WARLORD CRUZAN was brushed slightly on the inside at the start, had a good trip drafting just behind the pacesetter down the back straight, shifted outside in midturn lengthening stride, bid for the lead outside the leader with a quarter mile to run, dueled outside now with two others down the lane and got the better of his stretch rivals in the late going, edging away for the win in the final seventy yards. CANYOUHEARMERUNNIN had the rail stalking ahead of a couple of runners early on, advanced smartly on the fence around the oval, angled out getting a seam in the two path splitting the engaged duo at the top of the stretch making it a three horse affair up top, fought on determinedly between runners to the wire but it just wasn t enough in the final few strides. COUNTRY LIVING broke outwards on the start, emerged from the group to have the advantage along the backside, rolled along uncontested in the early portion of the turn, had company outside by the quarter pole, hugged the rail battling inside at the top of the lane, dug in down the stretch but grudgingly gave way late to be a clear third in the end. ECHO WITH LAUGHTER stalked near the rear in the beginning, narrowed the margin just off the fence around the turn, started to get into gear at the quarter pole, had a chance for a small share three wide straightening out for home, was no threat to the lead trio who had it to themselves in the final furlong and just lasted on the inside to settle on the fringes. ALWAYS A WAY was checked briefly leaving the chute to see the field down the back straight, still lagged behind around the turn, swung out widest in the seven path gathering momentum outside horses at the top of the lane and had good stretch energy trying to close in for a minor share in the end. SHERIF ALI missed the break, leaping up at the start, had a stalking position inside ahead of only one runner down the backstretch, had a sharp turn of foot at the five sixteenths pole reaching for more ground, shifted out four wide coming to the front group at the quarter marker, was full of run in the six path turning for home and stormed home in the final eighth of a mile to get up for the win in the last few jumps under a well timed stretch move. SOULMATE was away alertly to have the rail on the lead, continued up top while pressed outside down the backstretch, narrowly maintained the advantage inside rivals with

a quarter mile from home, spurted clear when called upon on the rail straightened out for the drive, moved well holding at the sixteenth pole but was caught in the last few strides almost getting the job down from start to finish. ELUSIVE KNIGHT settled in mid-pack on the fence, offered little movement down the backside, looked for running room in the two path behind runners at the midpoint of the last turn, skimmed the fence at the top of the stretch and had a good stretch kick inside rivals to be a clear third at the wire. C C'S KINGDOM was unhurried trailing outside in the early stages, started to commence a run three wide midway outside horses on the last turn, loomed widest in the seven path full of run at the top of the stretch, could not sustain the rally through the lane and stalled by the eighth pole. MISTER HOLDEN had a tracking role outside another early on, moved in to hound the pacesetter outside down the back straight, chased in vain making little headway on the frontrunner through the far turn, could not maintain forward position in the three path by upper stretch and had little to offer by the furlong marker. VOLCANIC travelled three wide settling close to the back on the initial turn, made no progression along the backside, could not keep up, being passed on either side to be in last at the five sixteenths pole and could only manage to pick up a couple, e of weary foes in the stretch run. GRANDE SOIREE had a good spot isolated watching the front three rivals in the first half of this two turn race, took closer order three wide in the final bend to be in the conversation in the front mix at the quarter pole, had little to give for the stretch drive and emptied out four wide between foes at the top of the lane.

DISSECTOLOGIST settled off the pace, advanced inside leaving the backstretch, moved out late on the turn gaining on the leader, took over in upper stretch, drew clear, held sway under steady handling. SUPER SICILY shifted in early settling off the pace, moved out on the turn racing between foes coming to the top of the stretch, bid in mid-stretch, took a narrow lead, dueled between foes and held. HOODLESS broke sharp for the early advantage, relinquished the front end settling into a good rhythm down the backside to track the leader three deep at the half, moved forward to bid for the lead outside at the three furlong pole, battled around the turn and down the entire stretch on the outside noses apart in the stretch drive and found that little bit extra nearing the wire to inch away for the hard fought win. ONDINE LADY moved to the lead on the fence by the five eighths pole, dueled inside having the eventual winner to her right throwing in down with each never wavering on the turn, kept finding more on the rail not giving up down the lane but just missed with a gutsy performance inside in the last few strides. DYNAMIC STRIKE settled on the inside of another in midfield, took the short way around the turn starting to lengthen stride at the quarter pole, scraped paint closing the gap in upper stretch, stayed on the incorrect lead to the wire still coming on and won the fight for the third place share while gaining on the lead pair at the finish line as well. CYMBAL COURT tossed its head on the break and was allowed to settle into stride seeing the field down the backside, had no gain on the rail early through the bends shifted outside with a quarter mile still to run, angled five wide at the top of the stretch and had a good late charge outside rivals in the final furlong to settle on the fringes while closing in sharply on the front trio at the wire. GENIUS OF LOVE was situated in the middle of the pack three deep outside foes, moved closer at the three furlong pole travelling three wide, crept up throughout the turn to be in the mix in upper stretch but stalled at the furlong pole finishing up one paced in the late running. FOREST B broke inwards but was quickly straightened out leaving the gate, settled between challengers near the rear down the back straight, travelled three wide on the outside of others making little impression around the bend, angled out to the four path at the top of the lane but l

SWITZLER JAMMIN emerged from the pack to have the lead heading into the backstretch, moved well having little pressure from her closest pursuers around the turn, was let out a notch quite in control with a furlong from home and was kept to the task late to hold comfortably for the gate to wire score. GINGER'S HOLIDAY broke outwards on the break, hounded the pacesetter on the outside down the backside, chased in vain just off the fence around the oval, kept on trying down the stretch, could not threaten the winner in the final furlong but did fight on to win the place share in the final sixteenth of a mile. RUN MATTEO RUN was tucked in on the rail behind the leader, continued to follow the frontrunner around the turn, shifted to the two path in upper stretch in the mix, could not get to the winner who had plenty left at the furlong pole and was outdueled inside another in the final sixteenth of a mile to settle for third money at the wire. DROGON stalked three deep near the back end, edged up three wide on the bend, closed in five wide outside foes at the quarter marker and finished with intent having a good late rally to be a fringe player in the end. EARNING MY EARS hopped up veering onwards on the break, was headstrong close the the rear on the fence in the early going, narrow the margin on the leader by the half, could not gain on runners hugging the rail by midturn, moved closer two wide straightening out for the stretch run but faded late battling between runners for a minor placing in the final furlong. AIM DON'T MISS kept in close view of the lead three rivals while on the inside along the backstretch, ran evenly between foes in the two path on the turn, shifted three wide at the top of the lane, darted to the rail with a furlong remaining but could not get into contention in the late stages. COMMERCIAL VALUE travelled three deep watching the lead trio down the back straight at the half, held her own going three wide outside horses on the bend, moved to the four path turning for home but failed to fire through the lane. SERENADE POINT was away awkwardly soon after the start stalking ahead of only one runner in the early stages, made no progression two wide through the oval, passed a rival on the outside at the quarter marker but could not improve any further in the drive to the wire. MARIACHI LOCO settled between rivals in mid-division, had the fence but going in the wrong direction around the bend and had little to give on the rail in the stret
