LIBERTY BAY had a slim advantage under a snug hold on the rail in the first turn, was content surrendering the lead to press the pace inside along the back straight, got shuffled back on the fence at the five sixteenths pole patiently waiting behind the engaged lead duo, hugged the rail coming to the leaders in upper stretch, shot on through to seize control opening up at the furlong pole and held safe for the win at the finish line. PADRAIG was under a hold on the rail watching the lead pair, dropped back slightly to midfield at the half, waited for the cue to go in the two path at the midway point of the final turn, found a seam five wide turning for home, came with a good run down the lane drifting inwards at the sixteenth pole trying to get to the winner and finished up well to best the rest for the runners up share at the wire. WAHEELA was pushed out on the start, travelled four wide on the first turn stalking near the rear, co-trailed on the outside down the backstretch, closed the gap at the half, made a rally four wide circling around foes at the three furlong pole, briefly had a head in front with a quarter mile to run, loomed four wide at the top of the stretch but evened out with a furlong remaining to be a clear but non-threatening third. NIGHT STRIKER travelled between horses in the second flight in the early stages, kept pace in the three path with runners on both sides midway around the far turn, angled to the six path for the drive to the wire and ran on mildly to get up for a minor placing. ARRAKASTA IZAN was unhurried trailing the field early on, shared the rear inside down the backside, remained at the rear going two to three wide on the last bend, swung out widest in the seven path with the entire field spread across at the top of the lane but could not offer an outside rally in the stretch running. GLORIOUS REVENGE hounded the pace on the outside in the beginning, had a narrow advantage on the outside down the backstretch, dueled inside others through the second turn, was just holding onto the lead two wide at the top of the stretch with rivals bearing down on either side, could not find more late and tired at the furlong marker. RACHAEL'S WAGON broke out on the start, had a outside tracking position three wide on the first turn, settled three deep in the second flight down the backside, moved in making a bid three wide at the three furlong pole, vied up front between foes with a quarter mile to go, gave way fighting on the front end three wide in upper stretch and wilted by the furlong marker.

POCKET SPEED had a clear advantage while in hand on the fence at the half, comfortably opened up in midturn, was well in control in mid-stretch and cruised home for the frontrunning tally. BIG SCREEN BOSS had a good spot nestled on the rail in the tracking flight early on, edged up on the fence by the five sixteenths pole, angled three wide straightening for home in the mix, was no match for the winner by the furlong pole and finished up determinedly getting the better of others for the secondary share at the finish line. SAMMYSAURUS REX had a slow start but recouped to prompt the pace outside down the backstretch, chased the winner but to no avail throughout the turn, dueled for the runners up share in the two path at the top of the lane with the winner long gone ahead, drifted to the fence at the furlong pole and ran on willingly to hold for the show money. AWESOME BEAT was off a step slow to be on the rail part of the rear trio down the backside, took the short way around the turn, started to reach for more ground on the fence at the quarter pole, scraped paint coming with a rally turning for home, altered course three wide at the furlong marker and ran on mildly just coming short of closing in for the third place share at the wire. BEE ME was pushed in by the outside foe at the break, co-trailed between runners down the backside, made little headway three wide around the oval, shifted to the five path turning for home but could not get involved. SUNSET SKIPPY was taken up briefly soon after the start, recovered to track on the outside of another watching the engaged duo at the half, was hard ridden in the two path between rivals at the three-furlong pole going in the wrong direction around the turn and could not factor in the late running. DANCING SHAMAN broke inwards on the start, shared the back while three deep outside a couple of foes down the back straight, offered a brief run three wide at the three furlong pole but stalled between foes by the quarter marker and came up empty for the stretch drive.

BALBONI'S CREW was bumped a couple times at the break bobbling slightly in the process, altered in when forced in tight quarters and moved forward inside, tracked the leader, was encouraged along three furlongs out, moved out in range leaving the turn and under further urging, drove through the stretch taking command past the furlong marker and kicked clear. SEEKING MAGIC sped clear, set the pace inside, was no match but second best. FULL STAR had a few bumps at the start, settled in behind inside a foe but off the fence into the turn, moved out fanning five wide into upper stretch, kept on to be best of the rest. HOT POTATO trailed outside going two to three wide into the turn, trailed on that bend, advanced past a foe then shifted in a bit leaving the turn, improved position inside. CELESTIAL HEART bumped with a rival at the start, stalked from outside, fanned six wide into upper stretch and weakened. NIKA'S PASSION was outpaced early racing outside, came out six to seven wide in the stretch, was never near enough to threaten. SOMETHING FAST chased three wide early and into the turn, floated out a path leaving that bend, came up empty. RUM TALK stumbled at the start, angled in early, was ridden along late up the backstretch but had no response.

