VOODOO DOLL had the rail position tracking the frontrunner early on, settled nicely inside another keeping a close eye on the contesting pair around the turn, skimmed the fence with run turning for home closing by the furlong pole, angled out three wide outside rivals fighting for the lead with a sixteenth remaining and found another gear late getting his head down just at the right time at the wire for the victory in a tight photo. BRACHETTO had a poor beginning breaking a step slow then having to be taken up briefly with the outside rivals bearing in soon after the start, lagged well behind finding his stride down the backside, closed the gap smartly just off the rail on the turn by the quarter pole, looked for clear running room two wide at the top of the lane, rallied up the fence at the eighth pole, shifted out in the two path coming on in deep stretch between horses and just missed with his gutsy performance at the finish line losing a tight bob at the wire for the win. FLYONBYE was away alertly loose on the front end heading into the backstretch, had company outside pressing the pace at the half, battled inside throughout the bend, edged away on the fence from the early speed rival at the top of the lane to have a clear advantage with a furlong to go, still was holding on by a diminishing margin inside at the sixteenth pole but was no match for the top two in deep stretch and finished up a clear third at the wire. STRÜCK GOLD was bumped by the outside foe on the break, had an inside stalking role down the back straight, made little movement for position around the oval but narrowed the margin on the leader outside of runners by the quarter pole, swung out widest in the five path for the drive to the wire and finished up evenly down the lane to capture a minor placing in the end. ADA CLARE had a outside stalking role down the back straight, improved at the half to be on the outside of another watching the embattled duo around the turn, shifted out four wide in the mix up top straightening out for home but failed to fire in the final furlong. MOR JOE'S SPIRIT broke inwards on the start, tracked the pacesetter three deep early on, moved in by the half mile marker to force the pace outside along the backside, dueled outside going head to head throughout the turn, gave way up top in the three path with runners on each side in upper stretch and wilted by the furlong pole having little left from his early efforts fighting on the lead.

KAVALA settled between rivals in mid-division at the half, made little headway in the early part of the turn, started to lengthen stride with a quarter mile from home, was coming to the leader in the two path in upper stretch and powered past at the sixteenth pole taking command drawing off convincingly at the wire. ALA TURKA broke tardily at the start, improved through the backstretch to sit in midfield in hand at the half, had a sharp turn of foot moving in on the fence at the five sixteenths pole, scraped paint pouncing to the lead straightening out for the drive but could not find more late, unable to fend off the charge by the winner in deep stretch still safely besting the rest for the second position when crossing the finish line. BRAZILIAN LEGACY traded bumps with the outside runner at the start, had the rail near the rear down the back straight, co-trailed on the inside with three eighths remaining, started to mount a rally

reaching for more ground at the quarter pole and closed in belatedly having a rail rally down the lane to be a non-threatening third at the wire. GOOGLY EYES had runners on either side while keeping a close eye on the lead pair along the backside, held position while scrubbed on three wide between challengers around the oval, had a chance five wide at the top of the stretch for a piece of the prize and ran on mildly to be a fringe player at the finish. NIGHTSABER (GB) chased the pacesetter inside in the early going, got her head in front while on the fence at the half, opened up midway on the turn, relinquished the lead three wide to an inside rival in upper stretch and drifted out considerably when weakening in the final furlong. GATHER stalked close to the back three deep outside of foes, put in a mild run four wide around rivals at the five sixteenths pole, angled out six wide turning for home but lacked a finish in the stretch running. CRUMLIN BEAST was away slowly seeing the field down the back straight, caught up to a rival outside at the three furlong marker, had a brief run when roused closing the gap four wide at the quarter pole, swung out widest to the seven path in upper stretch but failed to menace in the drive to the wire. SEATTLE SIGNAL broke sharp to be loose on the lead in the beginning, surrendered the front to an inside rival at the half, backed away abruptly through exchanged bumps with the inside rival on the break, settled three deep watching the lead duo along the backstretch, kept pace with others while travelling four wide outside foes in midturn, had little for the stretch run and faltered in the four path in the late running.

