo in upper stretch and drew away convincingly in the final furlong for the win. HAY HAY PAULA was allowed to settle at the back of the pack in the early going, co-trailed on the inside with a half mile remaining, narrowed the margin two wide inside horses through the far turn, split runners in the four path with a good late run at the furlong pole and finished up well to best the rest for the runners share at the finish line. FISH MOONEY travelled outside another in mid-division, kept tabs well within range of the engaged pair down the back straight, could not quicken when outside the eventual winner at the midway point of the far turn, swung out widest in the six path for the stretch run and came on to be a clear third at the wire. PURRFECT GIRL had a stalking role ahead of only one runner in the beginning, shared the rear outside of another foe at the half, inched up on the outside of a rival around the last turn, was in tight five wide having to be checked slightly between horses in upper stretch and finished up mildly in the final furlong for a minor placing in the end. TWISTING PISTONS had a head in front from the outside foe while under a snug hold around the first bend, never wavered dueling inside down the back straight and throughout the turn, had no answer on the fence when the winner quickly swept past at the top of the land and wilted inside runners in the final sixteenth. LOOKS LUCKY TO ME pressed the pace on the inside leader on the first turn, battled outside going head to head down the backside, gave way three wide fighting on the lead between horses turning for home, had nothing left to offer and folded by the furlong marker.

MRS. HOT SHOT was under a hard hold just behind the leader on the first turn, rated kindly watching the lead pair down the back straight, was poised in the two path waiting for cue at the five sixteenths pole, burst through runners four wide in upper stretch and was kept to the task to hold on from the late charging outside rival at the finish line. SERENADING AMAYA stalked three wide on the outside of others close to the back, edged up going three deep down the back straight, mounted a rally circling foes four wide at the quarter pole to threaten six wide at the top of the lane, was closing in steadily in deep stretch but it was just a little too late and had to settle for the runners up share at the wire instead. SOMEDAY GIRL was unhurried at the rear in the

beginning, lagged behind along the backside, still could see the field into the far turn, started to come with a rally around foes four wide at the quarter pole, swung out gathering more speed in the seven path turning for home and was full of run four wide in the final furlong to surge in deep stretch to get the show award on the final jump. RADIO GOO GOO hopped up on the break, quickly recouped to have the lead well in hand off the fence into the first turn, controlled a very slow pace along the backside, kept on by a slim margin on the front end around the last turn, could not fend off the winner by the furlong pole and weakened inside drifting out late to just get nabbed for the show money at the wire. POWAQA settled on the outside in mid-division in the early stages, offered a mild run three wide at the quarter pole to be in the mix in the five path for a share in upper stretch, ran on evenly having rivals on each side in the last eighth of a mile and was checked slightly in deep stretch between horses nearing the finish line. DANCING IN RIO had a stalked position on the inside near the rear, closed the gap of the fence down the backstretch by the half, took the short way around the turn looking for running room at the quarter pole and when clear in the two path down the lane failed to fire in the final furlong. TAKE CHANCES settled on the inside of another in the middle of the pack, made little impression in the two path when the running quickened around the far turn, shifted three wide at the top of the lane but could not get involved in the stretch running. SUPER SERENADE tracked the frontrunner outside early out, chased the leader down the backside, was hard ridden trying to get to the pacesetter but to no avail on the last turn, had nothing left for the drive to the wire and emptied out in the four path by the furlong pole.RIDERS CLAIM OF FOUL #6 POWAGA AGAINST #7 RADIO GOO GOO IN DEEP STRETCH WAS DISALLOWED
