SOUPER CALIBER was content to sit back off the frontrunner in the beginning, rated kindly always keeping a close eye on the leader down the backstretch, patiently started to reel in the pacesetter with just a nudge of the riders hands at the five sixteenths pole, glided to the lead three wide taking control in upper stretch, opened up effortlessly at the furlong pole and coasted home for the impressive win under only a hand ride. COMPUTER HACKER moved well in hand getting his head in front outside leaving the chute, shook loose by the half, increased the advantage on the turn with the rider still in the saddle and under a well rationed out ride had more when called upon at the furlong pole to hold sway for the front running win. SPARKLET was situated on the fence part of the rear foursome down the back straight, started to get into gear at the quarter pole mounting a rally, hugged

the rail coming with a strong run straightening out for home and charged home inside rivals late to get up right at the wire for the runners up share. THE NEW MAYBE had a good spot keeping a close eye on the lead three runners down the backstretch, commenced a rally three wide between horses at the five sixteenths pole, loomed boldly three wide outside the front duo at the top of the stretch, could not get to the winner by the furlong pole and stalled slightly in the late going, getting nabbed inside for the place share at the finish line. COHERENCE stalked in the two path with rivals on either side close to the back end, narrowed the margin inside of runners at the five sixteenths pole looking for running room, had a clear lane two widest at the top of the land and ran on evenly to the wire to capture a minor placing. PLAY THE DOTS had the three path near the rear between runners along the backside, offered little movement three wide between horses around the bend and could not get involved in the stretch running. FASCINATION STREET was hustled at the start pressing the issue just inside the leader in the early going, tracked the pacesetter inside another at the half, was under a busy ride on the rail through the turn unable to gain on the winner, still was in the mix two widest for a share at the top of the lane but weakened by the sixteenth pole. MAGIC SLIPS travelled three deep, outside two others in mid-division, kept pace while four wide outside rivals midway on the turn but could not find more in drive to the wire, failing to fire in the final furlong. PANYARD TAP settled three deep keeping a close eye on the front three rivals down the backstretch, tracked the frontrunner outside at the half, was under a ride chasing the winner midway on the turn making no gain, backed away through the field three widest the quarter pole and faltered five wide in upper stretch. ACTION POINT travelled four deep being part of the back quartet early on, tried to circle four to five wide around foes but made little headway on the turn, swung out widest in the six path for the drive but could not be a factor in the late stages. MILITARY FORCE was under a snug hold in the latter part of midfield down the backside, made a good move around horses three wide improving position at the five sixteenths pole, angled out to the four path with a chance outside of the leaders at the top of the stretch, kept coming on through the lane and powered past in deep stretch for the win. BOLD RELOAD traded bumps with the inside rival on the break, recovered to sit behind the engaged duo midway along the backside, vied between horses up front at the three eighths pole, seized control two wide in upper stretch, was just holding on coming to the sixteenth pole inside but could not fend off the late charge by the winner nearing the wire. BLAZING BO was up close four deep watching the front three horses in the beginning, took closer order to prompt the pace three wide at the three furlong pole through the turn, remained in the hunt two wide at the top of the stretch, battled stubbornly on the rail up top with a sixteenth from home but needed more late and had to settle for the show money at the wire. WILBERFORCE had a good position with runners on each side watching the contesting duo, moved in closer in the two path in midturn, had the rail in the mix at the top of the stretch looking for a seam, had to shift out three wide off the tiring frontrunner by the sixteenth pole lacking running room and could recover in time to play a role late. VALLEY VICTORY had the rail position in midfield, was in tight quarters having to be checked leaving the seven sixteenths pole to be shuffled back midway on the turn, shifted out three wide at the quarter marker starting to re-rally and had good late interest outside horses in the final furlong trying to close in for a minor role. MORE MONEY HUNNY contently let the loose leader go on with it down the back straight while sitting in the second position, methodically started to reel in the frontrunner inside another two wide at the quarter pole, moved in turning for home, poked her head in front on the outside at the furlong marker and edged clear for the win in deep stretch. FIRECRACKER FIONA shot away on the fence for a clear advantage down the backstretch, rolled along unchallenged on the turn but with the lead diminishing by the quarter pole, was clinging onto the front end inside coming to the eighth pole, could not match strides with the winner in the final furlong but did finish up well enough to comfortably best the rest for the runners share at the wire. STEALIN'TIME had a good trip under a hold watching the top two runners along the backside, rode the rail creeping closer through the turn, shifted to the three path for the drive to the wire, could not threaten the front duo with a furlong remaining but did have late energy to capture the show award at the finish line. ROCKET RILEY stalked three deep close to the back in the beginning, had a good rally starting three wide at the three furlong marker circling around rivals in the turn to pose a threat in the six path at the top of the stretch, could not sustain the run evening out by the furlong marker but still managed to pick up a weary runner late at the wire for a minor award. OUTFORARIP assumed command while in hand between runners down the backstretch, opened up at will midway on the turn for a commanding lead, was well in control on the fence in mid-stretch and held safe at the wire for the front running score. DANCIN MARY MARIE settled on the rail in the middle of the pack, picked up the bit going three wide outside of horses in midturn, continued three wide in the mix at the top of the lane, was full of run late closing in with every stride on the leader in the final furlong but it wasn?t enough to get to the winner at the wire. CLOSING APPEAL hopped slightly on the start, recovered quickly to track the lead duo early on, was scrubbed on for more having the rail with the winner getting away on the turn by the quarter pole, moved to the two path for the drive, could not keep up to the front pair by the furlong marker but did dig in the outside to win the battle for the show money in the final few strides. RYO AMAZING travelled between rivals in midfield, had a good rally in the two path inside challengers at the five sixteenths pole, skimmed the fence in the conversation for a small share turning for home, had no chance for the top two spots by the eighth pole, dueled inside for the show money in deep stretch but settled for a minor placing in the end. RACE DAY CHANCE settled on the outside of two others going three deep in midfield down the backside, her her own travelling three wide outside foes keeping pace on the bend, moved inwards to the two path for the stretch run and ran on mildly to the wire. CHARITY FIRST stalked close to the back while outside another, made little impression throughout the turn and could not get involved three wide in the later stages. RELOAD BABA chased the frontrunner on the outside along the back straight, could not keep up to the winner at the five sixteenths pole, shifted out four wide still with a chance for a piece of the prize outside rivals in upper stretch, could not find more late and wilted in the final furlong.