CHANCEL was hustled from the outer post getting to the rail on the front end around the first turn, slowed the tempo down uncontested down the backside, rambled on still loose on the far turn, finally was set down two wide at the top of the stretch and had more in the stretch drive to easily win by a good margin at the wire for the gate to wire score. PET SOUNDS was allowed to settle into stride on the fence having only one runner beaten on the first turn, travelled three deep in the third flight outside foes at the half starting to come with a run, moved back to the rail going past another runner at the five sixteenths pole, weaved back outside three wide still with a good sustained rally with a quarter left to run and kept on trying in the four path down the lane having a strong late charge on the outside to be second best behind the runaway frontrunner. NONNO'S LITTLE BOY had a stalking position on the rail ahead of a couple of runners early on, made little movement down the backstretch, had to be throttled down losing its run on the fence at the seven sixteenths pole, commenced a rally picking up rivals outside midway on the far turn and finished up with good stretch energy inside foes on the rail down the lane to capture

the show award while almost getting up late for the place share too. MAXIMUS MAGIC had the fence watching the front two challengers on the first turn, inched up gaining position on the fence at the three furlong marker, came under a drive still battling in the two path with a quarter mile still remaining and finished up evenly between foes to be a fringe player in the end. FAIRWAY TO HEAVEN kept a close eye on the lead pair while just off the fence in the early stages, rallied outside horses at the three-furlong pole, tried to close in on the frontrunner on the far turn but was repelled by the quarter pole, drifted inwards by mid-stretch clinging to the place share but faded between runners in the last sixteenth of a mile. CABERNAYDO could see the field on the first turn, lagged behind down the back straight, could not progress through the final turn, angled out to the four path turning for home and passed tired inside rivals in the final furlong. GENDRAGON tracked the leader in the two path on the first turn, chased the pacesetter down the backside, could not quicken with others making a run at the three-furlong pole back pedaling around the final bend and had nothing more to offer in the five path outside horses in the stretch run. SUGAR IT'S ELI was isolated in mid-pack in the early stages, was roused but started to regress at the three eighths marker weakening throughout the turn and emptied out in upper stretch.

BLITZ was hustled in the beginning to get the lead and the fence going under the wire for the first time, rolled along setting a brisk pace while shadowed outside down the backstretch, maintained a slim lead on the fence throughout the far turn, still was clinging onto the lead inside foes two wide

straightening out for home, shortened stride staying on the incorrect lead giving way up front at the furlong pole but did fight on to last for a minor share in the end. FOR FLYING (BRZ) broke out on the start, argued between rivals up front down the stretch for the first time, kept a close eye on the front two around the first bend, moved in on the outside to prompt the issue down the backstretch, dueled between runners at the five sixteenths pole, remained in the thick of things four wide with challengers on each side turning for home, could not find more late and yielded by the furlong pole. LONG AGO (GB) broke inwards on the break, was isolated in mid-division around the first turn, settled into stride between runners down the backstretch in the second flight at the half, was asked for more run to keep up to the lead group midway on the second turn, offered little response and failed to menace three wide in the stretch running.

PONDERING was hard held having an ideal trip watching the contesting pair on the fence down the backside, remained on the rail tracking the now embattled trio at the three furlong pole waiting to pounce, was nudged on at the quarter pole starting to lengthen stride, angled out to the five path in full flight in upper stretch, powered past rivals at the sixteenth pole and edged clear for the win when crossing the finish line. CAITLINHERGRTNESS pulled the rider along the backside while three deep watching the engaged duo at the half, moved in three wide at the three furlong marker, edged away to a clear advantage with a quarter mile still to run, battled in the four path between foes at the top of the lane, poked her head in front with a furlong to the wire but could not fend off the winners late charge on the outside in the final seventy yards. LOVE CERVERE was unhurried at the rear down the backstretch, started to get into gear splitting rivals five wide at the quarter pole with a sharp turn of foot, swung out widest in the eight path full of run but having much to do at the top of the stretch and stormed home outside foes to get up for the third place share in the final few jumps closing the fastest at the finish line. UPHILL DANCE travelled four deep ahead of a few rivals down the back straightaway, edged up around runners going three to four wide at the midpoint of the turn, angled out in the seven path in upper stretch, kept on coming to the end and just missed dueling inside for the show award at the finish line. SHOTGUN WEDDING travelled four deep in mid-division at the half, had a good move circling around foes four wide at the three-furlong pole, continued the rally through the turn to be in with a shot six wide in upper stretch, ran on willingly to the furlong pole but needed more late when relinquishing the third spot inside of a couple of rivals in deep stretch. SERENE SERAPH (IRE) broke out on the start, settled in a clustered midfield having the two path down the backside, made a brief rally three wide between foes at the five sixteenths pole, dropped back at the quarter marker and stubbornly resurged four wide in the stretch to pass many rivals in the final furlong. TRICKY TEMPER was brushed on the inside at the break, had the rail forwardly placed behind the front group midway down the backside, was steadied in tight on the fence coming up to the three-furlong marker, got back into gear showing grit closing the gap in the stretch run but could not get into contention. STORMCAST was away alertly to dictate terms down the backside, maintained a slim lead on the fence at the three eighths pole, surrendered the top spot to an outside rival at the quarter marker, determinedly dug back two wide inside horses straightening out for the drive dueling up front, could not offer a finish in the late going and wilted between foes in the last sixteenth of a mile. BOLT ENOREE settled in mid-pack in the two path between rivals down the backstretch, kept pace taking the shortest way around the oval, skimmed the fence fighting inside for a piece of the prize at the top of the lane but faded on the rail at the sixteenth pole. A LITTLE FRISKY kept tabs on the front guartet with rivals on either side down the back straight, took closer order three wide between foes at the five sixteenths pole having the eventual winner to her inside around the bend, lost her path forced to angle inwards to the three path still in the mix taking the corner, could not find more in the late stages and yielded by the sixteenth pole. GOLDEN CANARY broke outwards on the start, settled close to the back on the outside having one rival beaten down the back straight, held her own four wide early on the turn, was forced out six wide at the quarter pole losing momentum to be at the back of the pack at the top of the lane and could only manage to pass tired runners in the stretch run. MO FOX GIVIN stalked inside another ahead of only one runner in the early going, could not keep up to rivals on the turn to be at the rear with a quarter mile from home and showed little in the five path in the stretch drive. LES REYS (FR) was under a tight hold on the fence close to the back end in the beginning, offered a mild run just off the rail midway around the oval, stalled by the quarter pole and had no finish between horses down the lane. DOLCE SOPRESA pressed the pace on the outside in the early stages, moved up to bid between foes up front in the two path at the three furlong pole, could not hold forward position by midturn, backed away through the field around the bend and came up empty four wide in upper stretch and cantered home.

# Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

AMERICAN WOMEN rated kindly in midfield between horses down the backside, patiently waited behind runners from the five sixteenths pole to the quarter marker, shot through finding a seam three wide at the top of the stretch having aim on the pacesetter, was full of run late and drove by taking the lead at the sixteenth pole outside to win going away at the finish line. HOME FOR A REST stalked on the rail near the back end, crept up taking the short way around in hand midway on the turn, shifted out off a tiring foe two wide at the quarter pole, had a good late run in the three path down the stretch drive and with one final push, surged between rivals nabbing the place share right at the wire. SALT stalked four deep ahead of only one runner in the early going, started to come with a run four wide outside rivals at the five sixteenths pole, swooped around foes with a sharp turn of foot at the quarter pole to be eight wide with a full head of steam turning for home, was gaining steadily outside foes down the stretch but just missed in a three way finish for the runners up share at the wire settling for the show money instead. GIVE ME THE BOOTS dueled inside at the beginning for the top spot, edged away for a clear advantage on the fence at the half, opened up setting a brisk pace in midturn, still was well in control just off the fence in upper stretch, had no answer when the winner sailed on by at the sixteenth pole and faded inside runners in deep stretch getting nailed late losing the place and show award right at the finish line. ANAM CARA settled close to the back of the pack between foes in the three path down the backstretch, made little headway three wide between rivals running around the turn, shifted to the four path for the drive to the wire and finished up mildly inside horses in the last eighth of a mile. TWO SIP SALLY settled four deep outside foes watching the front four runners along the backside, closed the gap outside horses five wide in midturn, briefly drifted in under a ride at the quarter pole to be in the hunt four wide in upper stretch, had little left for the stretch run and yielded by the sixteenth pole. FOURFIFTYFOUR stalled near the runners with rivals on either side, made little impression three wide between horses throughout the turn and had no rally to offer in the three path for the stretch running. SOUNDS PRACTICAL was off slowly lagging behind the group down the back straight, offered a brief rally splitting foes four wide at the quarter pole, angled to the six path between horses at the top of the stretch but had no finishing kick to give in the final furlong. TAKEMYBOURBONNEAT was under a vigorous ride early on being hustled from the start with intent on the lead, was taken back inside by the five furlong marker watching the lead pair down the backstretch, chased the leader in the two path around the turn making no gain, stopped on the fence at the furlong pole and was wrapped up on in the last sixteenth of a mile. NEVER SILENT was roused at the start to sit in mid-pack on the fence by the half, edged up on the fence saving ground on the turn while scrubbed on midway around the bend, scraped paint turning for home but folded by the furlong marker. MIRAMICHI travelled in mid-division with runners on each side at the half, kept pace three wide between horses at the five sixteenths pole, had to be checked in tight in the four path at the quarter pole and tired five wide in upper stretch. KIKITSA hounded the pace outside down the backstretch, chased the leader three wide at the three-furlong marker, backed away abruptly through the field at the guarter pole and cantered down the stretch crossing the finish line.