BLACK GODDESS was urged to the lead early, shifted in, set the pace in the clear, faced just minor presence of a rival in pursuit near the three-eighths then shook clear of that one, drew off and extended the margin in the stretch, held safe. SUNNYVILLE was in a bit tight entering the first turn, switched out off the inside five to six wide for the run up the backstretch, advanced some, moved out seven wide leaving the far turn, was no match for the winner but second best. SISTER MARJORIE chased from inside on or just off the rail, steadily dropped back into and early on the far turn, tipped out coming into upper stretch and kept on in the lane to secure show honors. CONQUER THE STORM was caught four wide into the first turn racing in the back half, advanced steadily but gradually up the backstretch and far turn, was under urging three furlongs out, angled out turning into upper stretch bumping a rival, kept on late from between foes to get the nod for minor award. LOVE TO DREAM was in a bit tight early entering the first turn, raced inside on or just off the rail mid-pack, steadily dropped back to be last on the far turn but saving ground, came out in mid-stretch and finished willingly between foes. FLIGHTMARE switched out off the rail racing at the back, fanned six wide into upper stretch, was never a threat. HEY NIAMH chased mid-pack two to three wide, dropped back and faded. PRIZED SPIRIT bumped with a rival at the start, was off the pace toward the rear outside two to four wide, made no impact. CRUMLIN MISSION broke outwardly, was caught six then five wide on the first turn, shifted in a bit further moving forward up the backstretch, chased mid-pack, retreated between foes.

LOIS LEN took control right from the onset, had an uncontested lead at the half going comfortably, cruised along having little pressure applied by rivals through the turn and under a well rationed ride had more when called upon in the final furlong to safely cross the finish line for the gate to wire score. LADY MOONSHINE settled on the inside in mid-pack down the backstretch, edged up under a snug hold on the fence by midturn, shifted out off the leader coming with a run at the quarter pole, loomed three wide between horses turning for home and determinedly chased the winner in vain through the stretch. MITOLE POWER travelled outside another in midfield down the back straightaway, advanced gingerly between runners three wide having the loose horse on its outside throughout the turn, was in the hunt four wide outside the lead two rivals straightening out for the drive and ran on willingly in stretch to last for the show money at the wire. I HAVE AN IDEA had a stalking trip ahead of a couple of horses down the back straight, made little progression just off the fence

around the bend and while in the five path for the drive finished up one paced down the lane to garner a minor placing in the end. KATHERINE'S GEM shared the rear outside a couple of runners early on, could see the field with a half mile remaining, picked up a challenger moving on the outside at the quarter pole two wide and could only manage to pass a weary foe while running on the rail at the furlong marker. ROYAL PRESENCE settled off the pace outside, advanced four wide on the far turn, took a narrow lead at the top of the stretch, was joined by an outside rival, dueled inside that one bumping lightly nearing the wire and held that foe to prevail. AFLEET FLATTER shifted in to the rail early, settled off the pace saving ground, bided time on the far turn till the five-sixteenths then was asked for more while being guided out, swung five wide turning into upper stretch, engaged the leader near mid-stretch, dueled with that one, had minor contact late and was fended off. HELLO STRANGER got away well then was taken back off the leading pair heading to the first turn, switched out off the rail settling off the leaders two wide, waited just briefly in behind foes late on the far turn, found room up the rail at the top of the stretch, got through there but was outkicked by outside foes while best of the rest. KAMASI was prominent heading to the first turn then taken back off the pace to track in behind near but just off the rail, was within range heading into the far turn, moved out three wide and was asked for more coming past the quarter pole, weakened in the stretch. LOVER BOY MO was up close early chasing two to three wide, continued to pursue mid-pack, swung out a bit leaving the far turn, failed to rally. STRAWBERRY AGAIN bumped a rival at the start, settled at the rear, saved ground and ran on mildly inside late. ONEHOTMESS was bumped at the start, moved forward outside the second flight three wide heading into the first turn then moved closer taking the lead after a quarter and clear soon after, dictated terms from just off the rail up the backstretch, was overtaken by the top of the stretch, faltered and faded. SALTED set the early pace from off the fence, ceded that lead to another foe to stalk in behind, was three wide in range on the far turn, asked for more but had no late response and faded.

AWE INSPIRED was isolated in mid-pack rating kindly through the first turn and along the backside, advanced inside of horses making a sharp move on the fence at the quarter pole, shifted to the two path at the top of the lane posing the main opposition at the furlong pole and drove by a leg weary leader outside in the final sixteenth of a mile to win going away in the end for the win. KING PUTT had the lead on the inside going into the first turn, continued up top top setting a brisk pace while shadowed outside down the back straightaway, edged away from the other early speed runner by the three eighths pole, still maintained a comfortable advantage but was shortening stride on the incorrect lead in mid-stretch and could not fend off the winner outside at the sixteenth pole all the while saving for the place share at the wire. MONDAY MORNING broke outwards but was quickly straightened out on the break, had the inside position well back off the embattled duo down the back straightaway, started to reel in the lead twosome just off the fence at the quarter pole, moved in to be in the thick of things four wide between rivals at the top of the stretch and closed belatedly through the lane in the final furlong to get up for the show money at the wire. PERFECT PLAY settled at the rear heading into the first bend, lagged well behind with the field spread out down the backstretch, moved closer but could not gain position taking the short way on the final turn, hugged the rail passing a rival at the top of the lane and found his best stride late on the fence in the final furlong to be a fringe player at the finish line. GUARD OF HONOUR prompted the issue outside in the beginning, hounded the frontrunner

while separating themselves from the field setting a brisk tempo down the backstretch, could not continue on with the pacesetter at the three eighths marker, dueled for the secondary share between horses three wide in upper stretch, had little left late and faded in the final furlong. FINAL RUN FOR LOVE stalked close to the back on the rail with the field strung out down the backstretch, came under a ride between foes two wide making little impression around the far turn and could not get into contention just off the rail in the stretch running. ALTA CALIBRE kept a close eye on the contesting trio while inside another for the first half of this route race, pounced three wide easily going to the lead around the embattled pair midway on the final turn, opened up at will in the two path in upper stretch and drew off with authority for the win in the final furlong. BAYTOWN STORM was isolated in midfield in the early stages, began to lengthen stride swooping four wide around horses midway on the far turn, posed the only threat in the five path at the top of the stretch, could not get to the long gone winner by the furlong pole and ran on well enough to be a distant second best at the wire. BUFF BAY settled close to the back on the outside, made no progress outside of runners down the back straight, started to uncork a run three wide around rivals at the three furlong pole, continued with the sustained run five wide down the lane outside horses and surged between runners winning a tight three way finish for the show money at the wire. HURRICANE GIZMO was antsy in stall prior to the start, missed the break trailing the field early on, was unhurried at the back end along the backside, started to go by rivals outside at the five sixteenths pole, angled to the four path for the stretch run, came with a good rally outside challengers in the final furlong and just missed getting up for the third place share at the finish, settling for a minor role in the end instead. MCKENZIE ROAD had a narrow advantage on the rail on the first turn, lost the lead briefly inside two others entering the backstretch, rebid to take command again at the half, battled inside up top at the three furlong pole, offered no resistance when the winner swept past three wide getting the lead at the five sixteenths pole, tried to dig in on the fence holding for the runners up share in mid-stretch but tired in the final seventy yards losing a couple of positions late. SULTRY SOPHIE tracked in the second flight going three wide outside foes on the first turn, kept pace watching the lead trio at tbe half, was under a ride three wide inside another but could not close the gap on the lead threesome on the final turn, skimmed the fence with a chance for a minor share in the stretch running but faded inside at the furlong marker. BLING D'MONEY HOME vied between rivals on the first turn, continued to press the pace with foes on either side down the backstretch, was no match when the winner stormed by on the outside at the five sixteenths marker taking over control and wilted in the three path by mid-stretch. ECLIPTICAL LADYBUG stalked close to the back having the rail, settled on the fence down the backside ahead of only one runner, saved ground making little headway on the far turn and could not be a factor in the late running. HELANA prompted the pace four wide around the initial bend, improved outside to poke her head in front at the five eighths marker outside two rivals, gave way unable to continue on up top by the half, retreated steadily through the pack on the final turn, lost touch with the field by upper stretch and galloped home.
